RCP dominant L bursting 1201-1239 UTC from 16 to 21 MHz, negative drift emission envelope, no modulation lanes visible.


Jupiter was +11° to +20° off axis.

Jupiter was leading the Sun by 94°.


The RCP Jove receiver has developed a slight, slowly varying gain instability. Troubleshooting is in work.






