RCP dominant L bursting 1547-1642 UTC from 16 to 24 MHz, negative frequency drift, even some major (positive freq drift) modulation lanes.

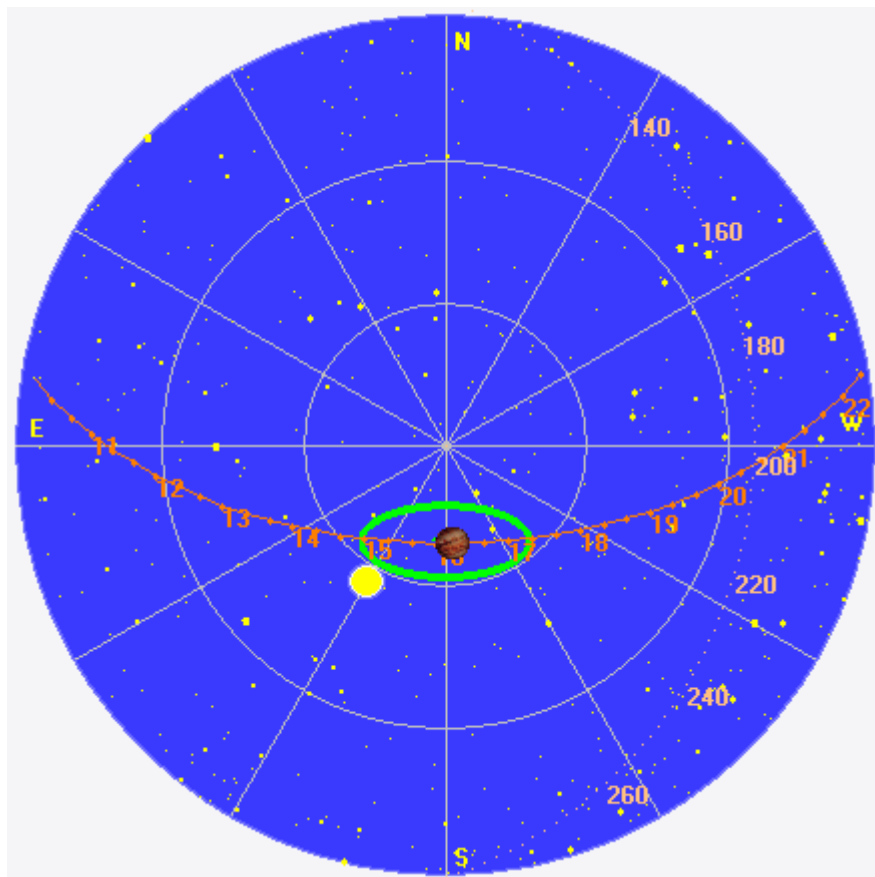
Jupiter was -6° to $+8^\circ$ off axis.

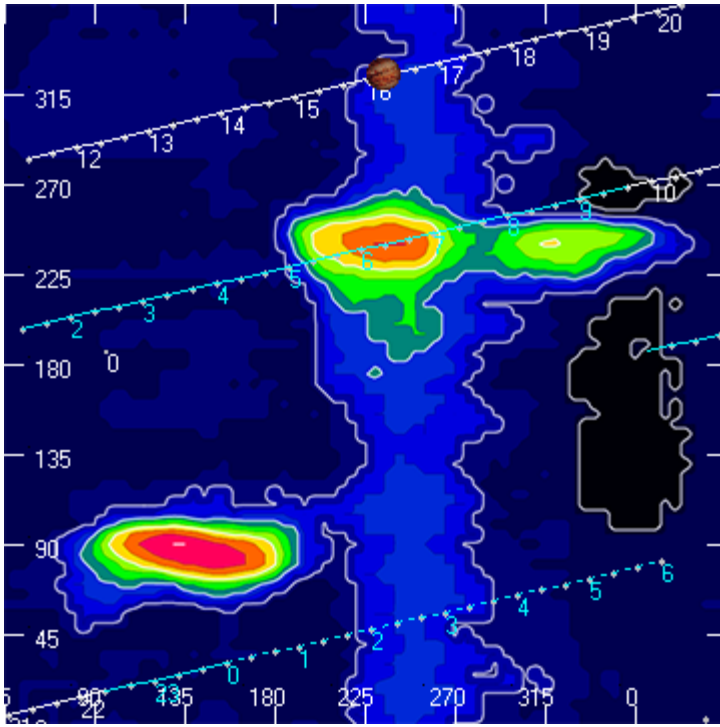
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 20° .

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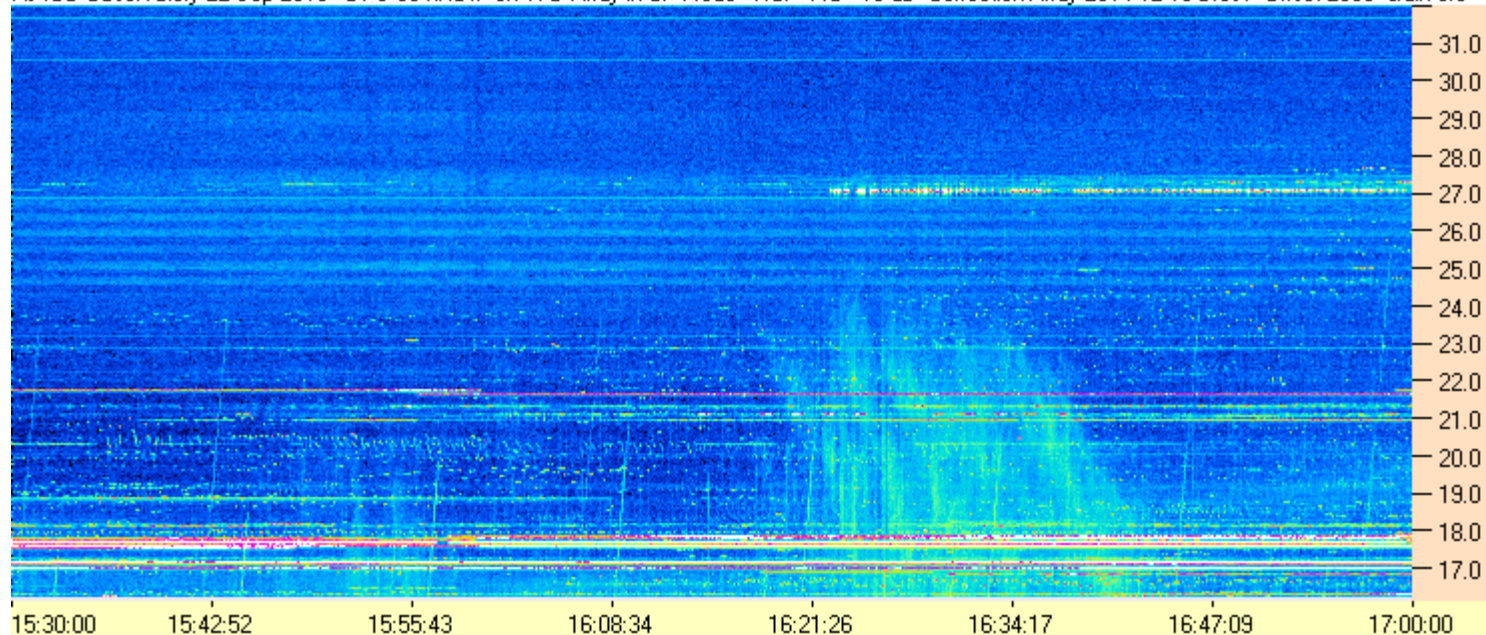

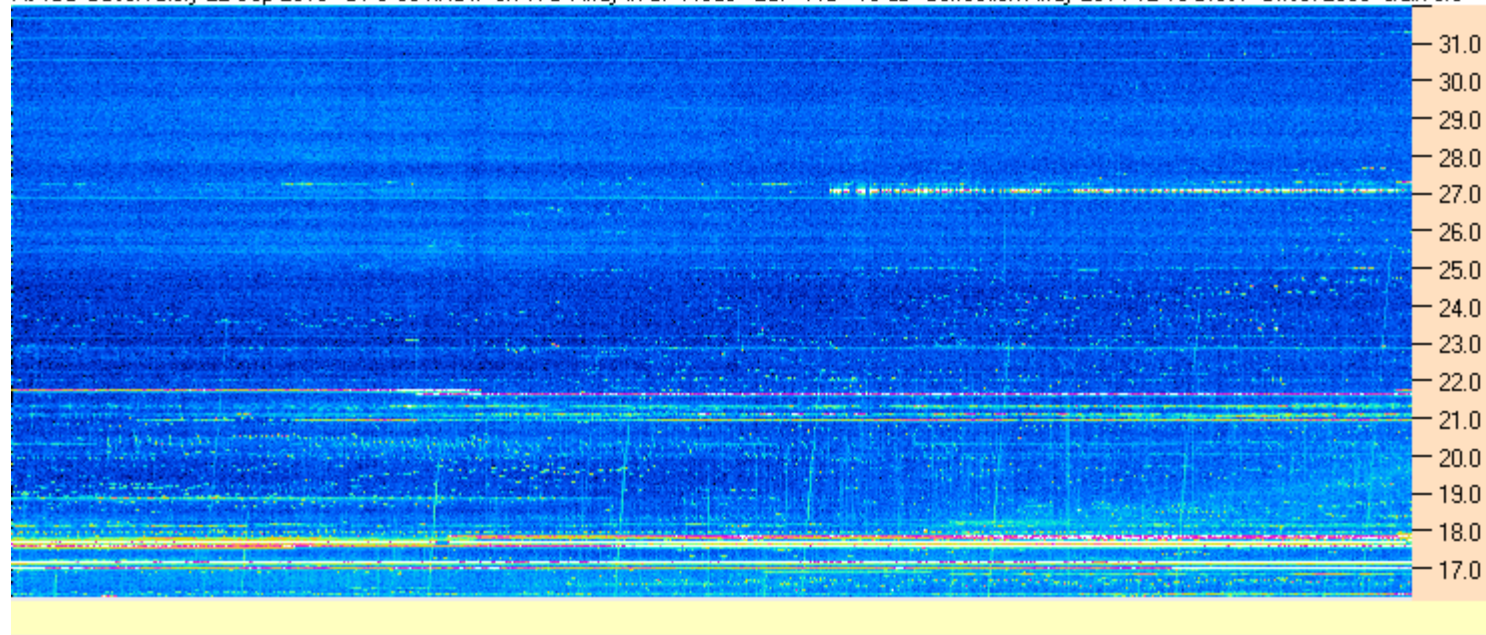




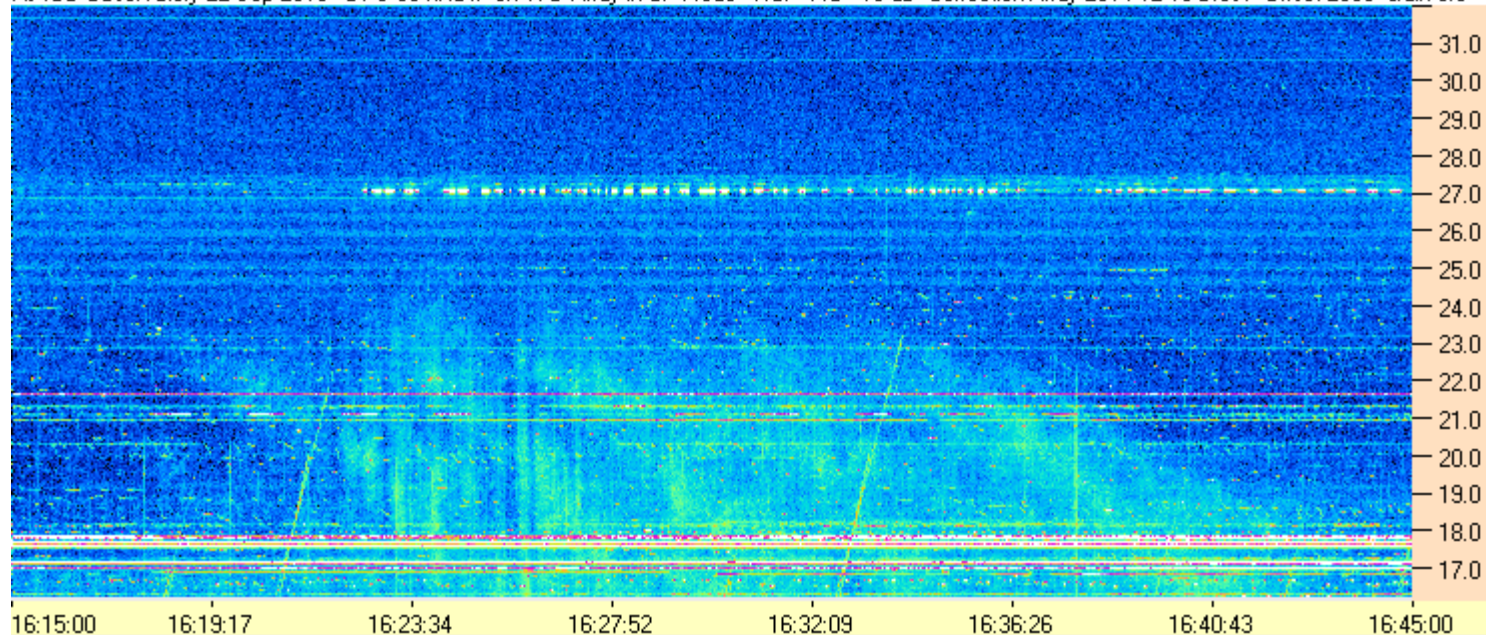
