RCP dominant L bursting 0114-0145 UTC from 16 to 22 MHz, no arc shape, no modulation lanes visible.

Weak line noise throughout.

The second spectrogram with more offset digs the emission at 16-17 MHz out of the band noise.

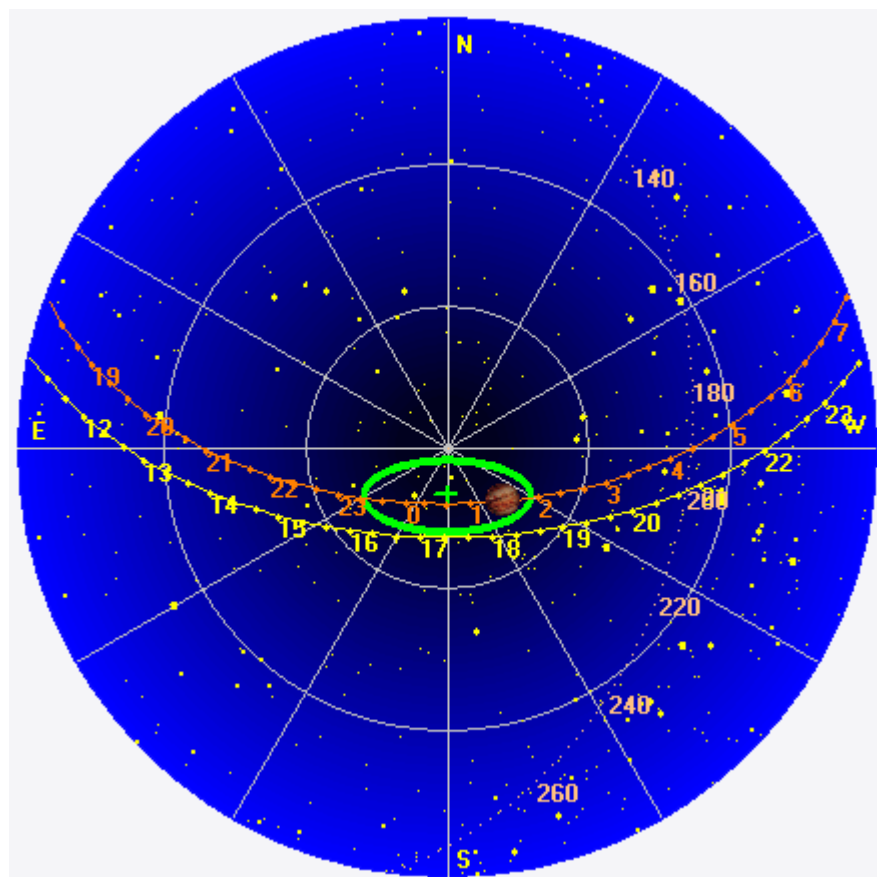
Jupiter was +8° to +15° off axis.

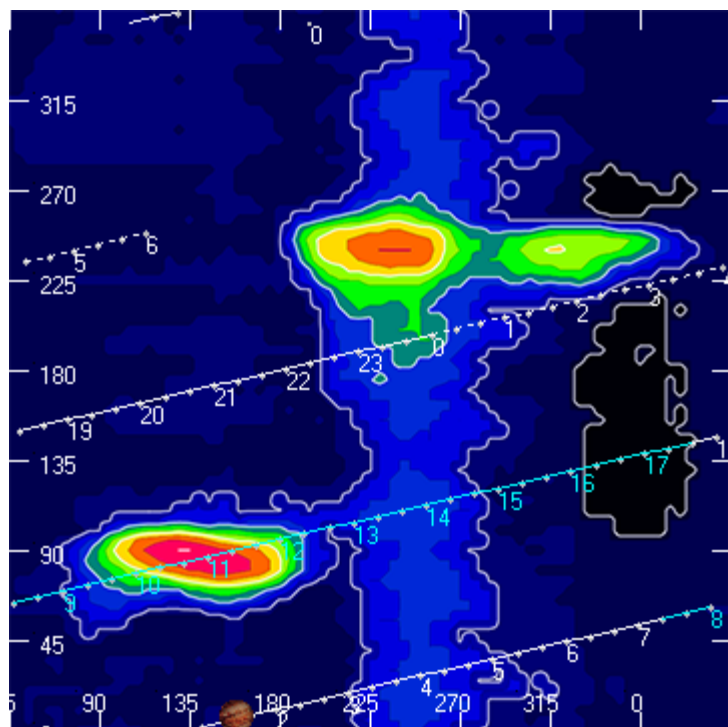
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 103°.

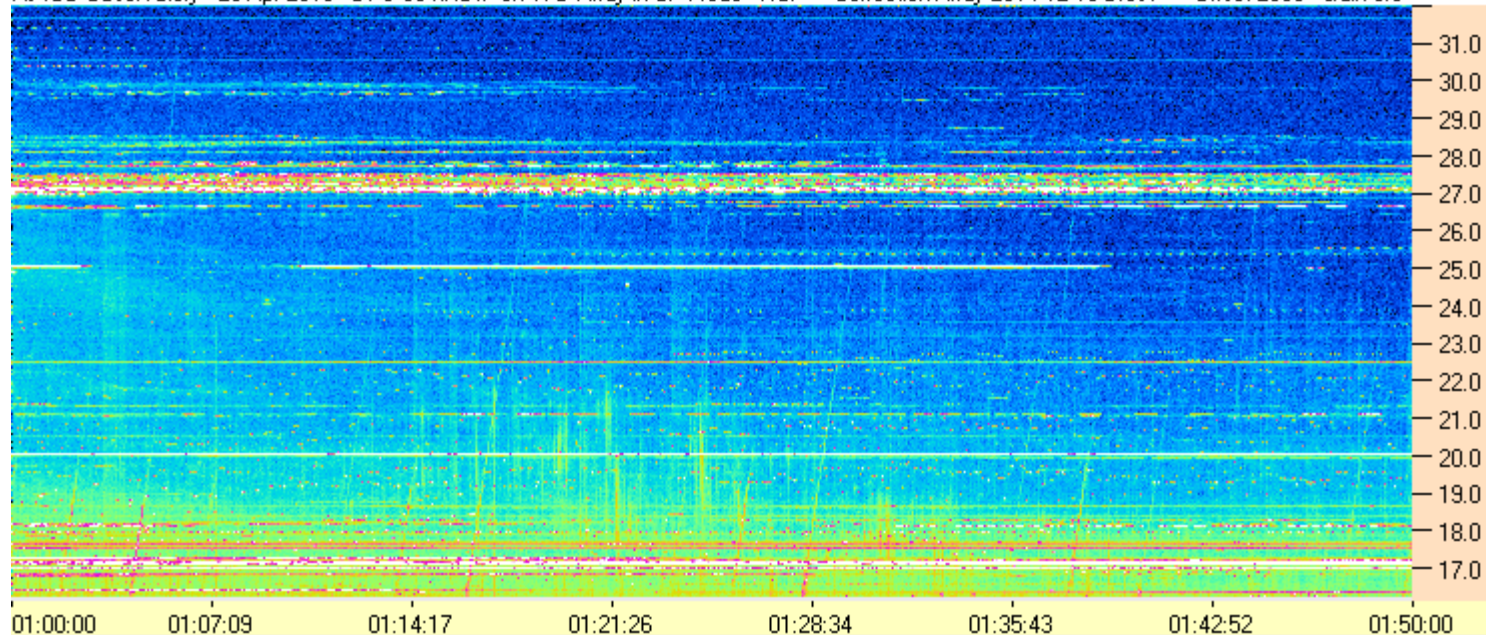

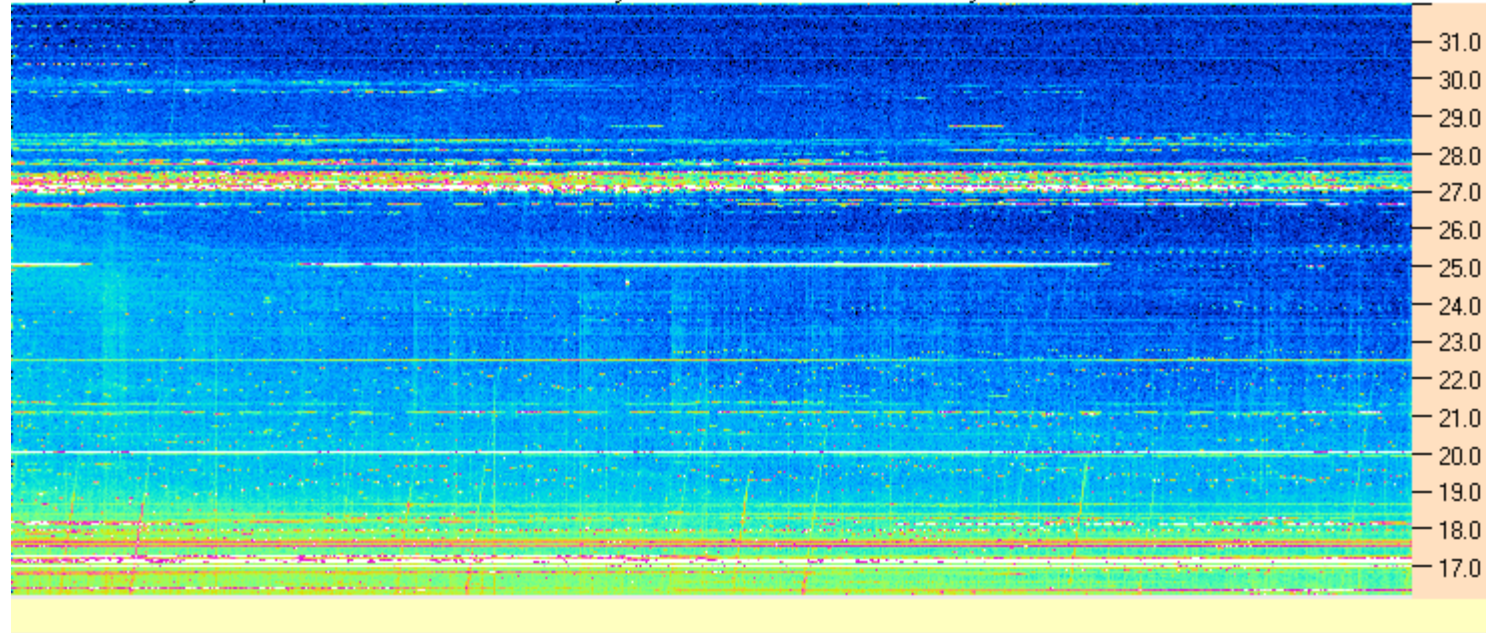




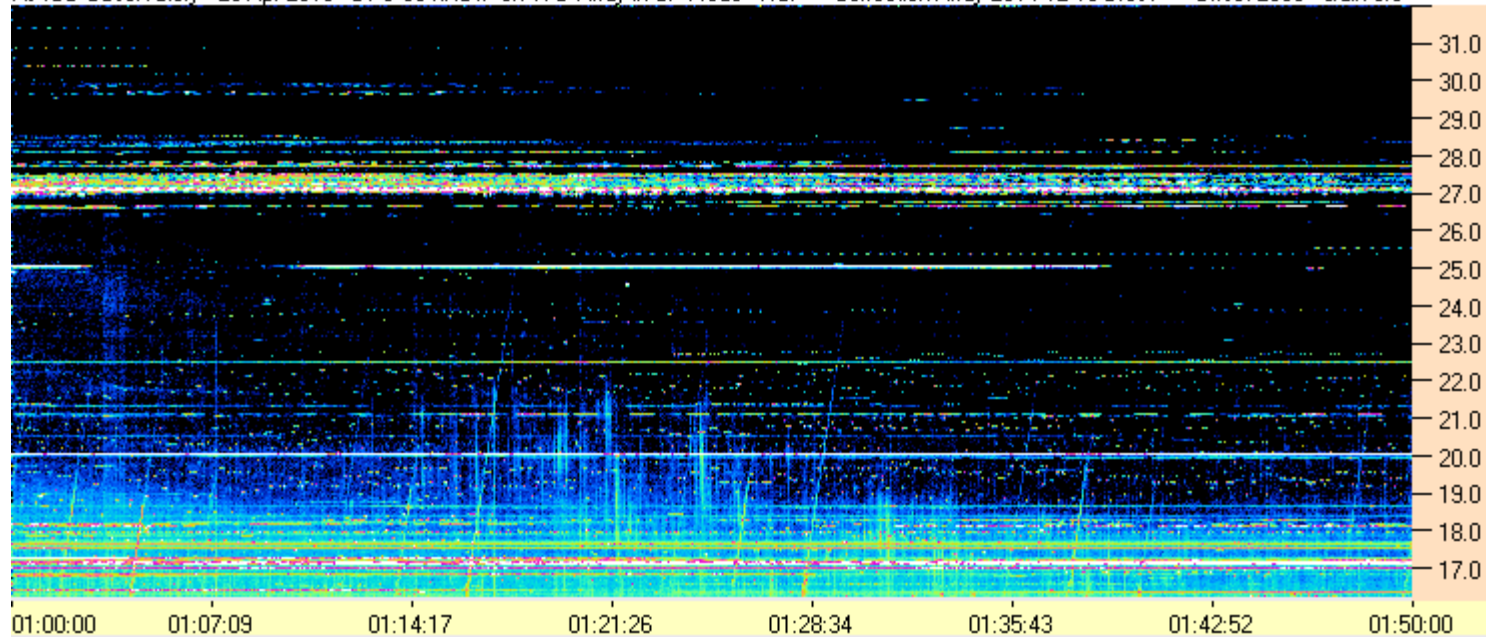
