Was a rather poor day for terrestrial propagation, which was nice for us: less daytime ionospheric attenuation than usual.


RCP dominant L bursting 1849-1859 UTC from 16 to 21 MHz, negatively drifting emission envelope. No modulation lanes visible.

Jupiter was -29° to -27° off axis.


Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 47°.


