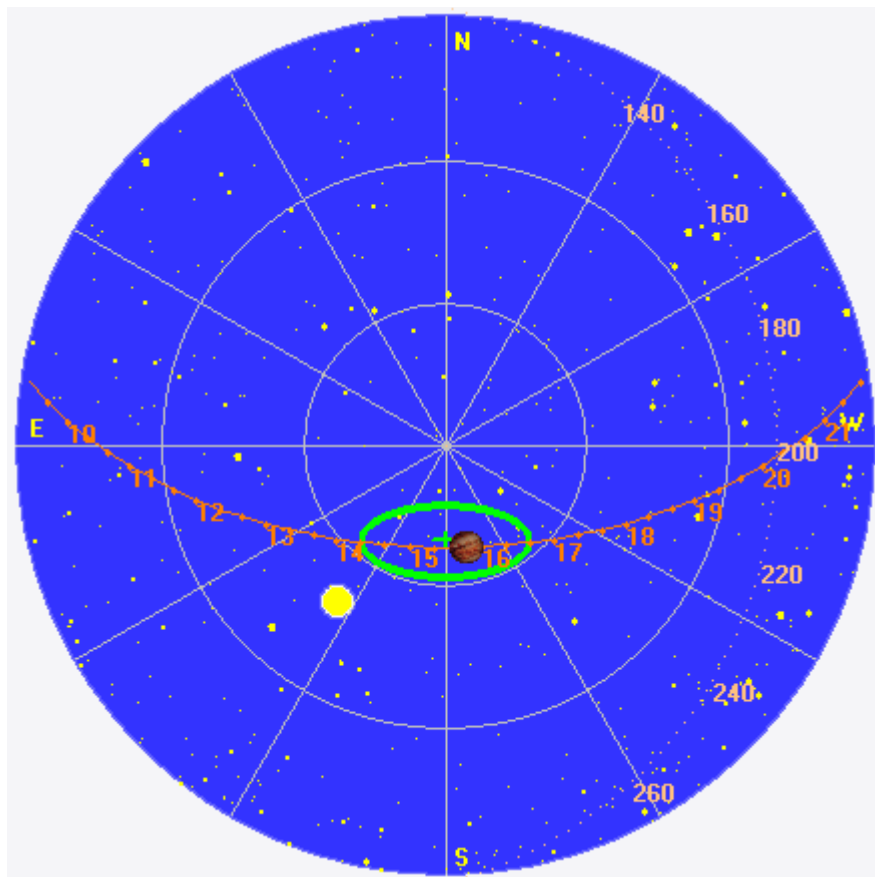
Jupiter was -10° to $+18^\circ$ off axis.

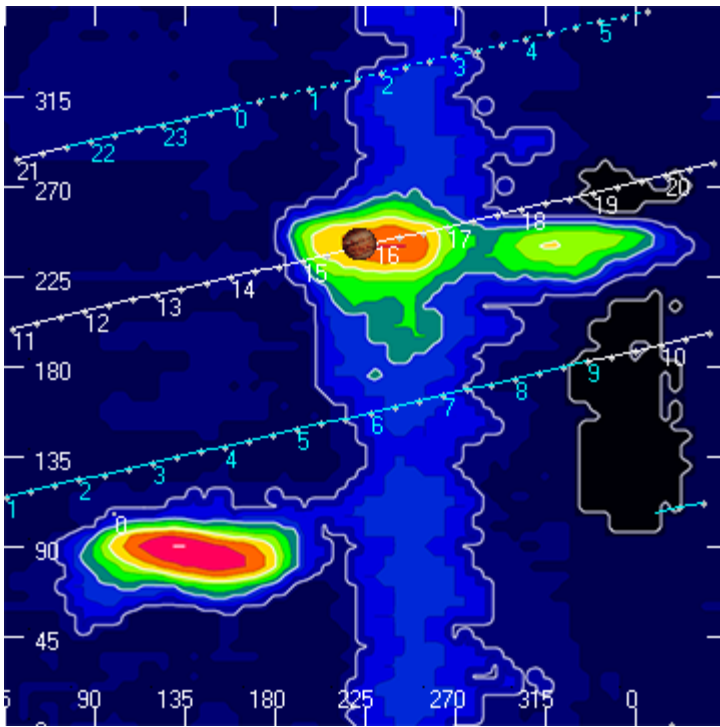
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 30° .

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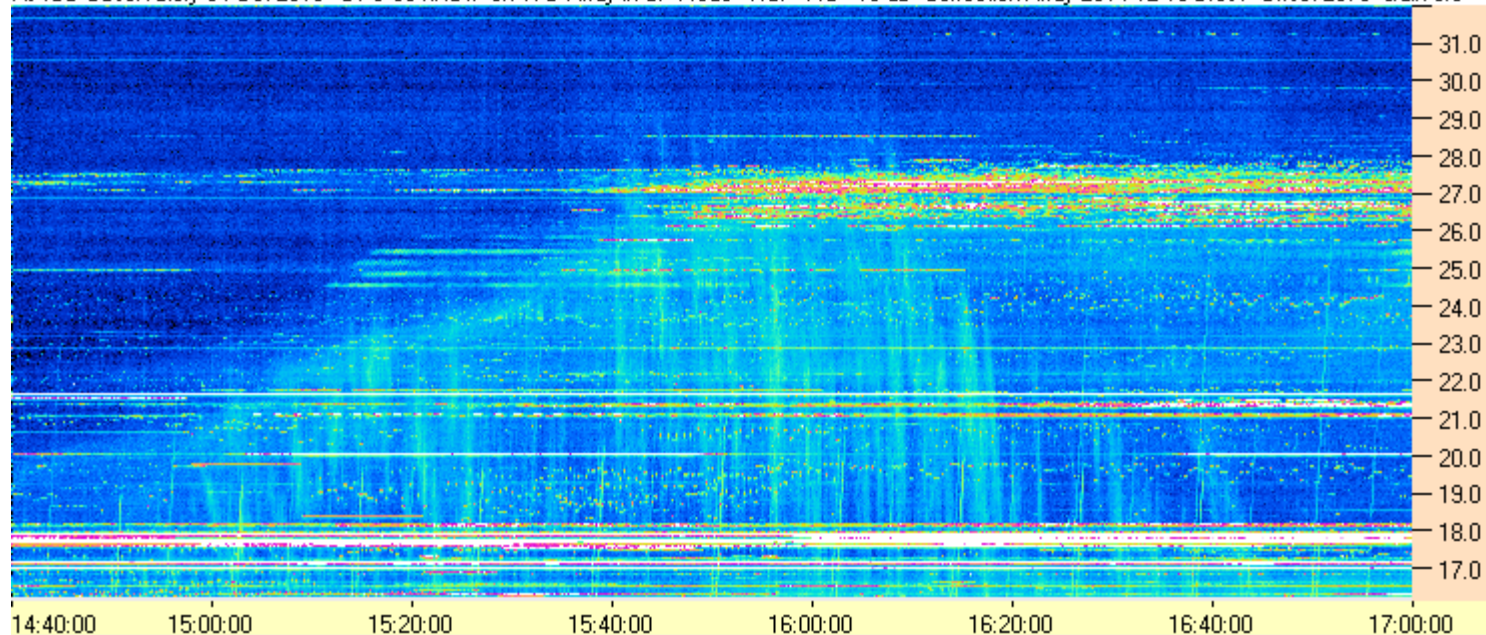

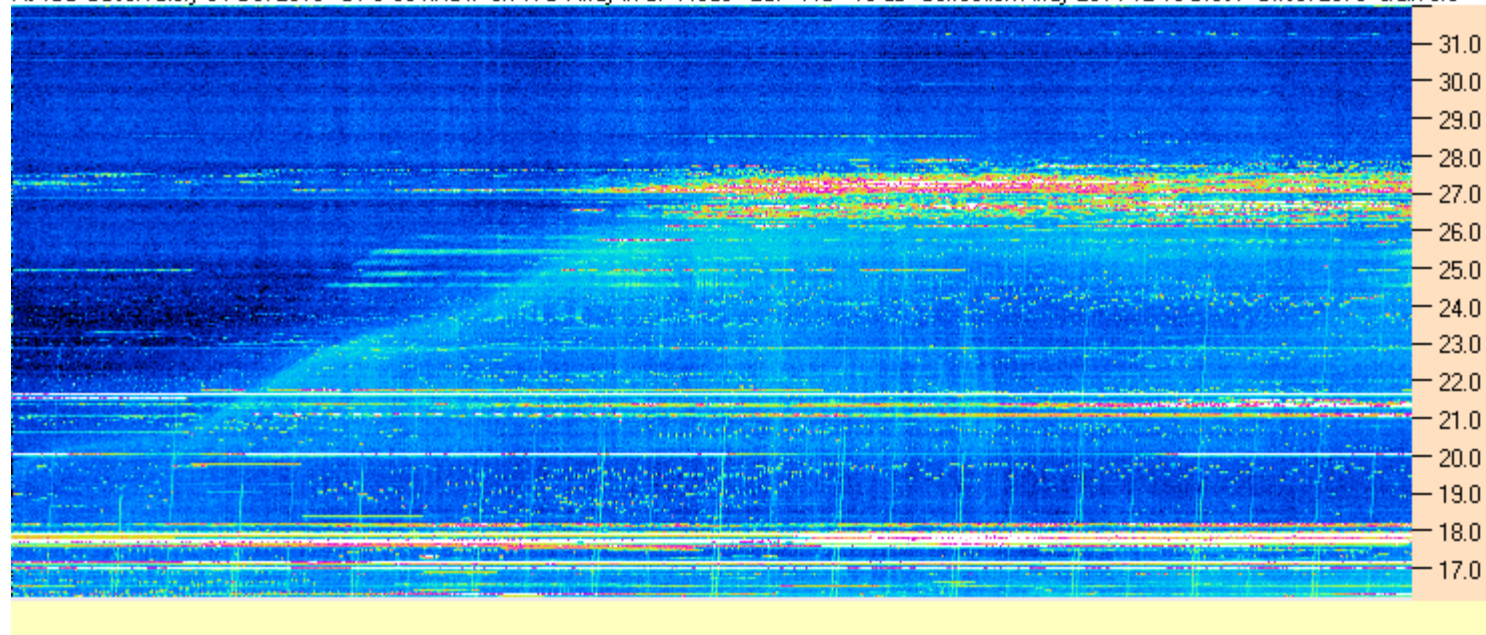




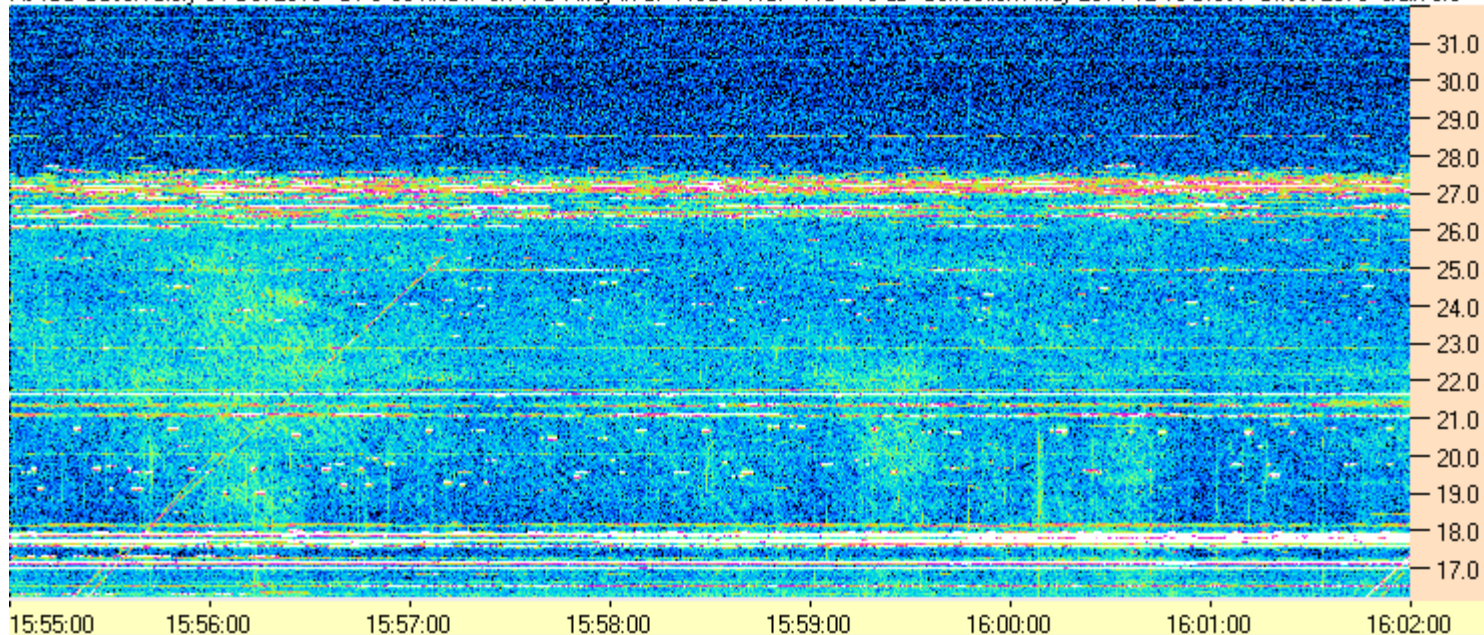
