RCP dominant L bursting 2027-2100 UTC from 16 to 28 MHz, negatively drifting emission envelope. No modulation lanes visible.

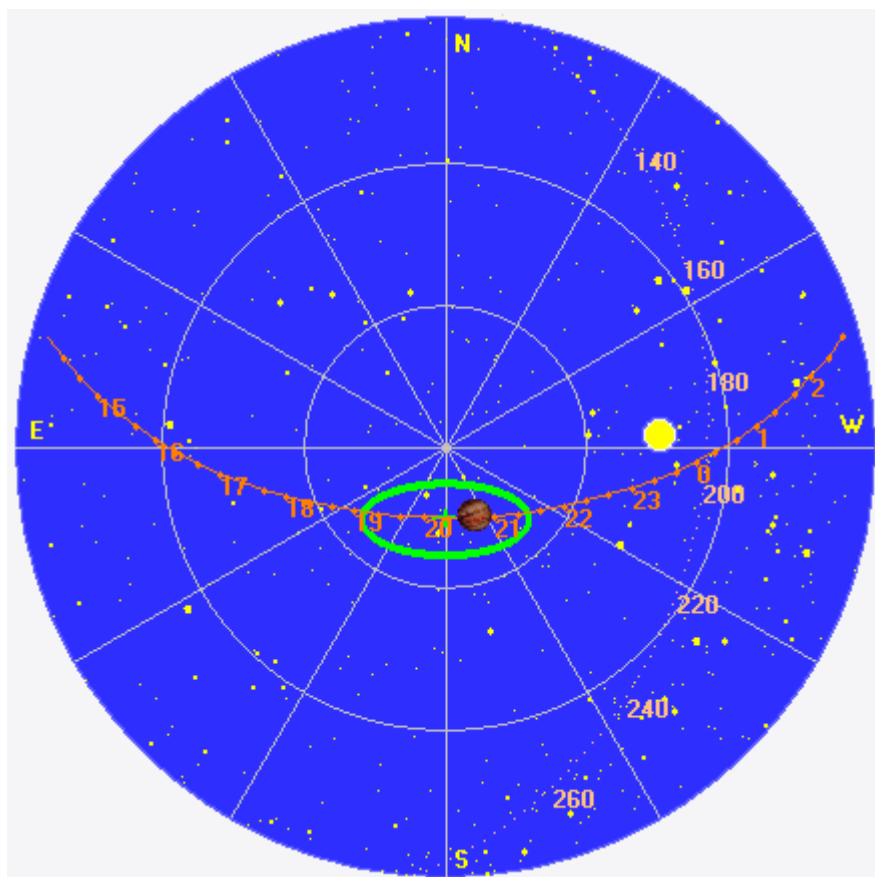
Jupiter was $+2^\circ$ to $+10^\circ$ off axis.

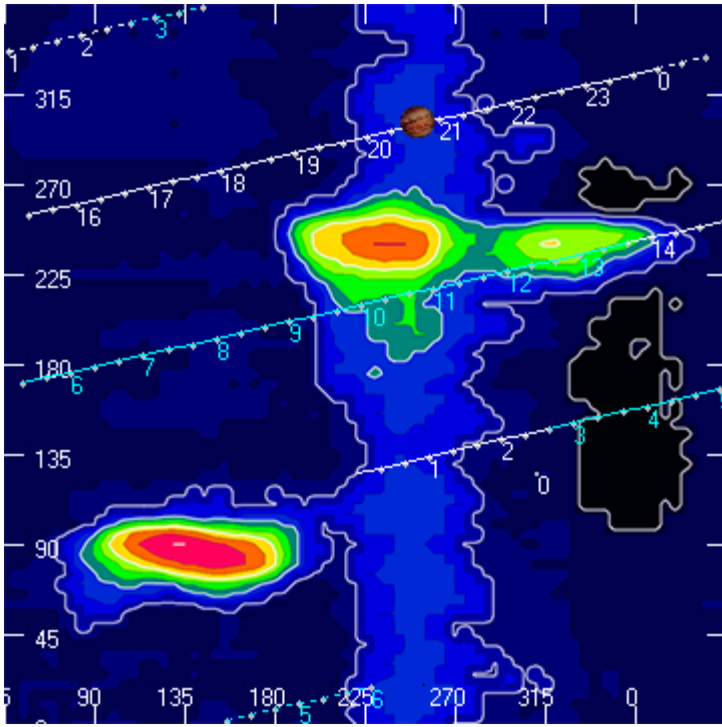
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 40° .

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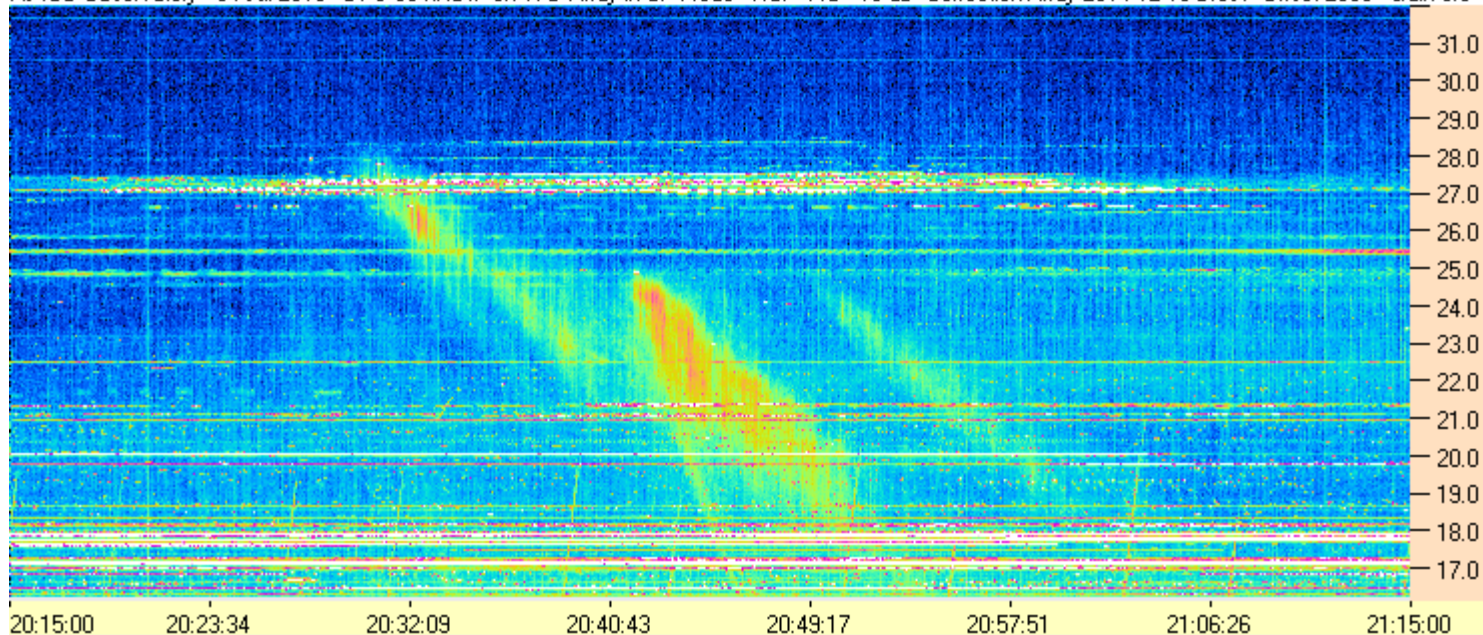
