RCP dominant L bursting from 16 to 25 MHz. Deep ionospheric lanes visible around 0430 and 0525 UTC.

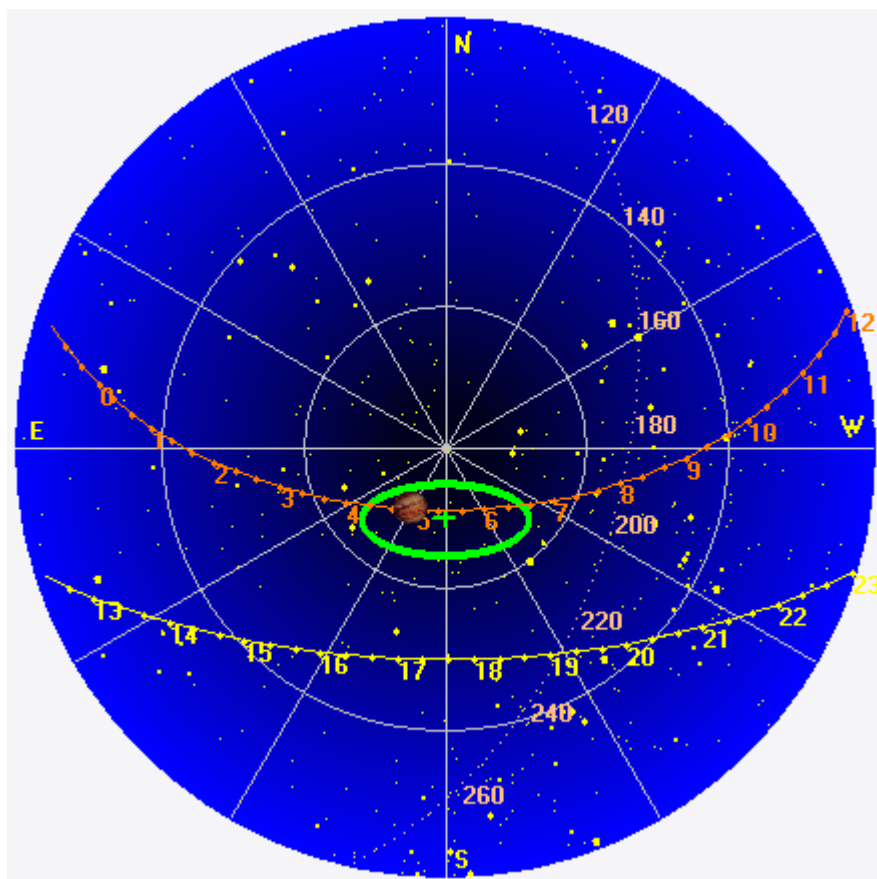
Jupiter was -23° to $+9^\circ$ off axis.

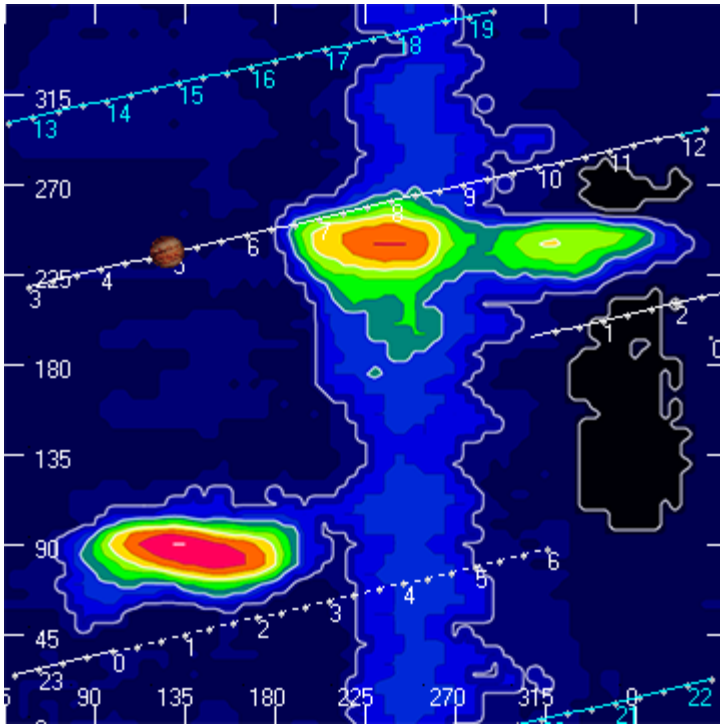
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 175° .

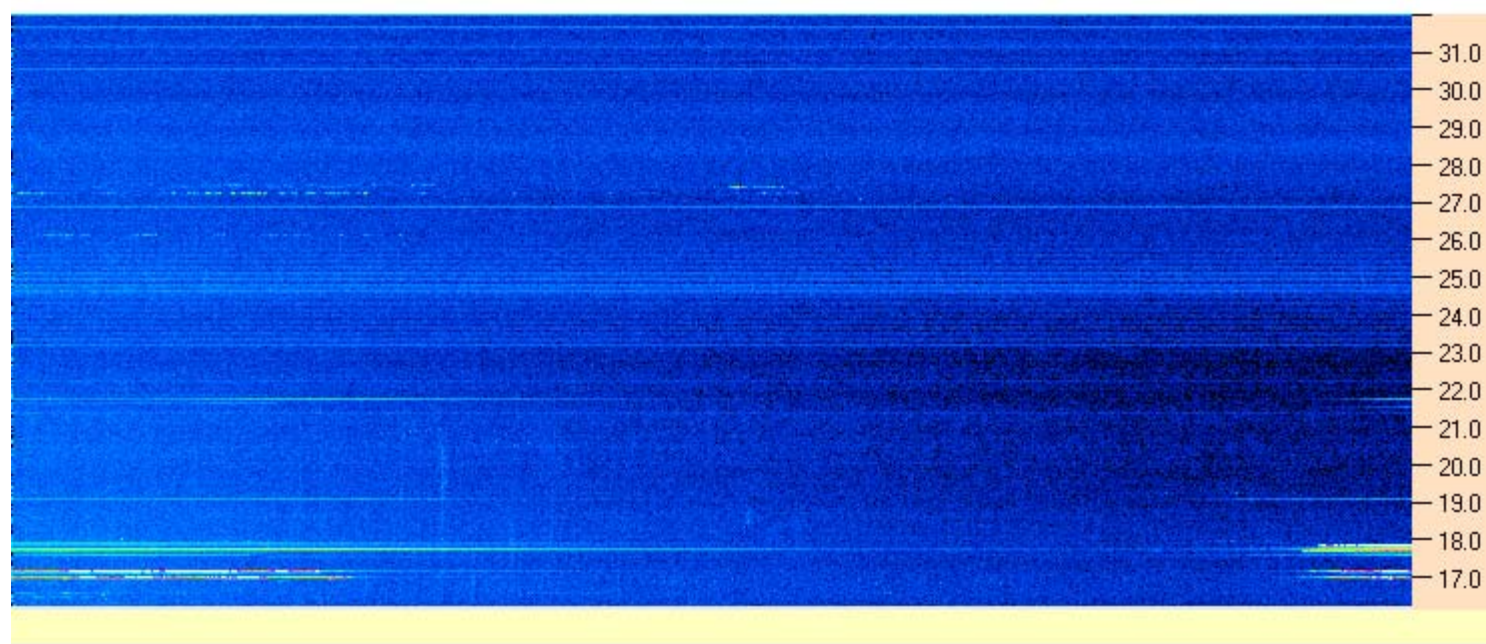
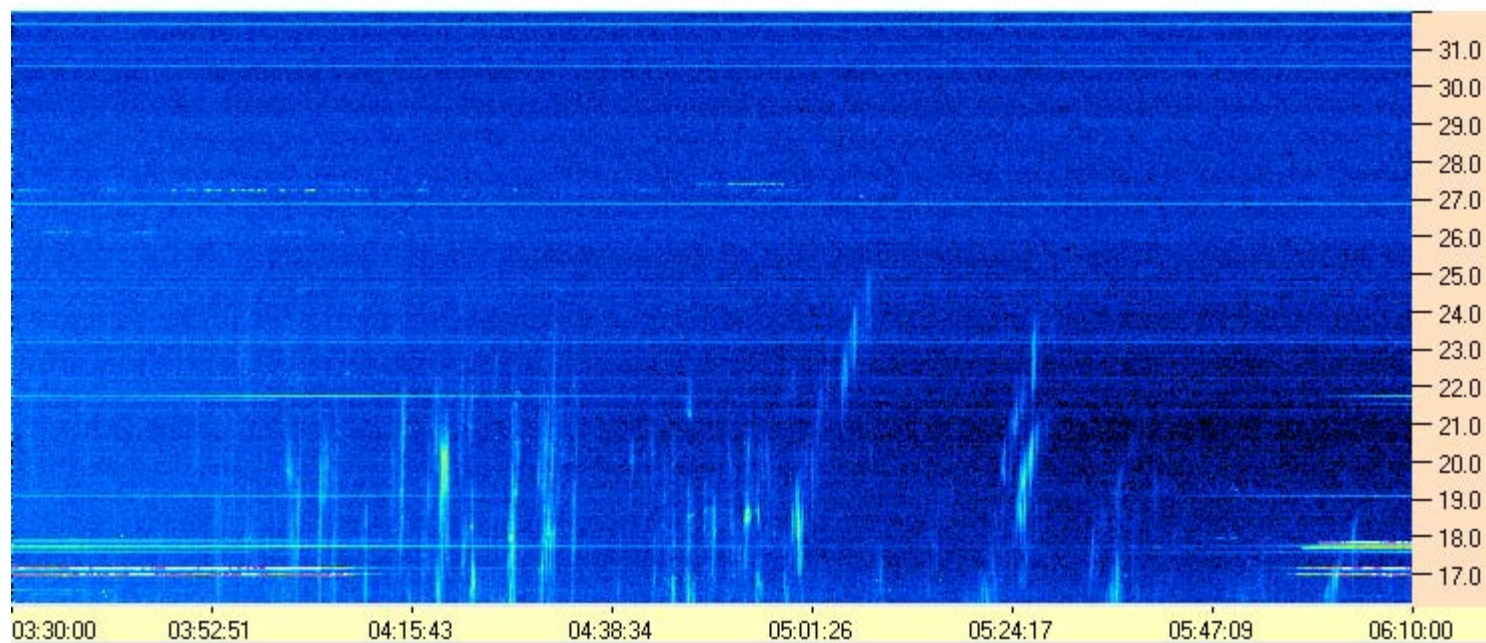
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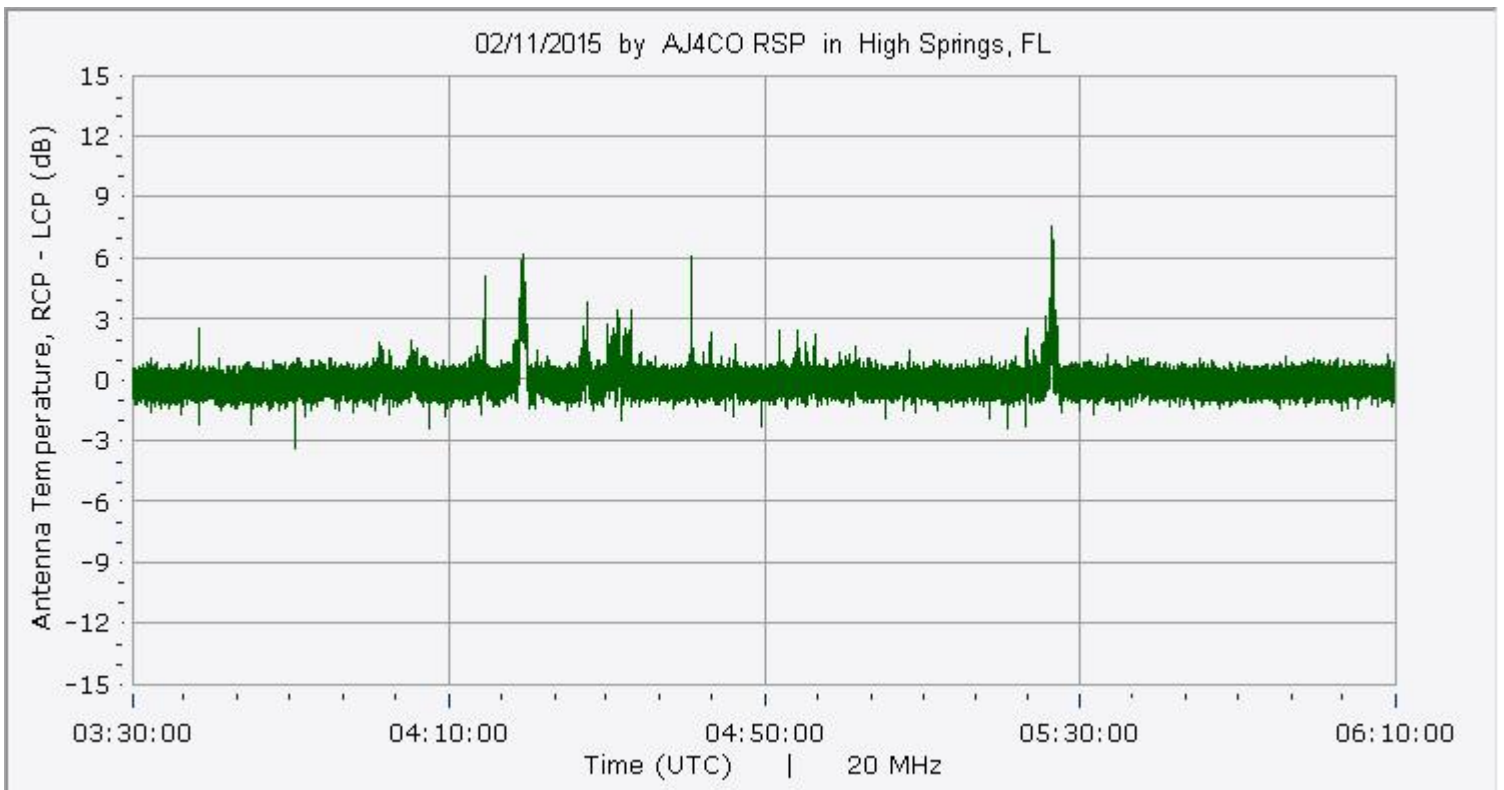
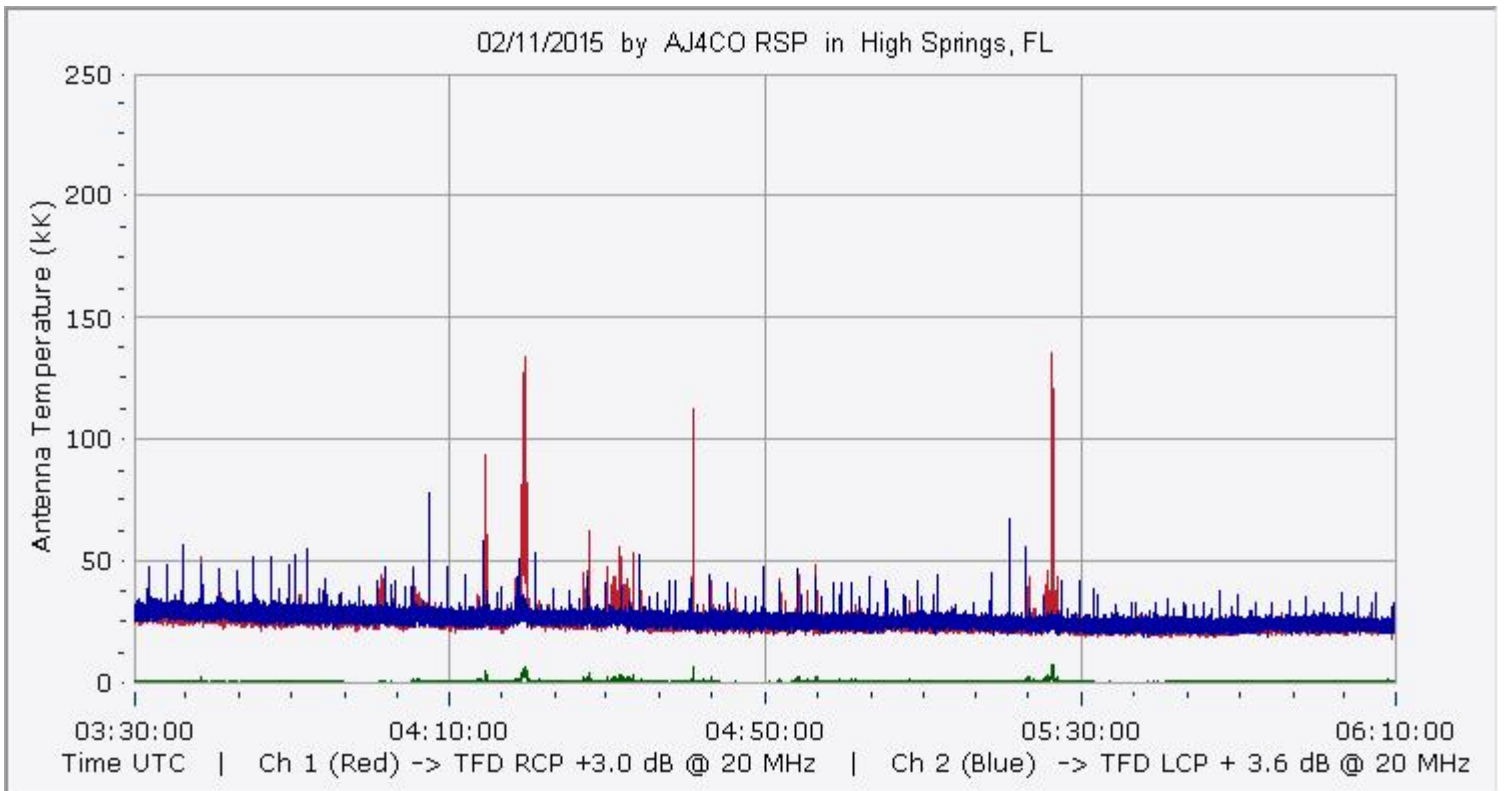

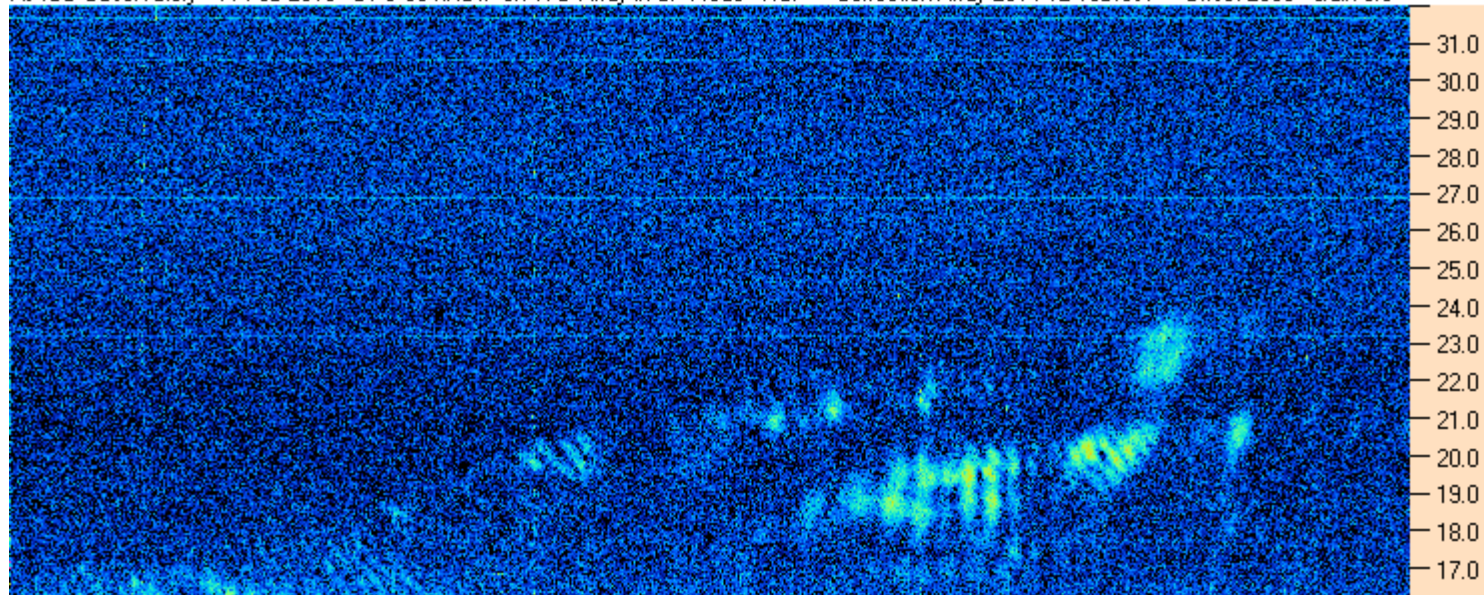
