RCP dominant L bursting 1412-1509 UTC from 16 to 31 MHz, vertex early arcs, some minor (negative slope) modulation lanes visible.

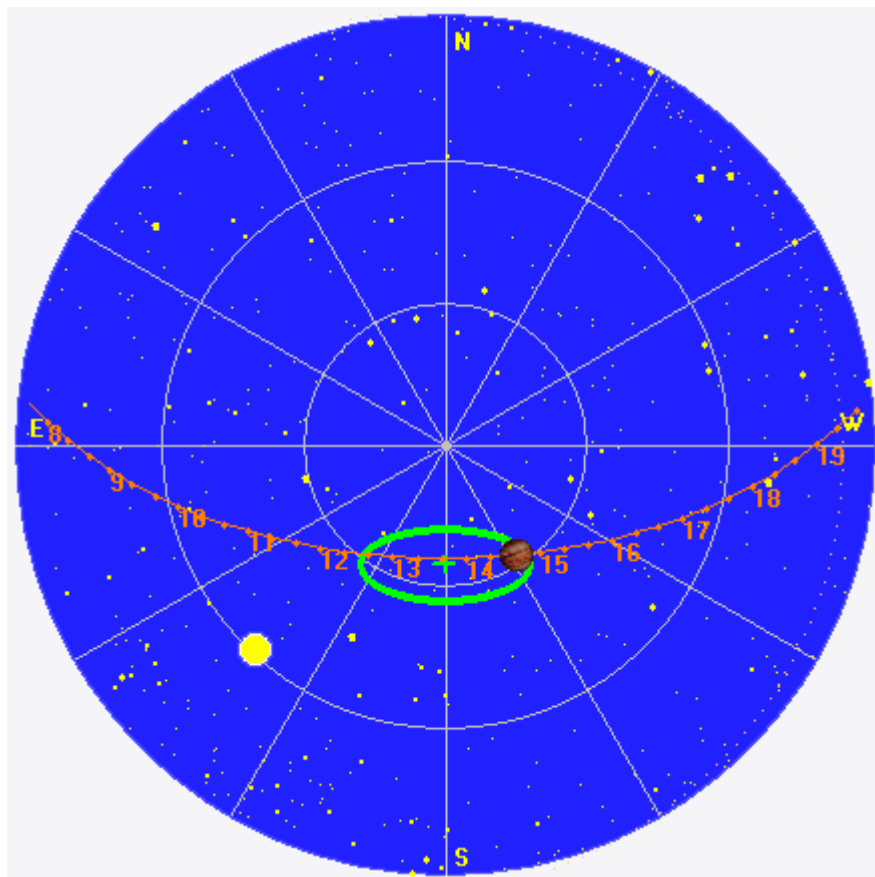
Jupiter was $+7^\circ$ to $+21^\circ$ off axis.

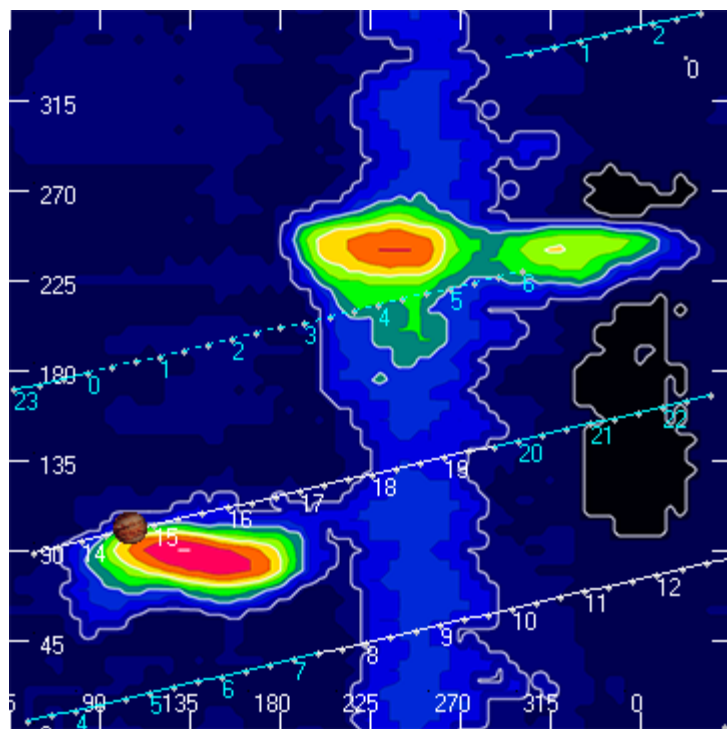
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 56° .

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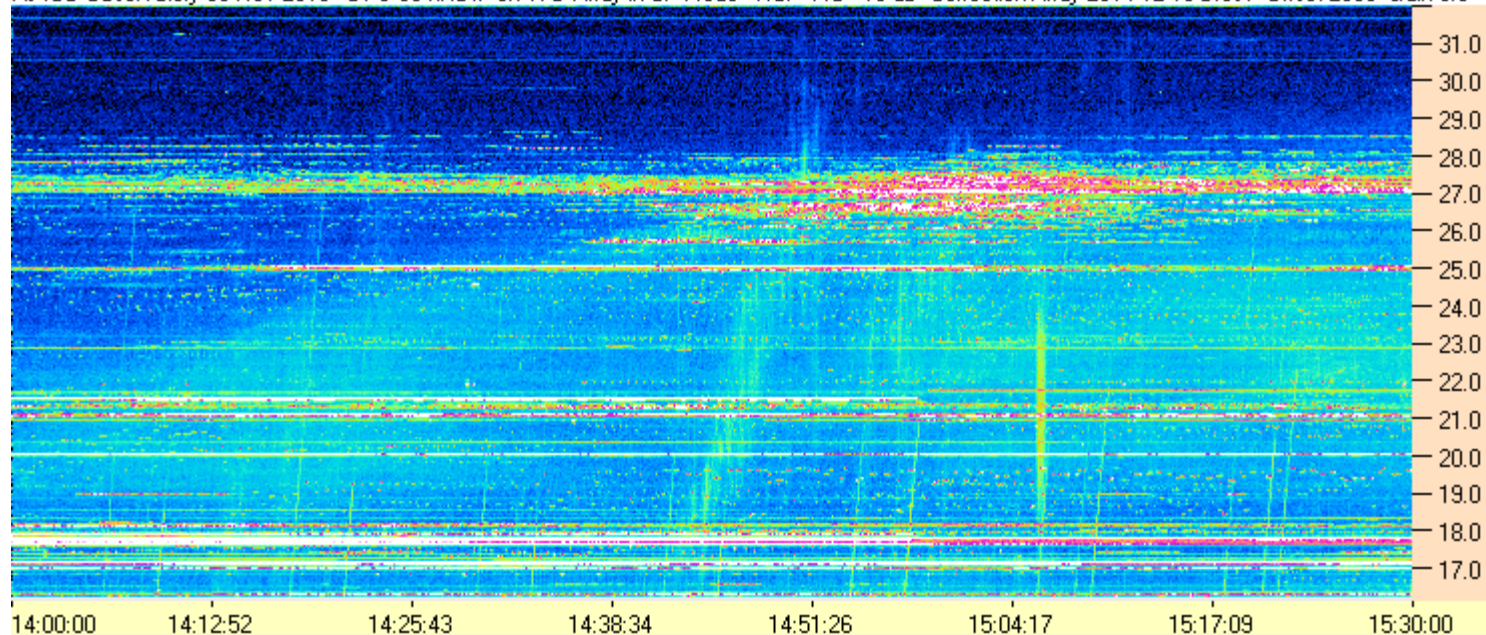

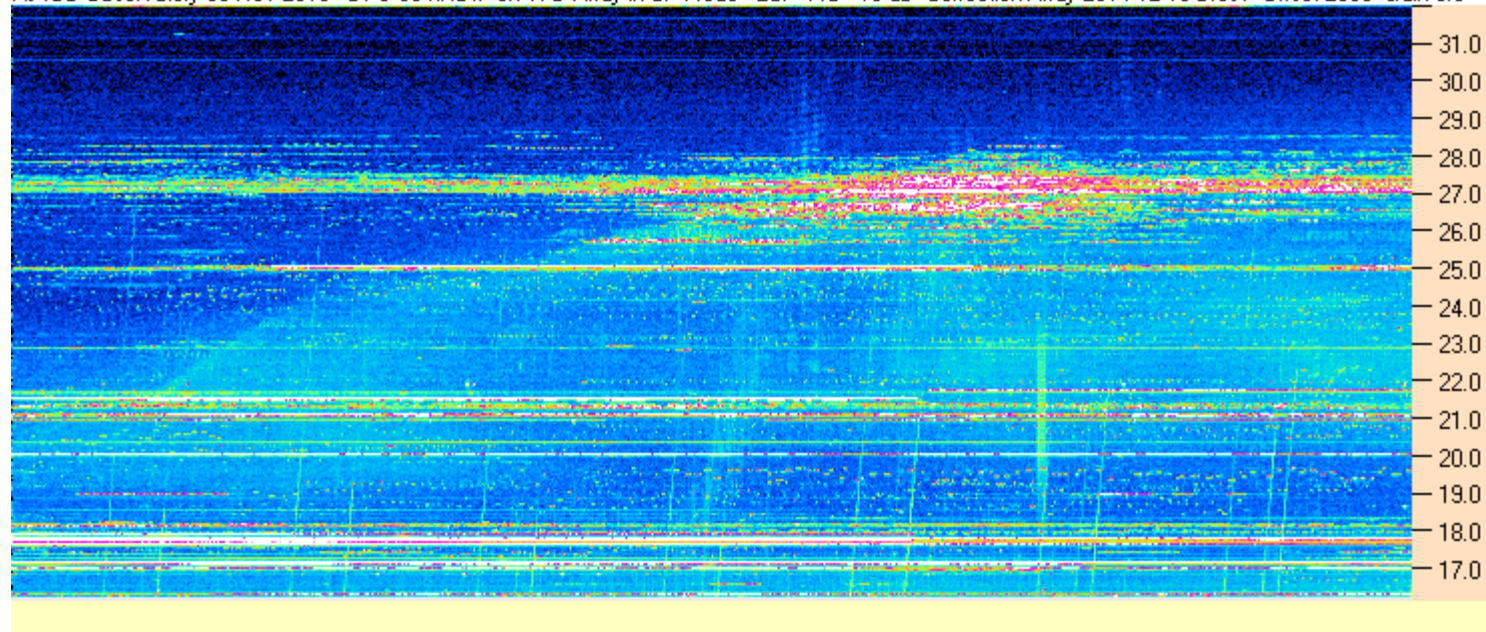




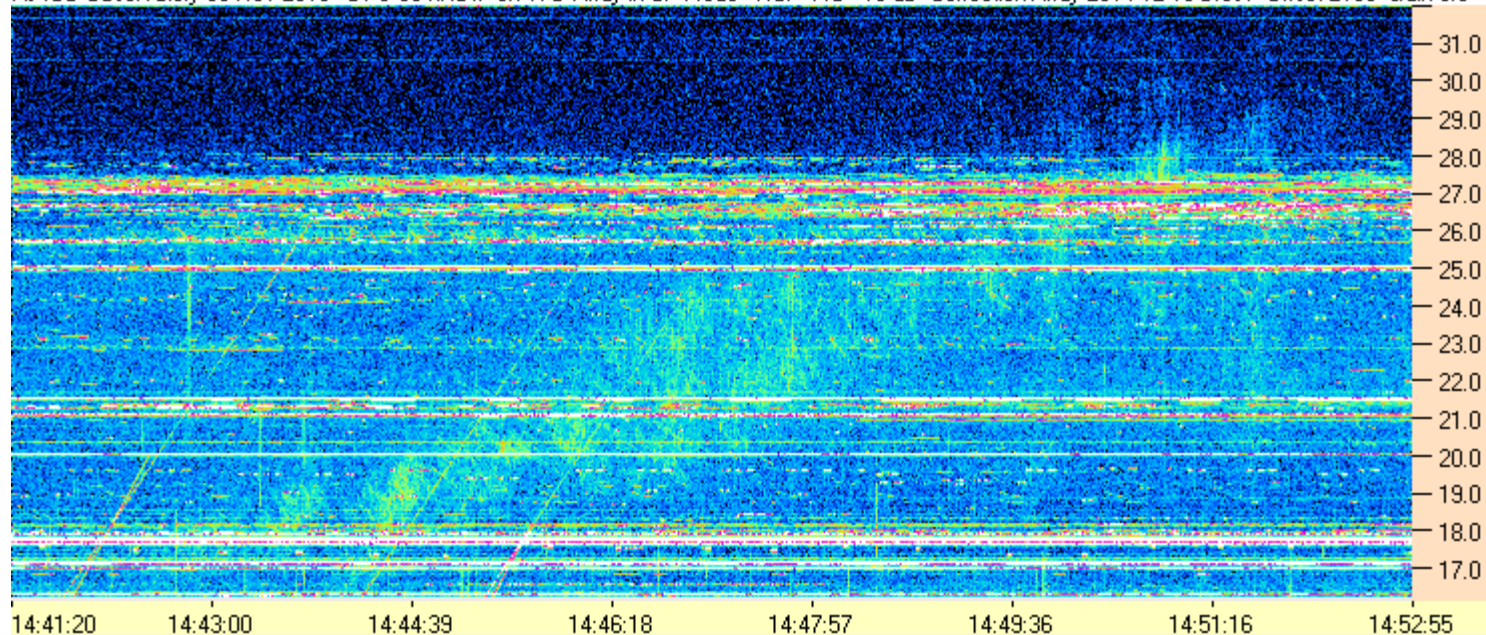

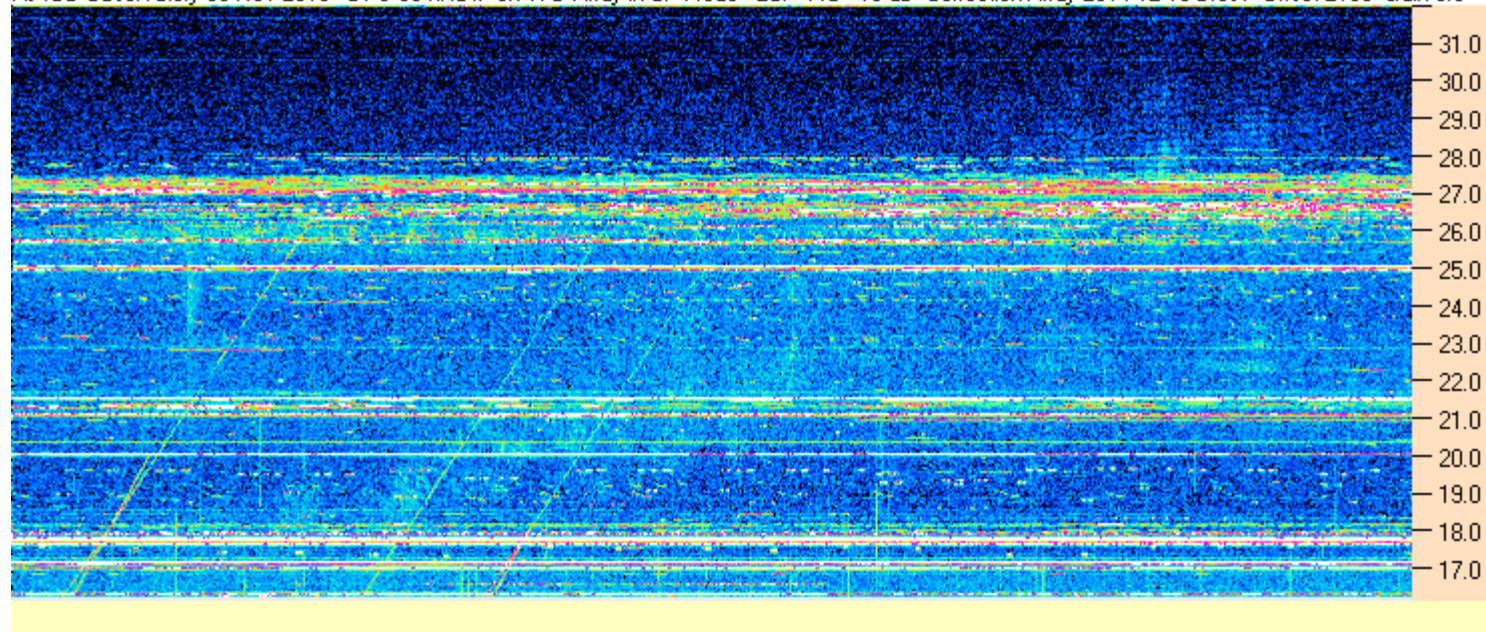

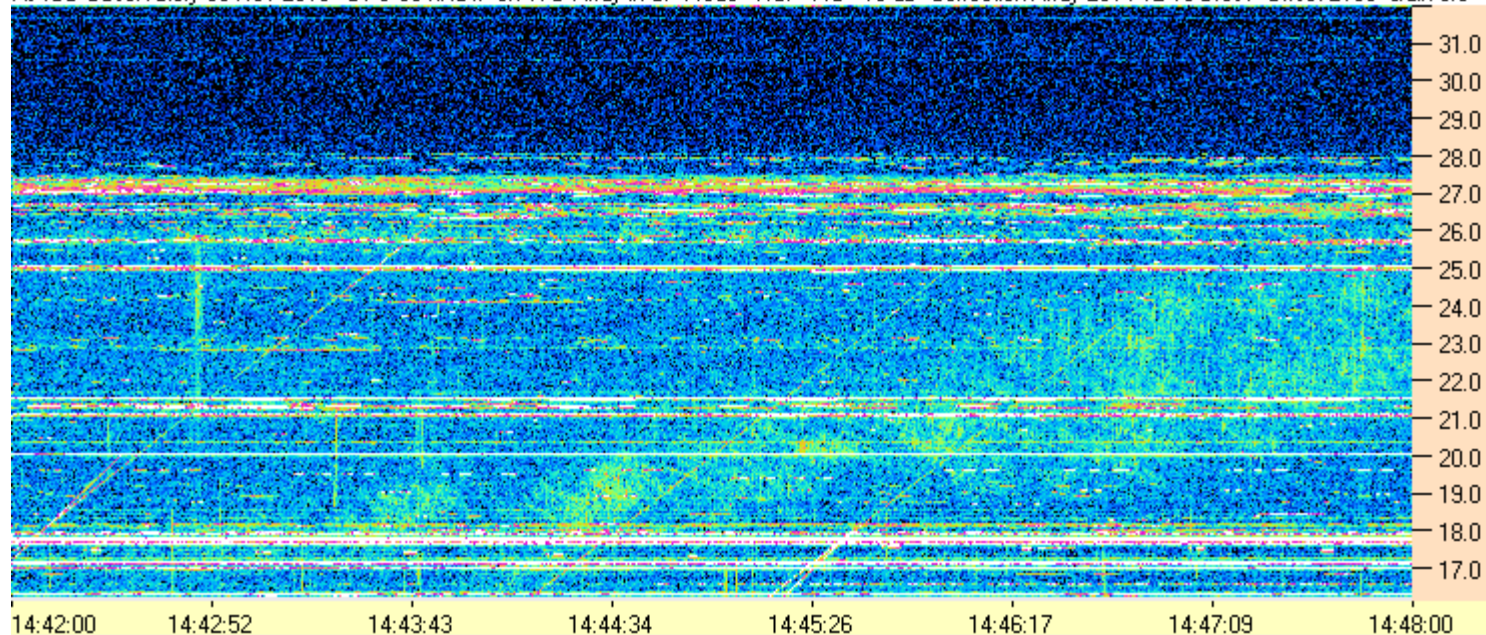
