Line noise throughout.

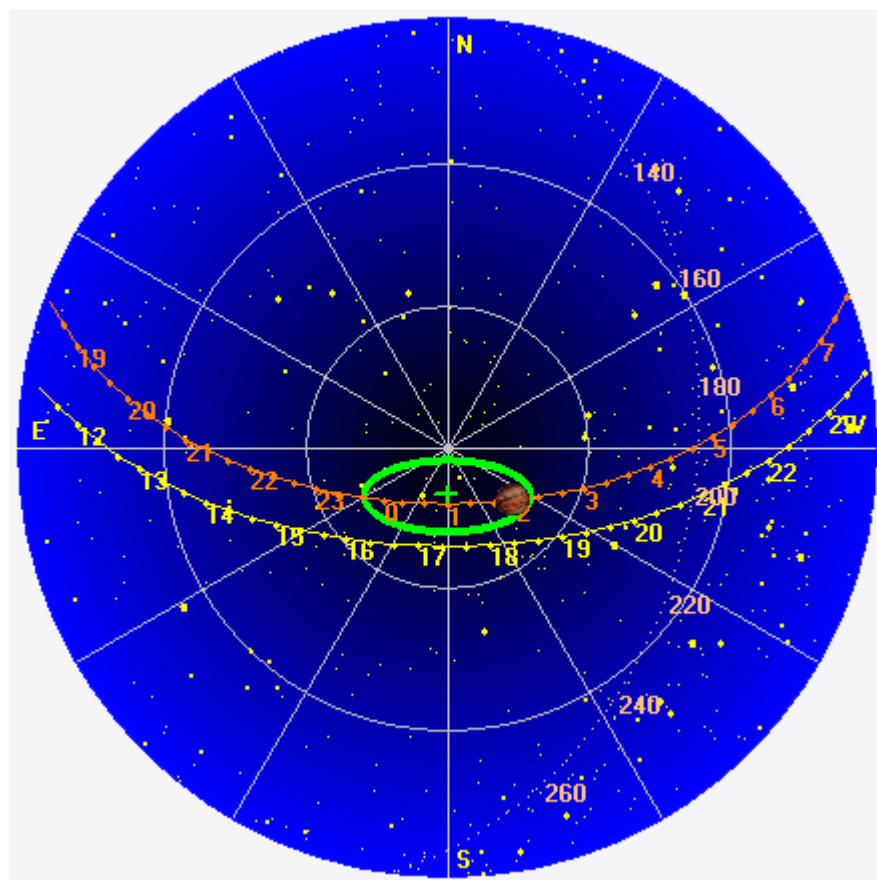
Jupiter was $+8^\circ$ to $+18^\circ$ off axis.

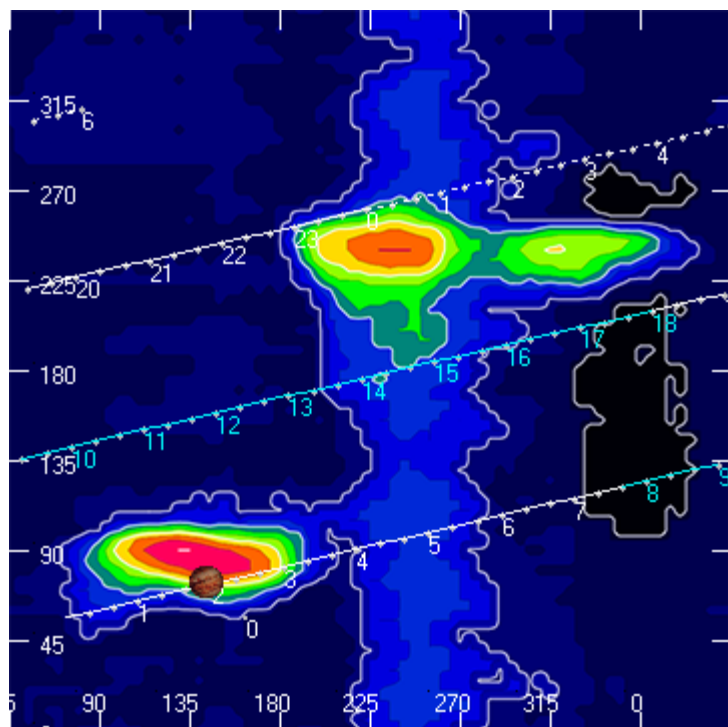
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 108° .

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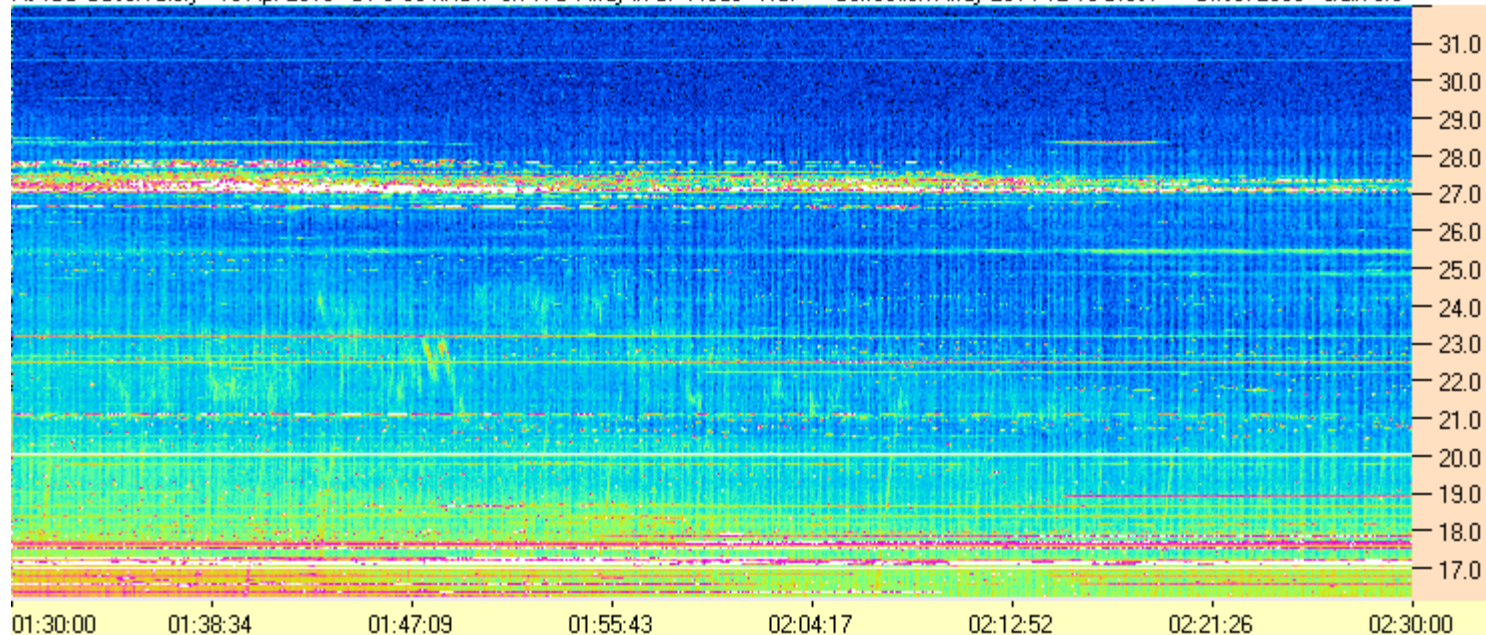

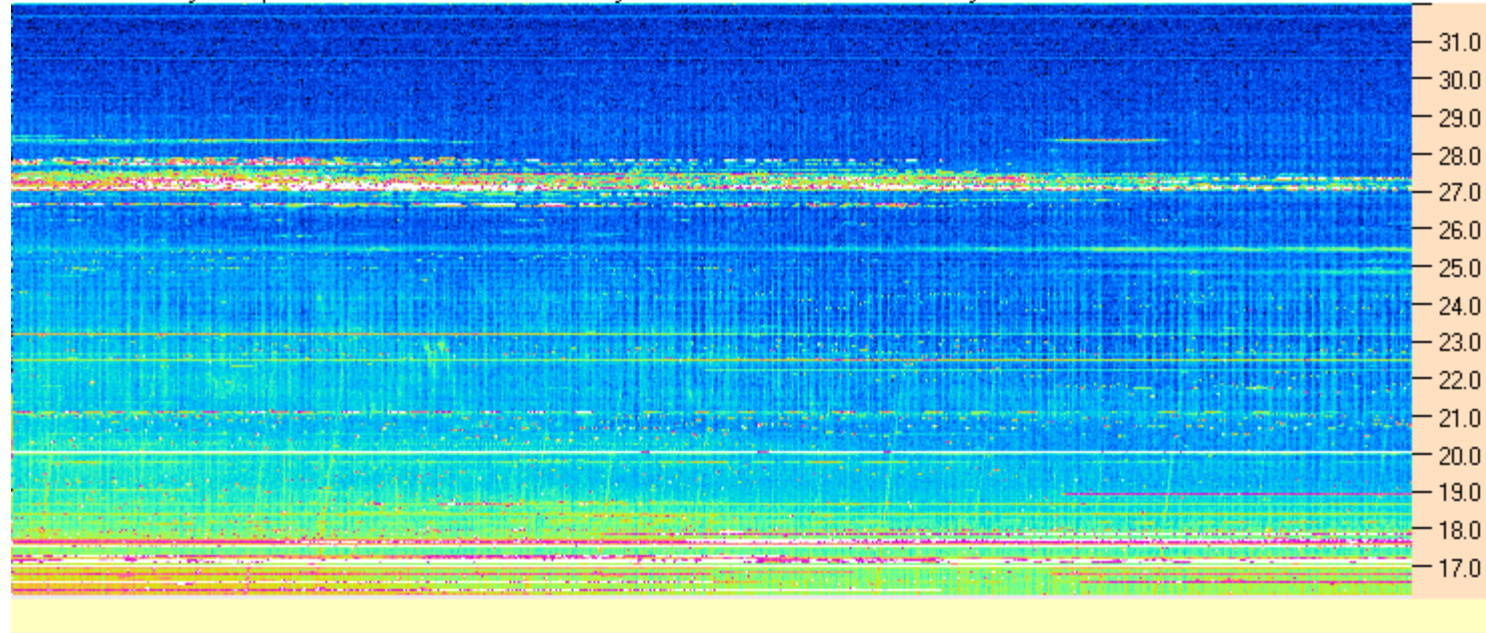




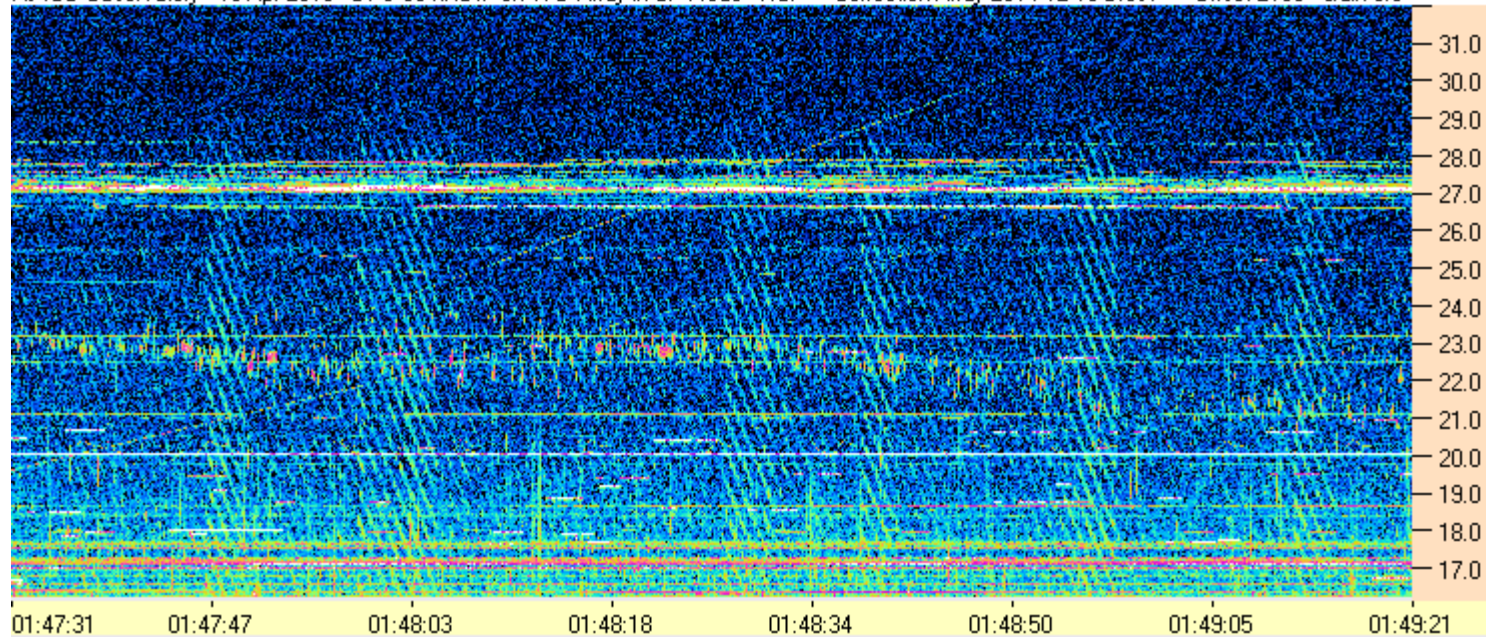
