LCP dominant L bursting 0834-848 UTC from 16 to 18 MHz, negative drift envelope, no modulation lanes visible.

RCP dominant L bursting 0846-1009 UTC from 16 to 23 MHz, negative drift envelope, no modulation lanes visible.

LCP dominant L bursting 1021-1028 UTC from 16 to 18 MHz, negative drift envelope, no modulation lanes visible.

Some intermittent line noise present.

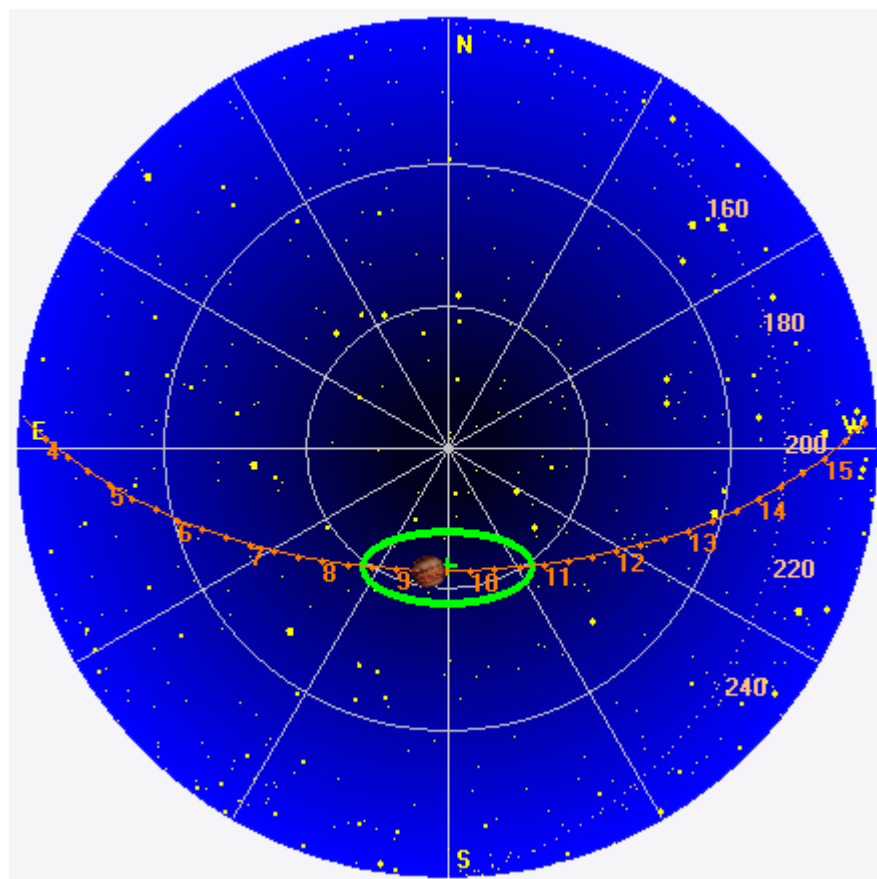
Jupiter was -17° to $+7^\circ$ off axis.

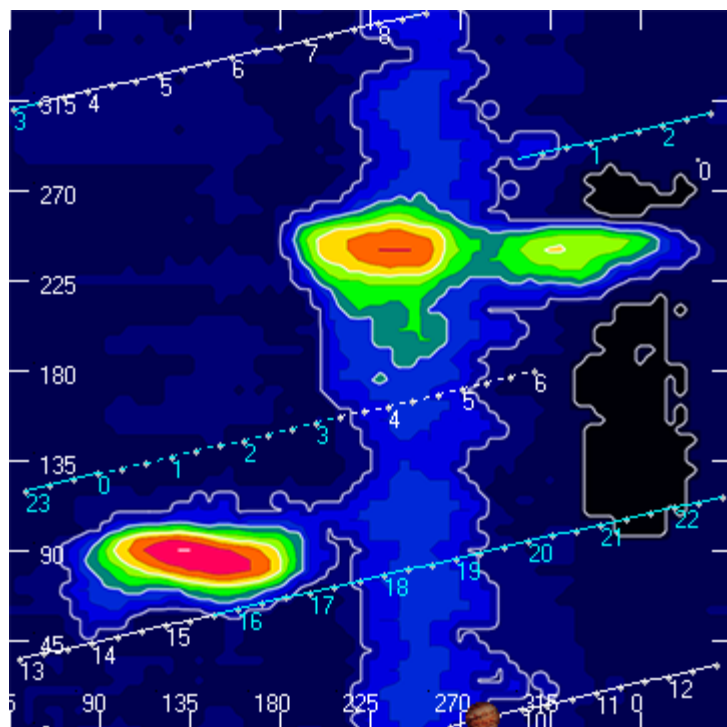
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 118° .

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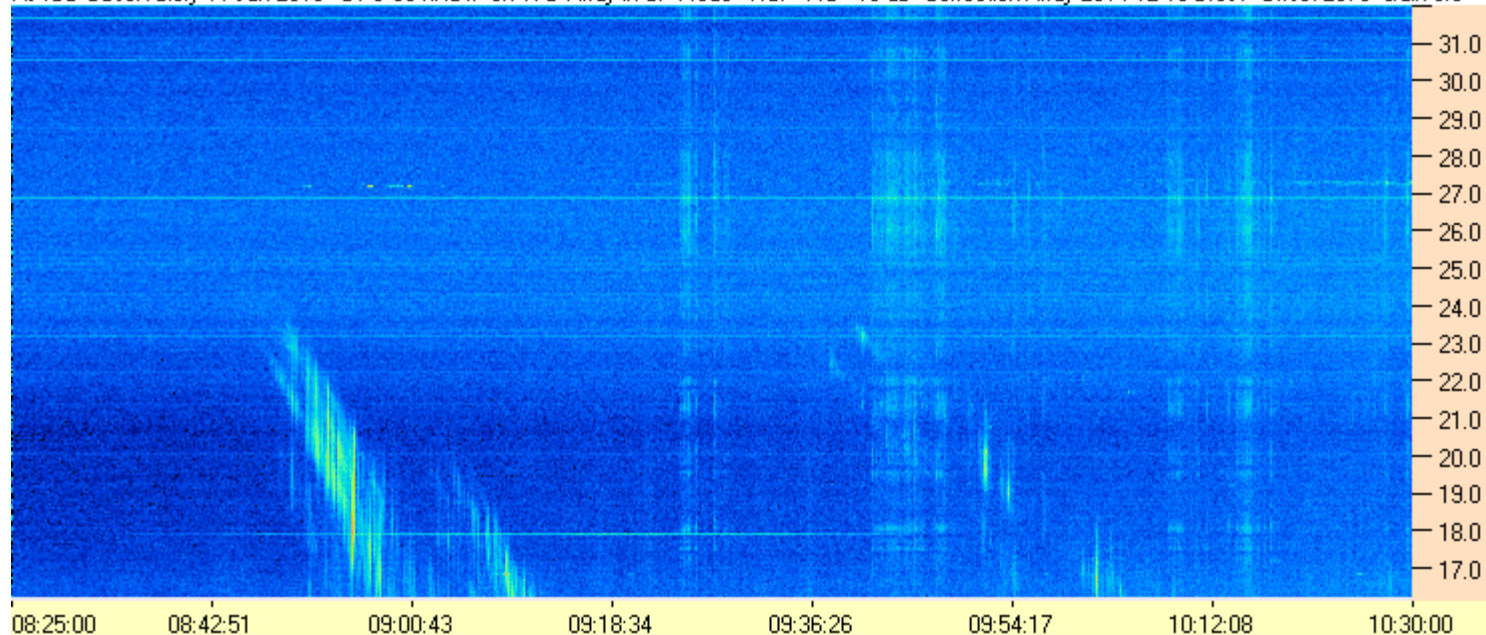
