RCP dominant L bursting from 16 to 26 MHz. No modulation lanes visible.

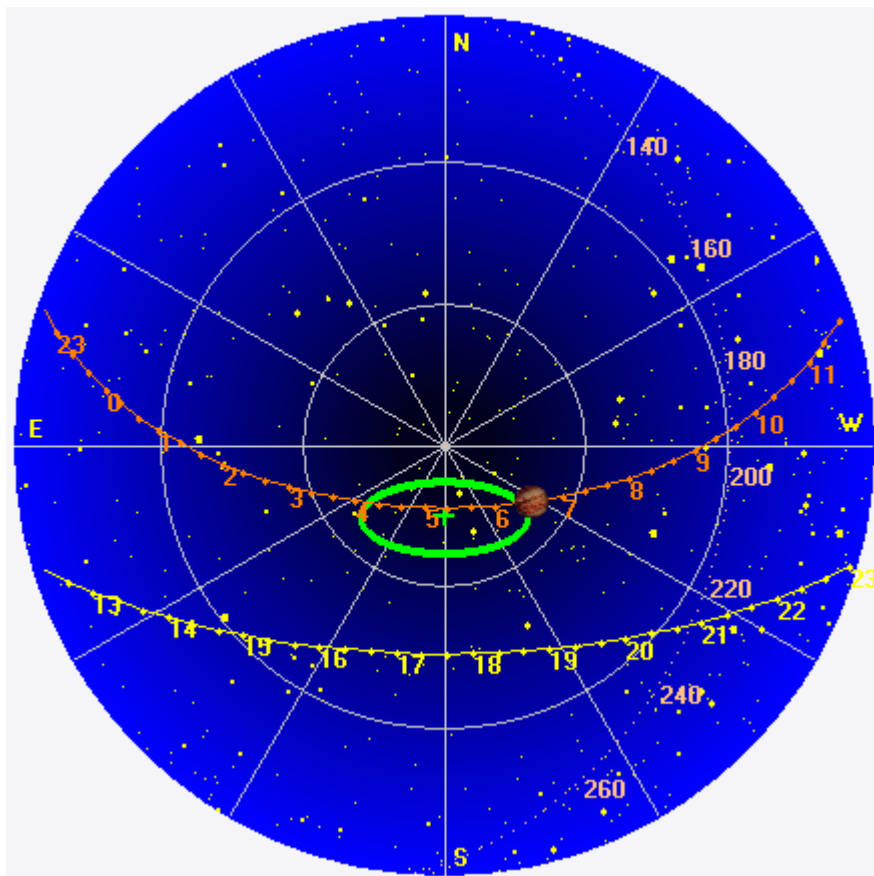
Jupiter was $+13^\circ$ to $+23^\circ$ off axis.

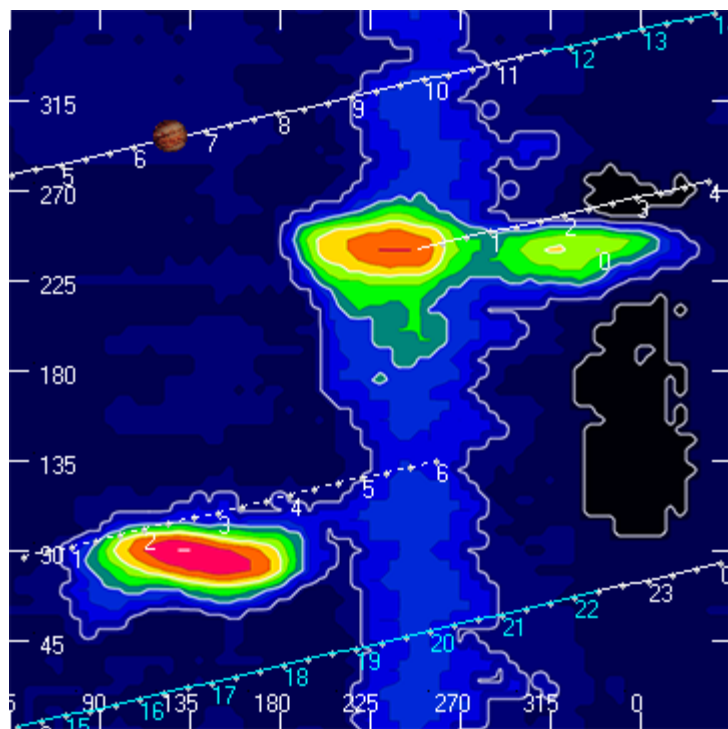
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 172° .

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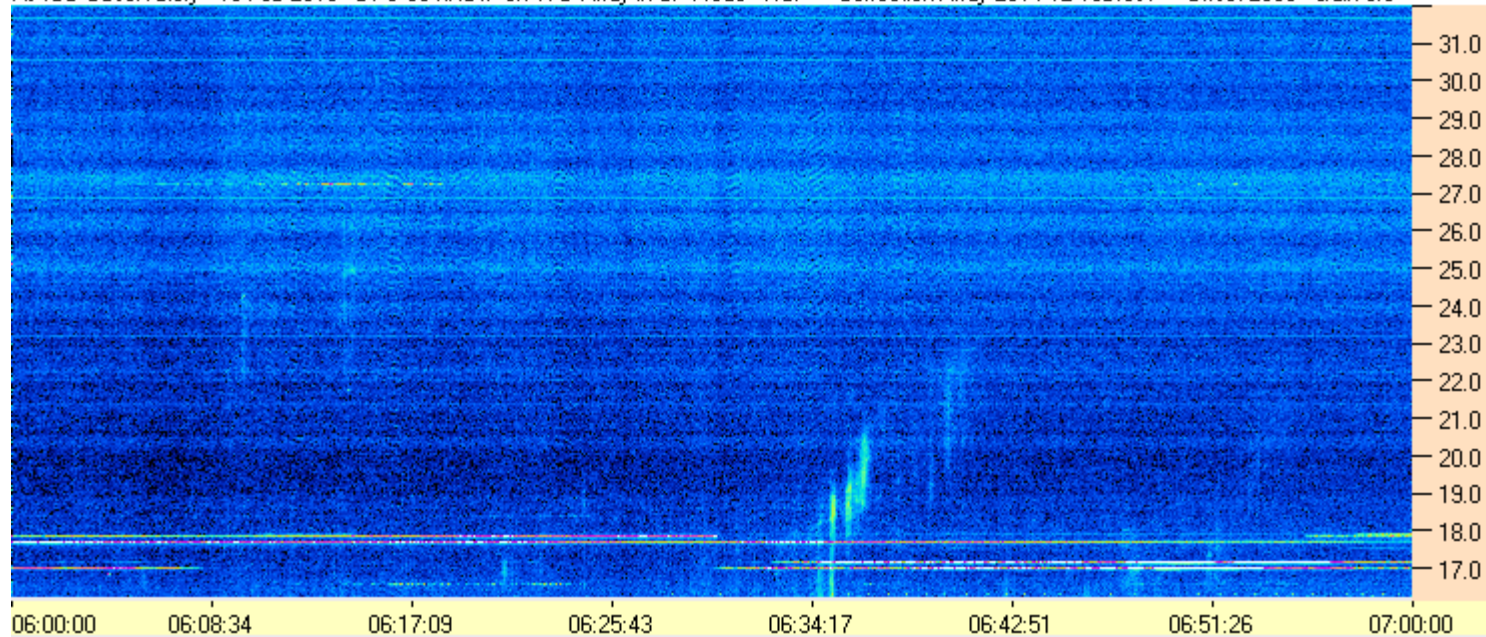

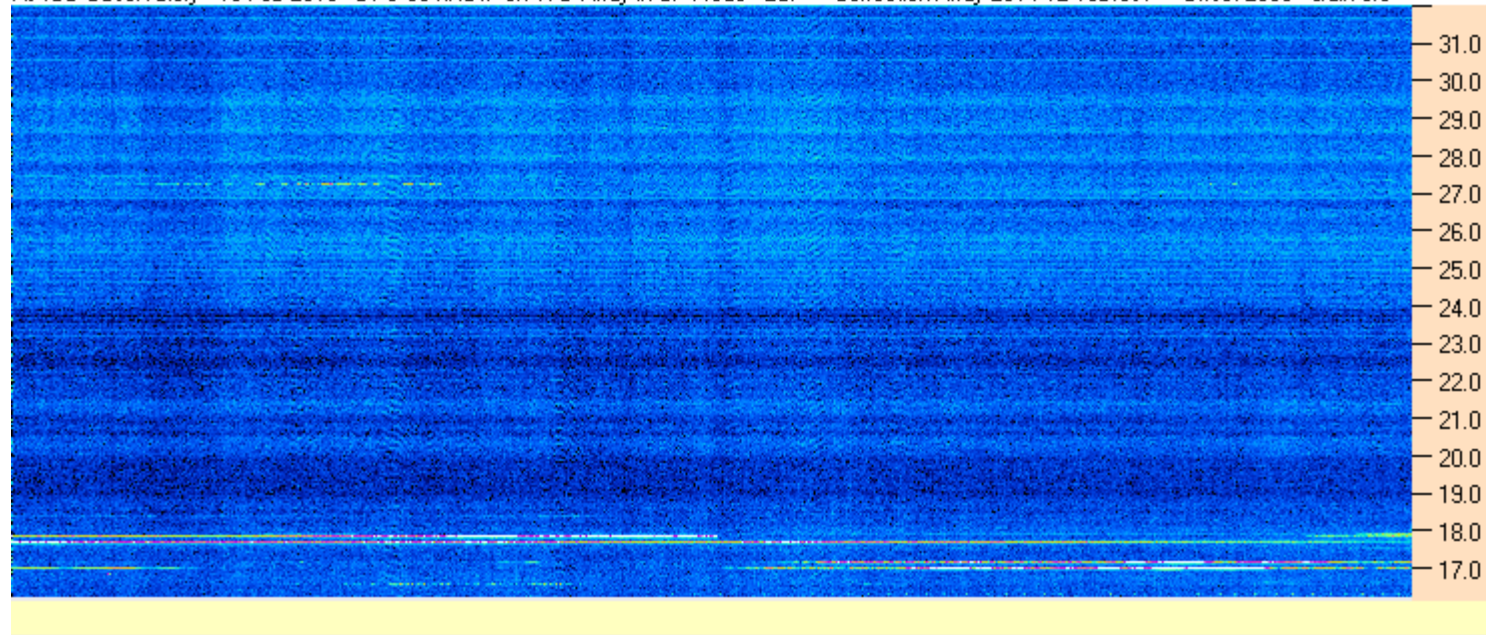


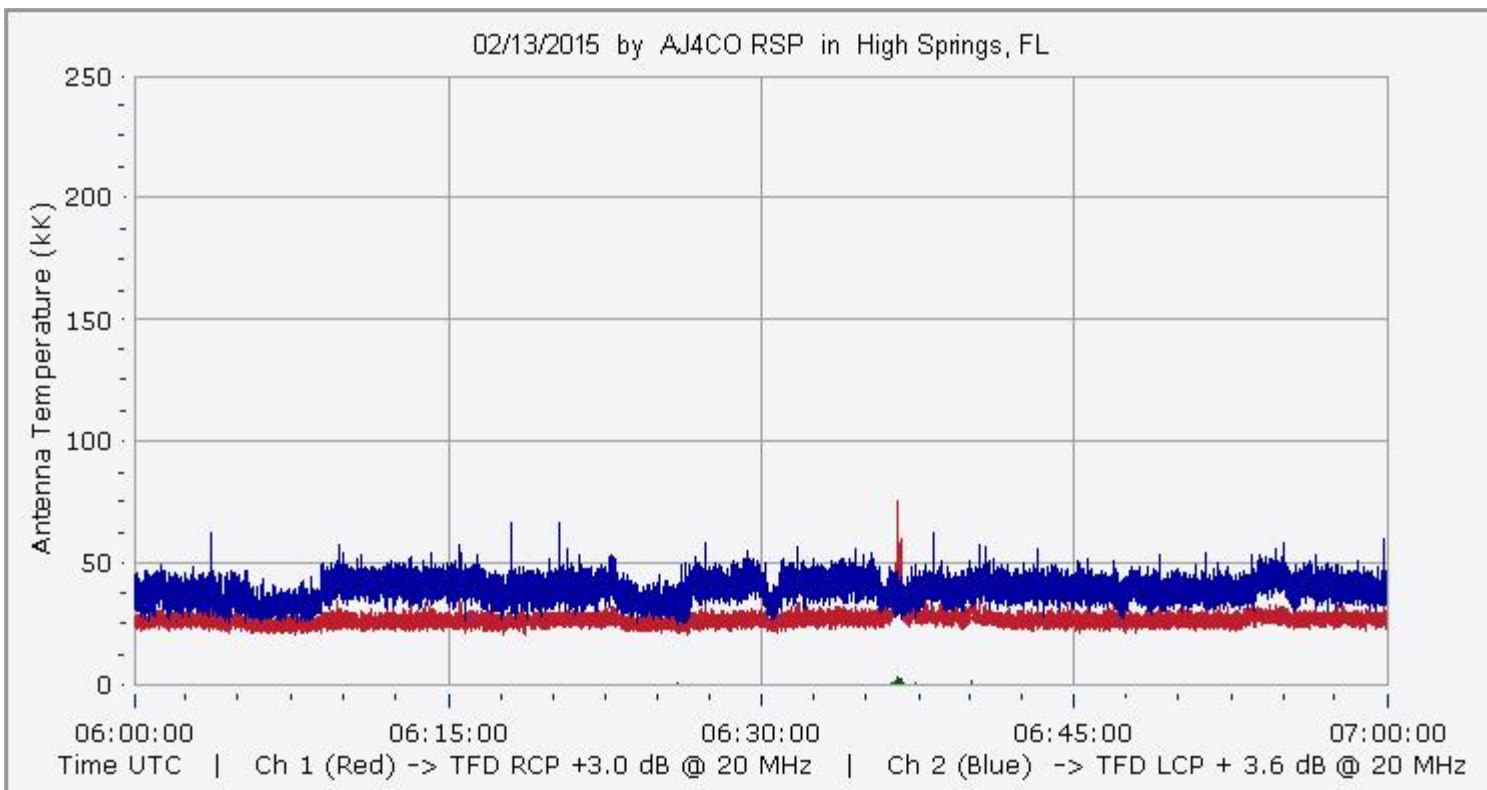

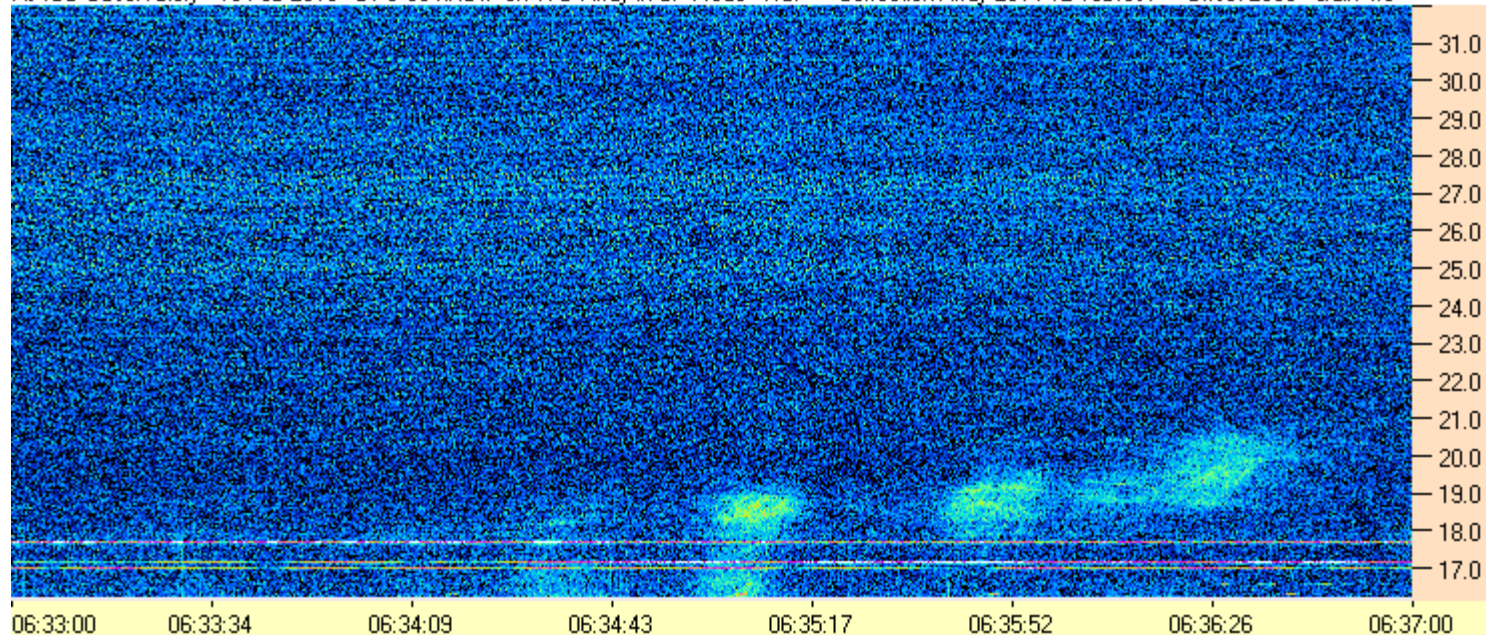
