RCP dominant L bursting 2153-2321 UTC from 18 to 32 MHz, vertex late arcs. No modulation lanes visible.

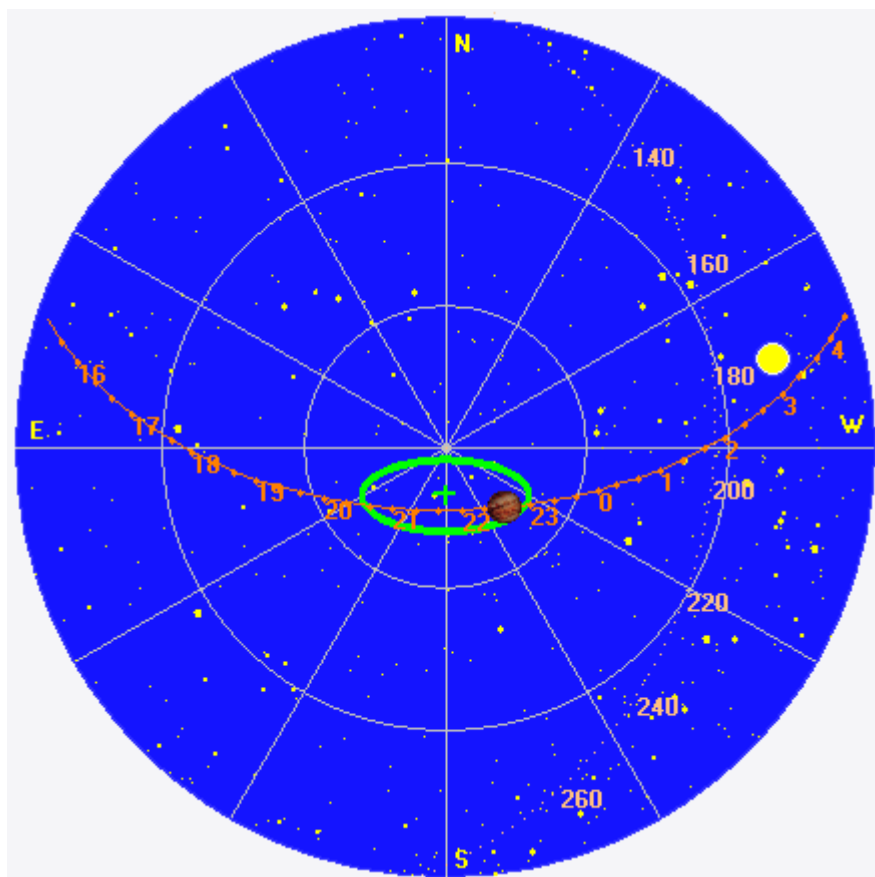
Jupiter was $+4^\circ$ to $+22^\circ$ off axis.

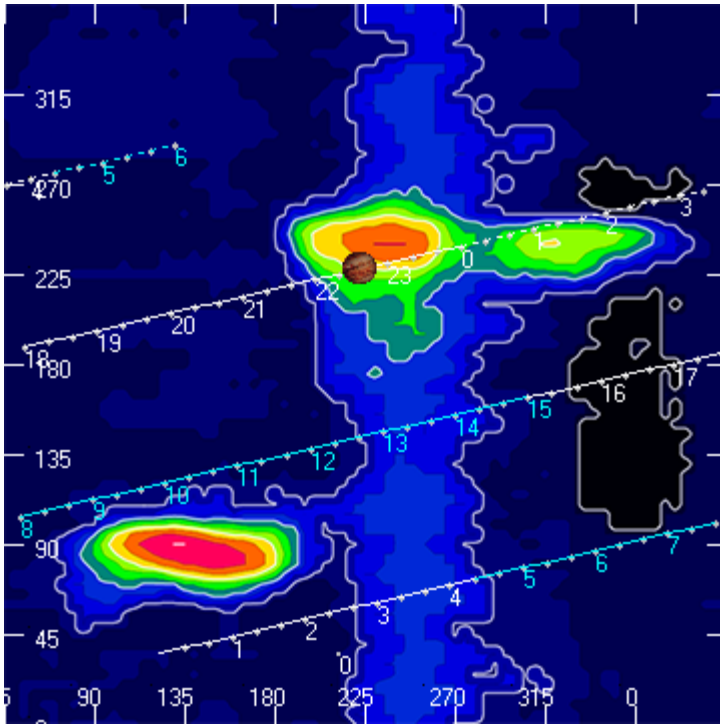
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 61° .

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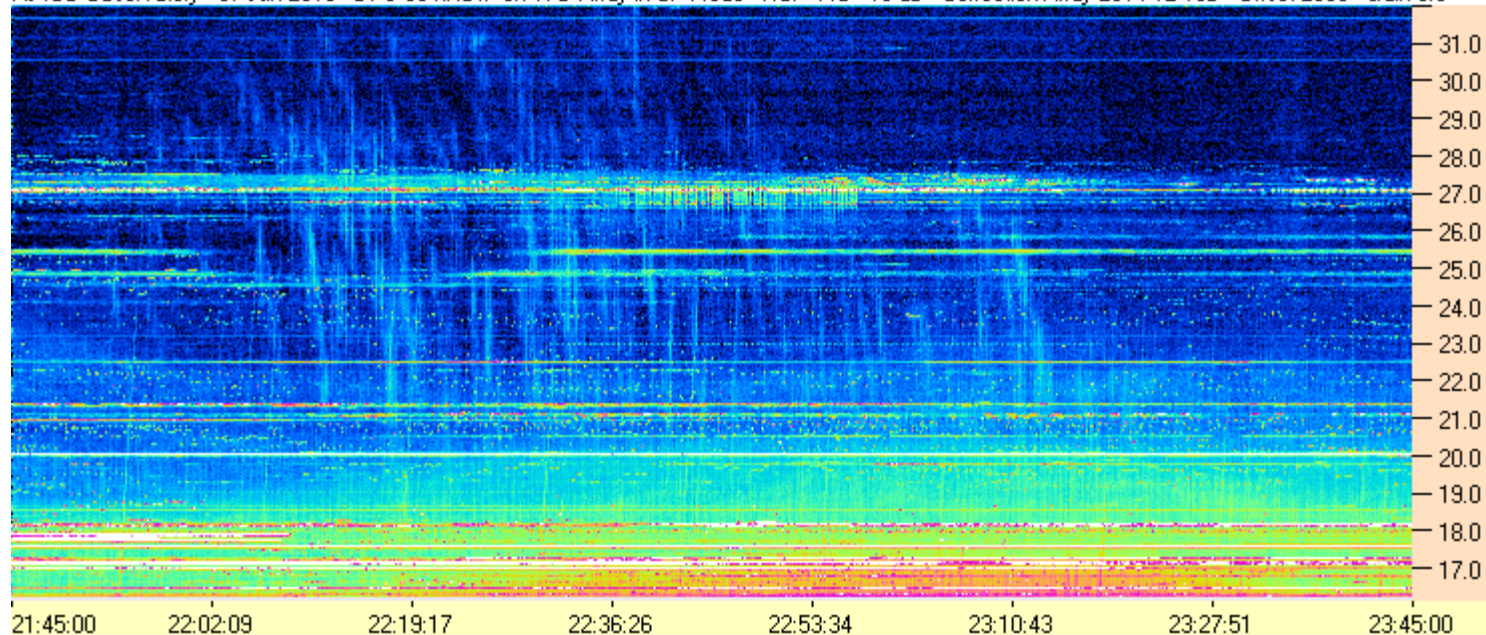
