LCP dominant L bursting 0130-0203 UTC from 16 to 21 MHz, sort of vertex late arc, no modulation lanes visible.

RCP dominant L bursting 0211-0320 UTC from 16 to 30 MHz, vertex late arcs, no modulation lanes visible.

Power line noise present throughout.

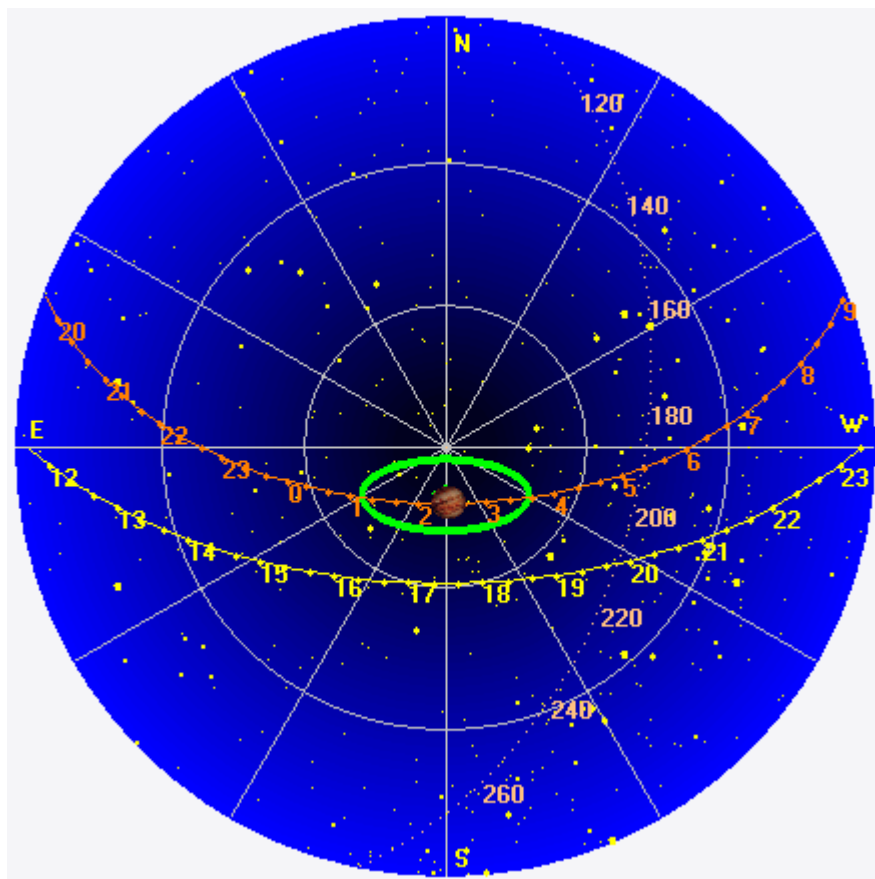
Jupiter was -13° to $+13^\circ$ off axis.

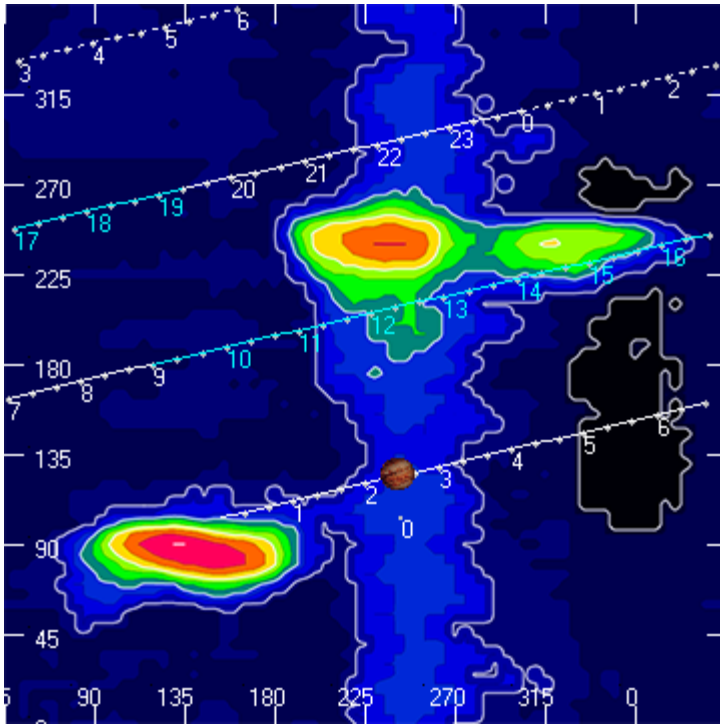
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 129° .

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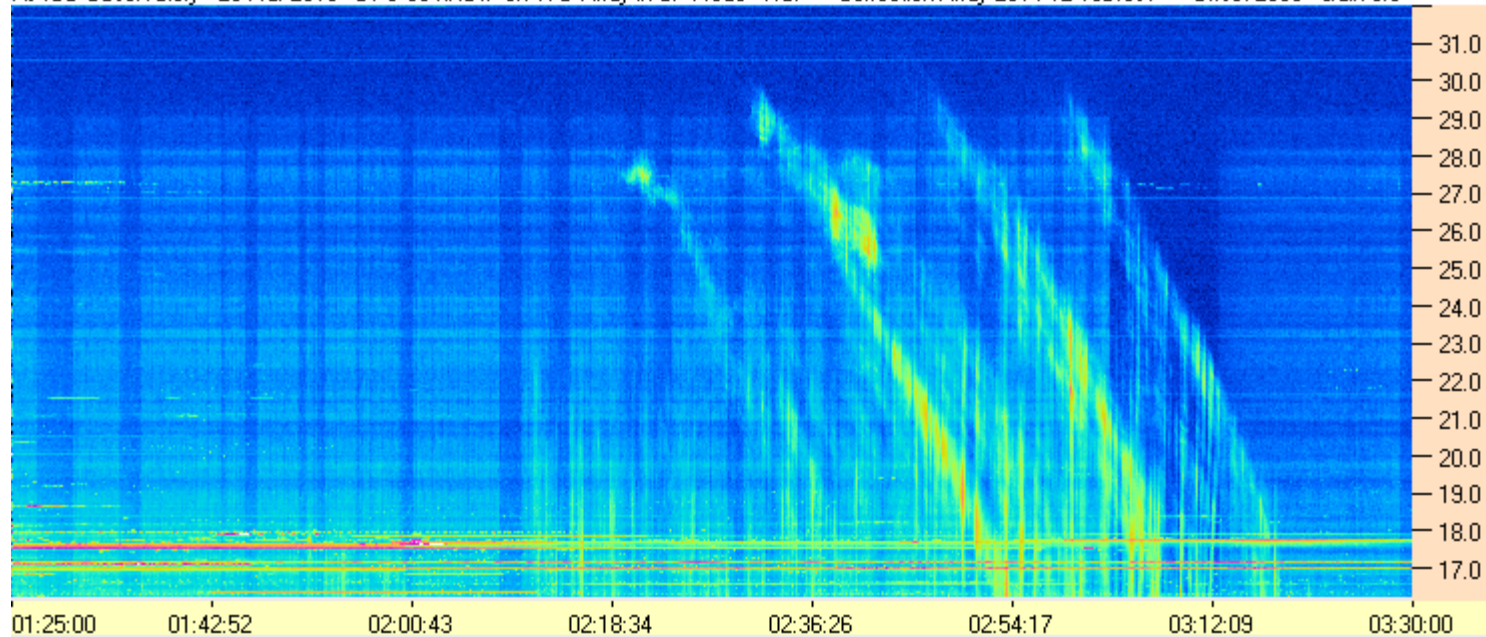

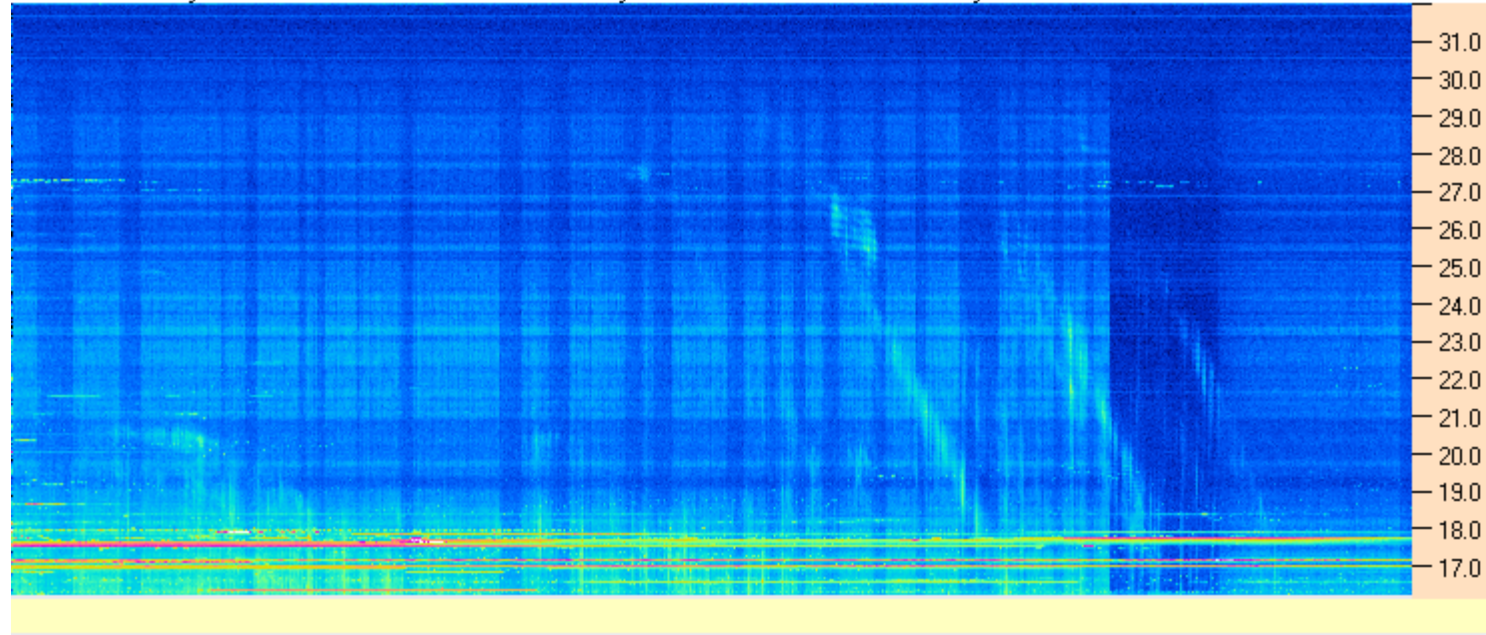


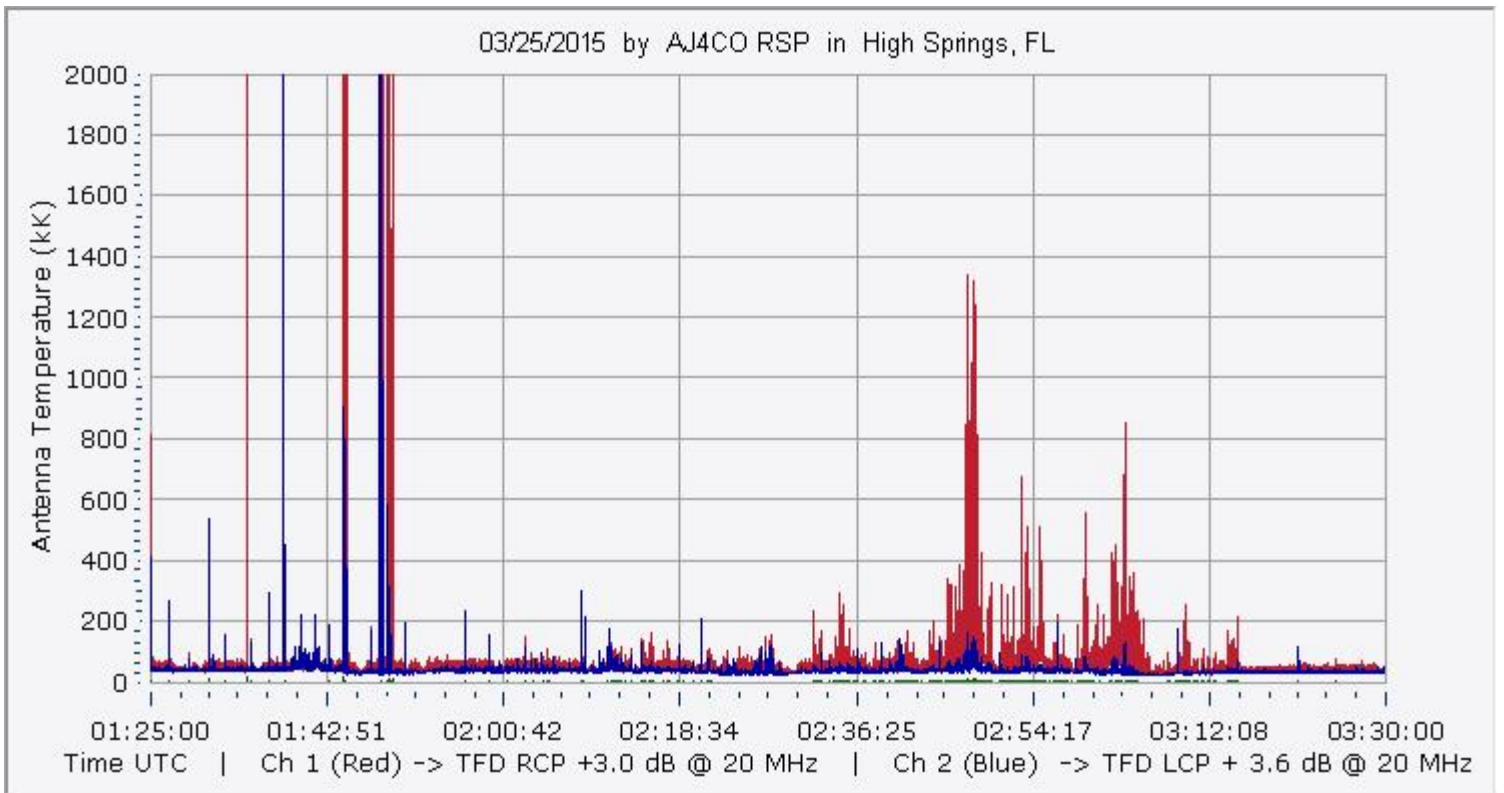

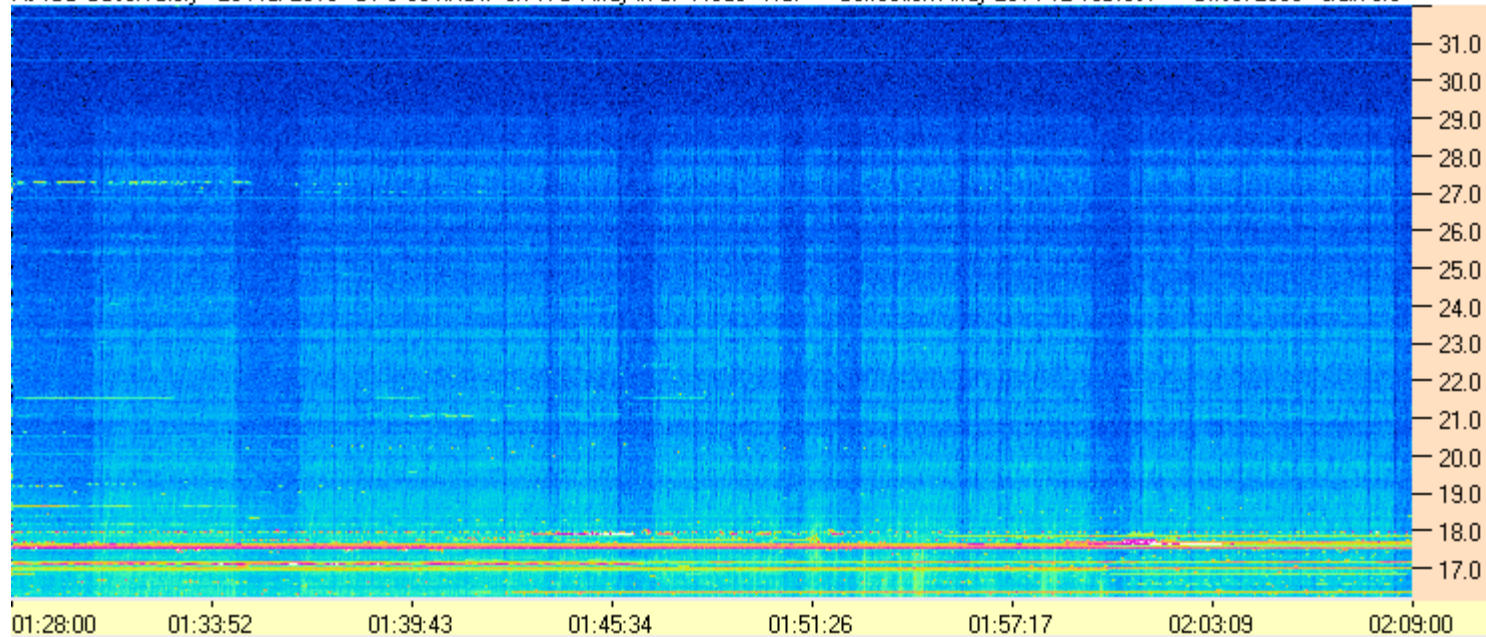
