LCP dominant L bursting from 16 to 18 MHz, No modulation lanes visible.

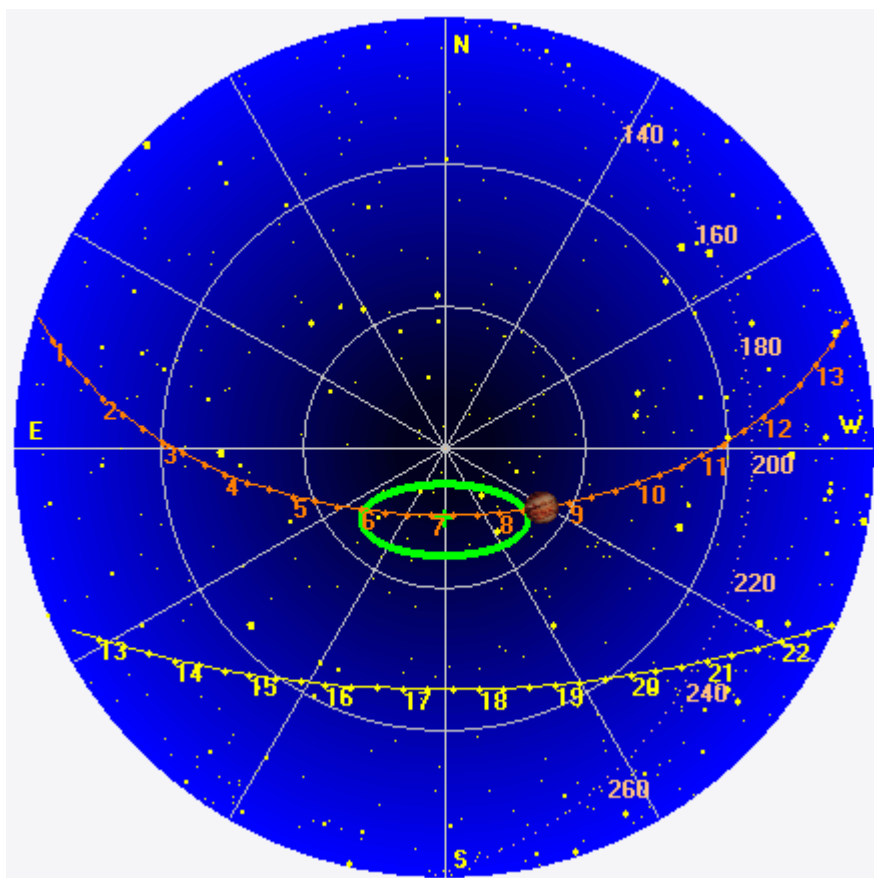
Jupiter was +13° to +25° off axis.

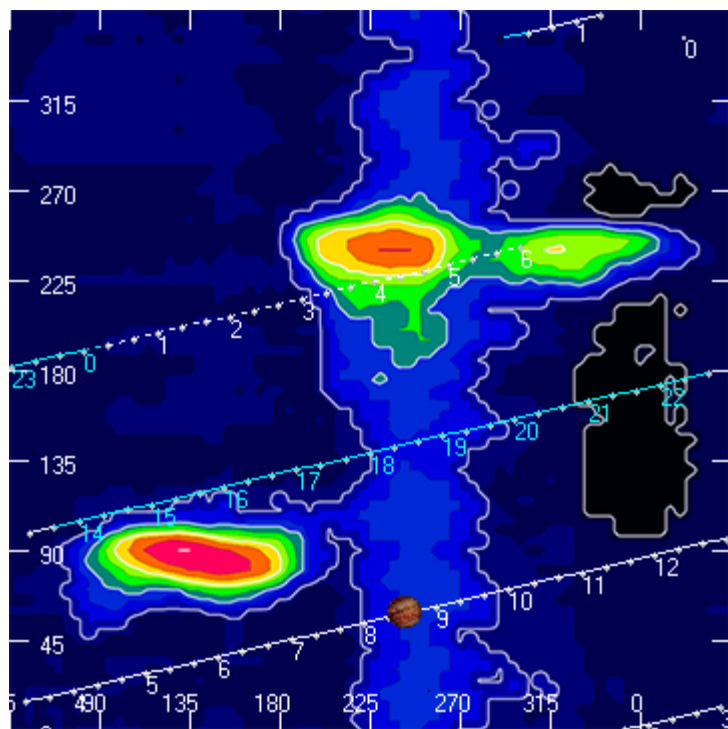
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 158°.

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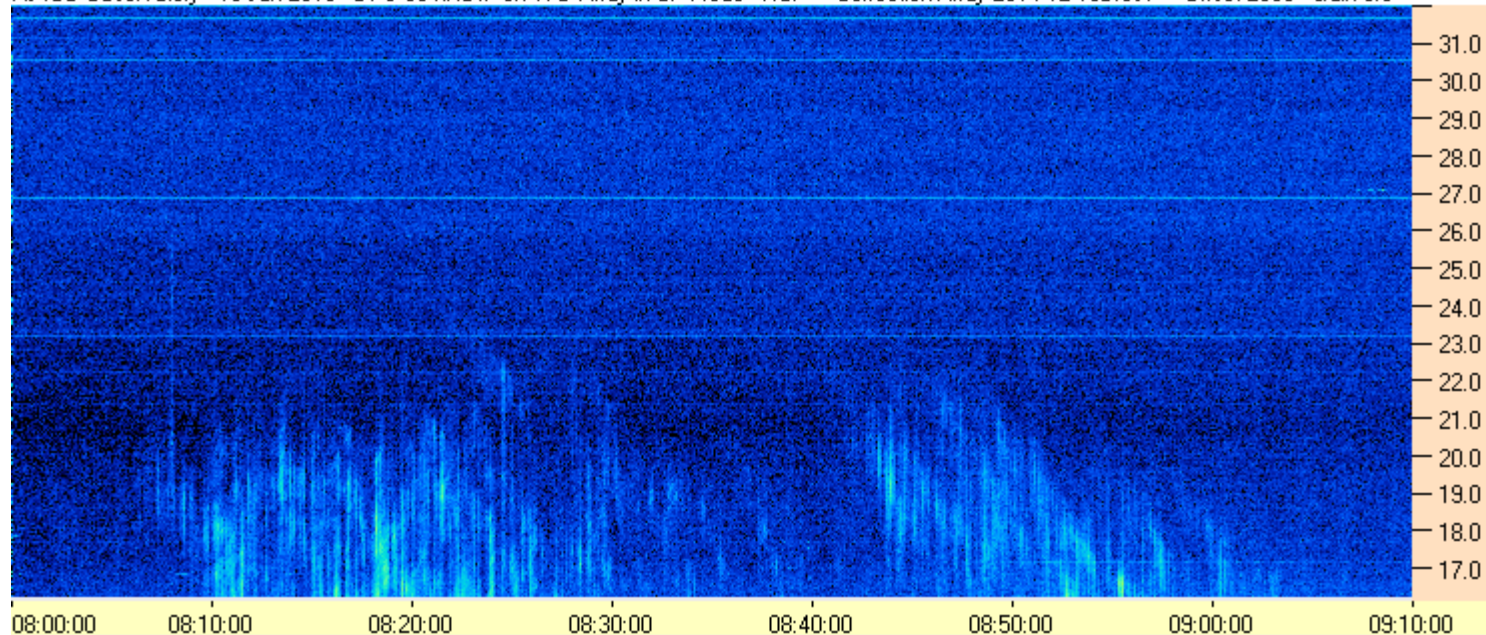

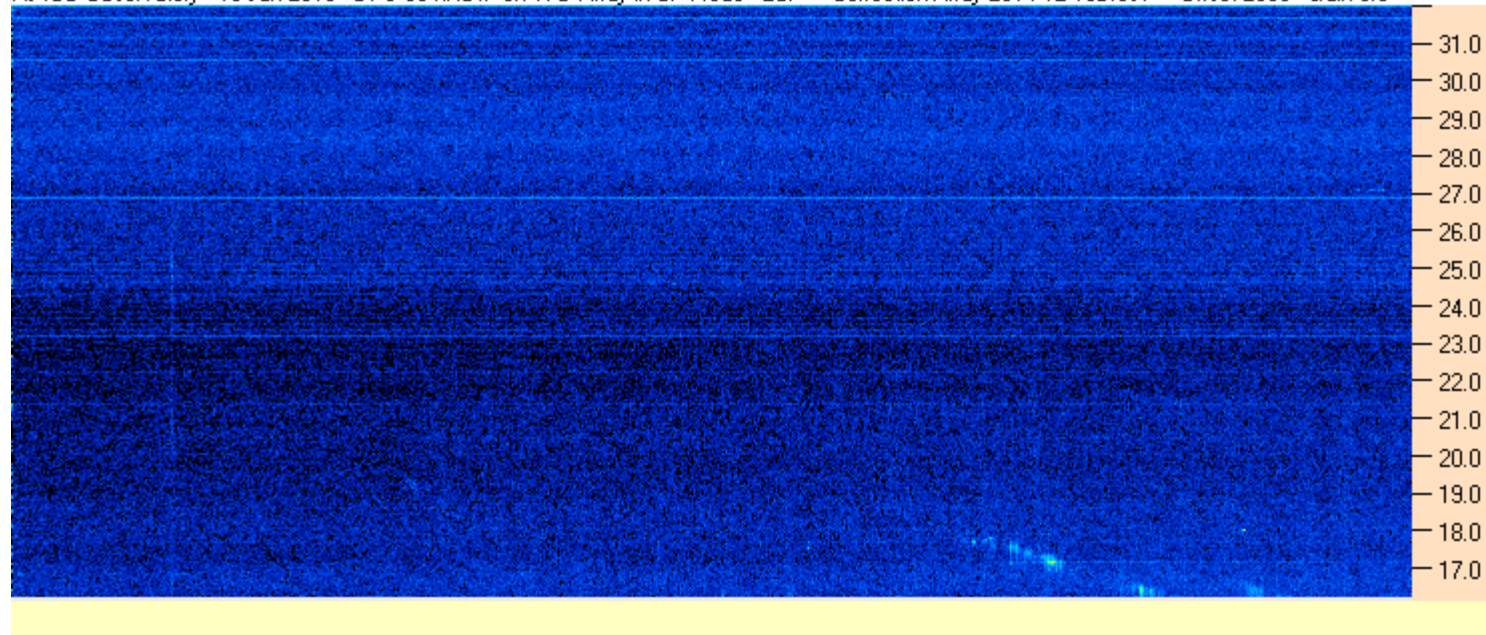

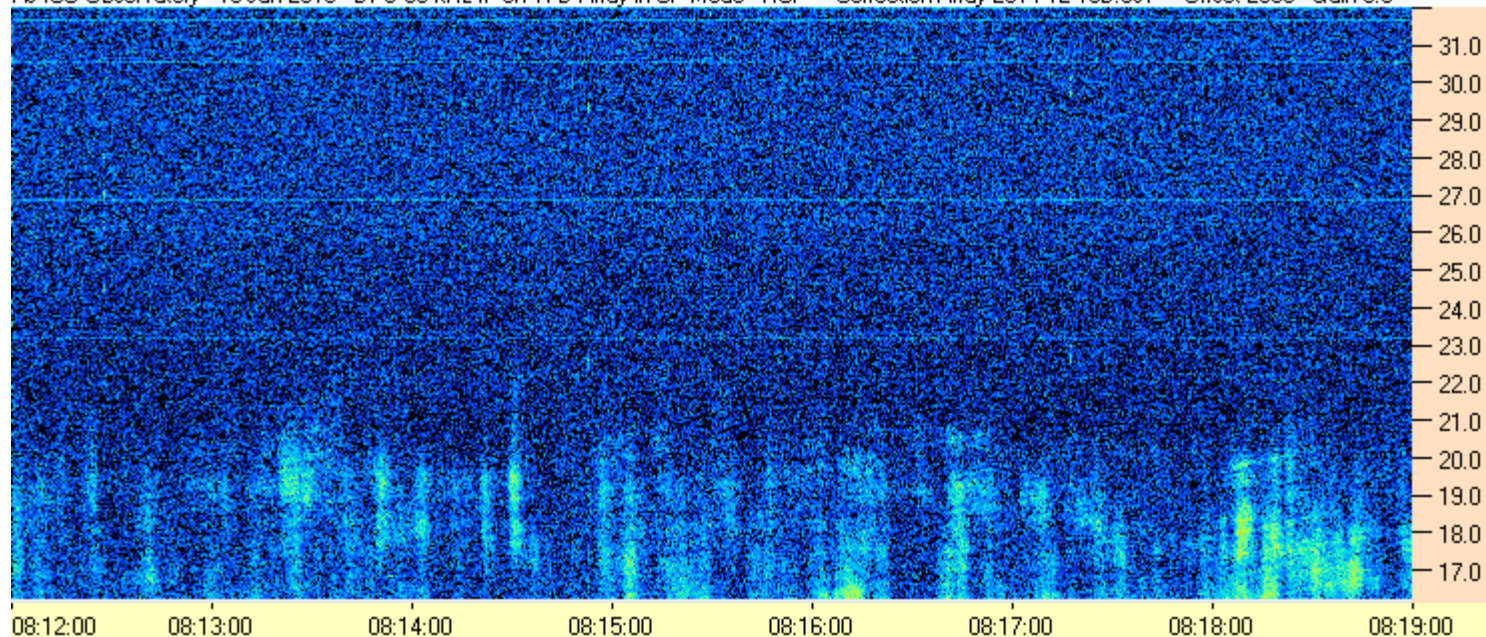
