Adding to Tom's nice report, here's some non-lo-A and perhaps some non-lo-D (again, if there is such a thing, but LCP and vertex early doesn't really fit anything else) from Wednesday morning.

RCP dominant L bursting 0958-1150 UTC from 16 to 27 MHz, vertex late arcs, no modulation lanes visible.

LCP dominant L bursting 1012-1107 UTC from 16 to 24 MHz, vertex early arcs, no modulation lanes visible.

Jupiter was -30° to +6° off axis.

Jupiter was leading the Sun by 92°.

The RCP Jove receiver has developed a slight, slowly varying gain instability. Troubleshooting is in work.
