RCP dominant L bursting 1247-1312 UTC from 16 to 23 MHz, positive drifting emission envelope, no modulation lanes visible.

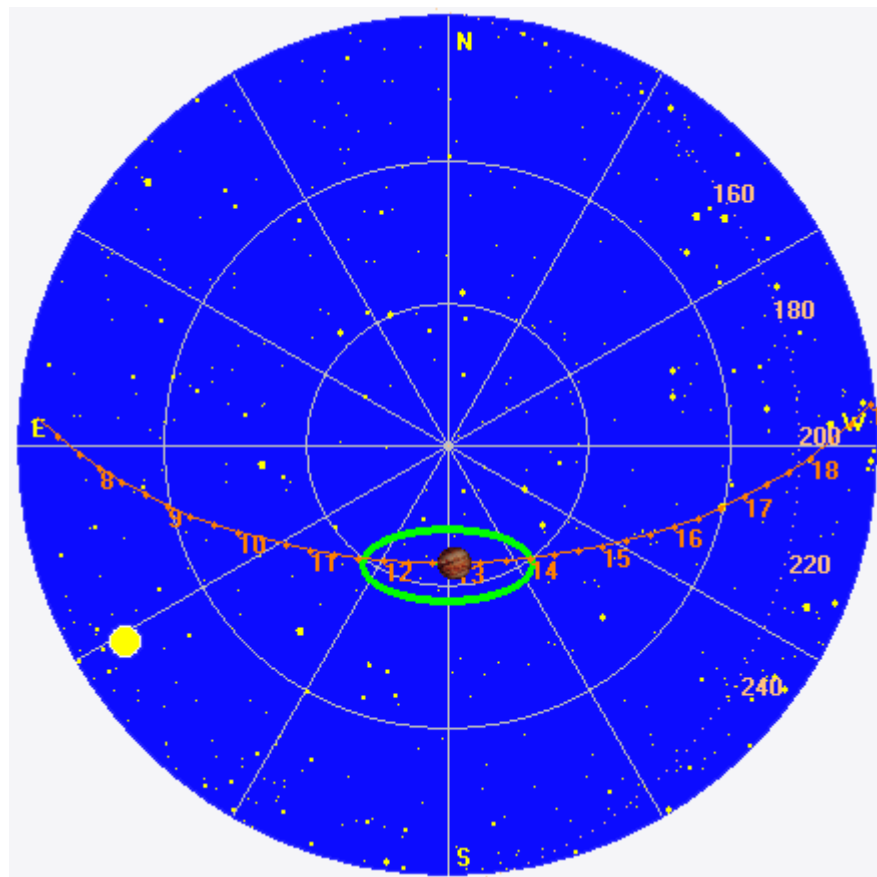
Jupiter was -2° to $+4^\circ$ off axis.

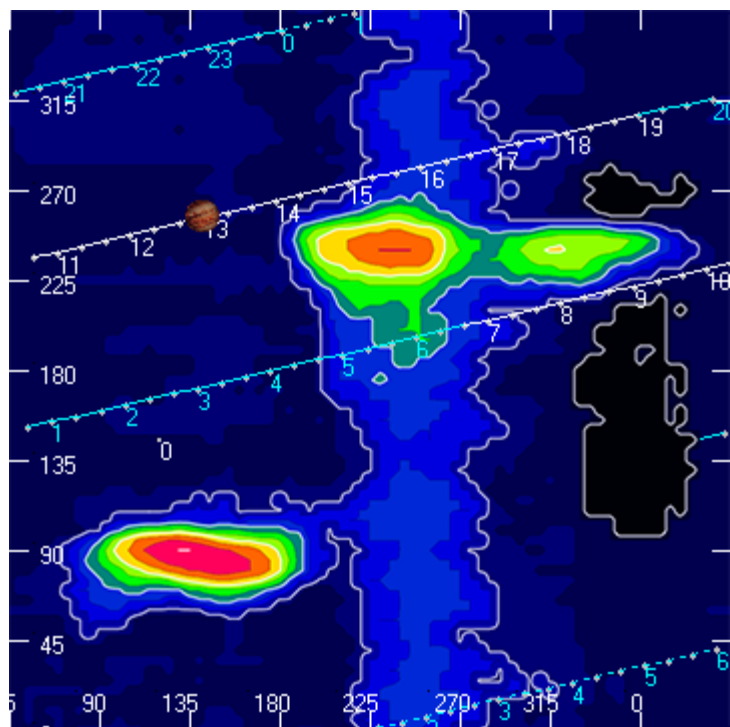
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 69° .

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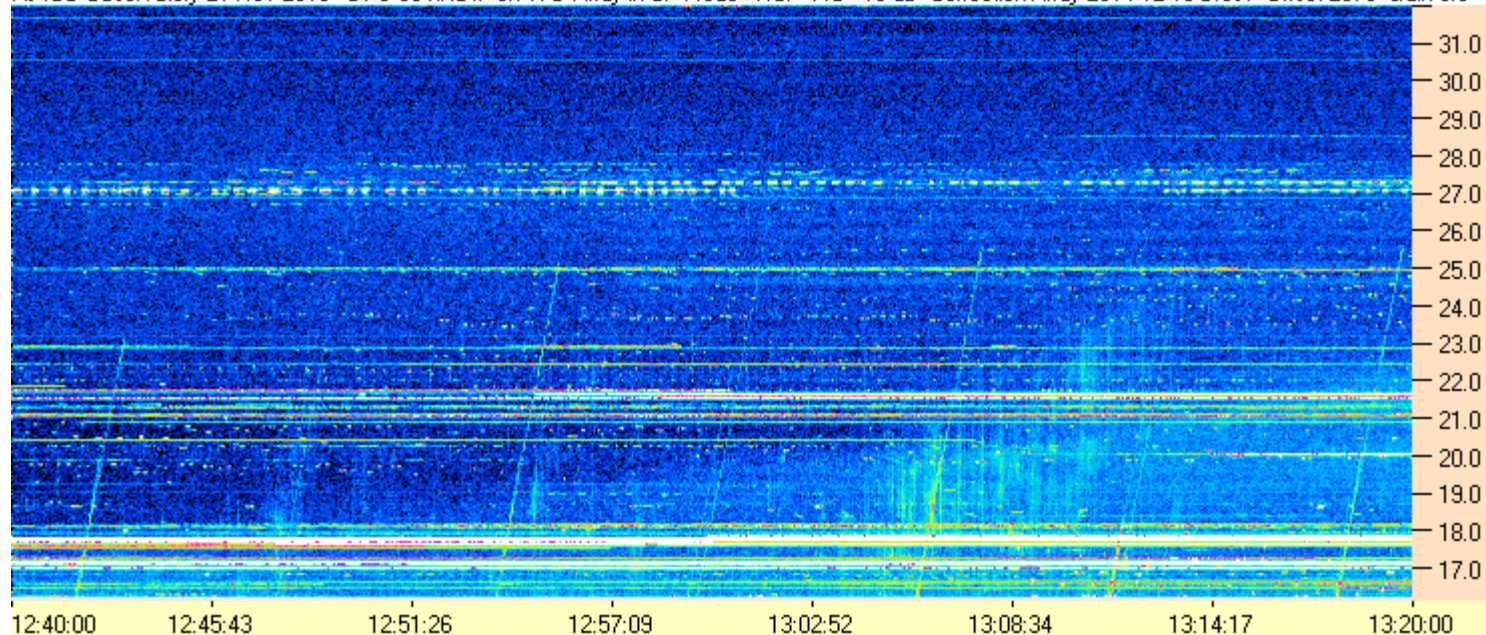

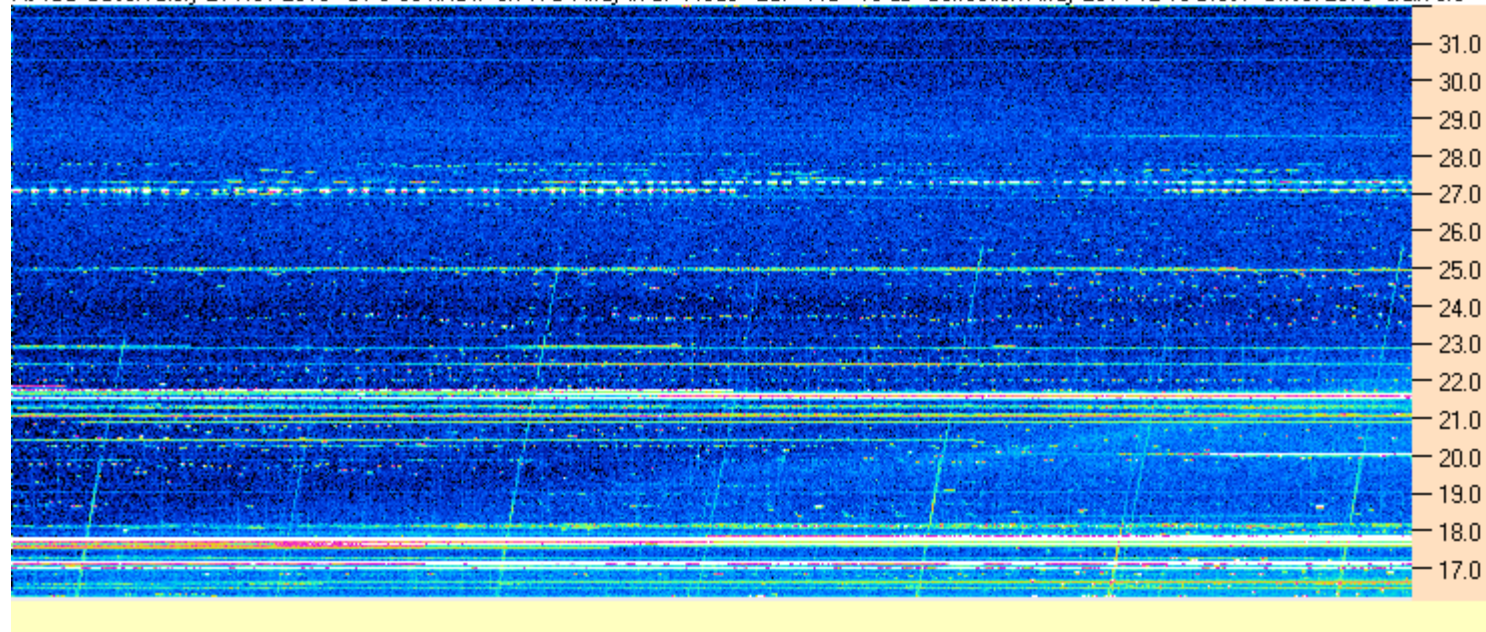




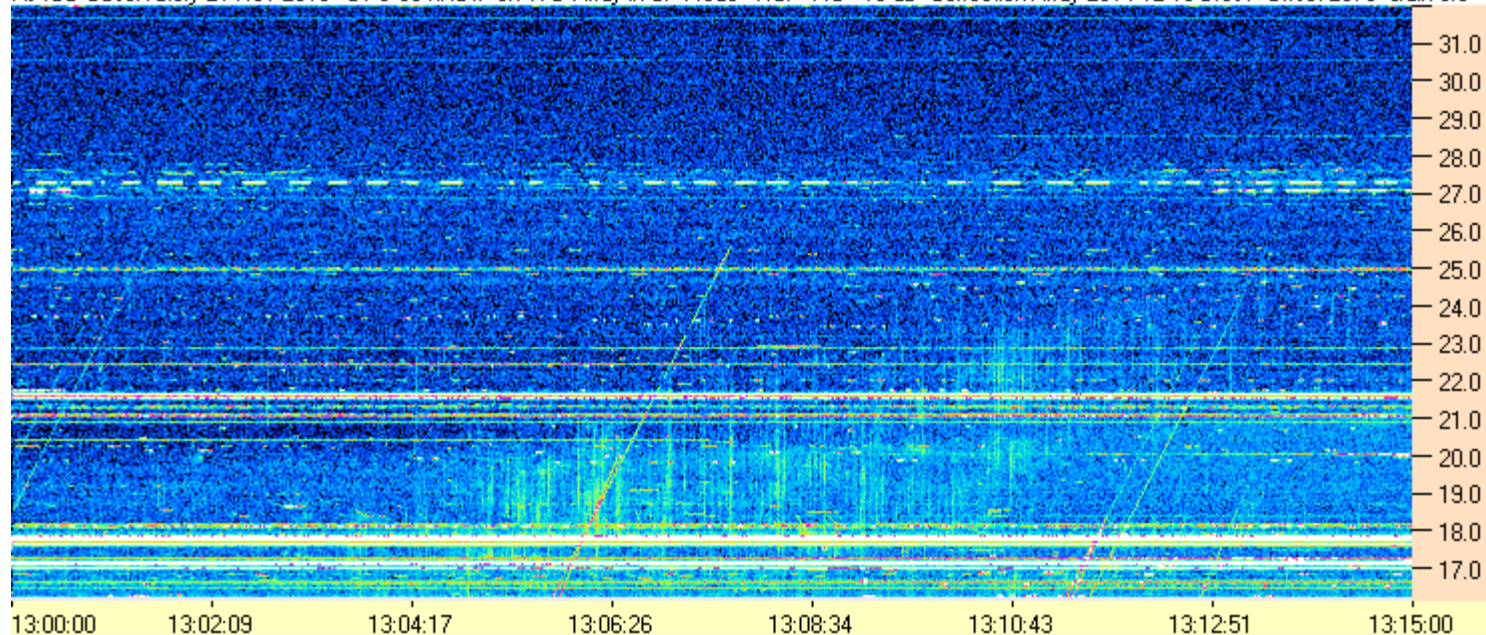
