RCP dominant L bursting 1356-1549 UTC from 16 to 30 MHz, vertex late arcs, minor (negative freq drift) modulation lanes visible.

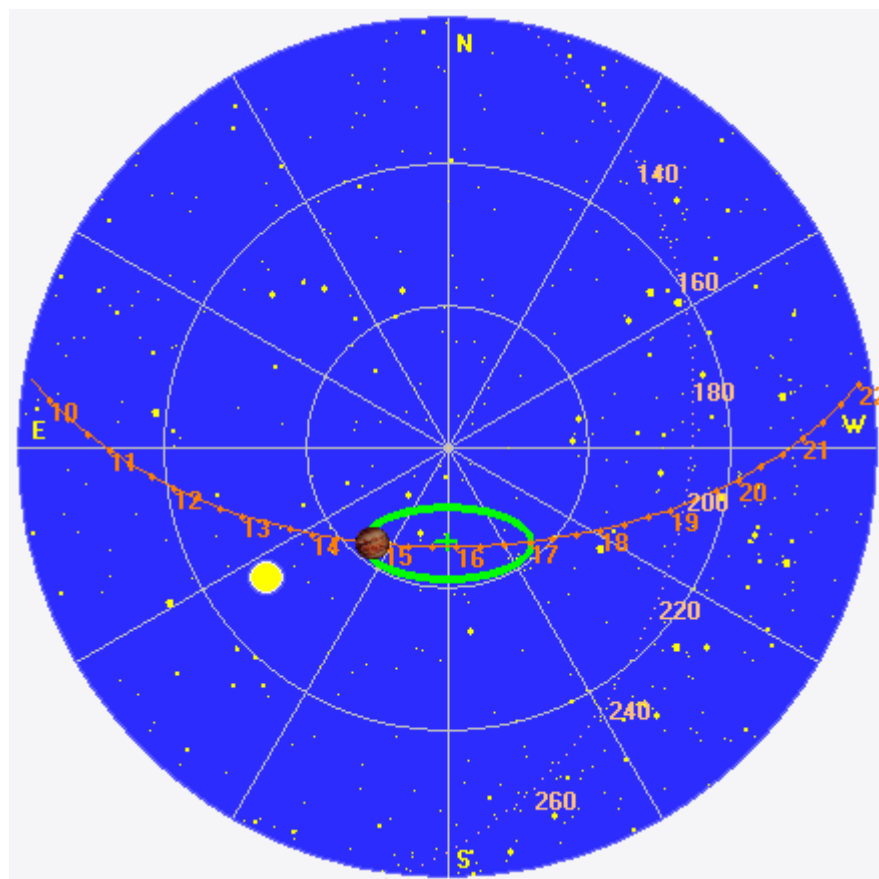
Jupiter was -29° to -2° off axis.

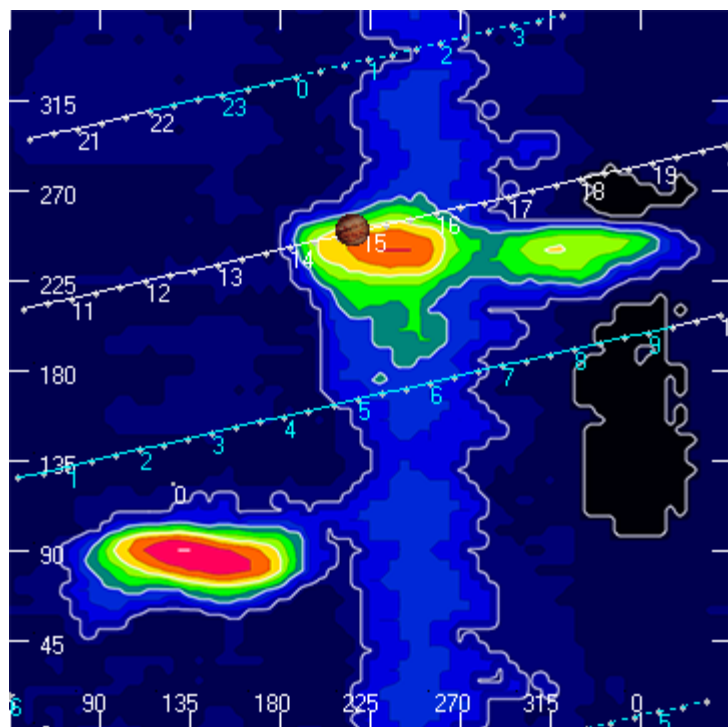
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 24° .

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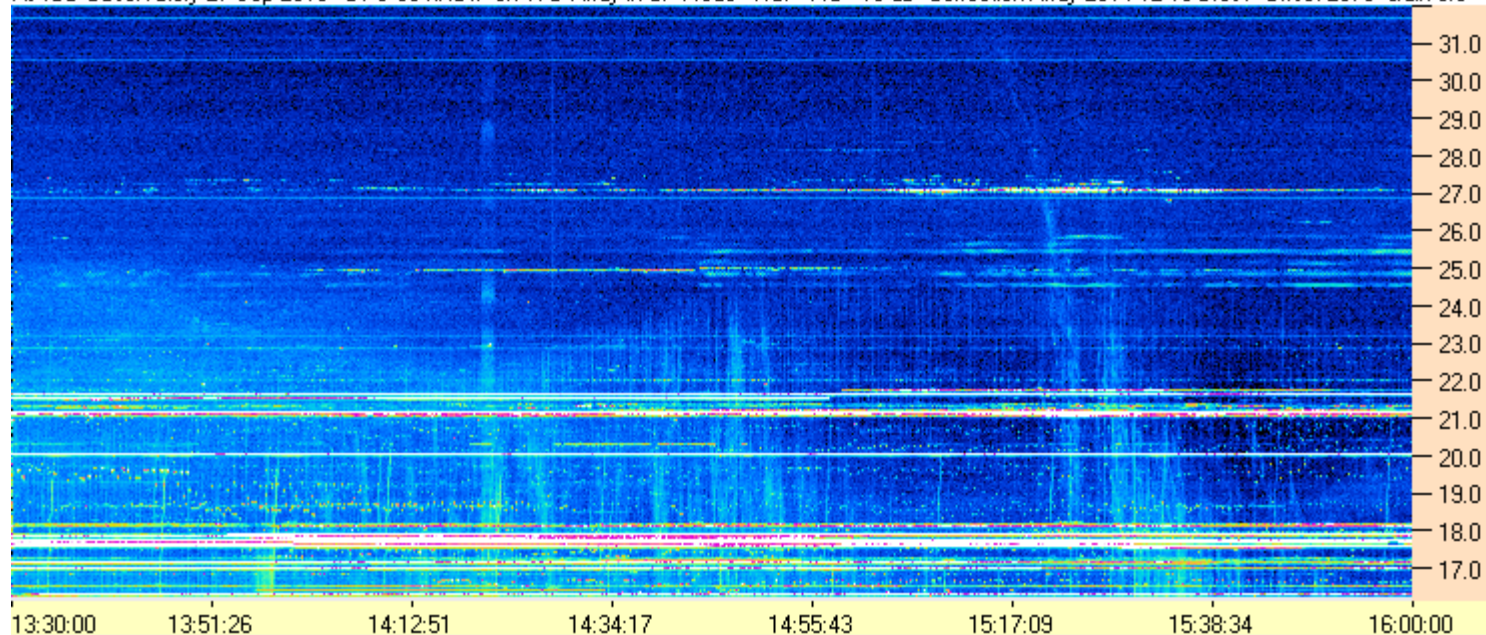

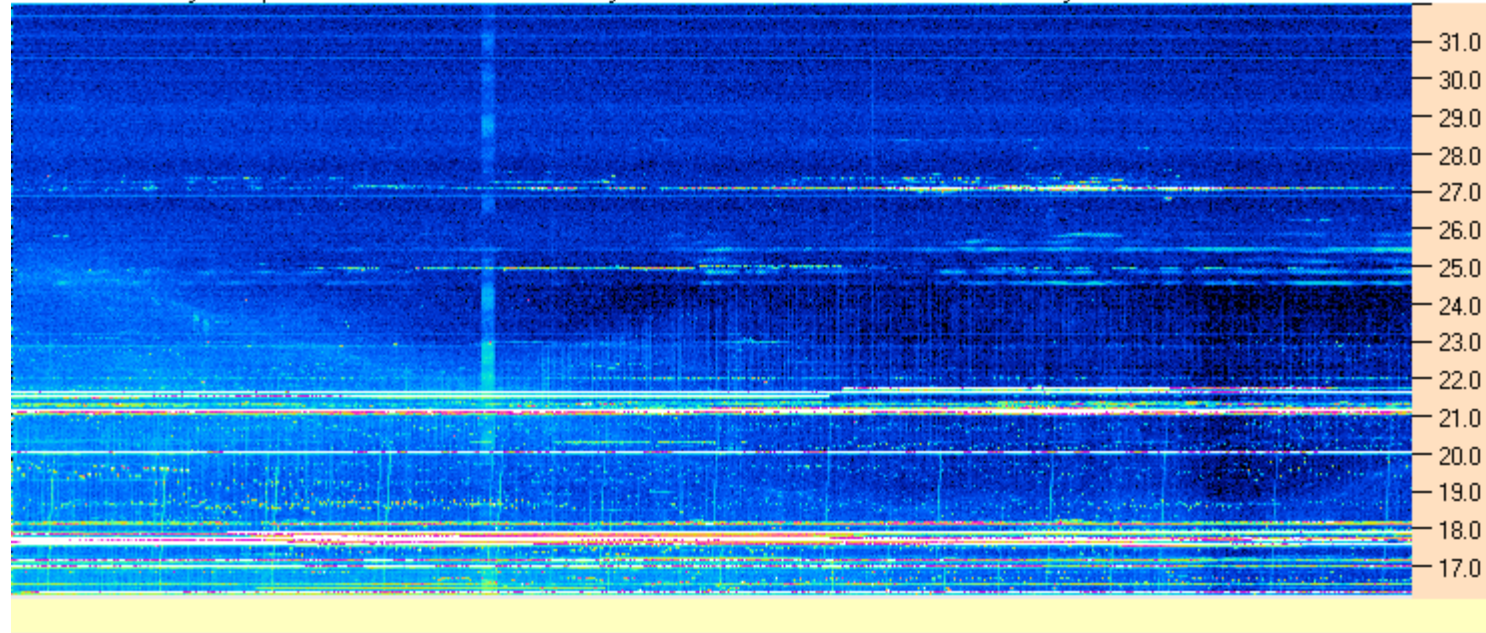




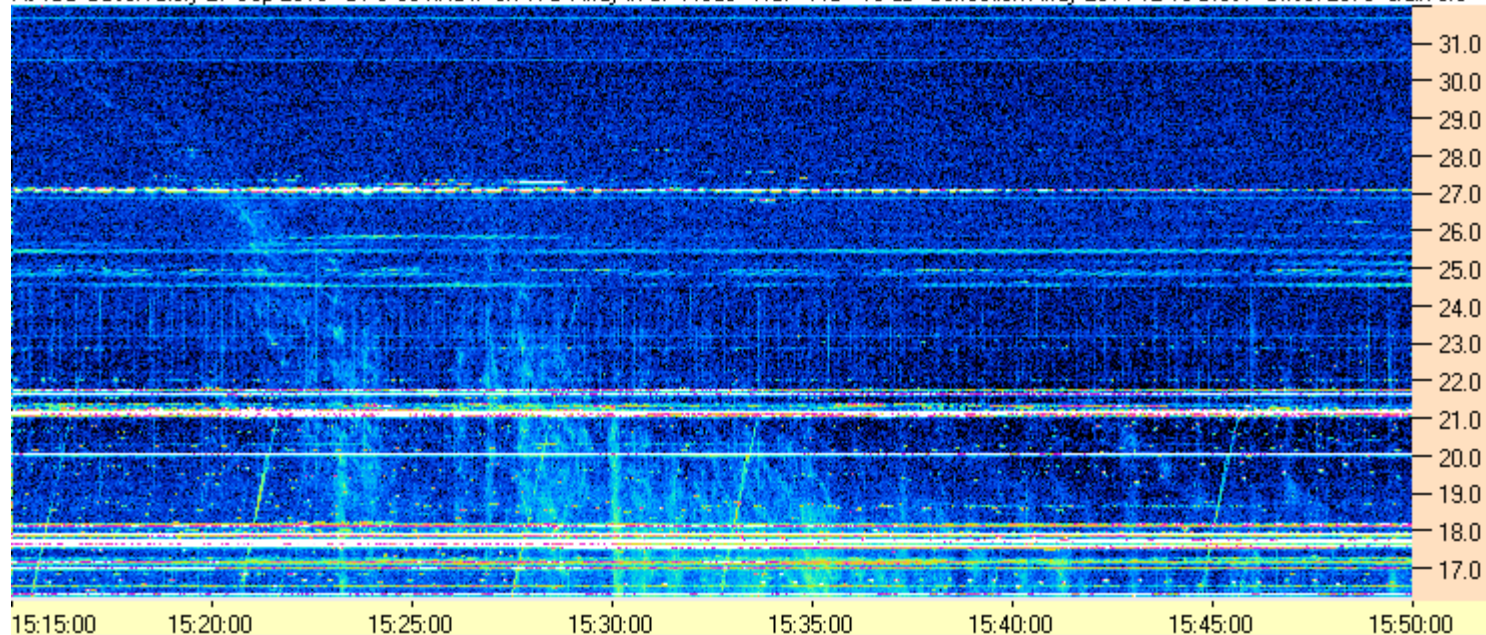
