RCP dominant L bursting 0945-1023 UTC from 16 to 24 MHz, positive drift emission envelope, no modulation lanes visible.


Jupiter was -23° to -14° off axis.

Jupiter was leading the Sun by 94°.


The RCP Jove receiver has developed a slight, slowly varying gain instability. Troubleshooting is in work.






