RCP dominant L bursting 2142-2214 UTC from 16 to 23 MHz, negative drift emission envelope. No modulation lanes visible.

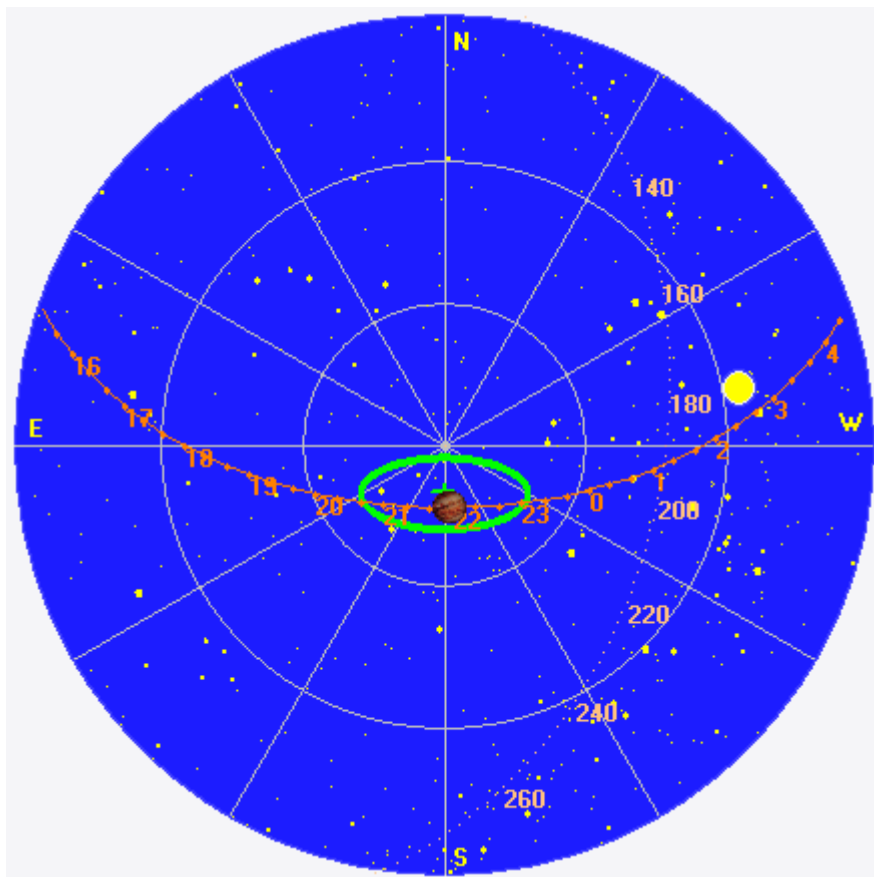
Jupiter was -5° to $+6^\circ$ off axis.

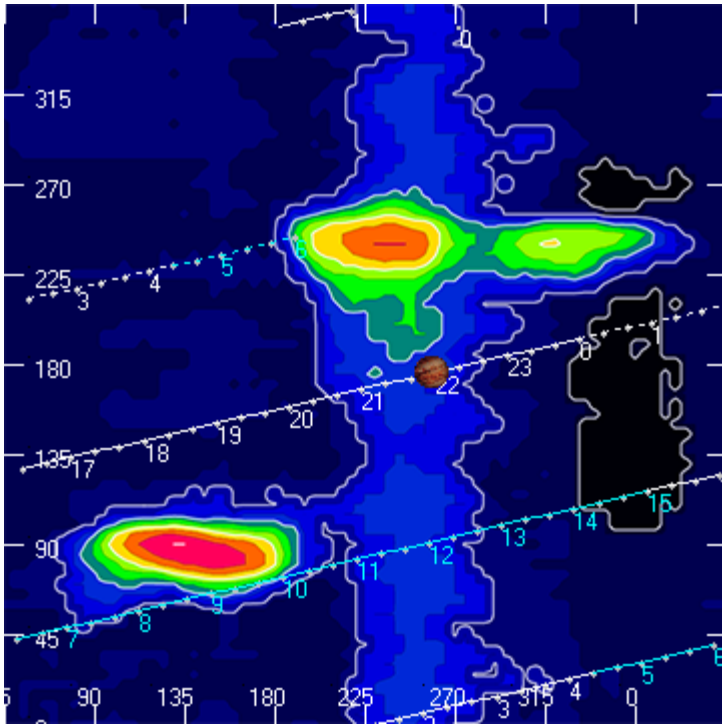
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 62° .

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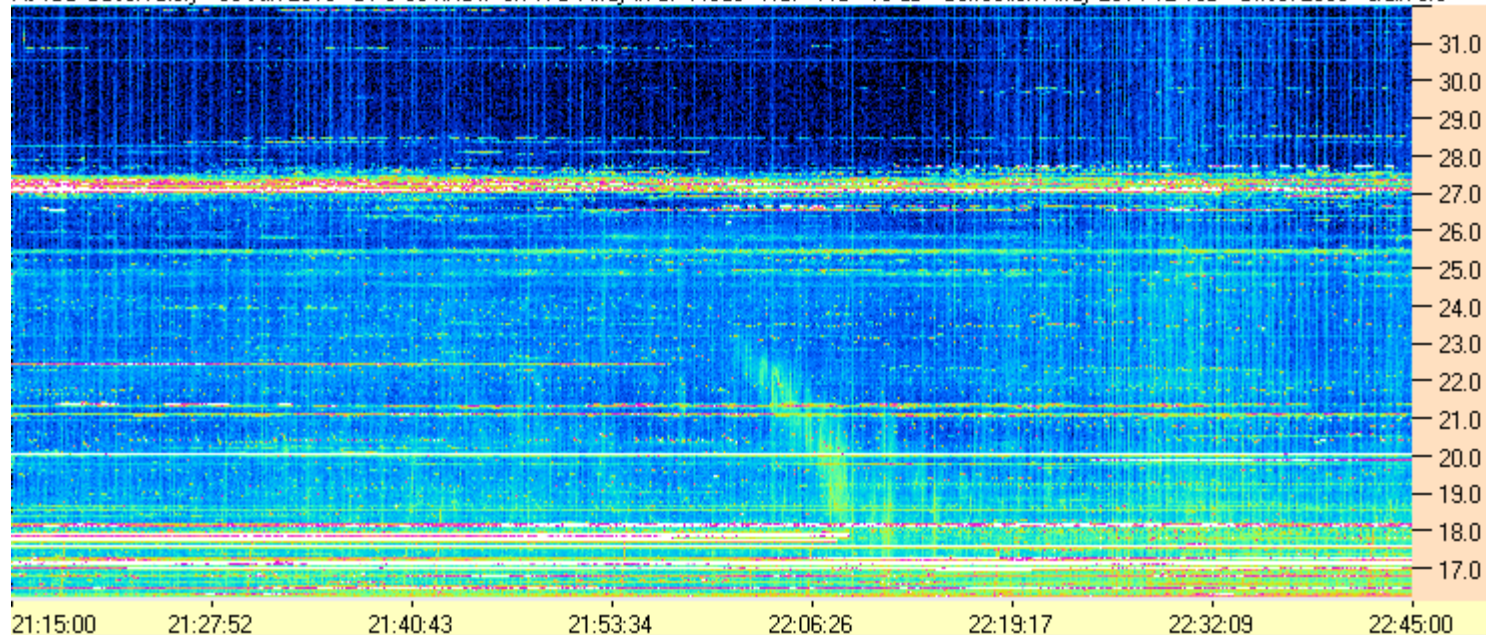
