RCP dominant L bursting from 16 to 26 MHz. Deep ionospheric lanes visible from 0700 to 0730 UTC.

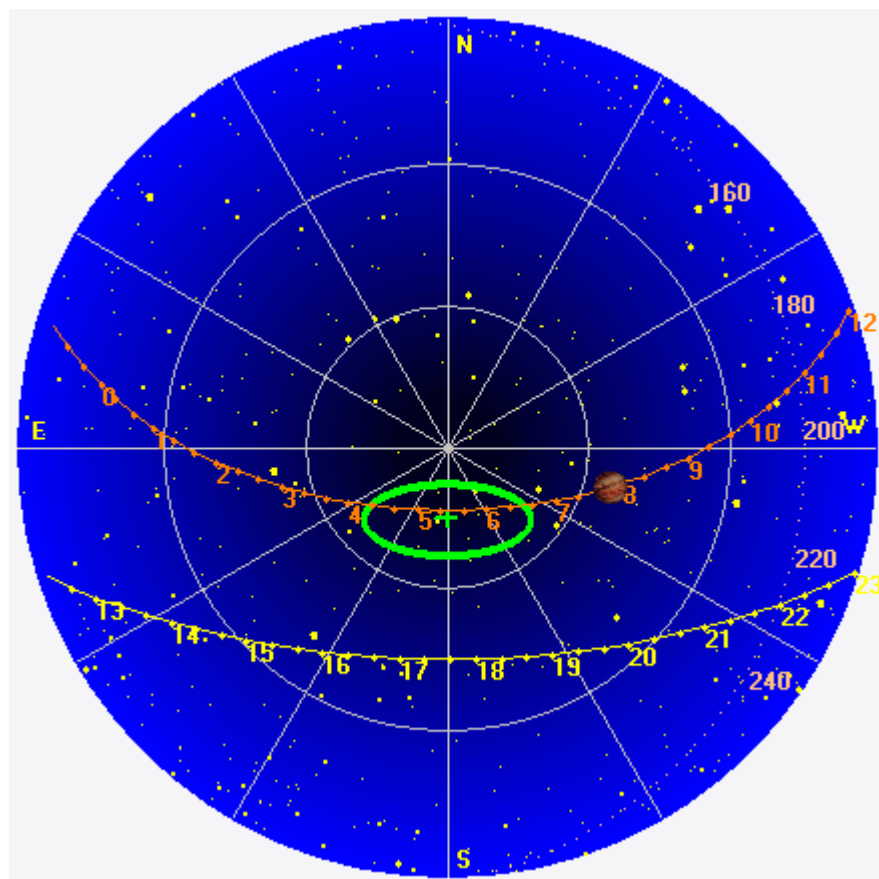
Jupiter was $+15^\circ$ to $+53^\circ$ off axis.

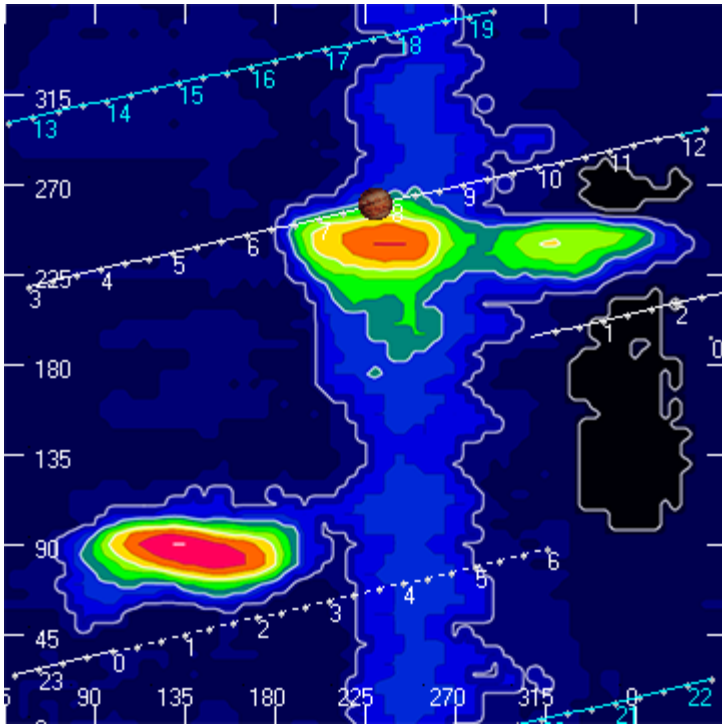
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 175° .

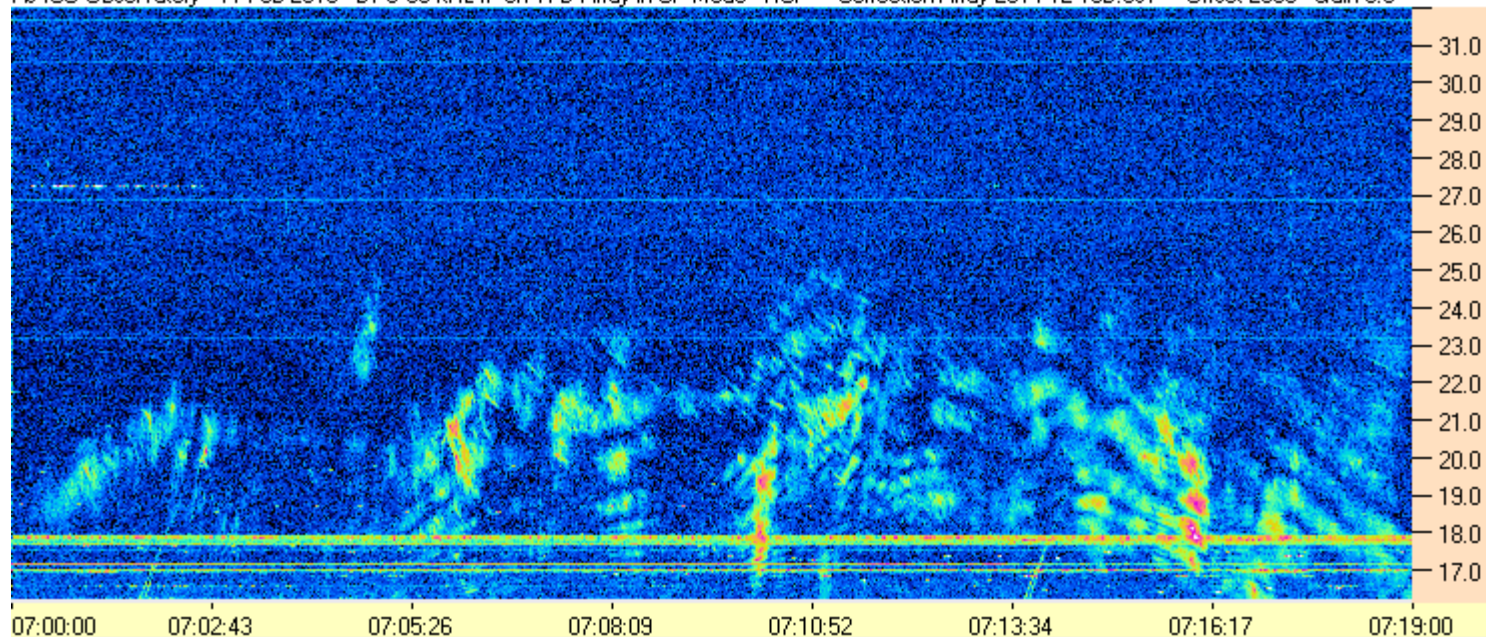

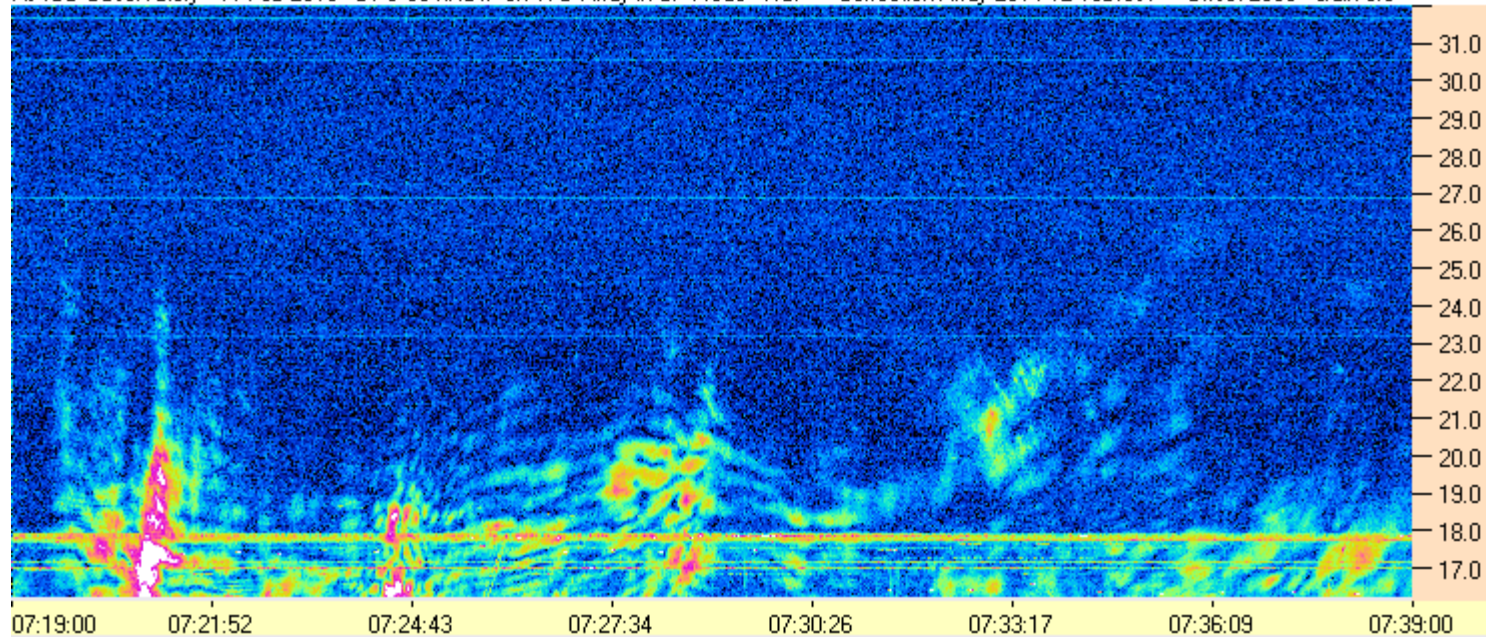
