RCP dominant L bursting from 16 to 25 MHz. Deep ionospheric lanes visible around 0435 UTC.

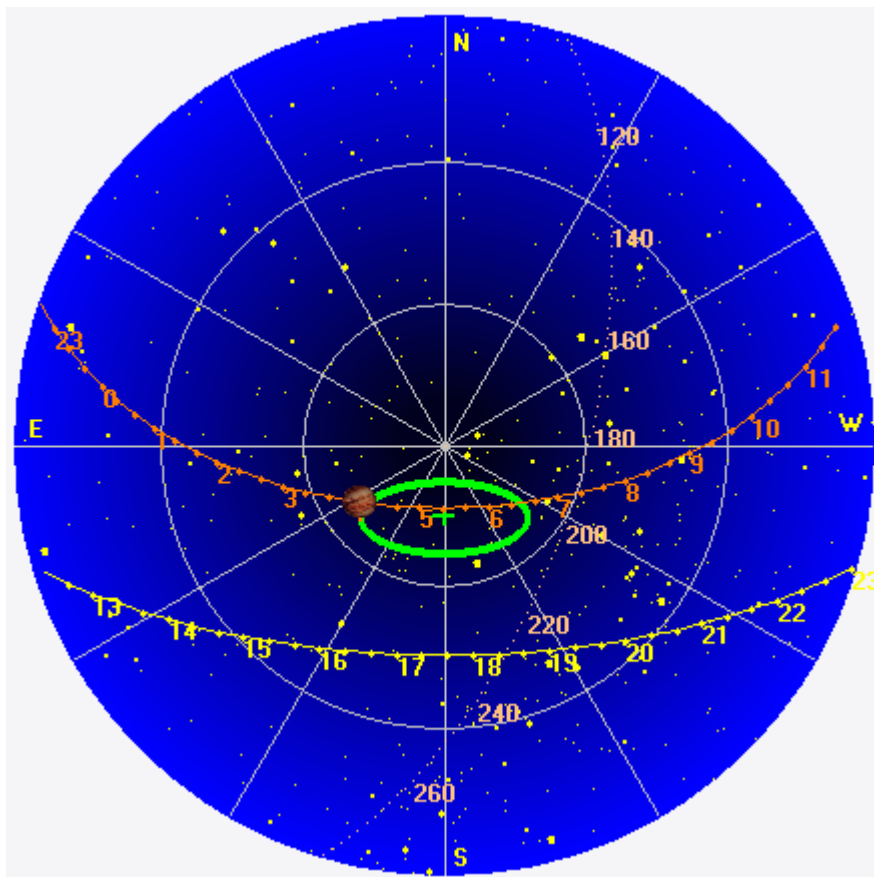
Jupiter was -32° to -3° off axis.

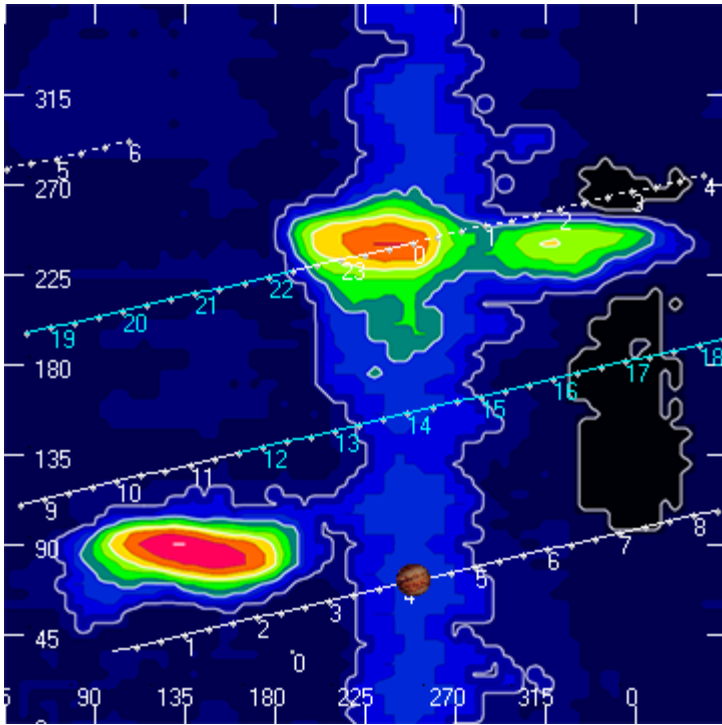
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 174° .

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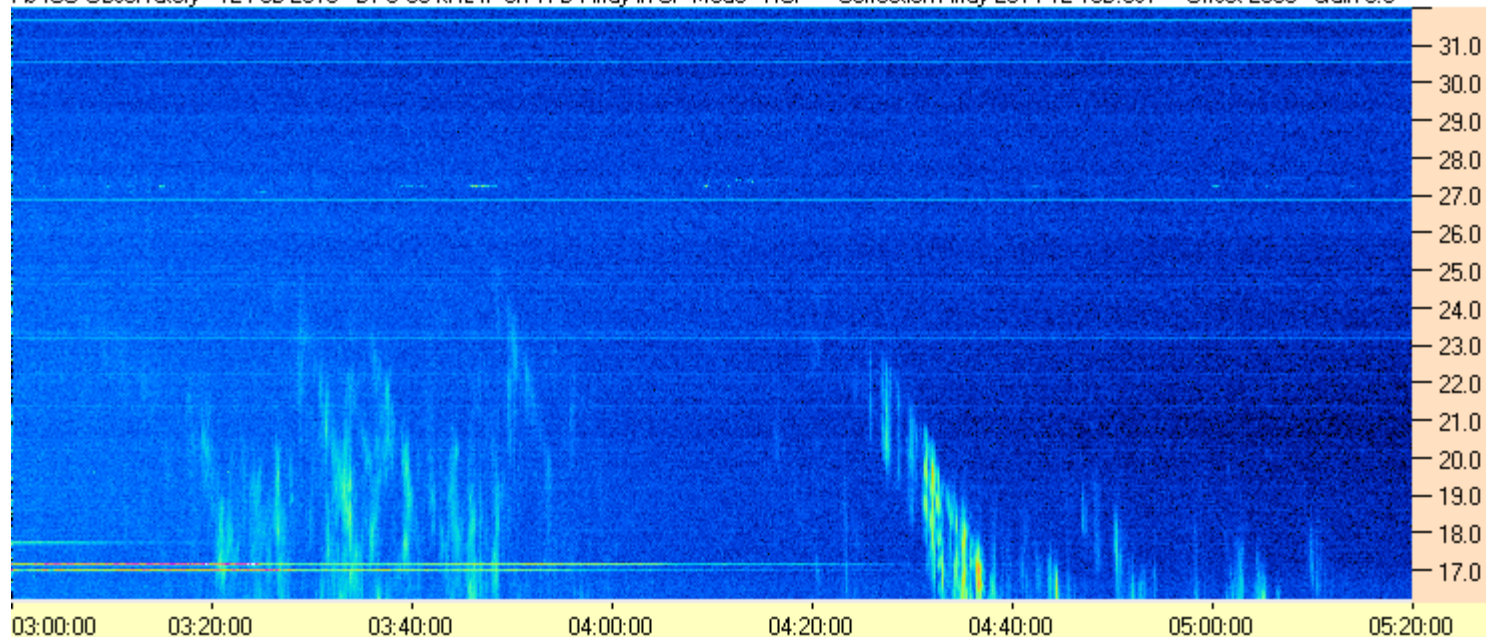

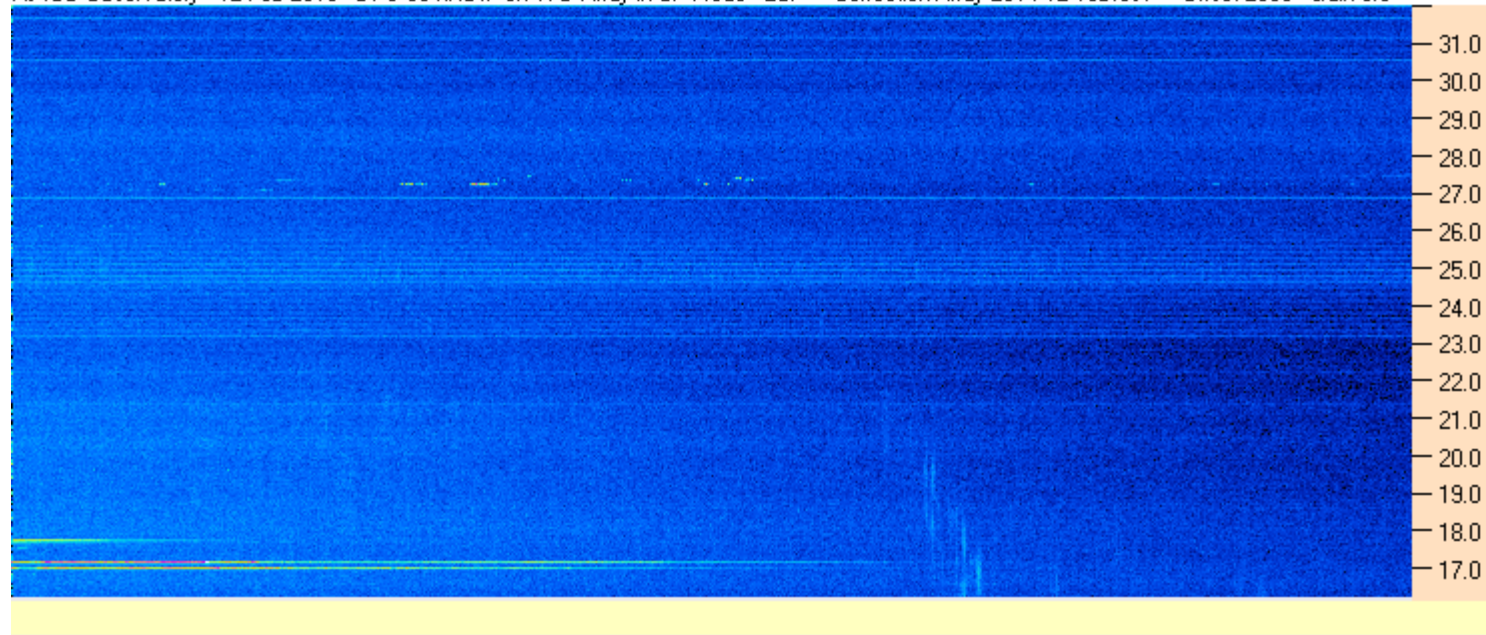


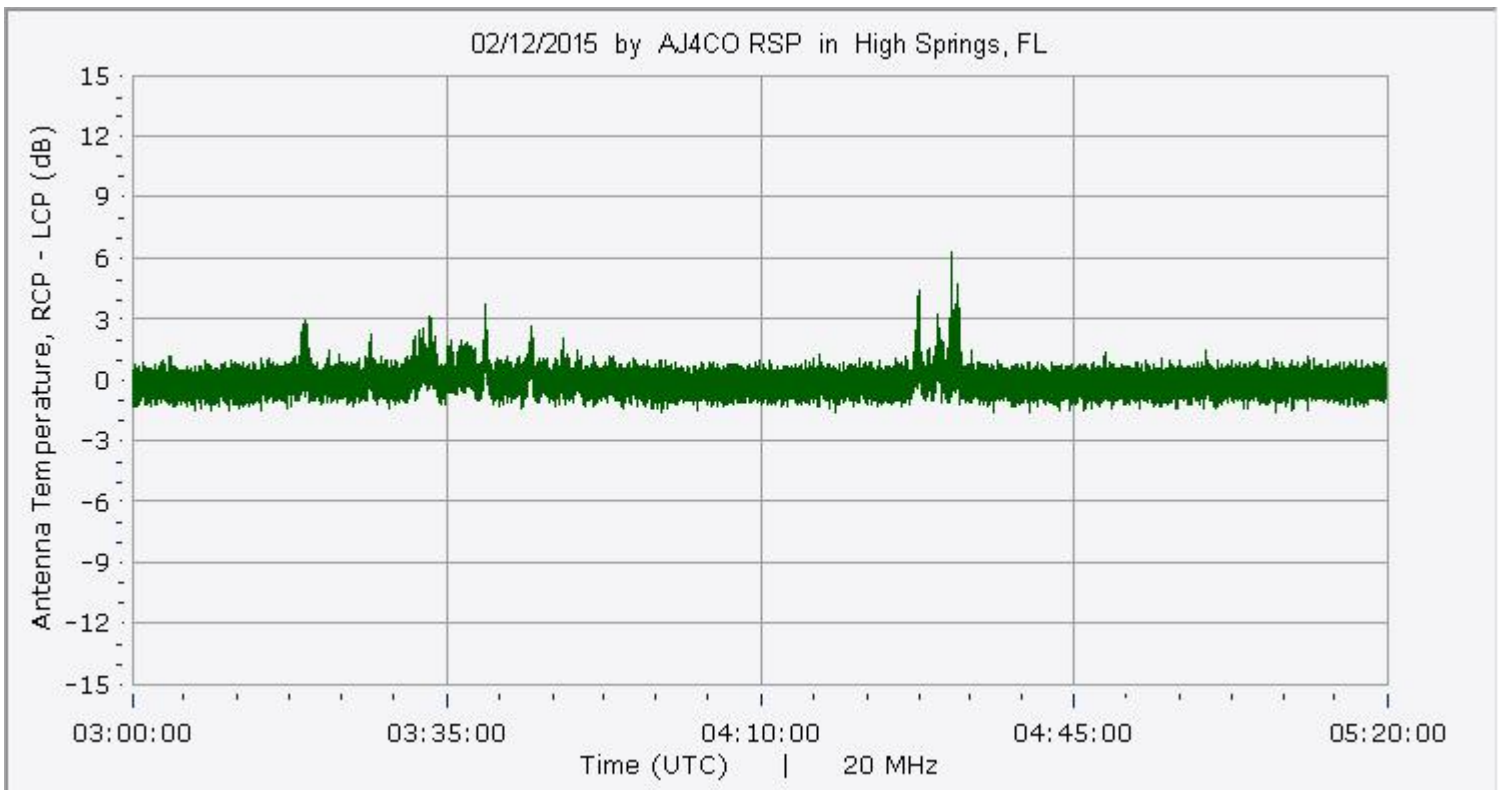

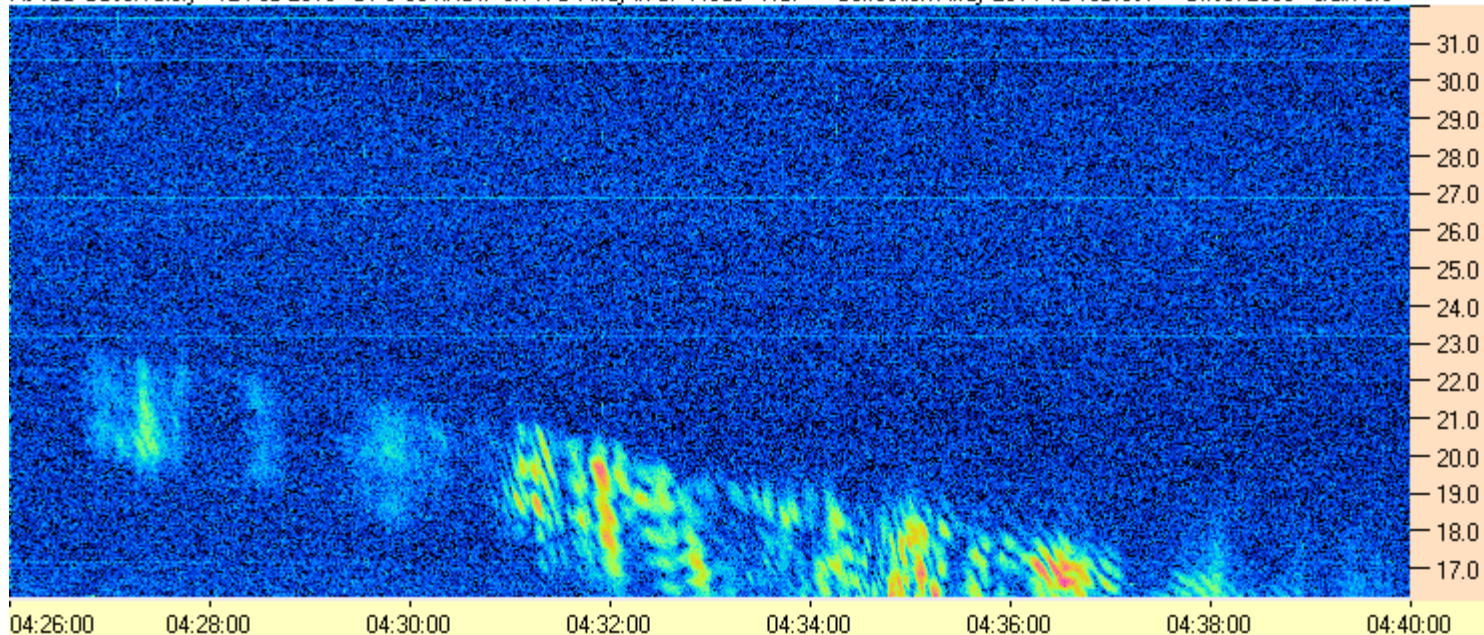
