Apparently too weak to show up on the 20 MHz strip chart.

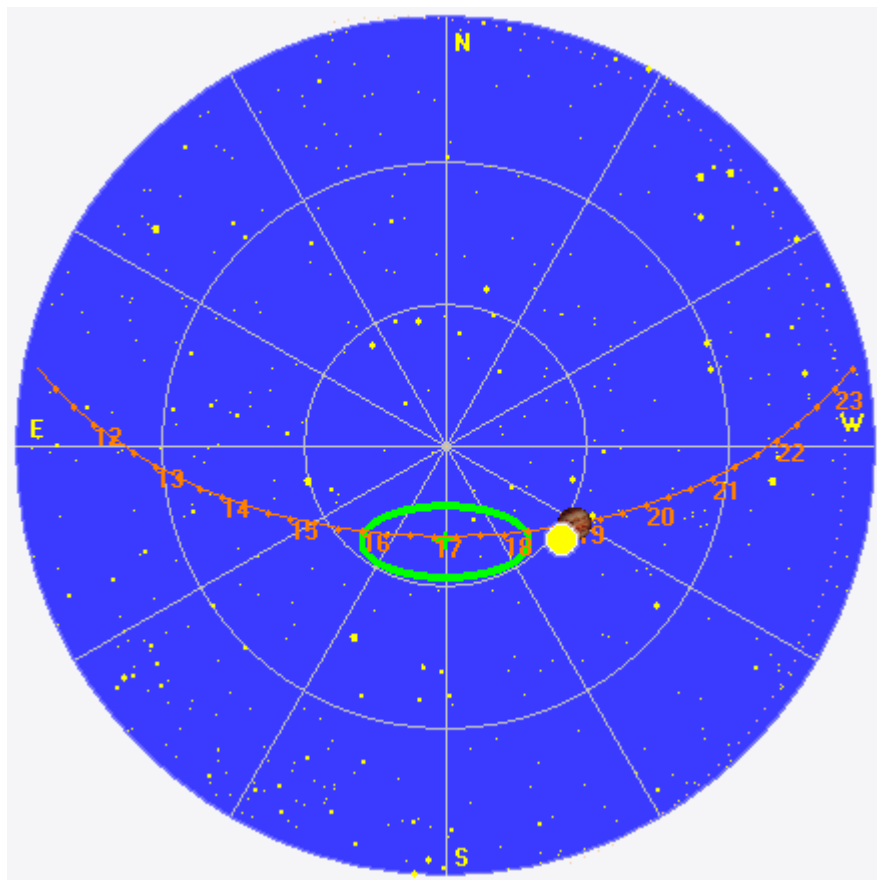
Jupiter was +20° to +32° off axis.

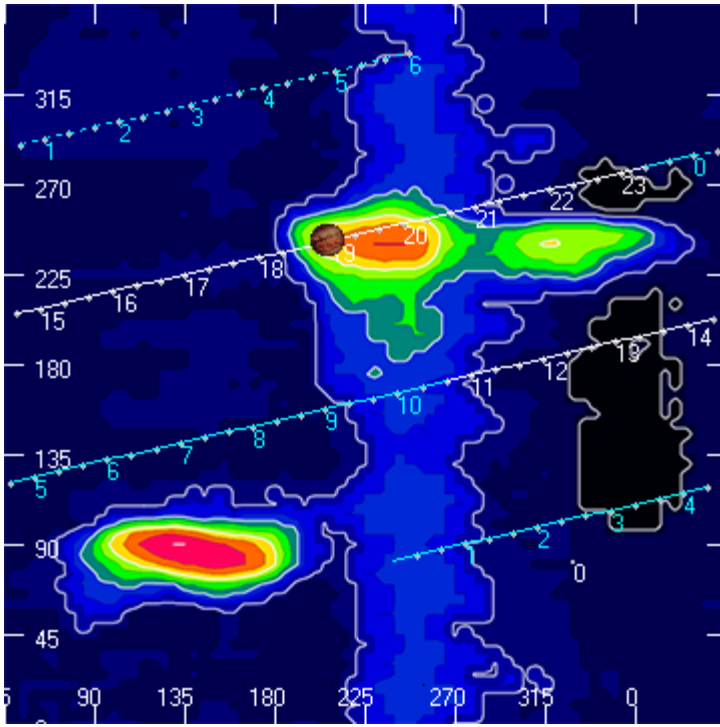
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 5°.

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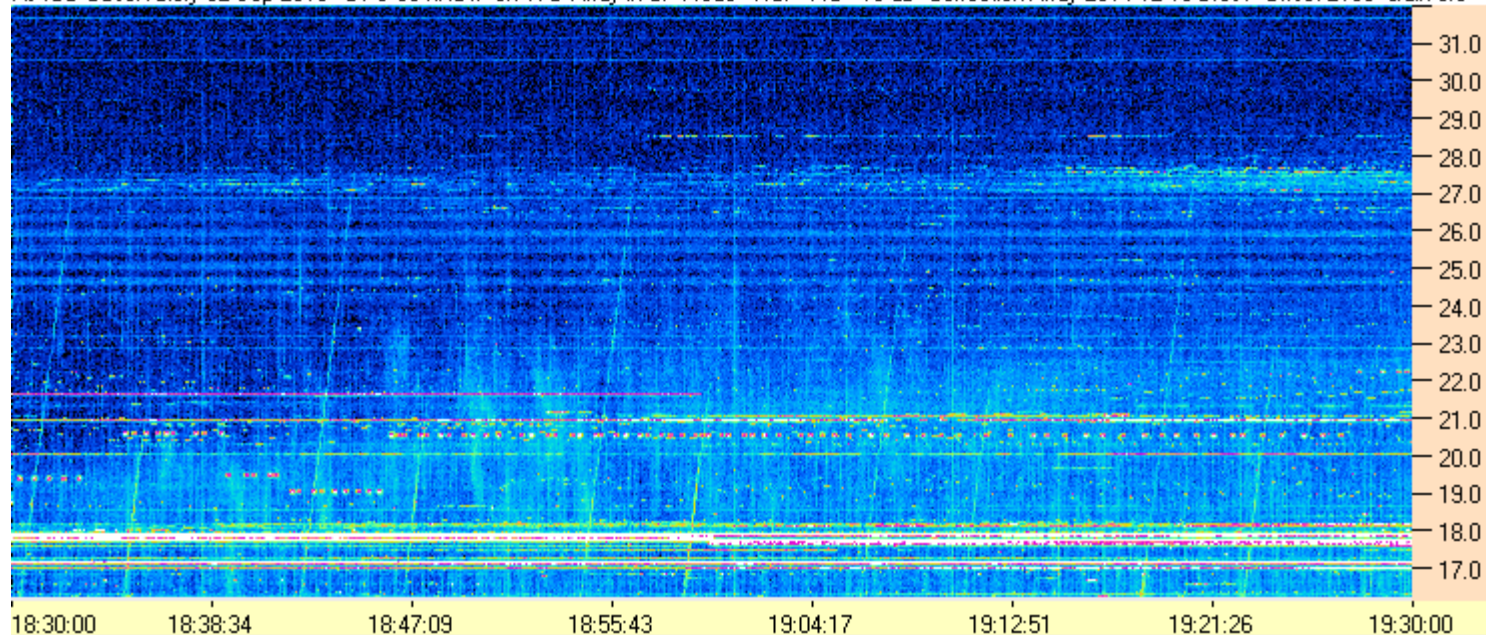
