RCP dominant L bursting 2021 - 2217 UTC from 18 to 24 MHz, vertex late arc(s). No modulation lanes visible.

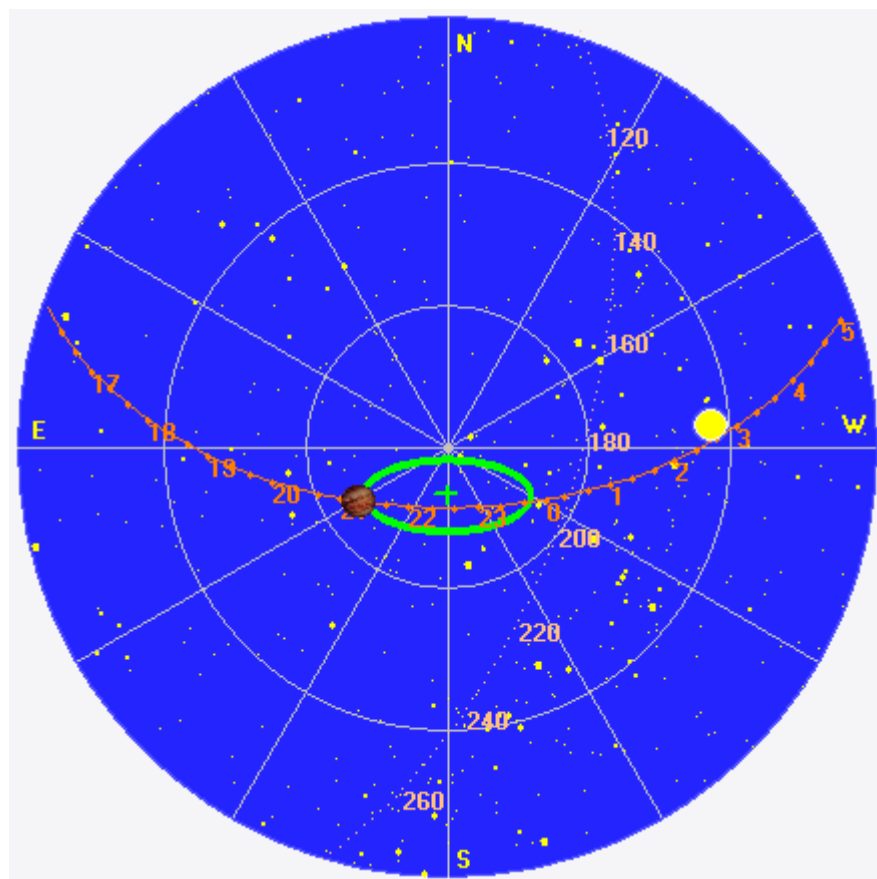
Jupiter was -32° to -5° off axis.

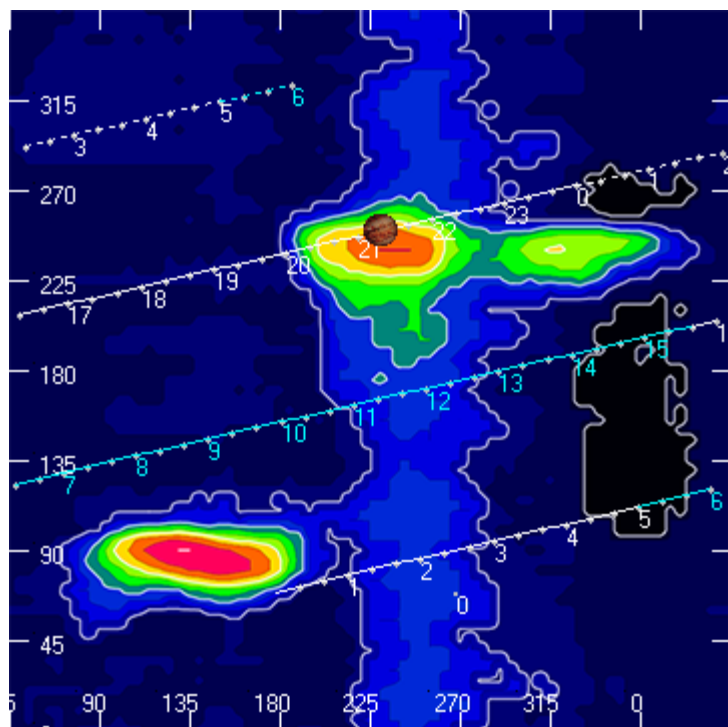
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 72° .

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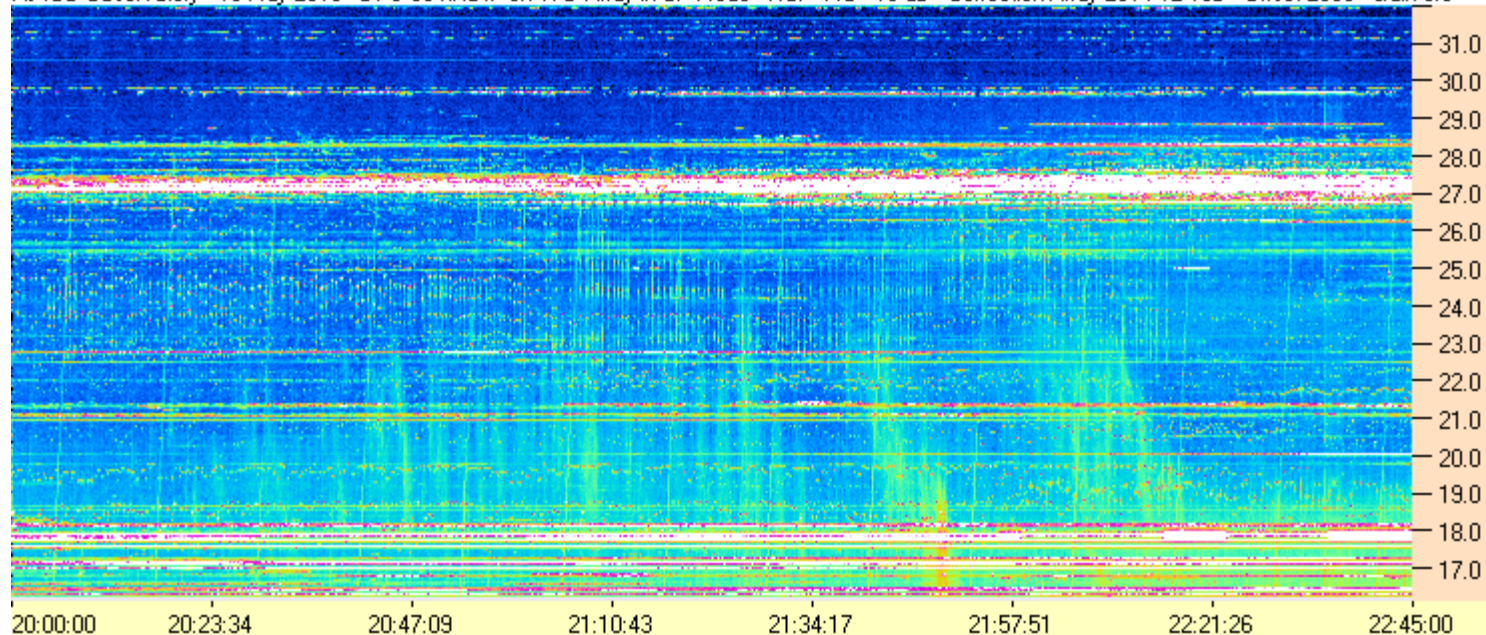
