Jupiter was -31° to -7° off axis.

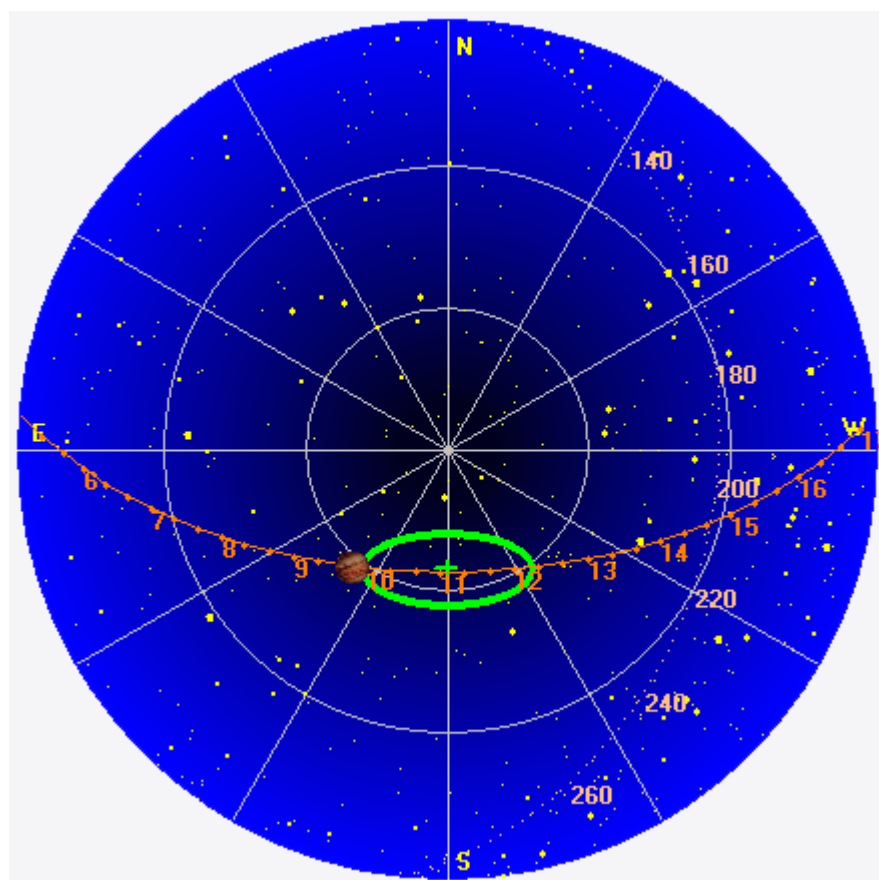
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 97° .

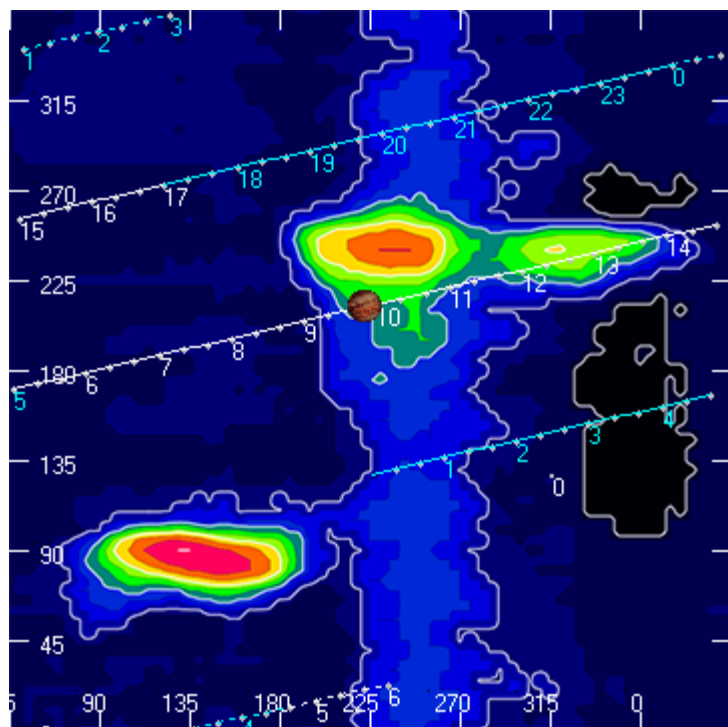
The RCP Jove receiver's gain instability was fixed at 1233 UTC.

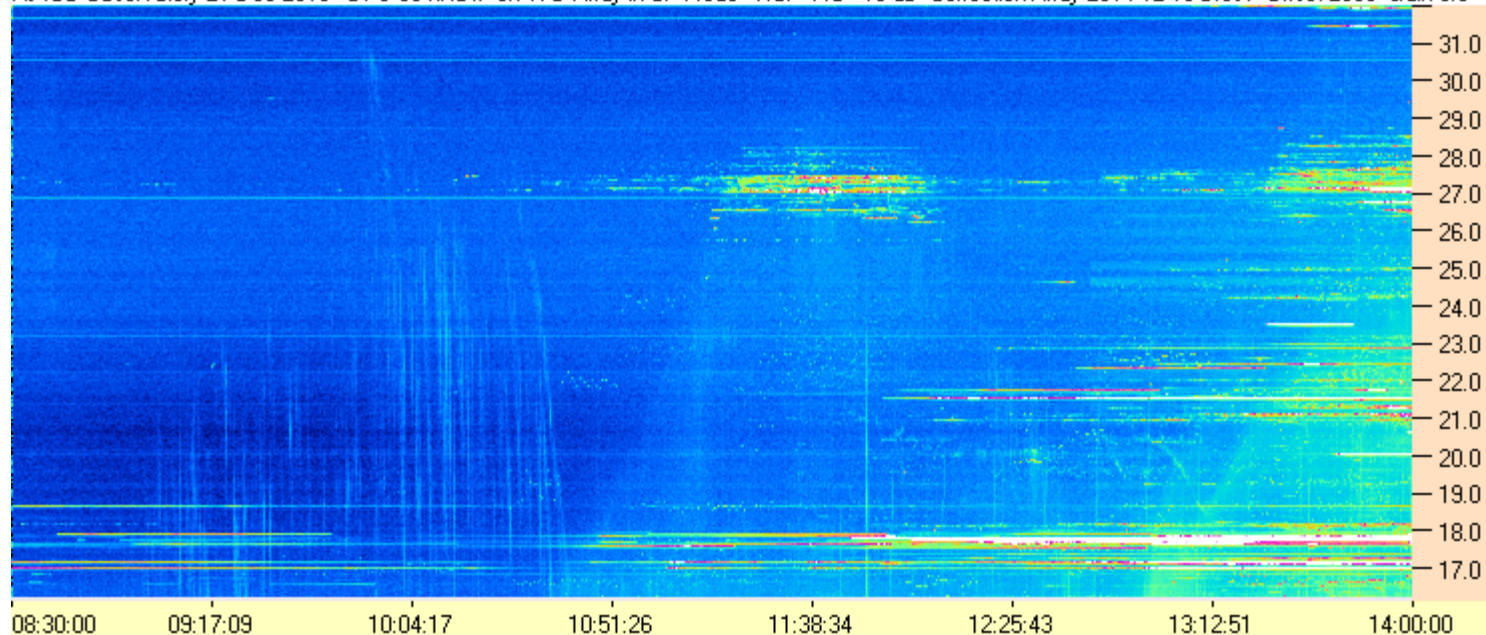

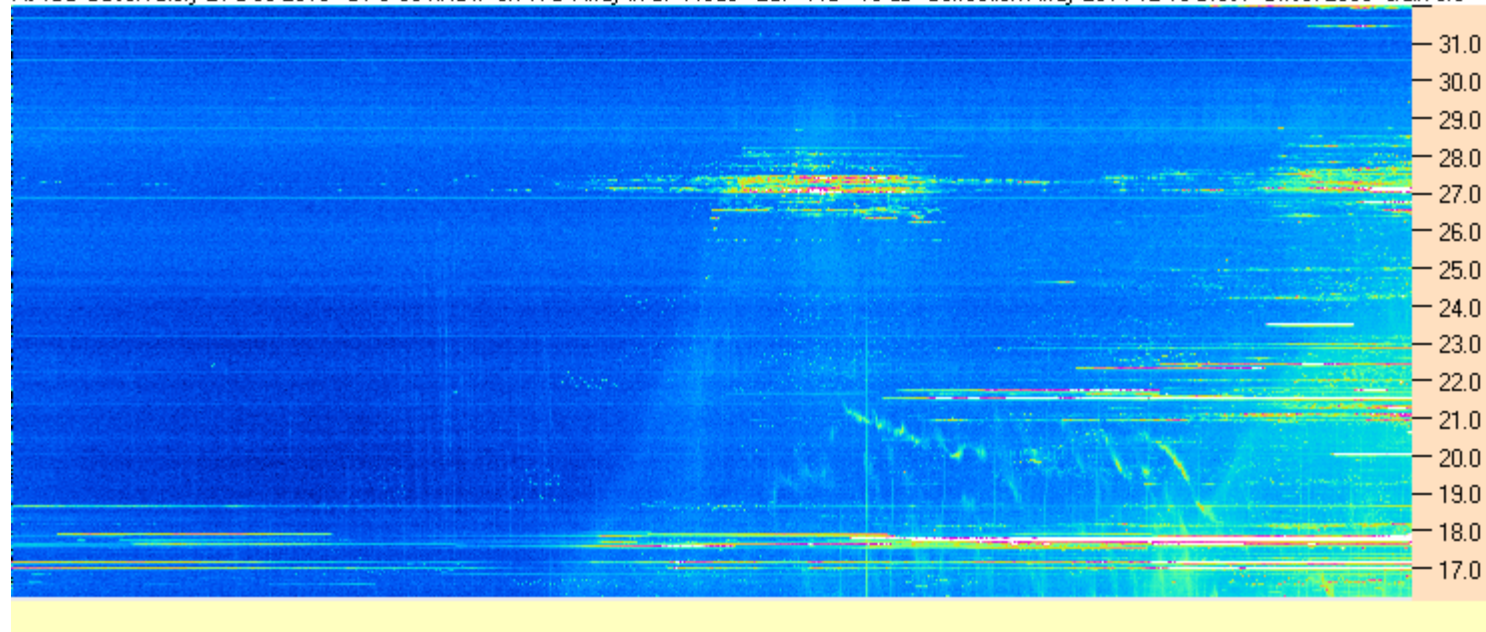




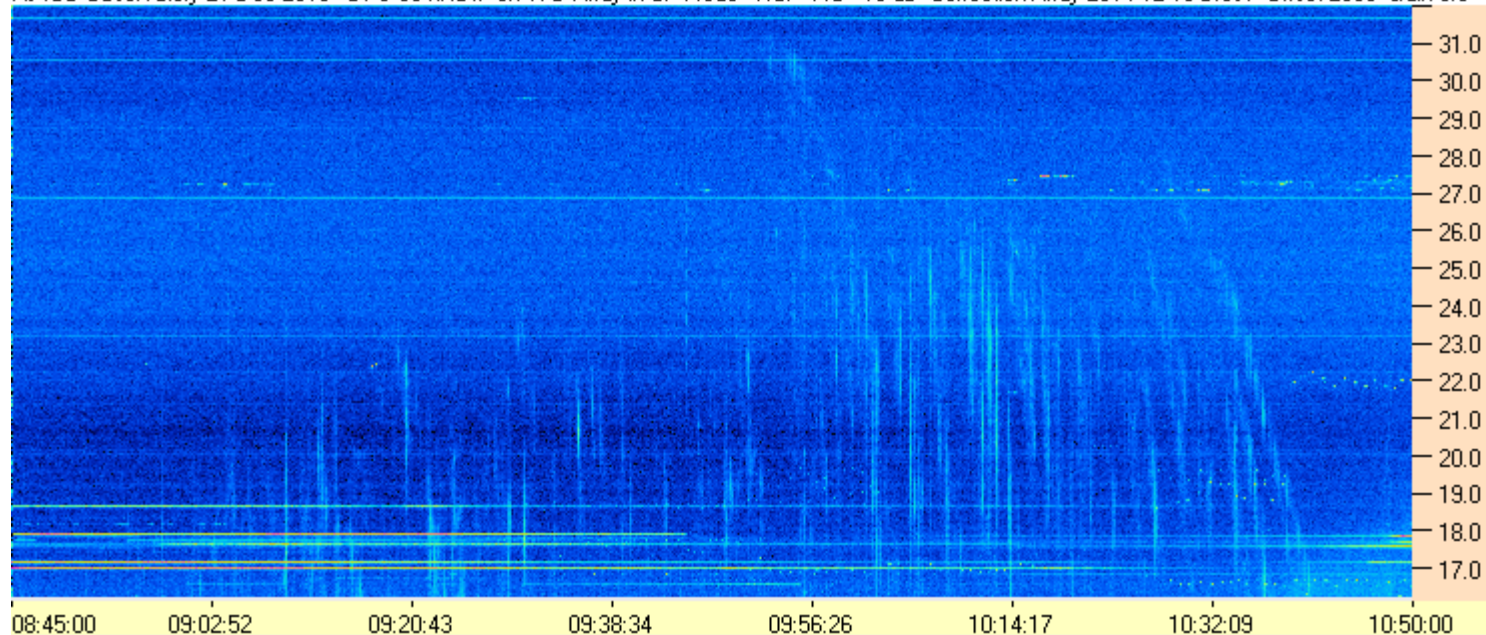
