The line noise has become worse; strip chart is now useless. The power company has responded and is investigating.

LCP dominant L bursting 1948-2030 UTC from 16 to 20 MHz, upward then downward drifting envelope. No modulation lanes visible.

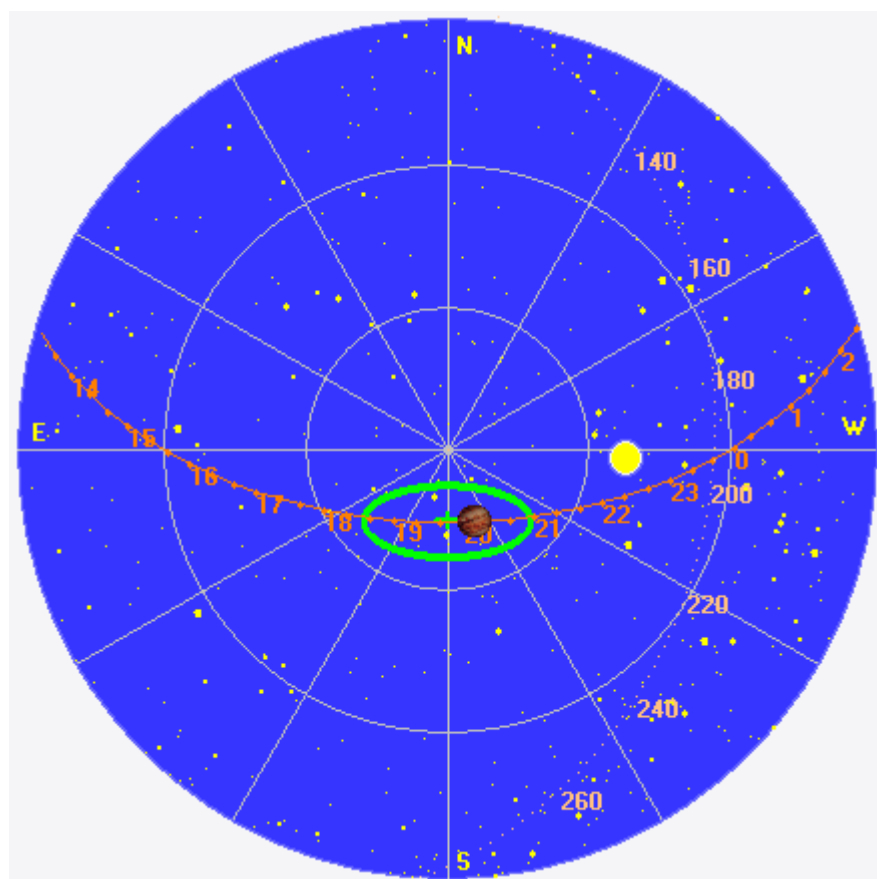
Jupiter was -1° to $+10^\circ$ off axis.

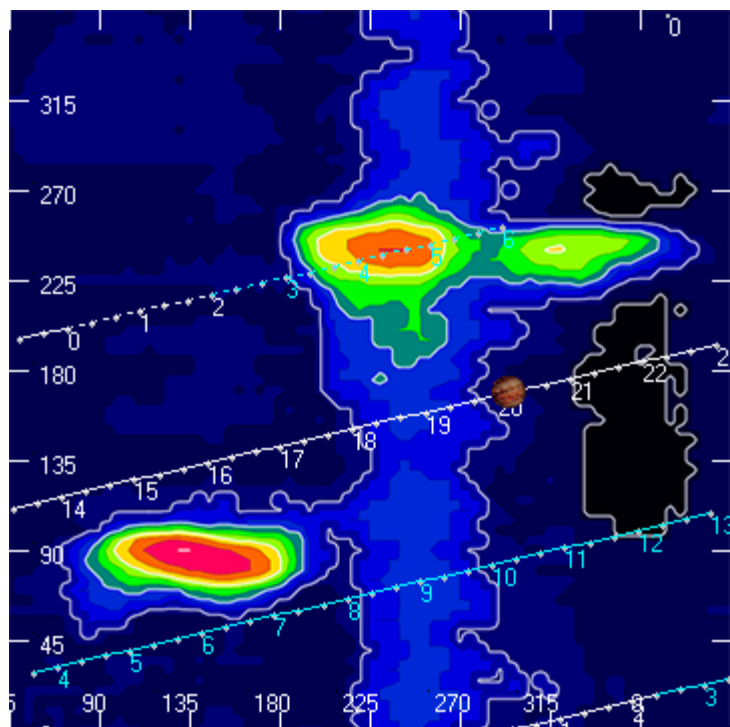
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 32° .

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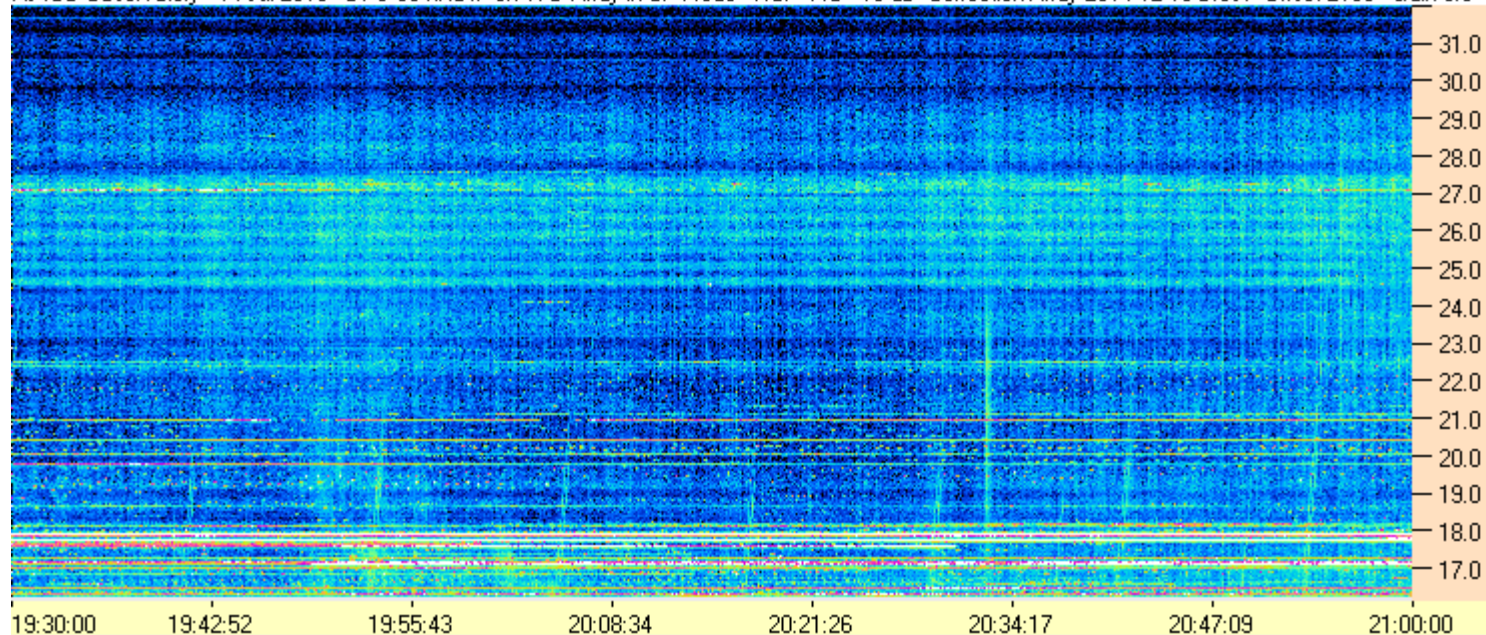
