Nothing visible here from the later non-Io-C that Jim and Tom saw (too far off axis here).

RCP dominant L bursting from 16 to 28 MHz. No modulation lanes visible.

Very low level line noise in the background, which oddly showed up as spikey RFI in RCP.

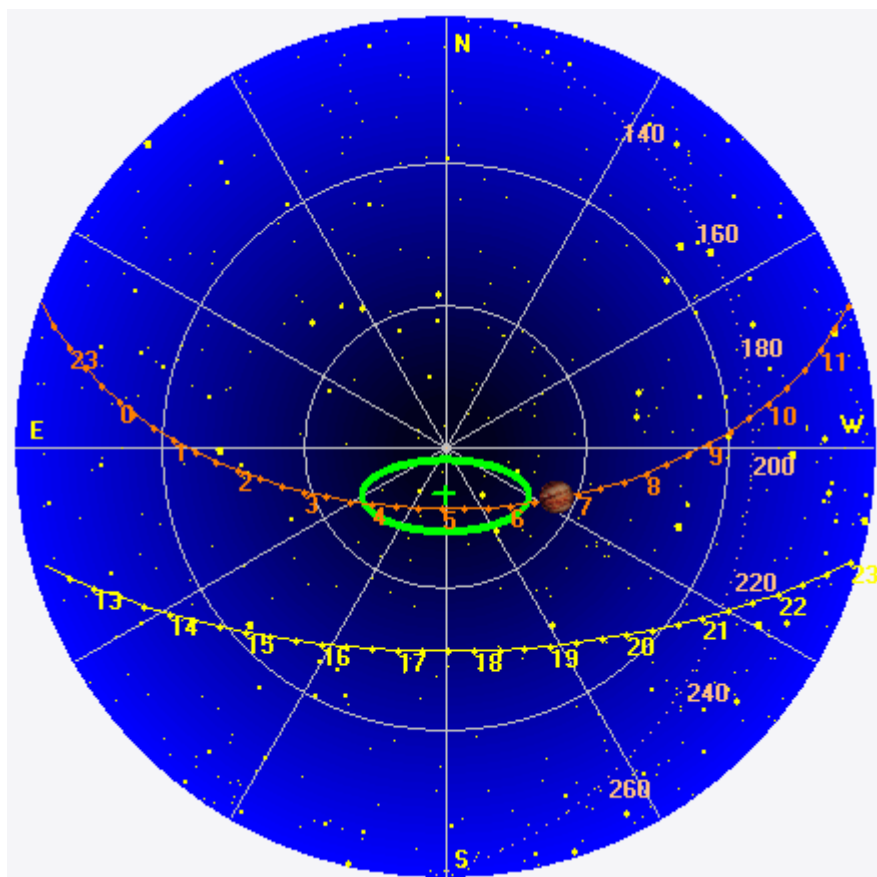
Jupiter was +14° to +32° off axis.

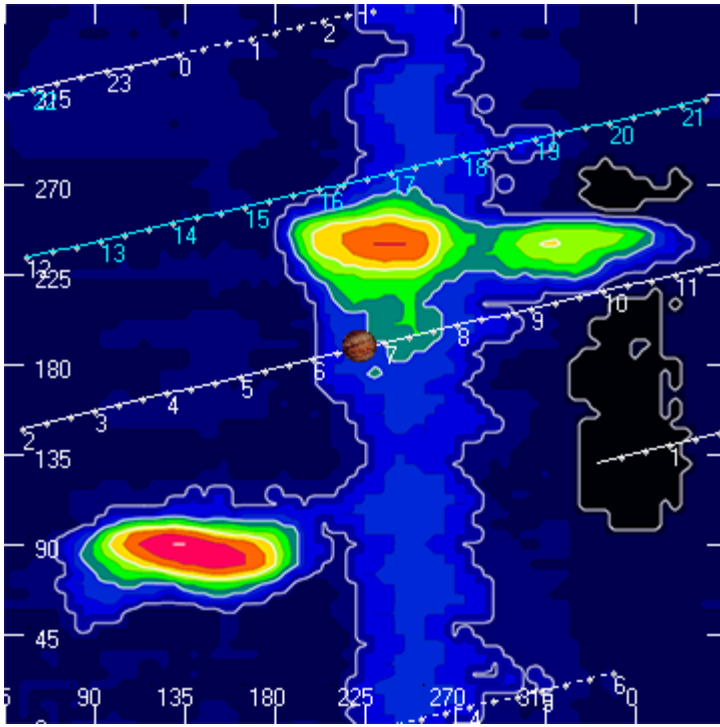
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 169°.

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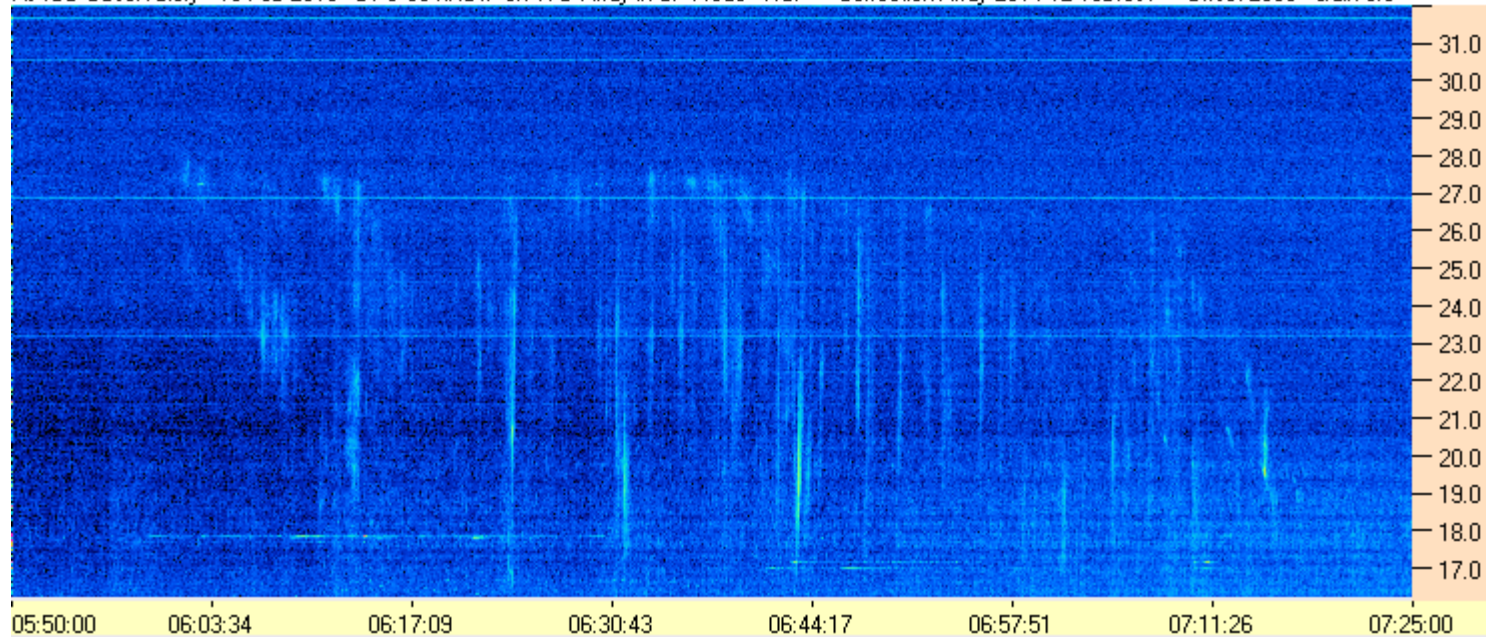

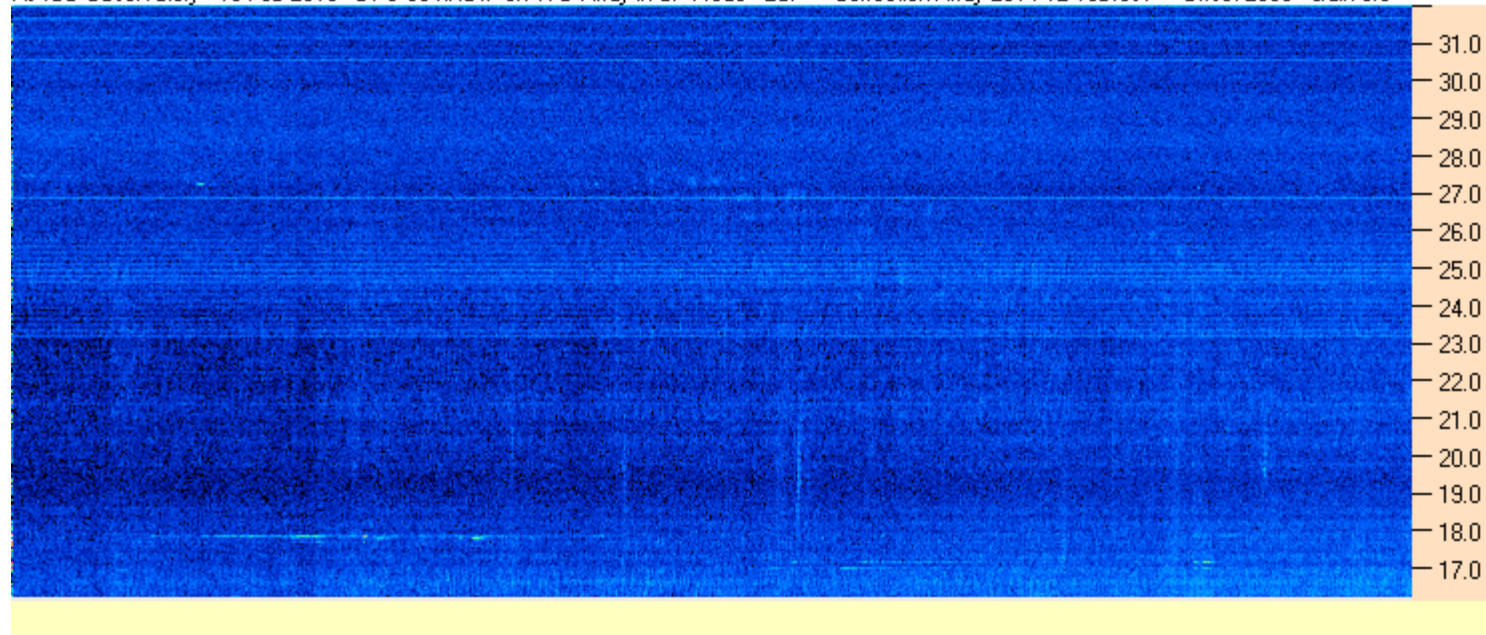


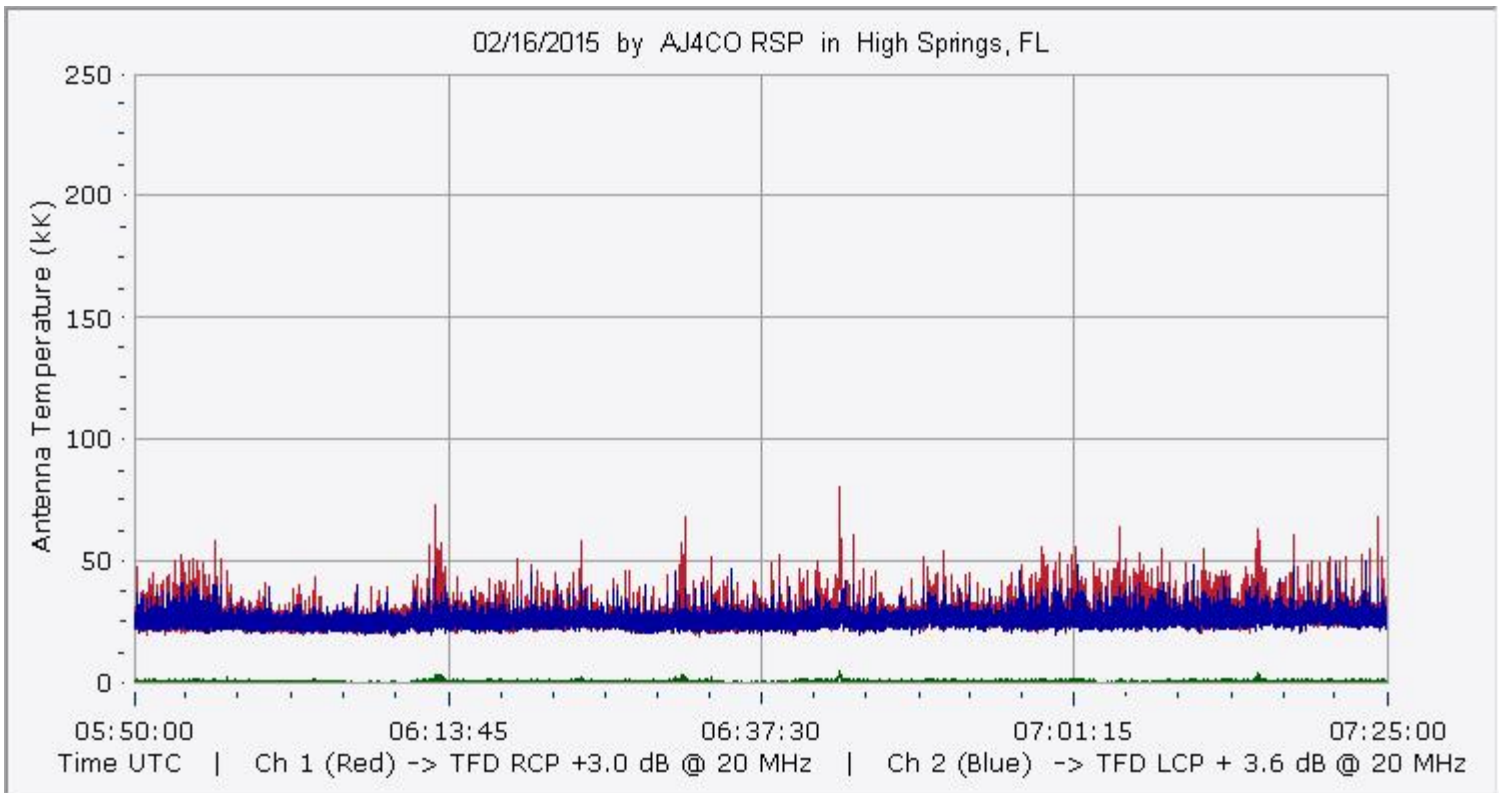

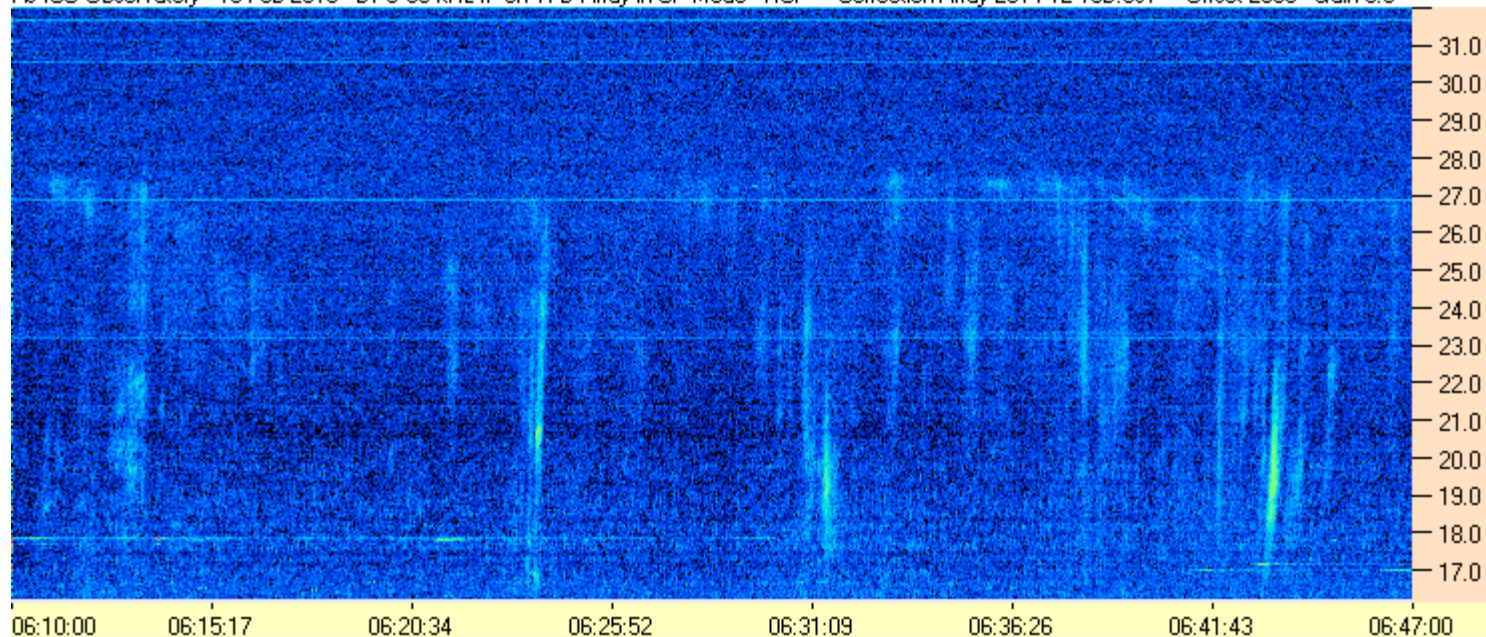
