RCP dominant L bursting 1135-1314 UTC from 16 to 28 MHz, vertex late arcs, some minor (negative slope) modulation lanes visible.

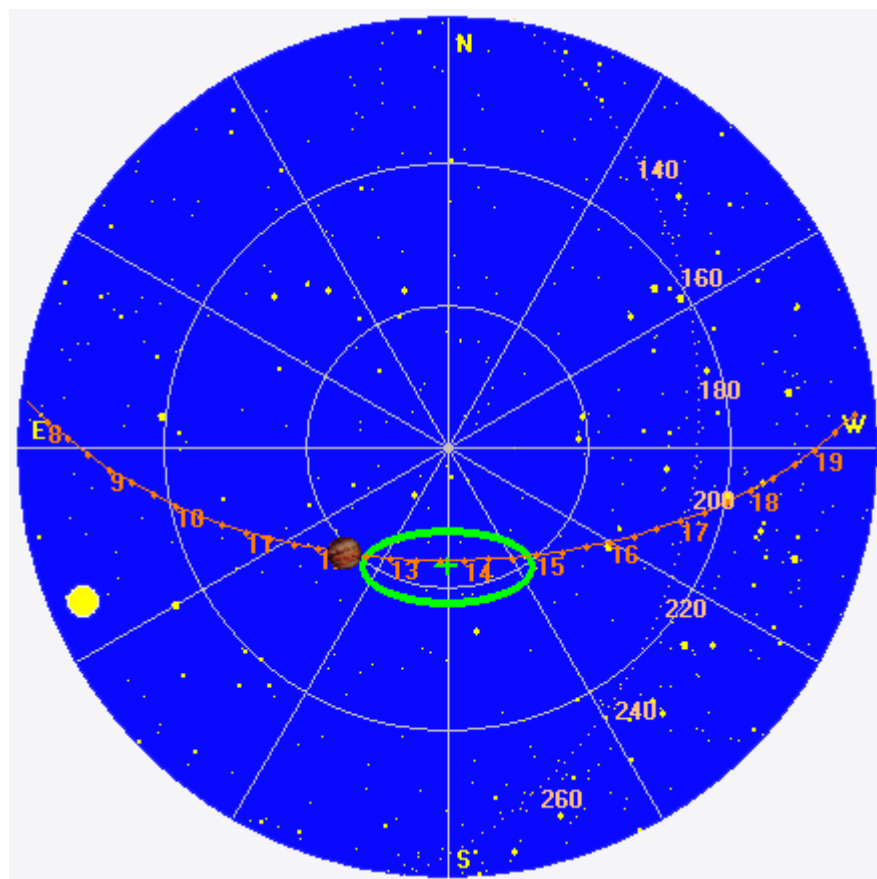
Jupiter was -33° to -9° off axis.

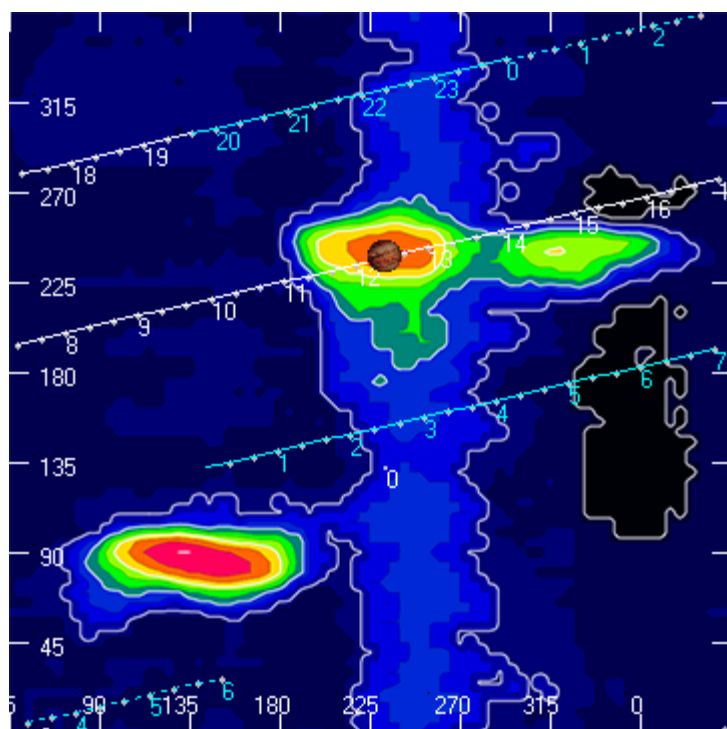
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 55° .

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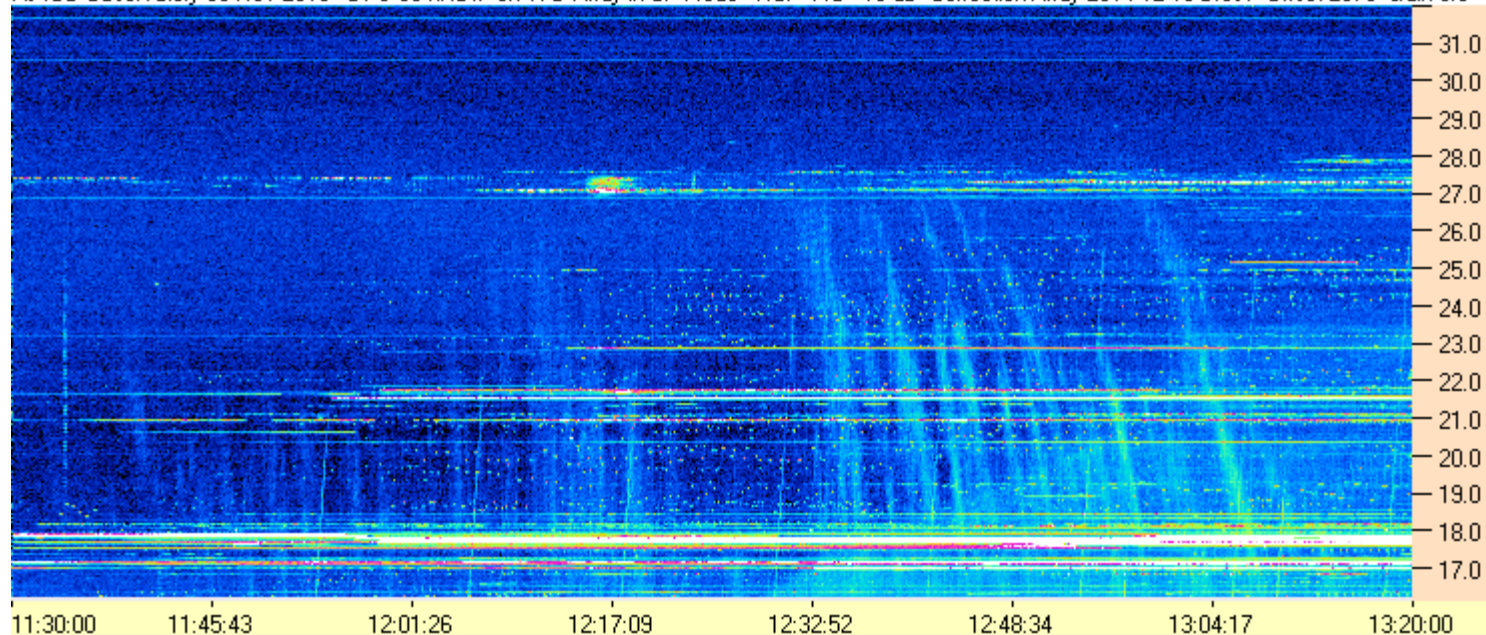
