Jupiter was trailing the Sun by  $176^\circ$ .

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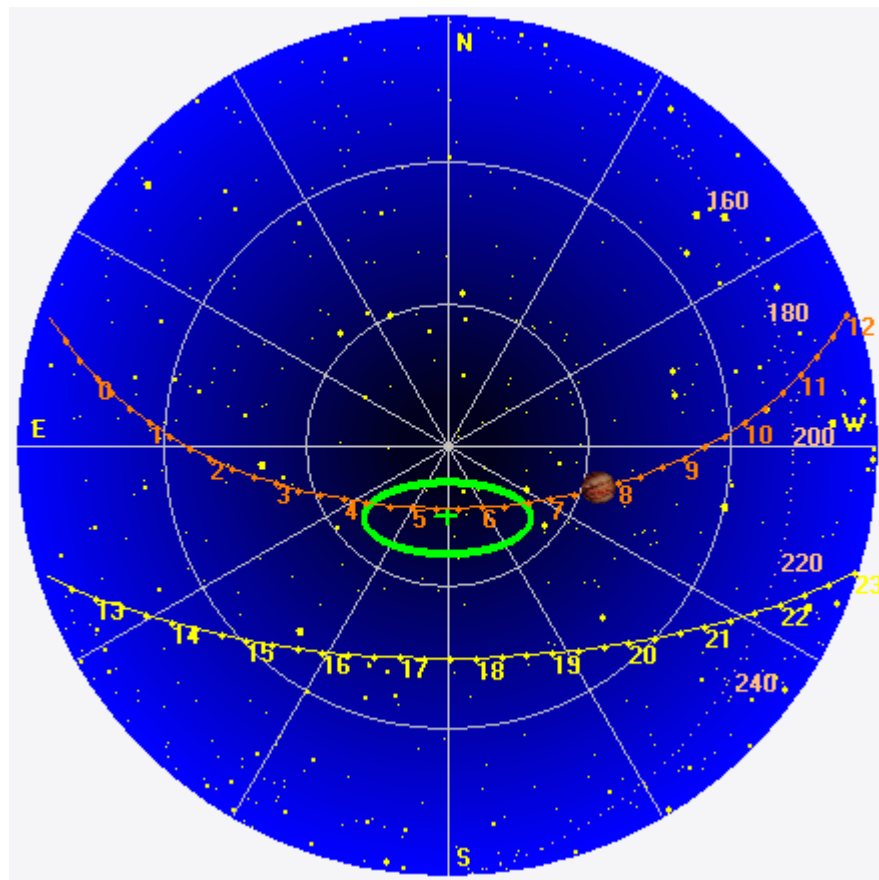

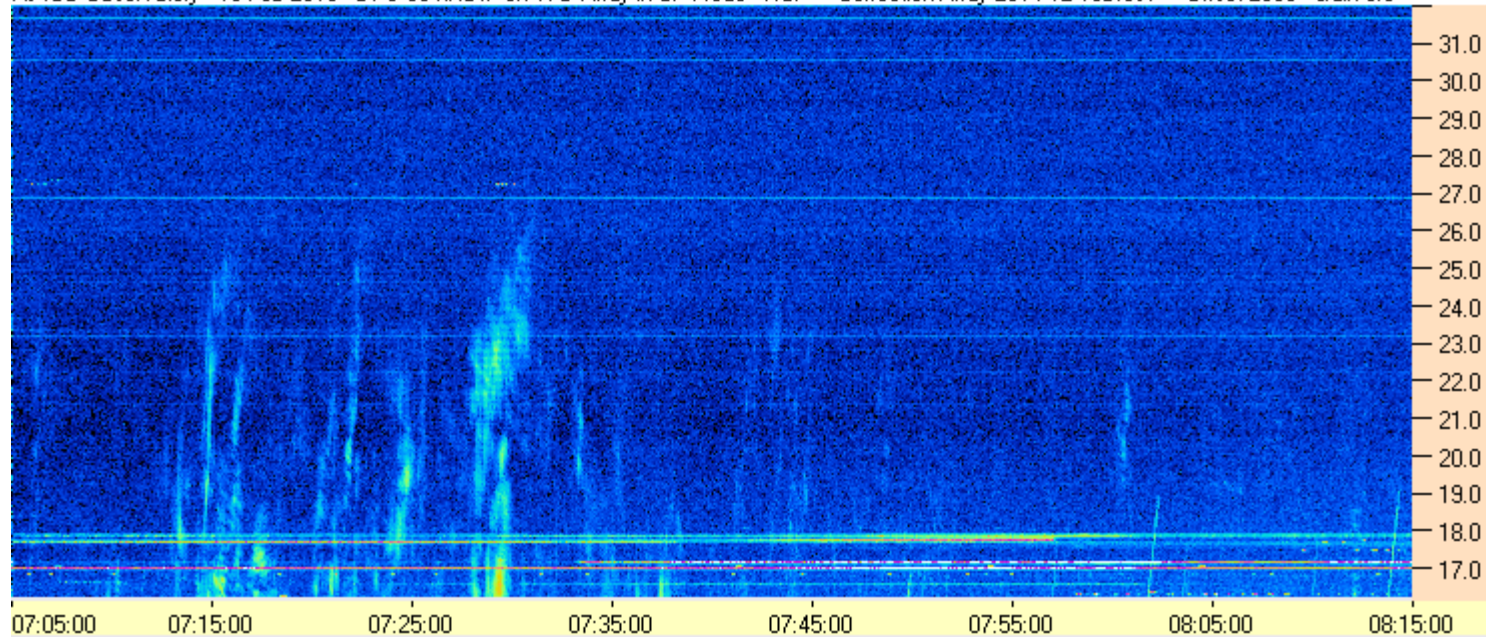

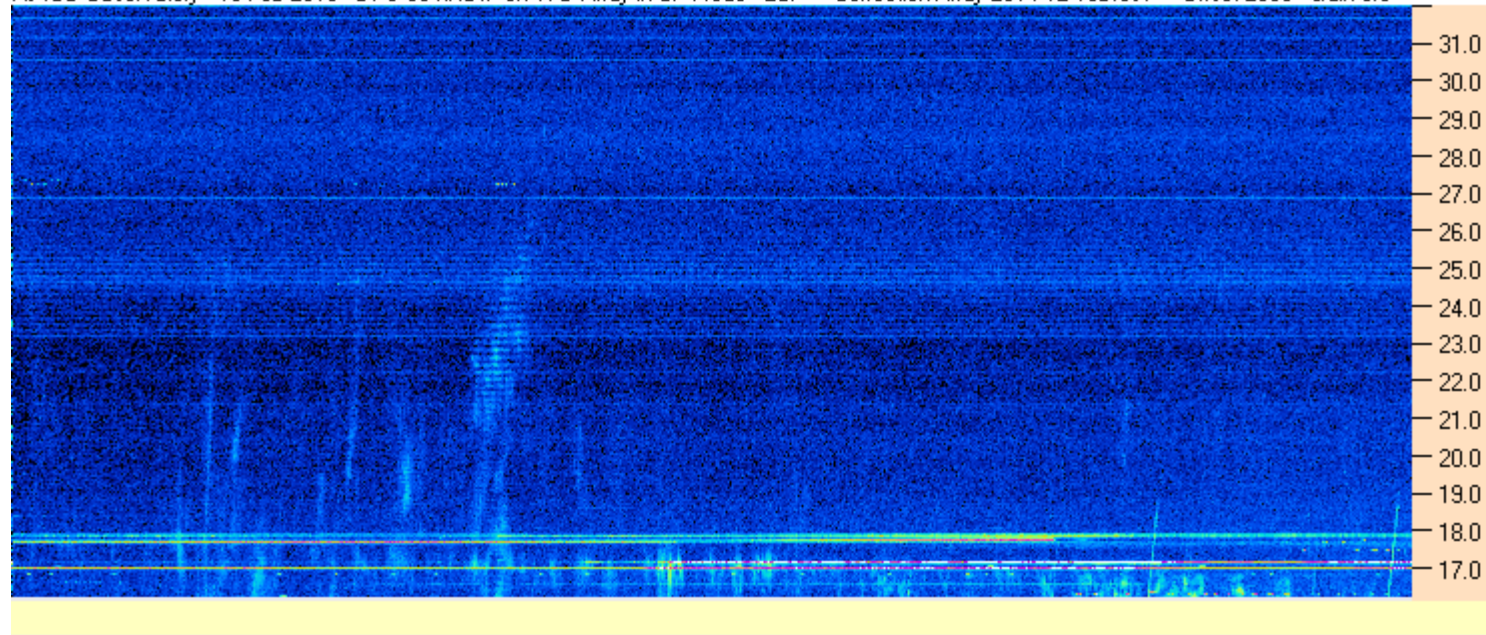

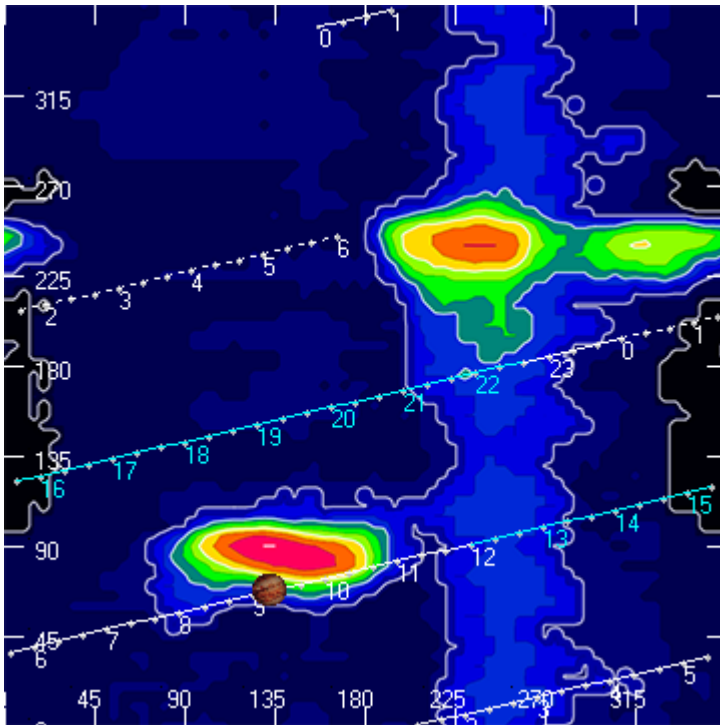

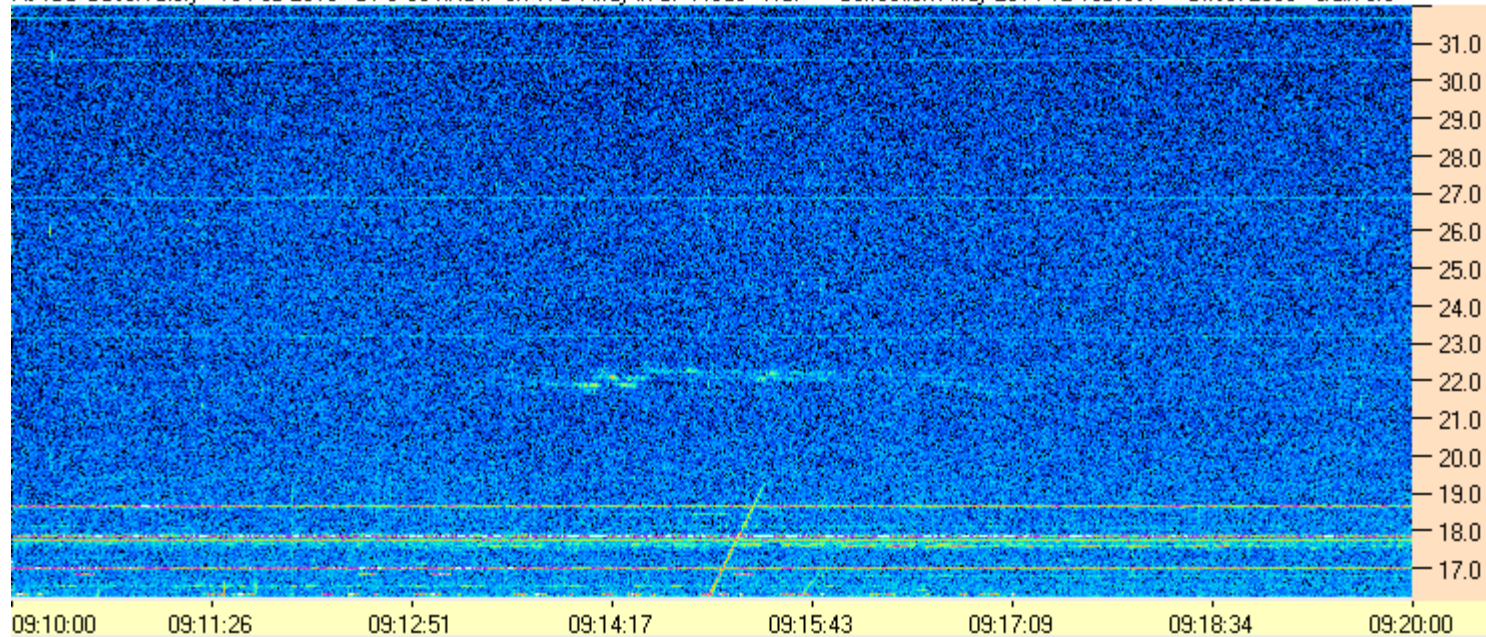


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Io-D N event



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
