RCP dominant L bursting from 16 to 25 MHz. No modulation lanes visible.

Lots of line noise that morning. Seems to affect the LCP channel more; there's a dB or so of DC offset towards LCP in the polarization strip charts.

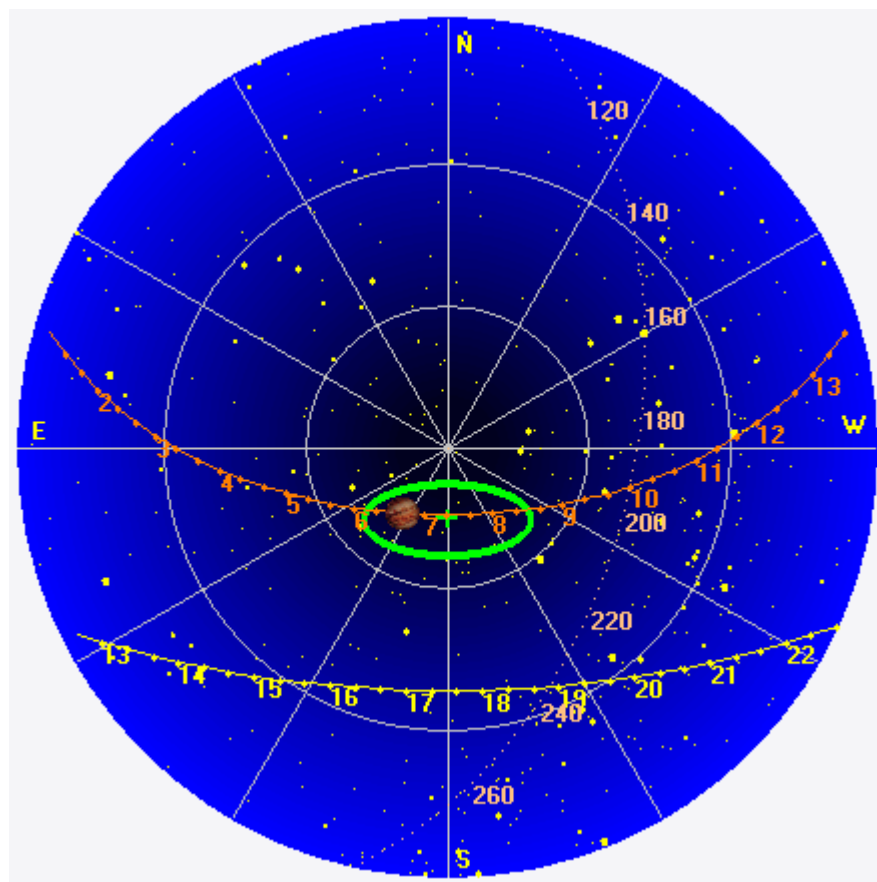
Jupiter was -21° to $+3^\circ$ off axis.

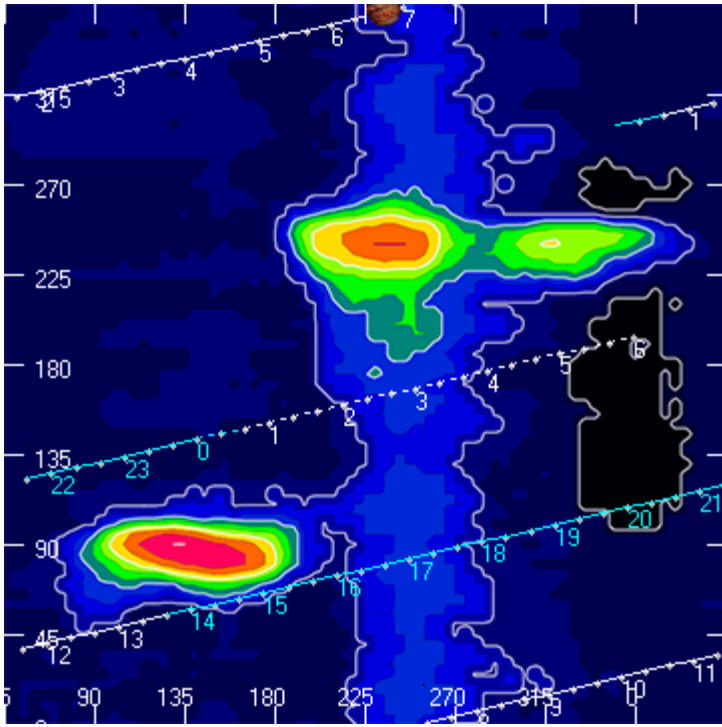
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 155° .

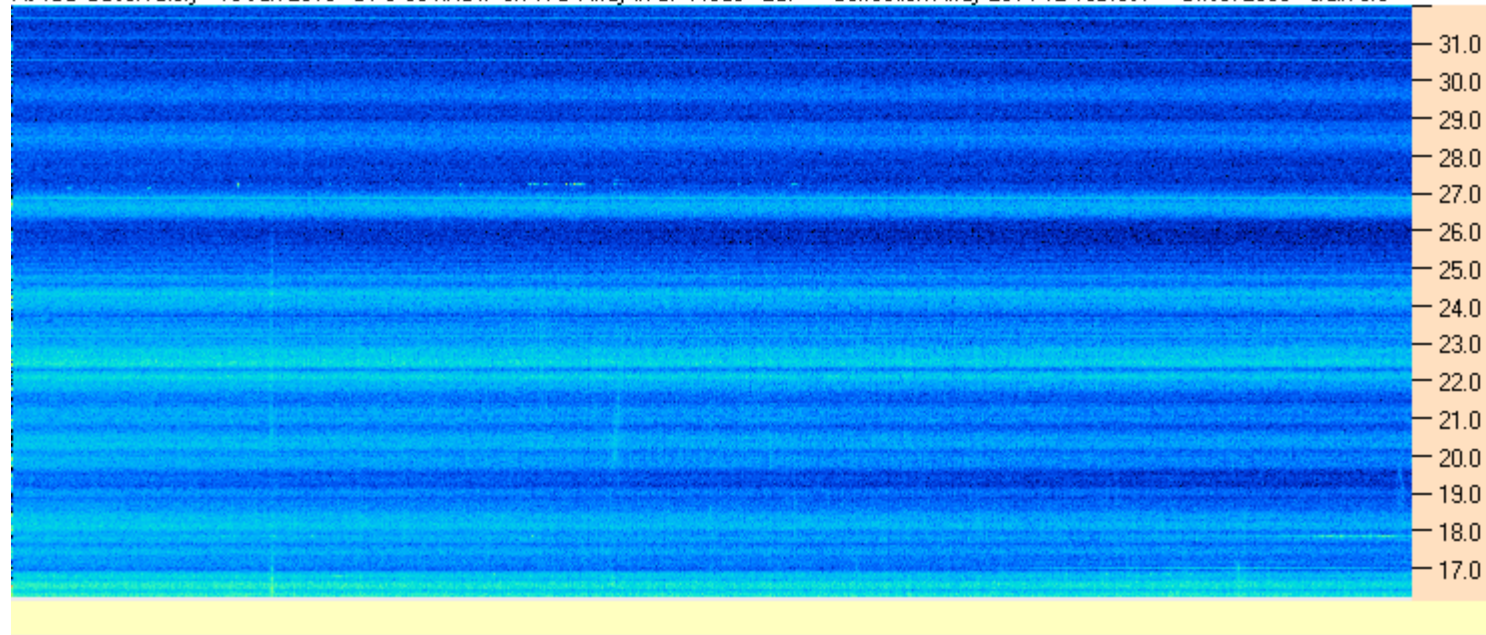

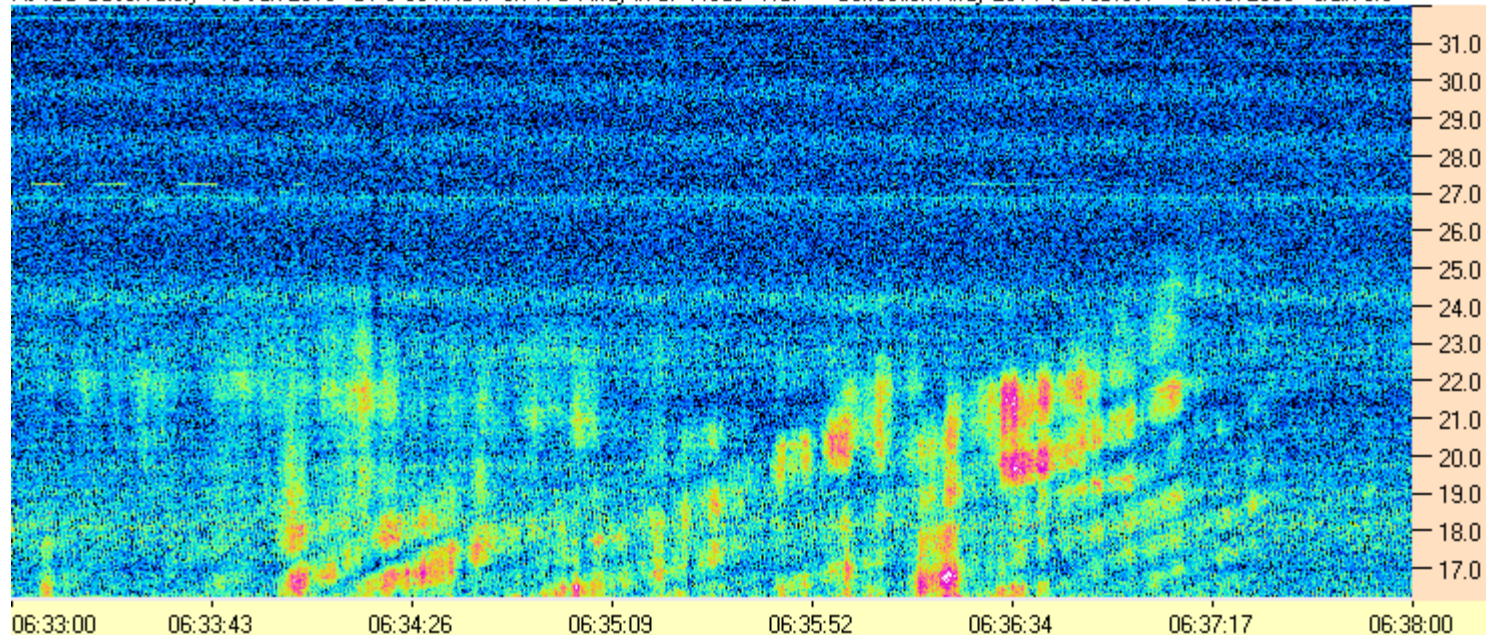

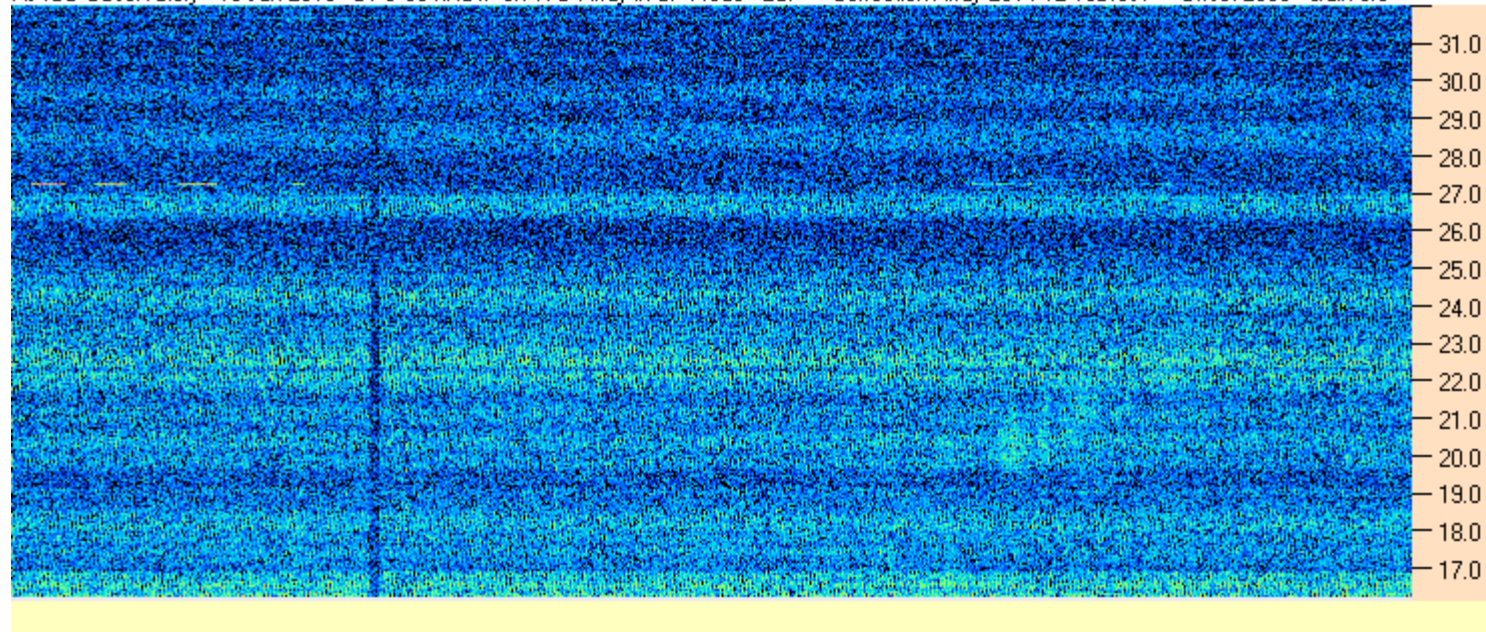

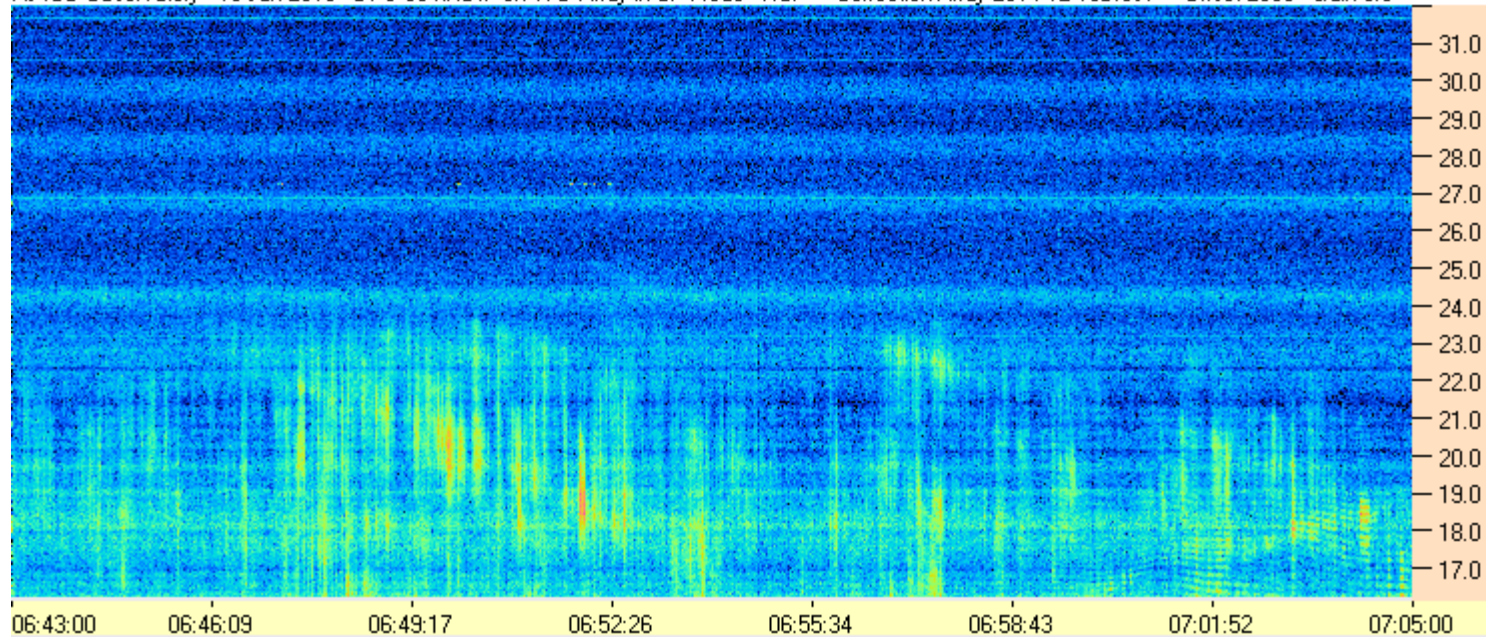
