RCP dominant L bursting 1344-1407 UTC from 16 to 24 MHz, negative envelope frequency drift, no modulation lanes visible.

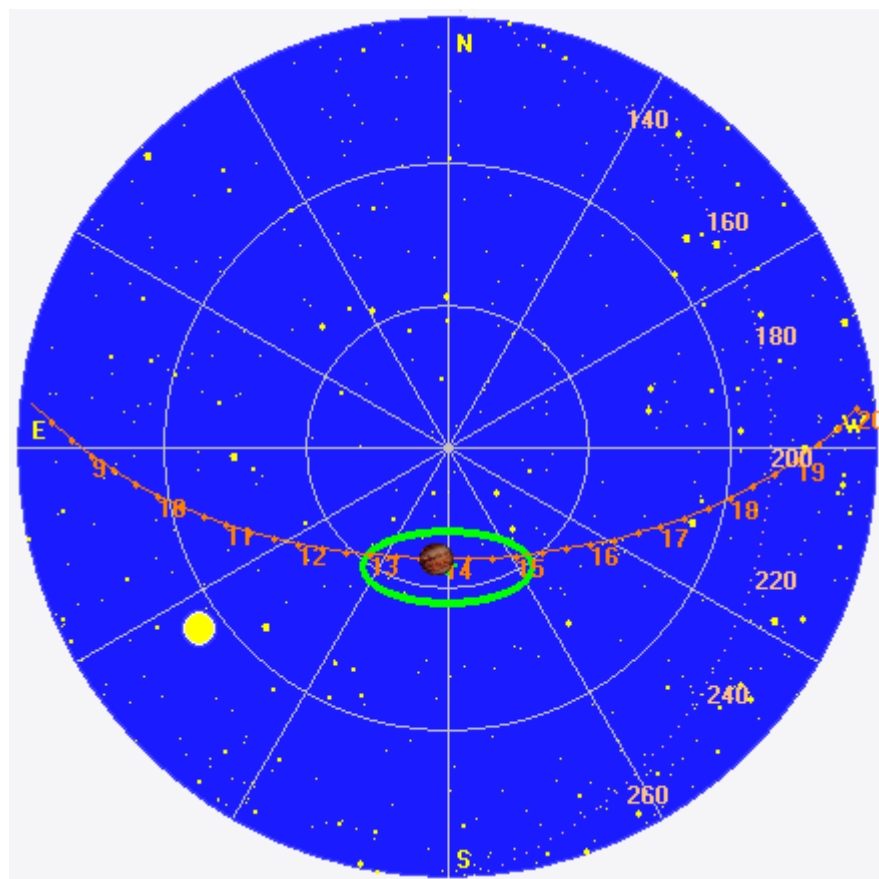
Jupiter was -5° to $+1^\circ$ off axis.

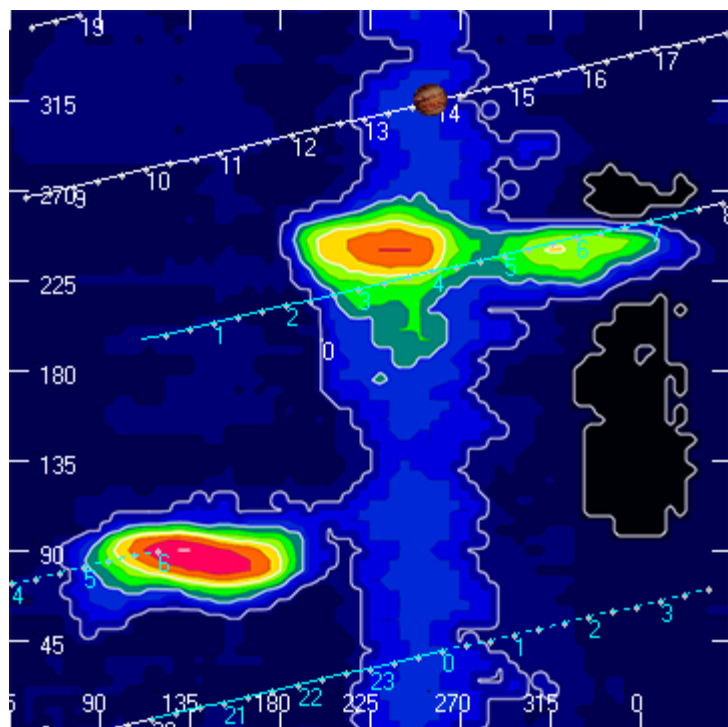
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 51° .

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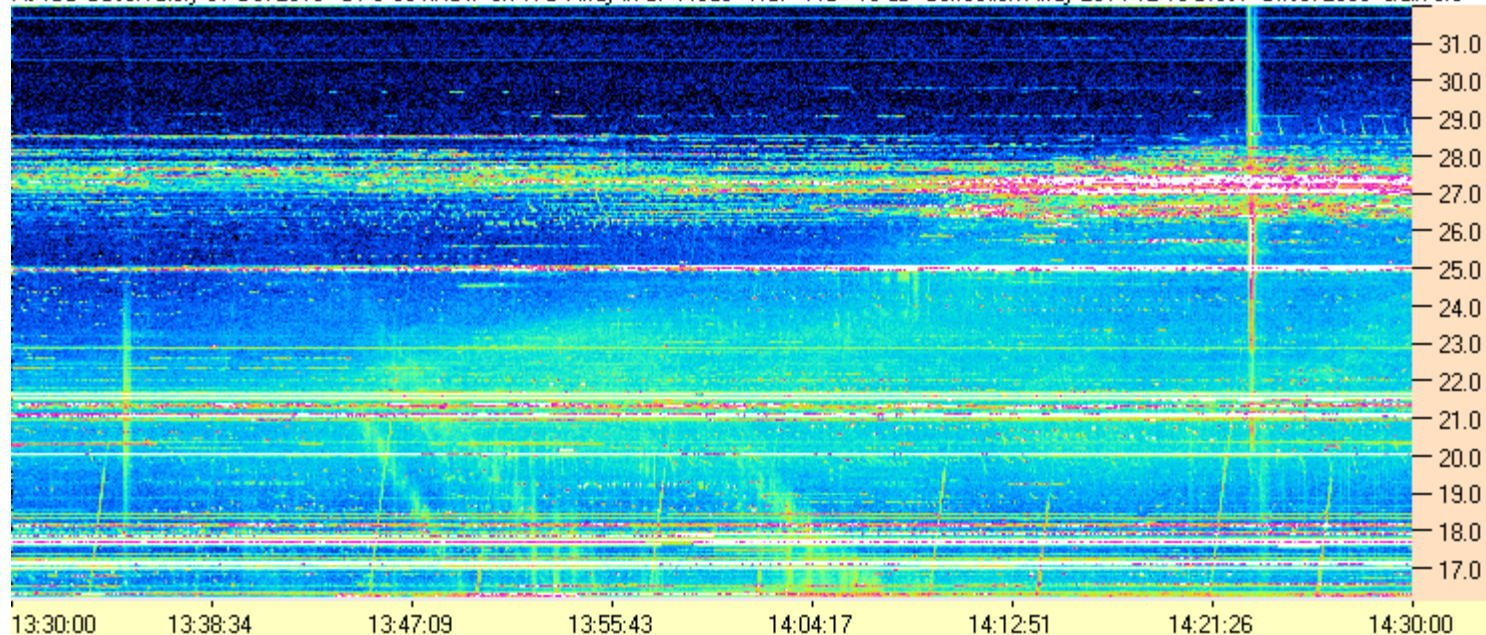

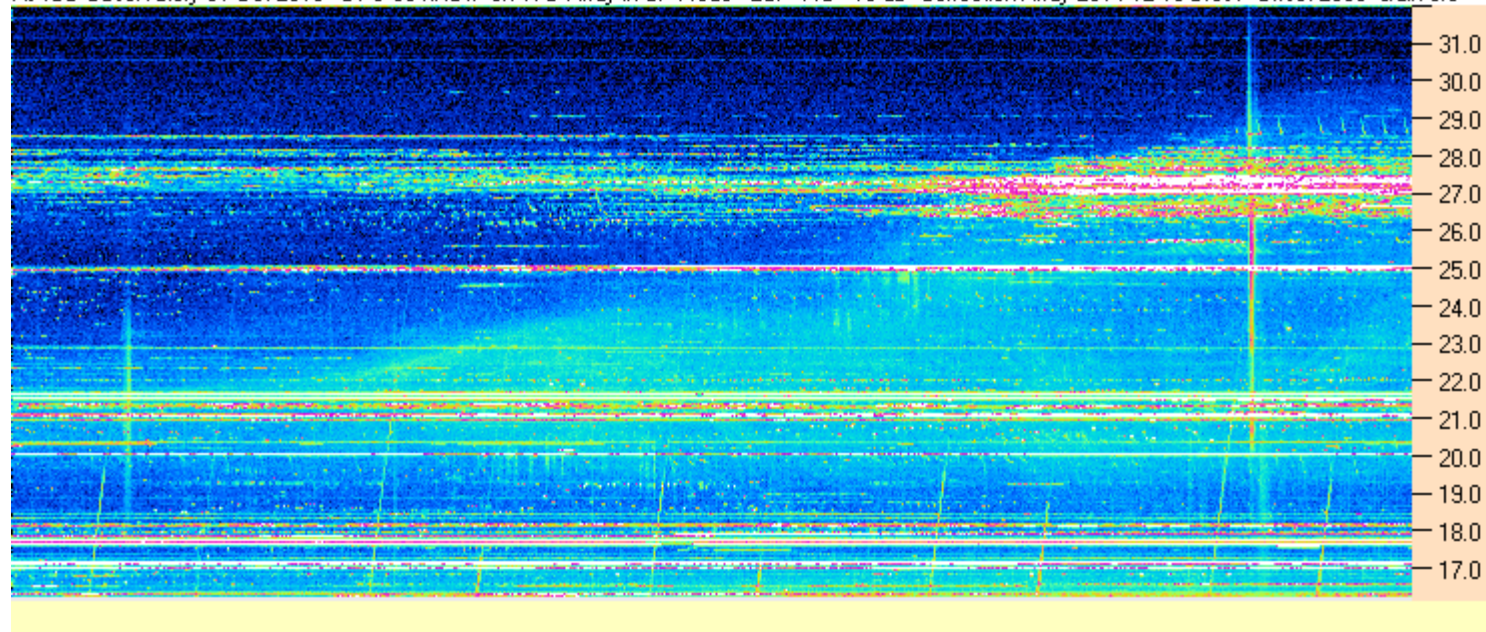




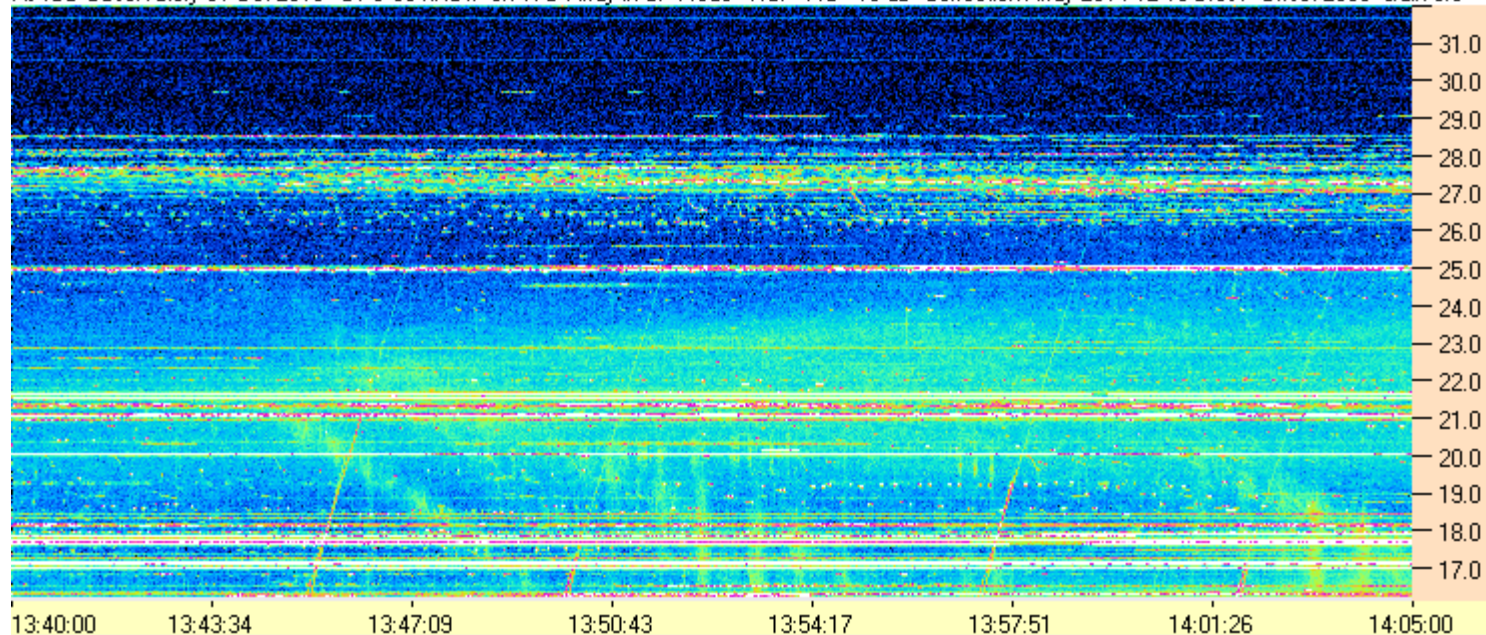
