RCP dominant narrow band S bursting 2145 - 2309 UTC from 18 to 26 MHz, zero drift emission envelope. No modulation lanes visible.

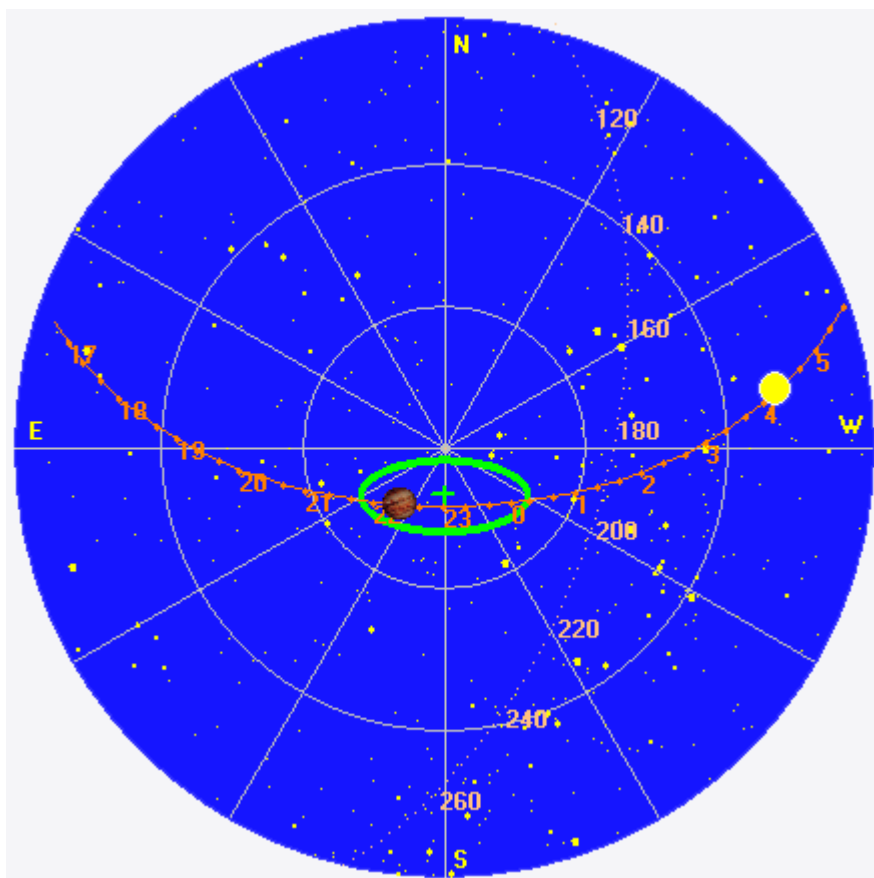
Jupiter was -18° to -3° off axis.

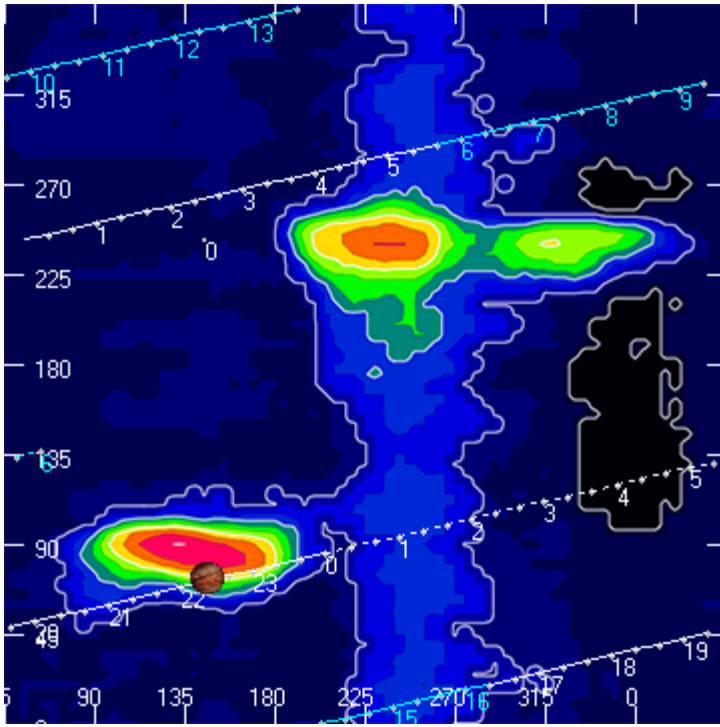
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 79° .

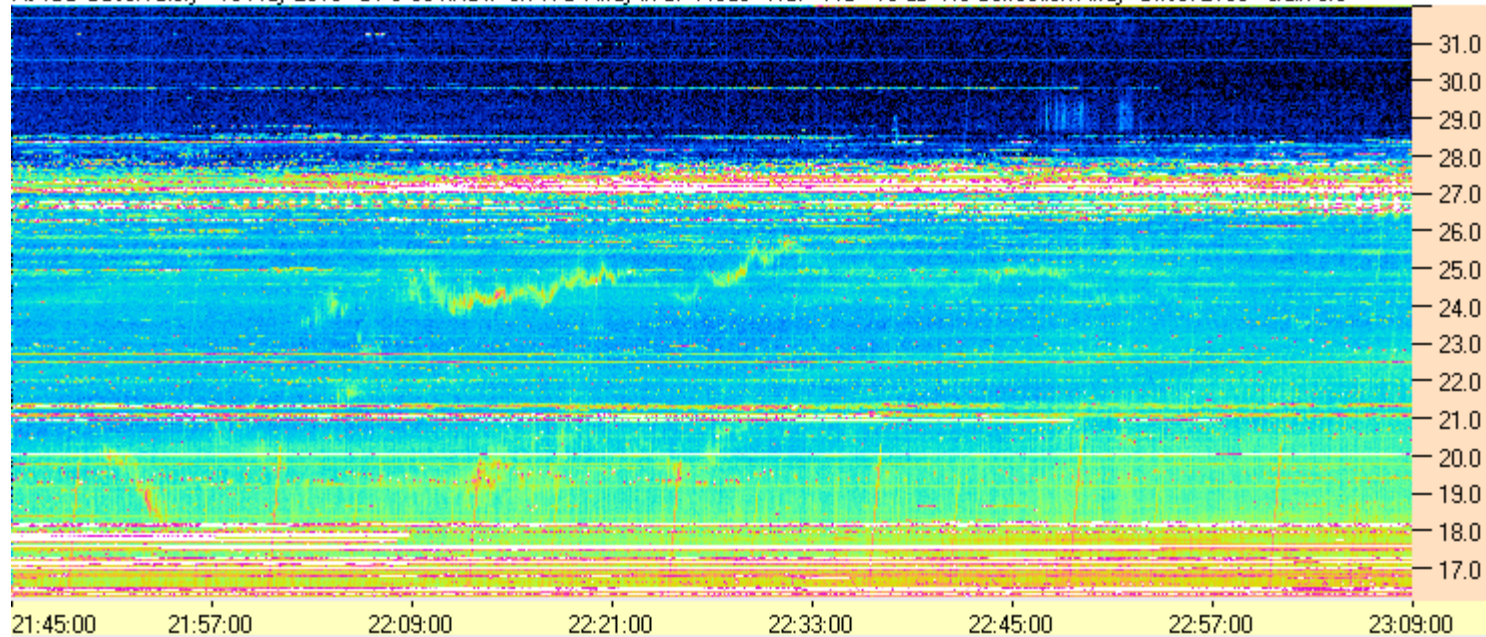

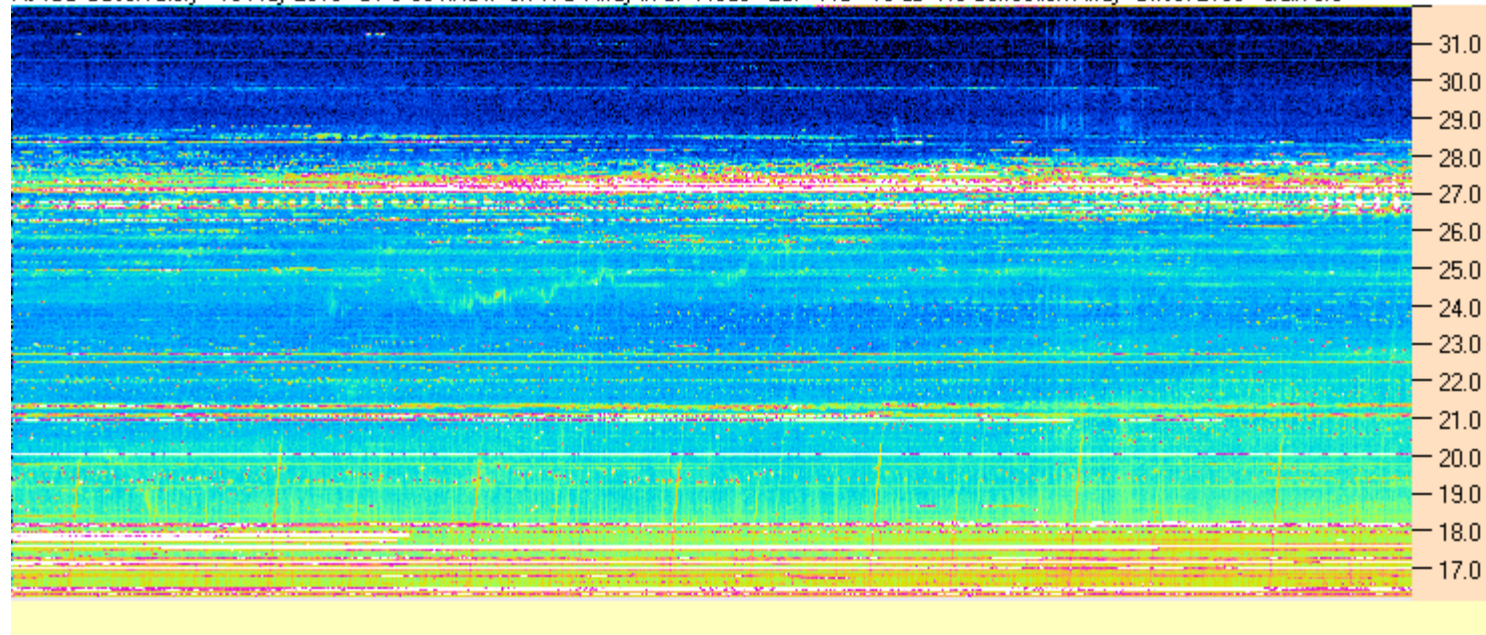




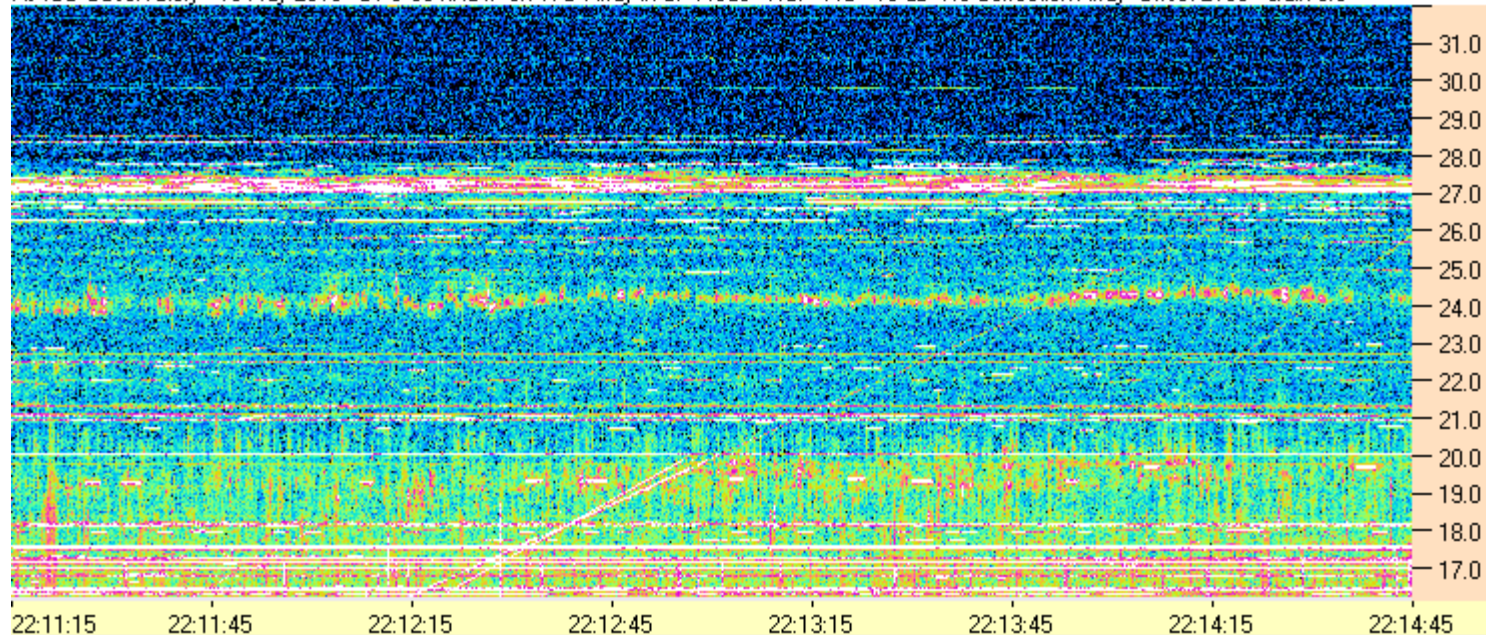
