RCP dominant L bursting from 16 to 25 MHz. No modulation lanes visible.

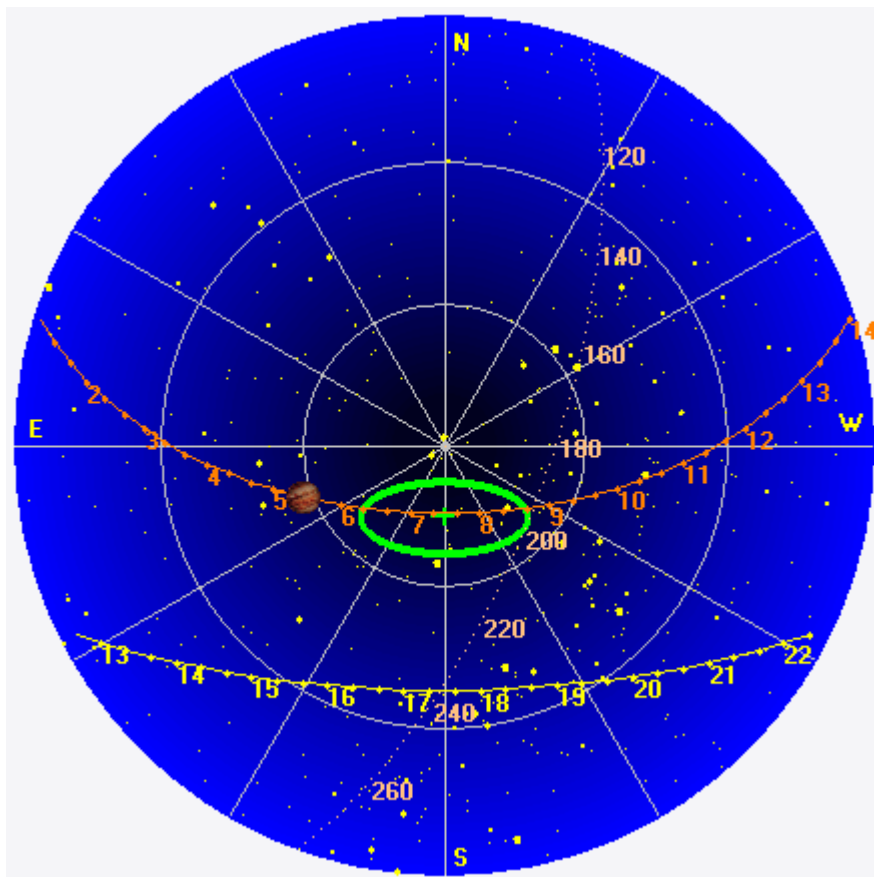
Jupiter was -42° to -16° off axis.

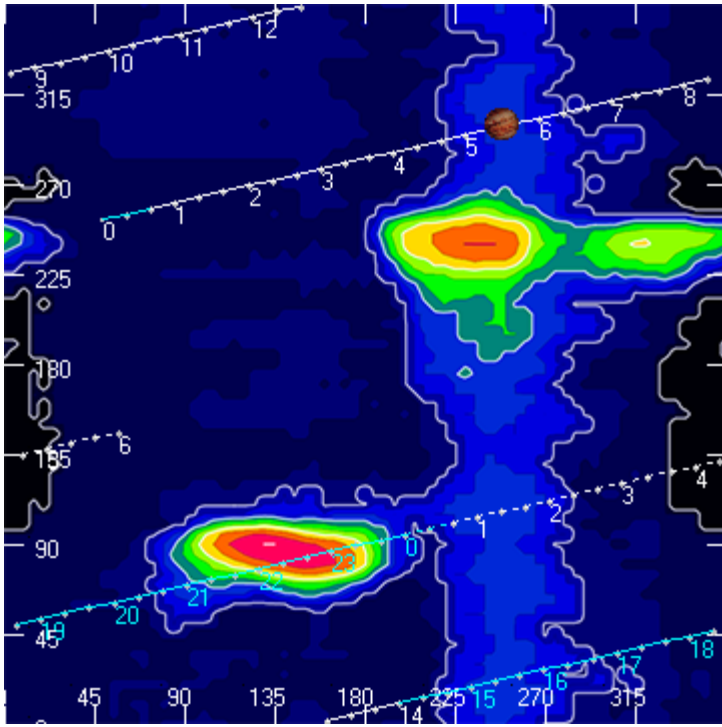
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 153° .

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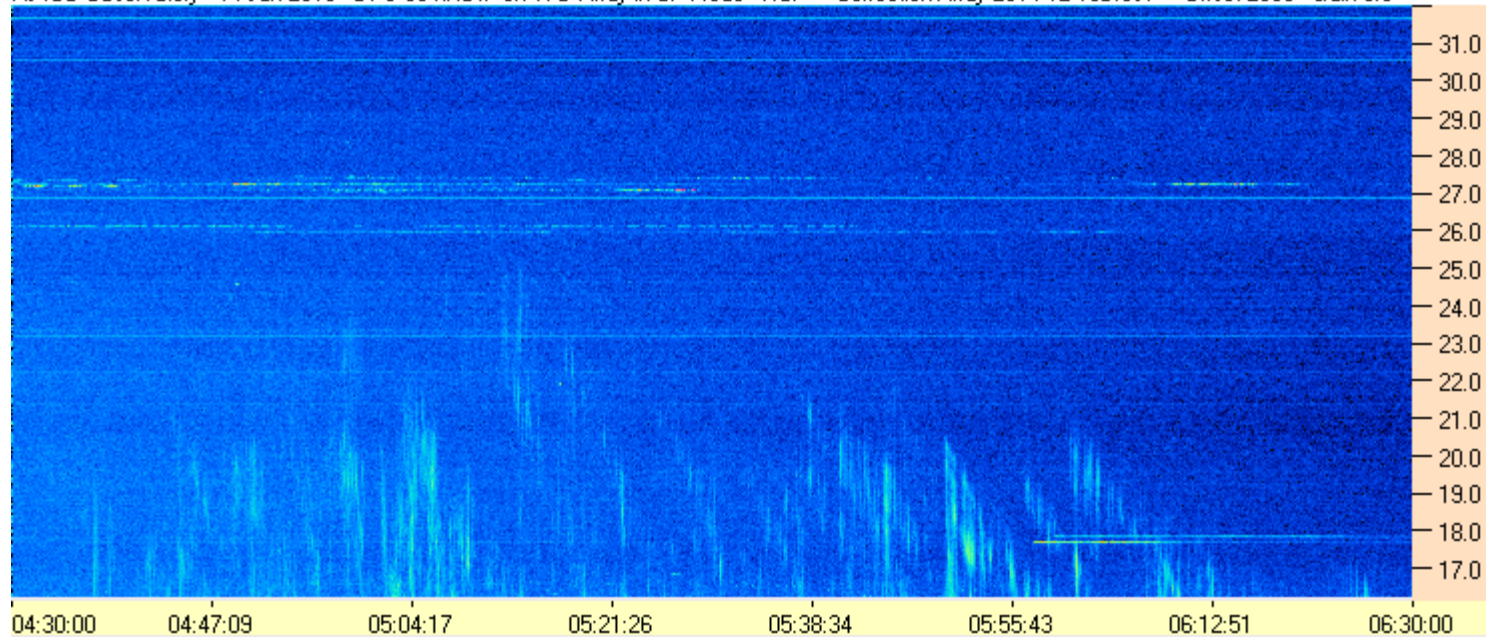

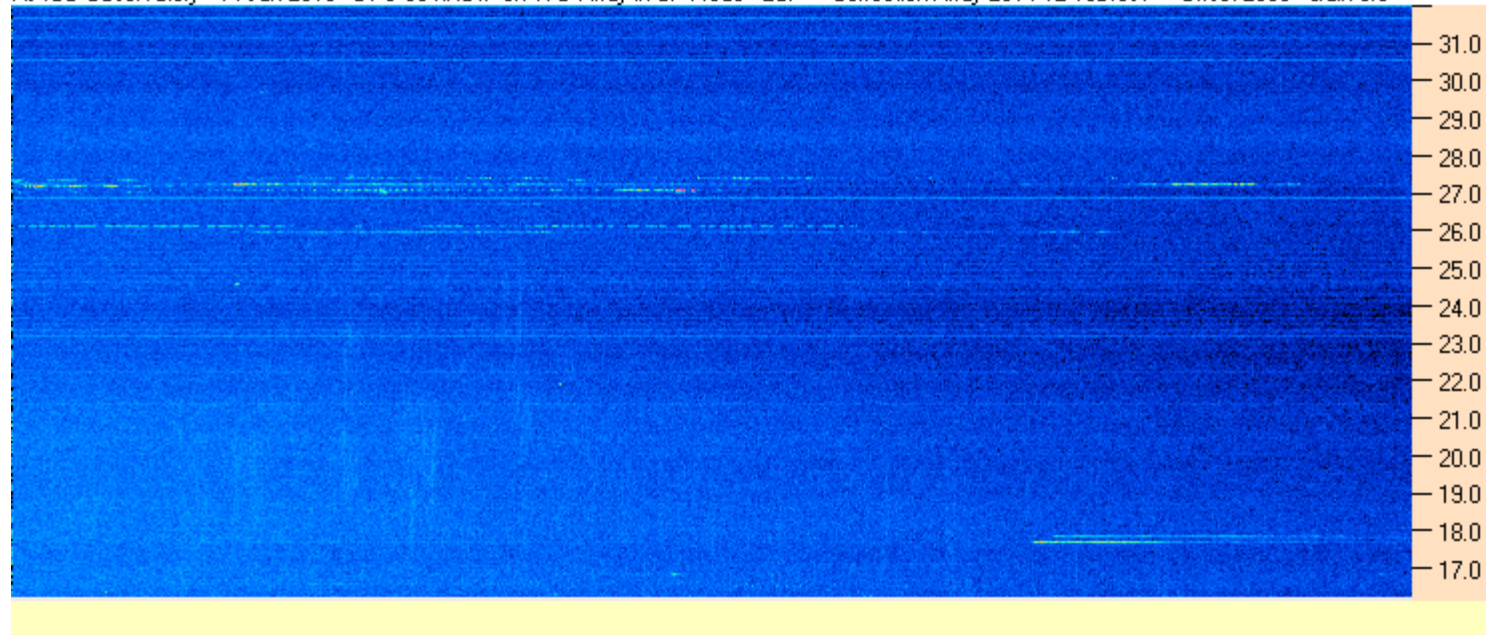

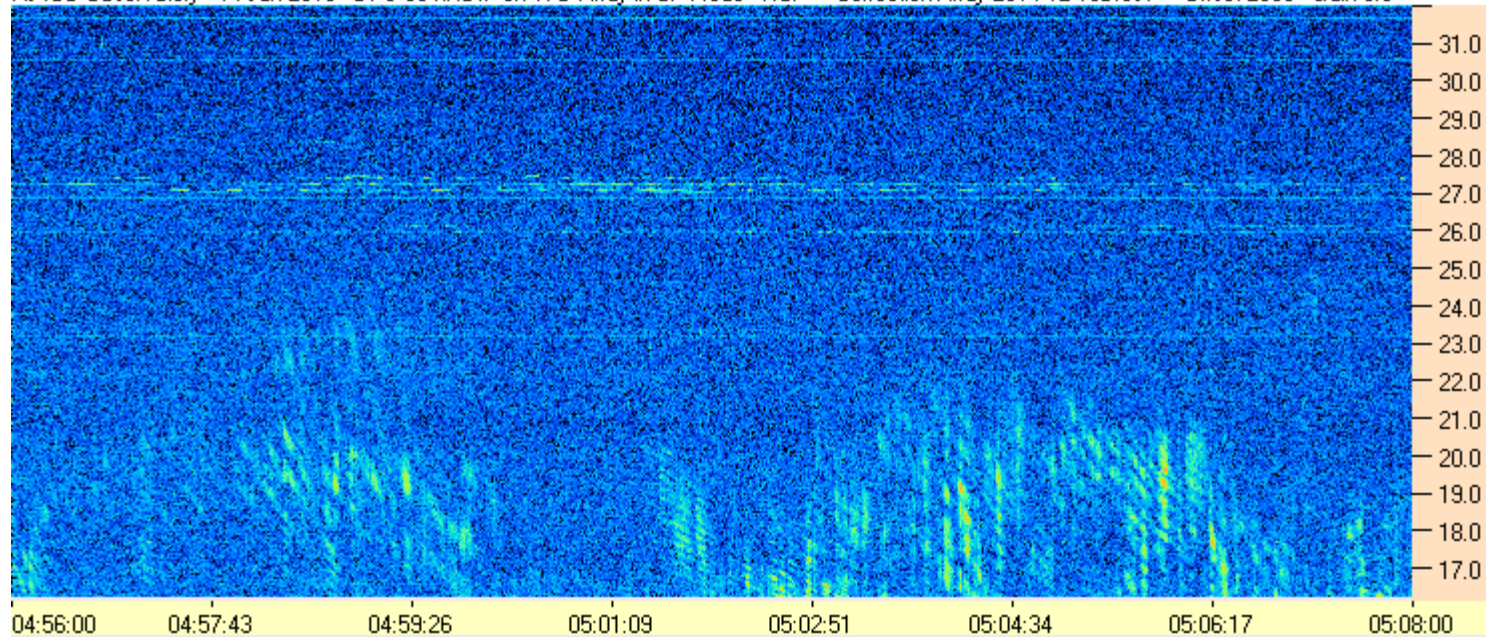
