
RCP dominant L bursting from 16 to 23 MHz. No modulation lanes visible.

Jupiter was -12° to +11 ° off axis.


Jupiter was 179° from the Sun -- OPPOSITION. Why this isn't 180° is left as an exercise for the reader. Hint: space has three dimensions.




