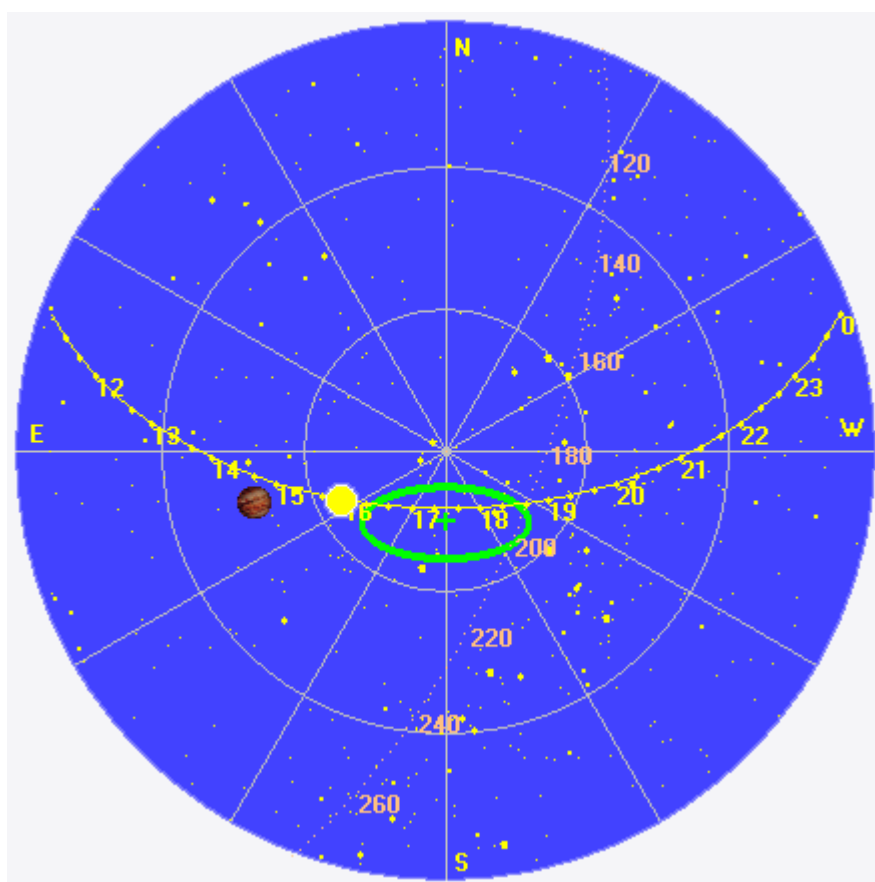
Adding to Tom's nice report, here's some rapid bursting Type VI solar emission from Tuesday morning.

Interesting LCP dominance on some of the bursts, especially the hot one -- and doubly interesting that it only got really hot near 20 MHz.

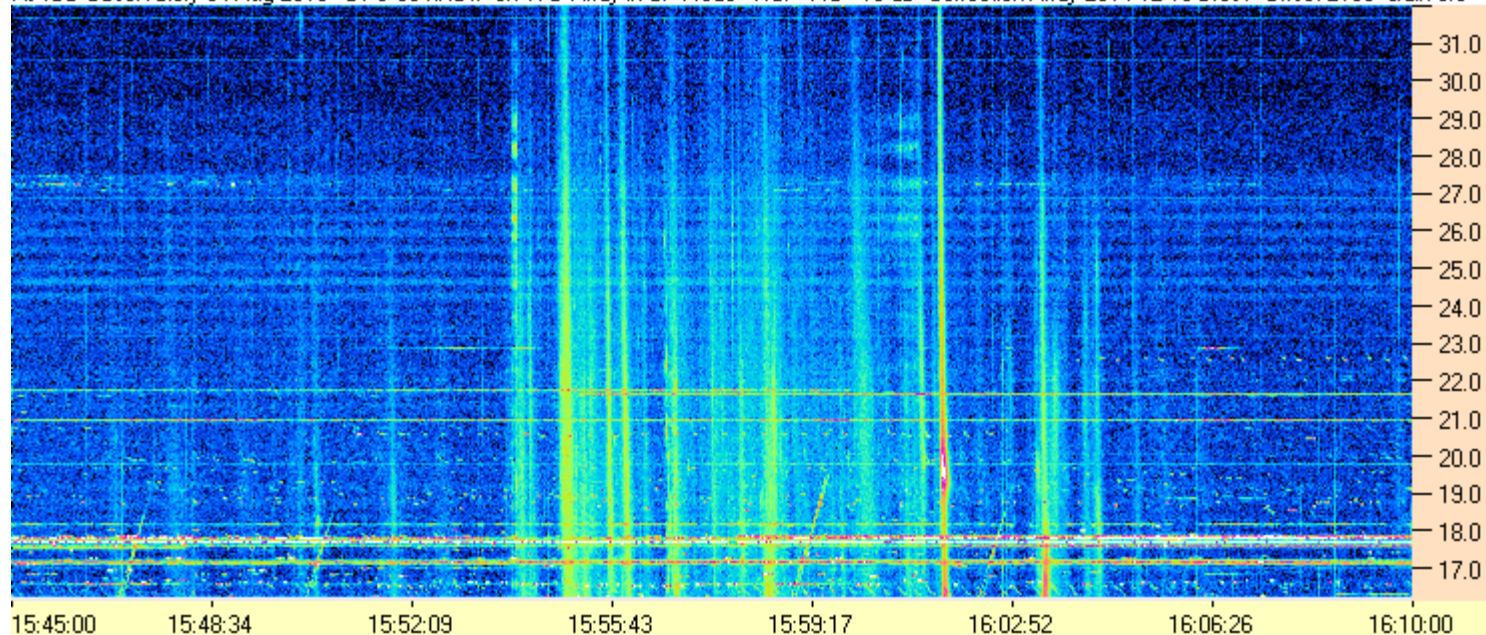
