RCP dominant L bursting from 16 to 26 MHz. Modulation lanes visible with -97 kHz/s drift.

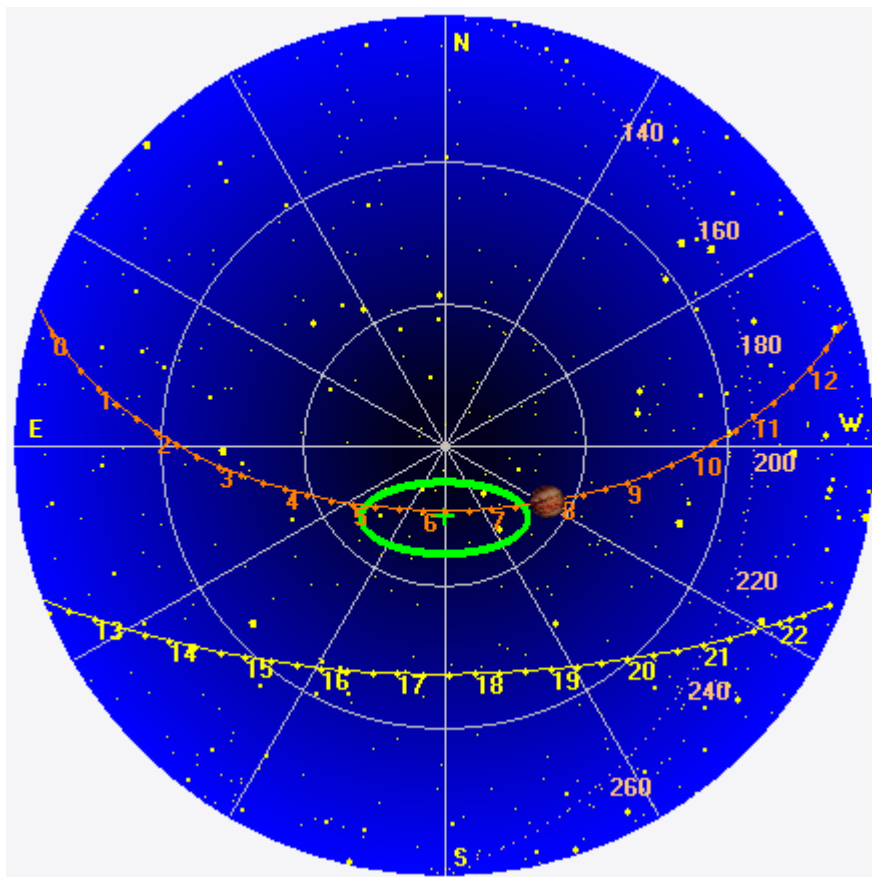
Jupiter was +18° to +25° off axis.

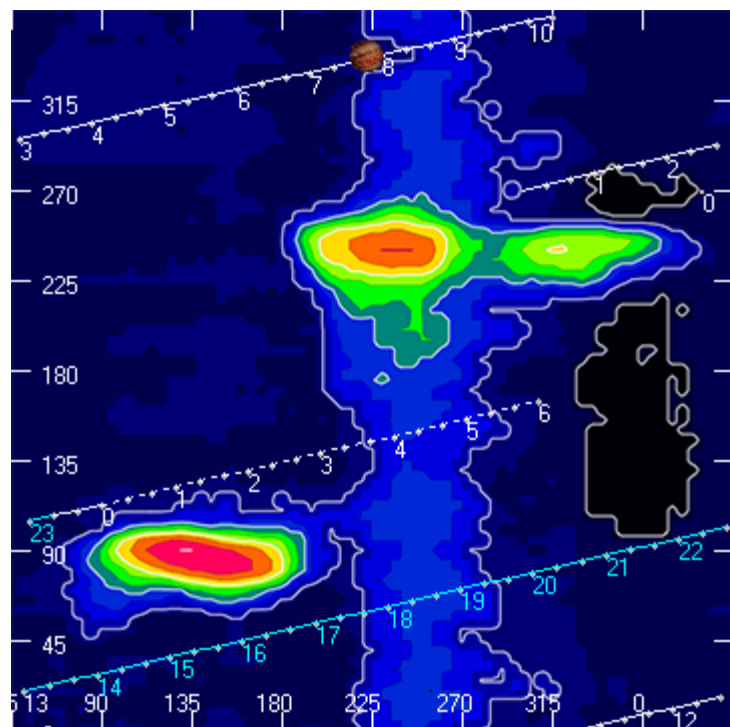
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 171°.

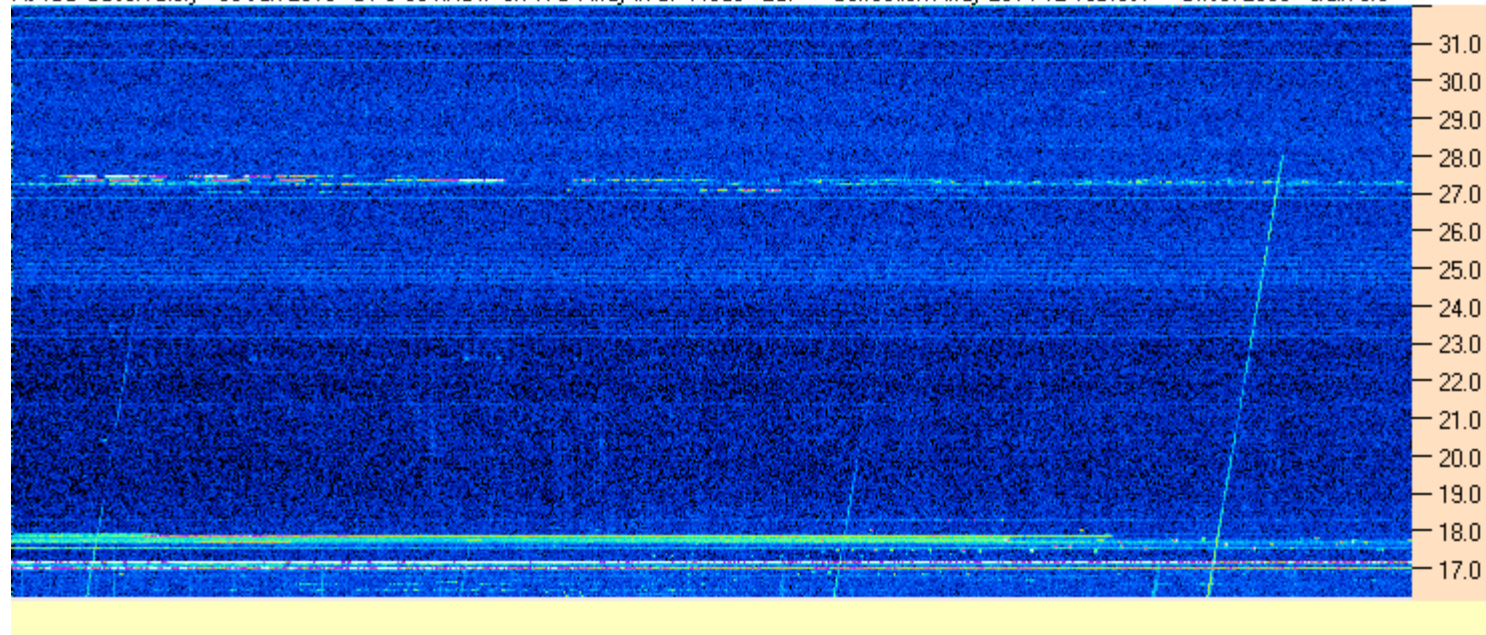

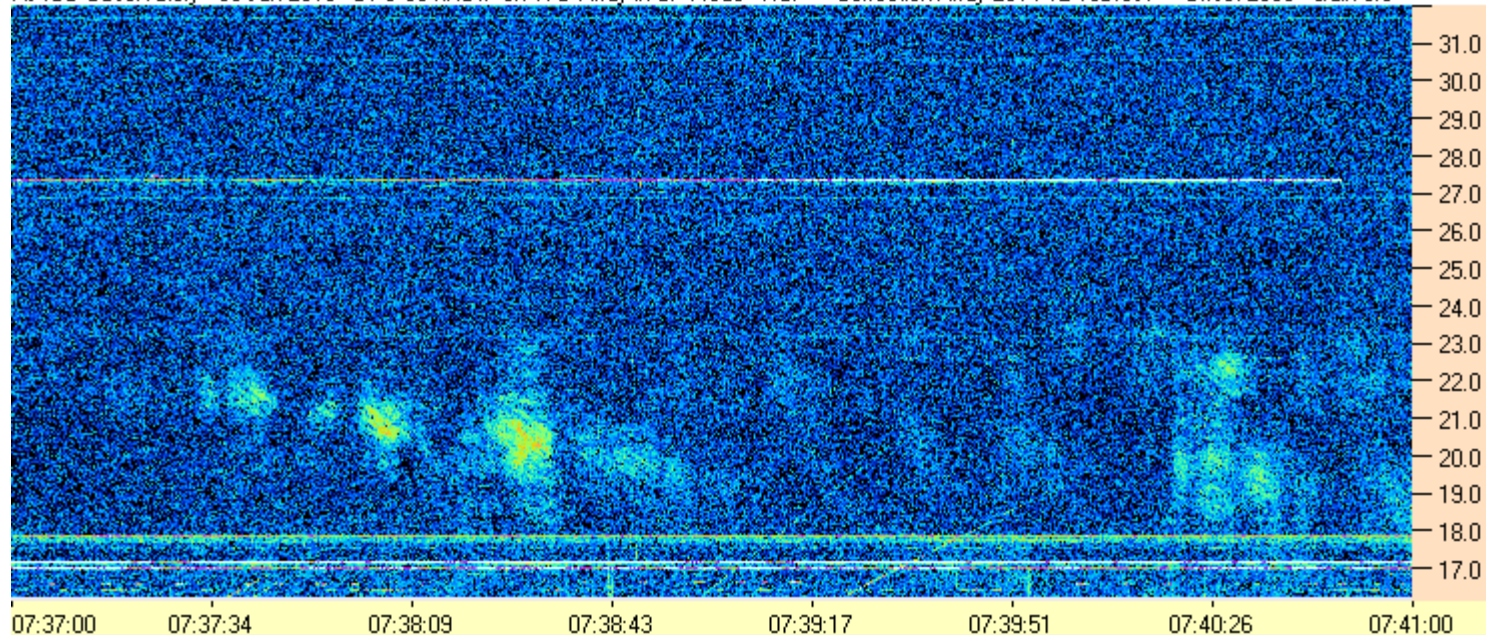

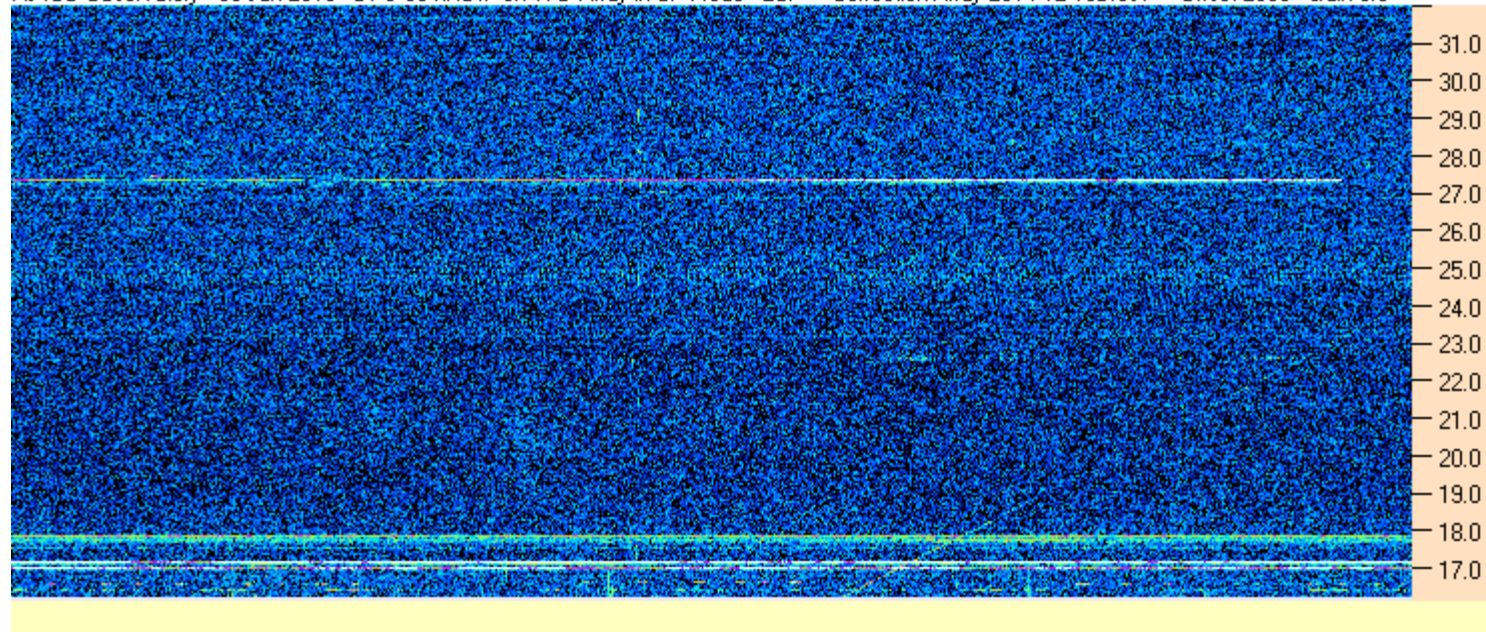

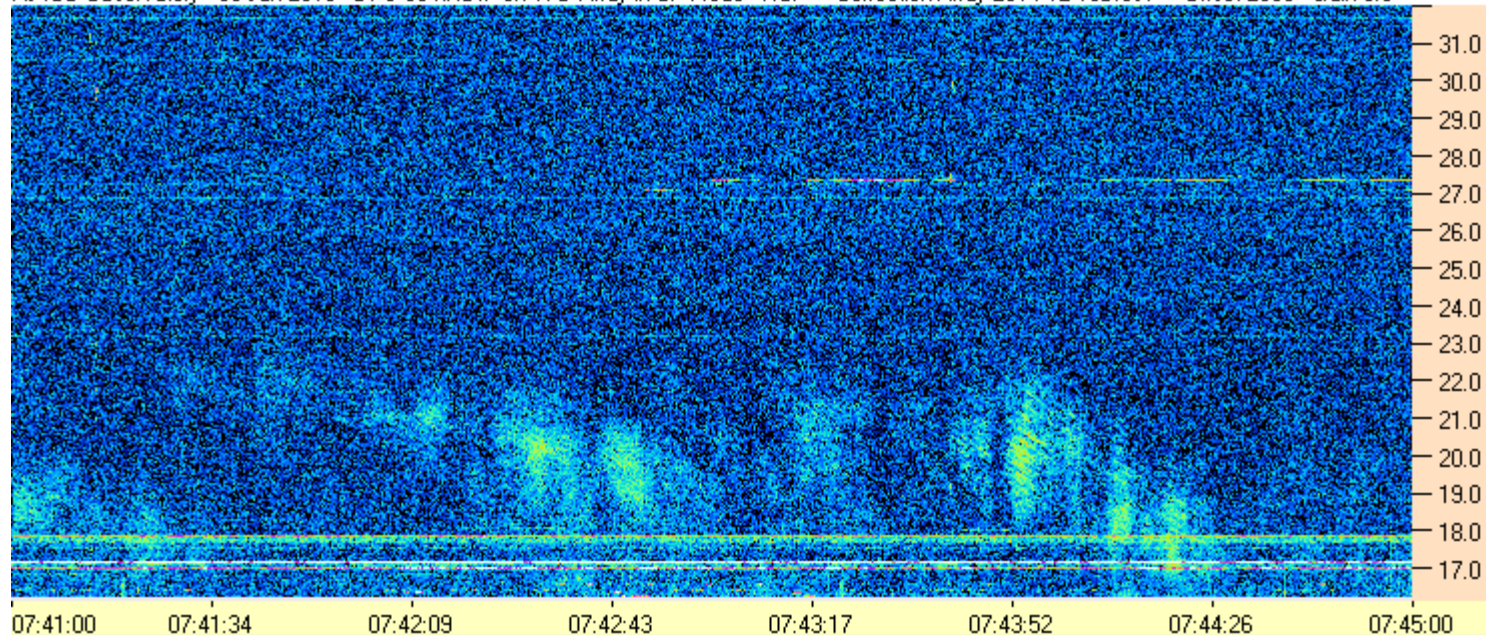
