Here's some non-Io-A behind the band noise, weak line noise, and local lightning noise (making the strip charts pretty much unreadable) from Wednesday afternoon.

RCP dominant L bursting 2111-2230 UTC from 16 to 23 MHz, negatively drifting emission envelope. No modulation lanes visible.

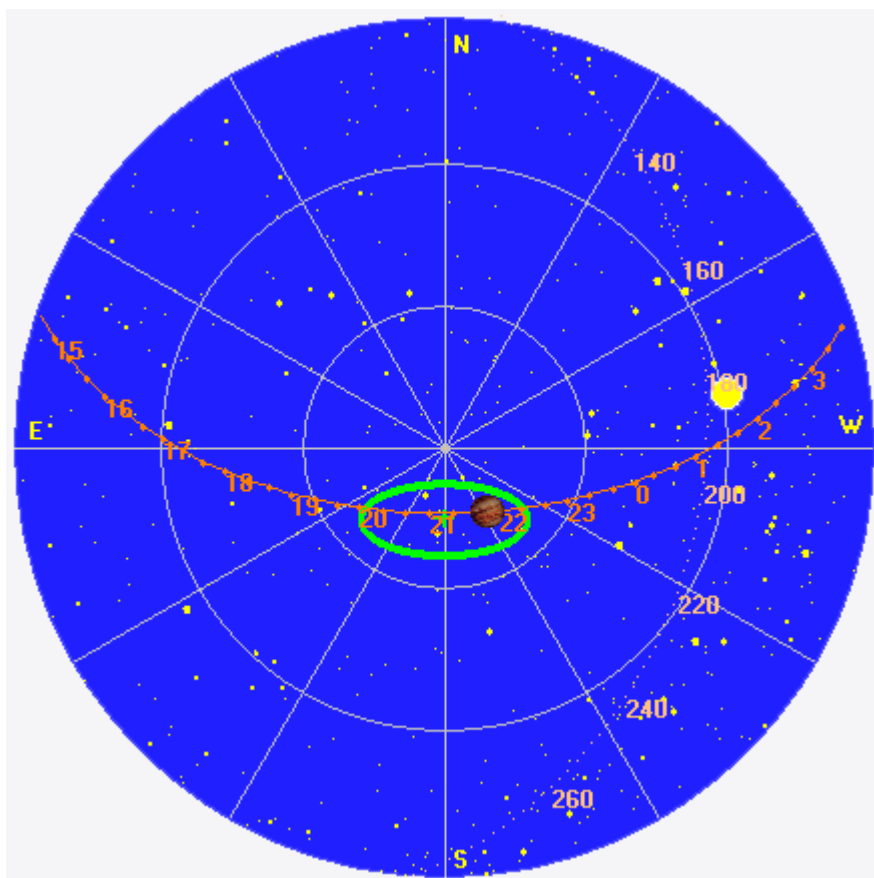
Jupiter was -1° to $+18^\circ$ off axis.

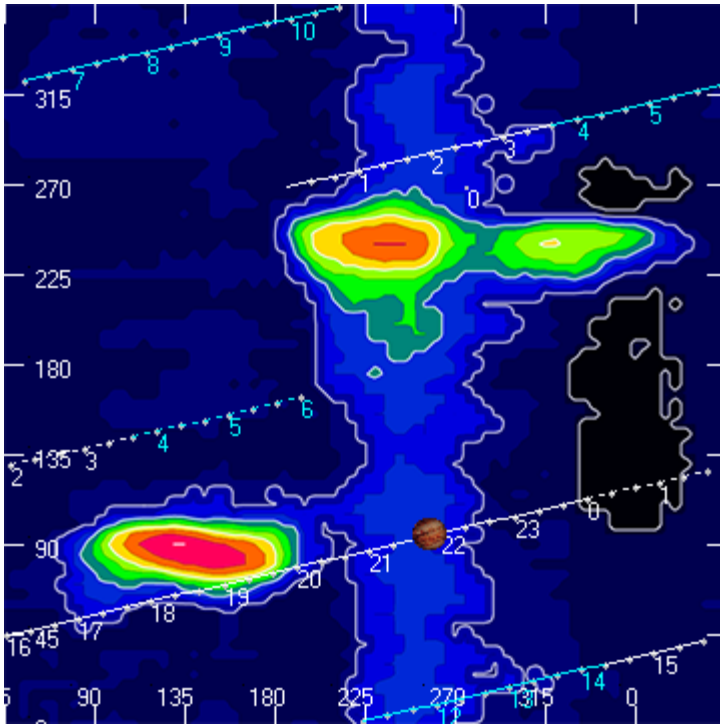
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 53° .

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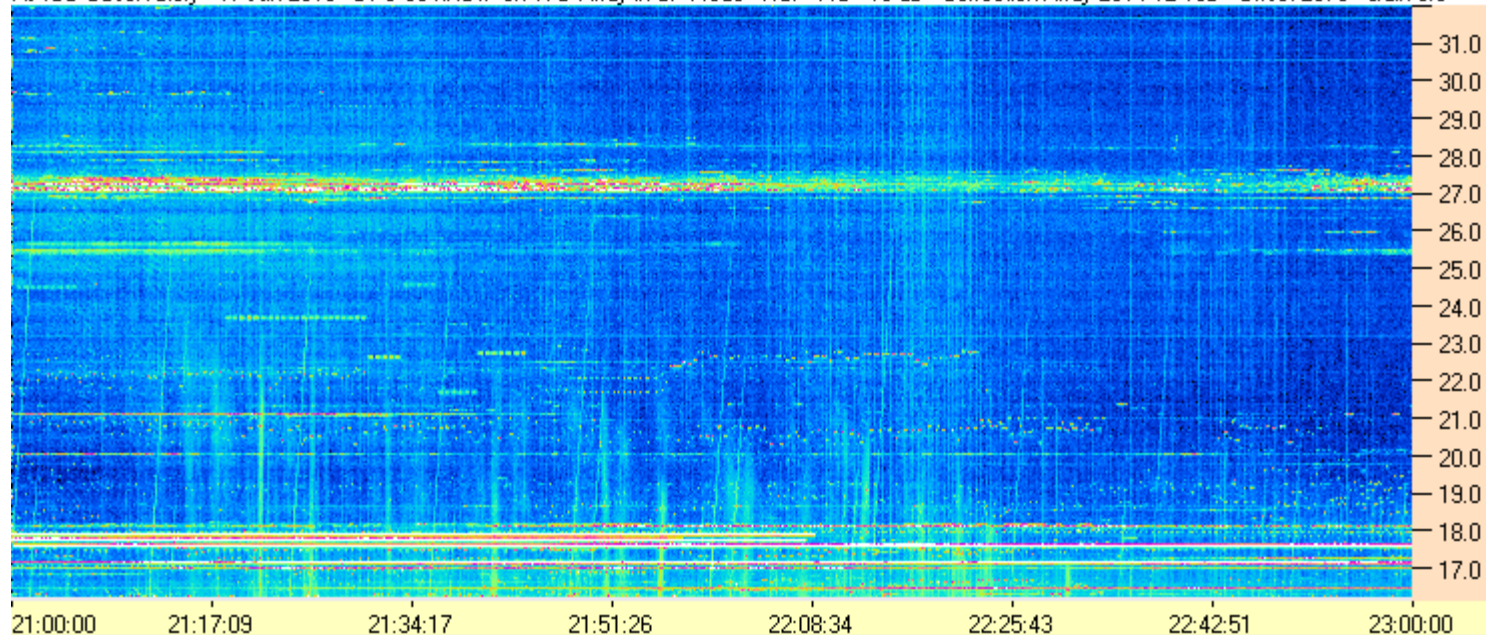
