LCP dominant N events 1445-1742 UTC from 16 to 22 MHz, negative frequency drift.

RCP dominant L bursting 1503-1539 UTC from 18 to 23 MHz, negative frequency drift, no modulation lanes visible.

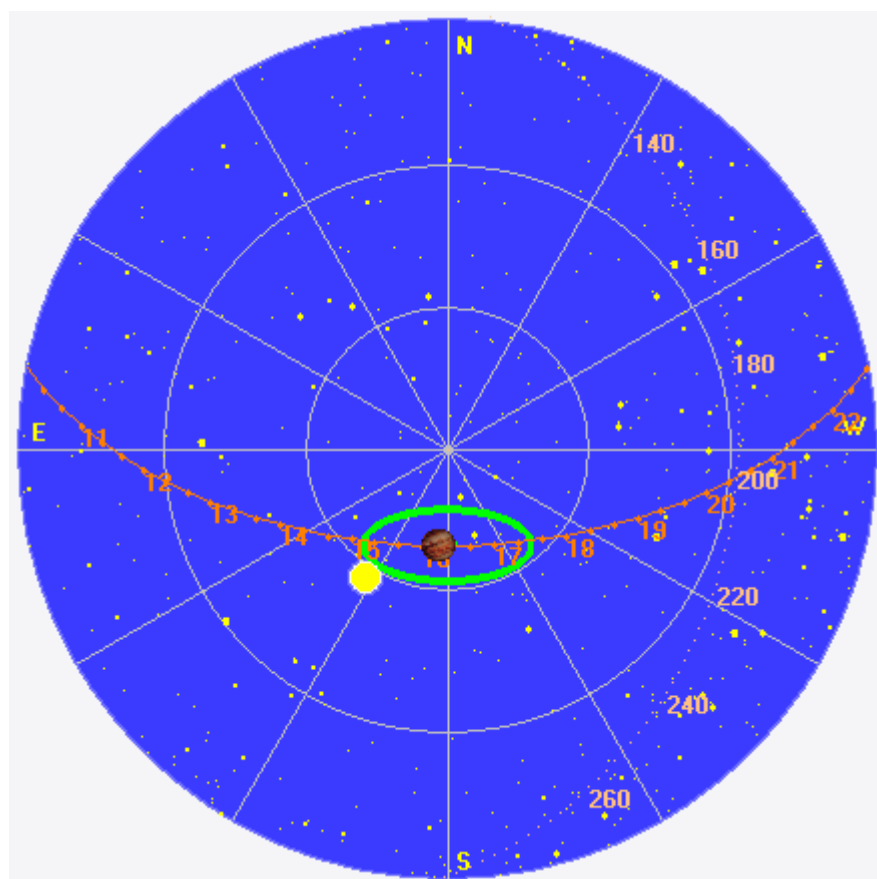
Jupiter was -24° to $+20^\circ$ off axis.

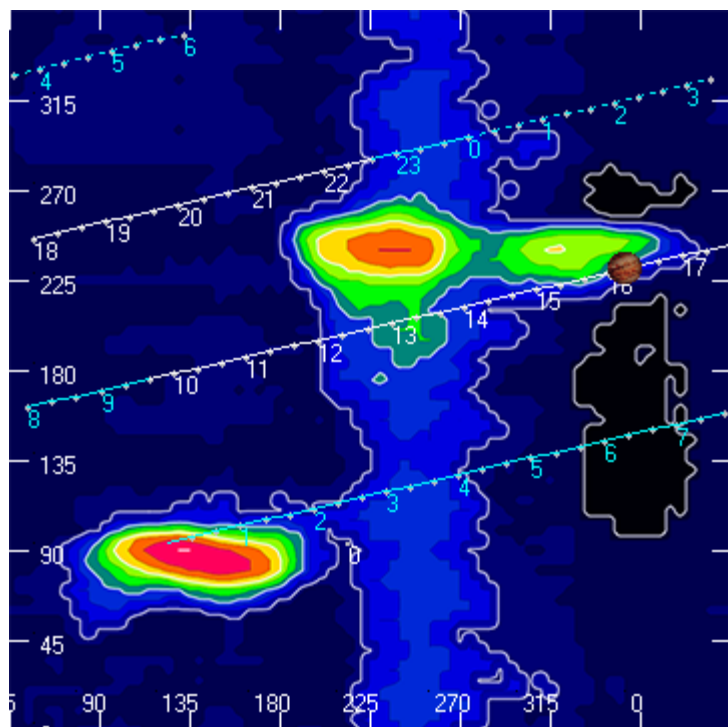
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 17° .

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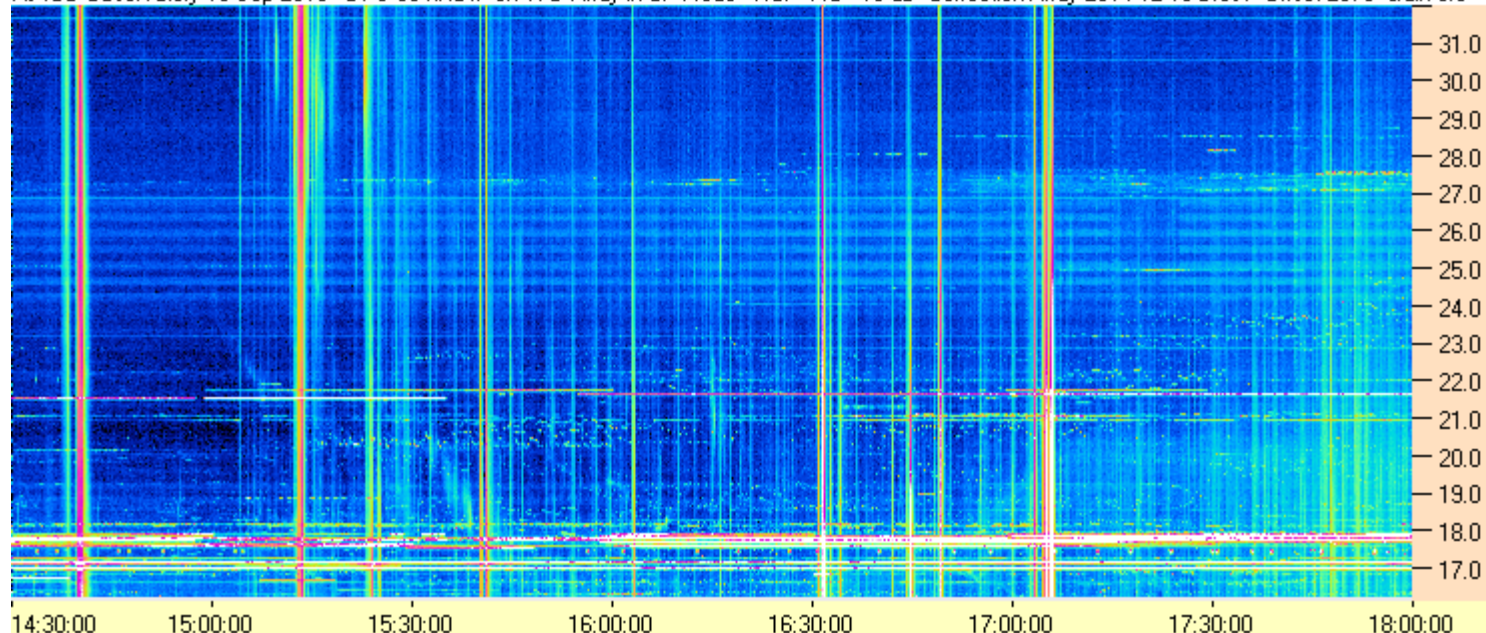
