RCP dominant L bursting 0011 - 0034 UTC from 18 to 24 MHz, downward drifting emission envelope. No modulation lanes visible.

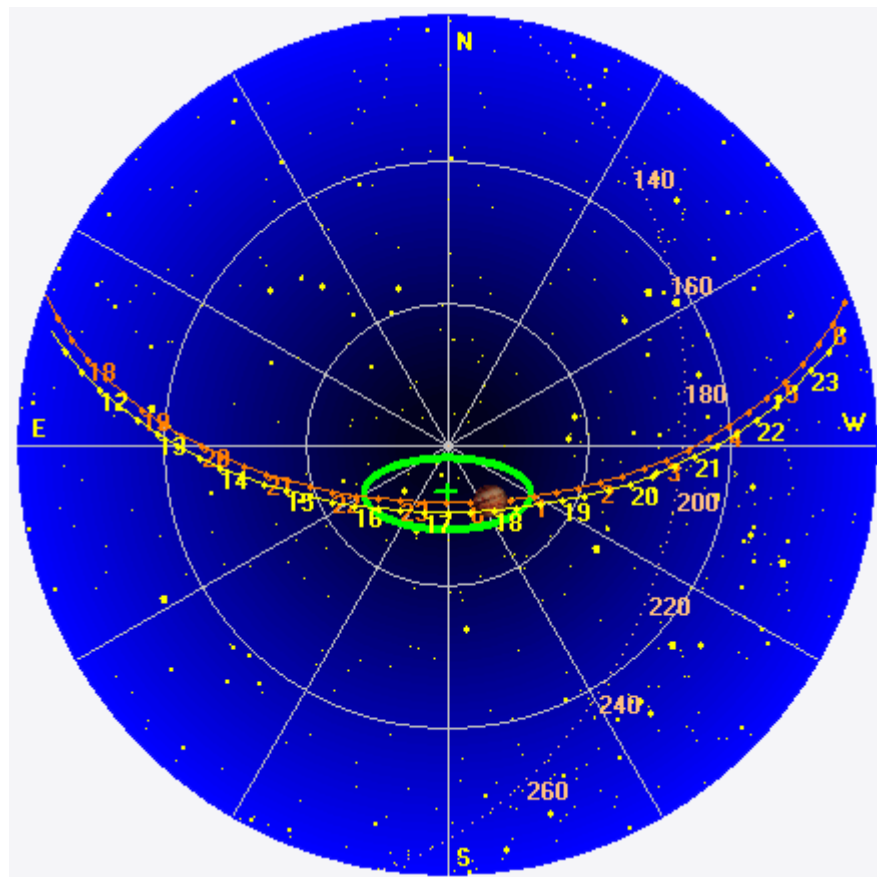
Jupiter was $+6^\circ$ to $+12^\circ$ off axis.

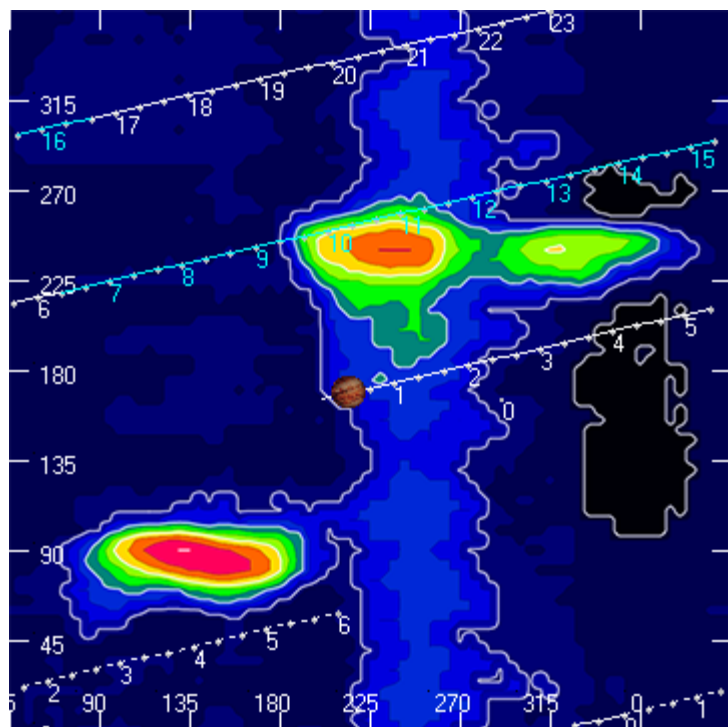
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 89° .

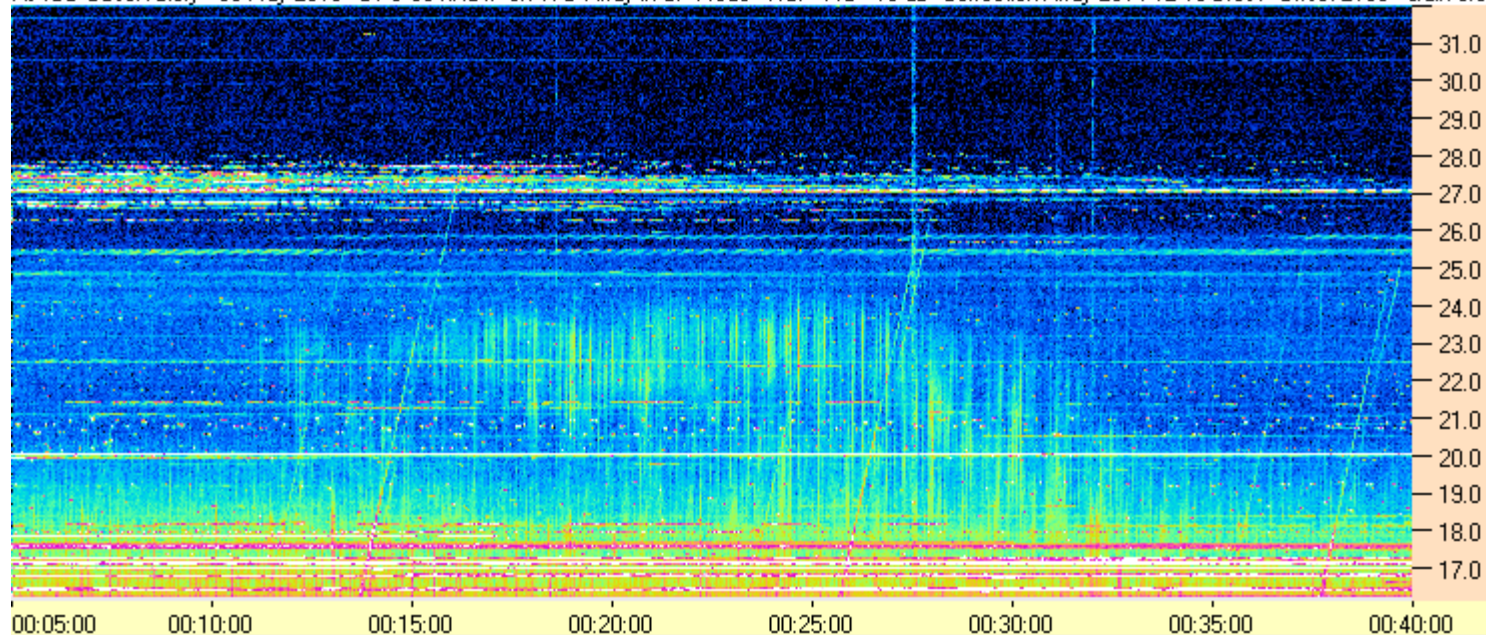
