LCP dominant L bursting 0723-0923 UTC from 16 to 25 MHz, vertex late arcs, negative drift modulation lanes visible.

LCP dominant narrow banded S burst trains 0655-0811 UTC from 16 to 22 MHz, vertex late arcs.

LCP was very dominant, peaking 14 dB over RCP at times.

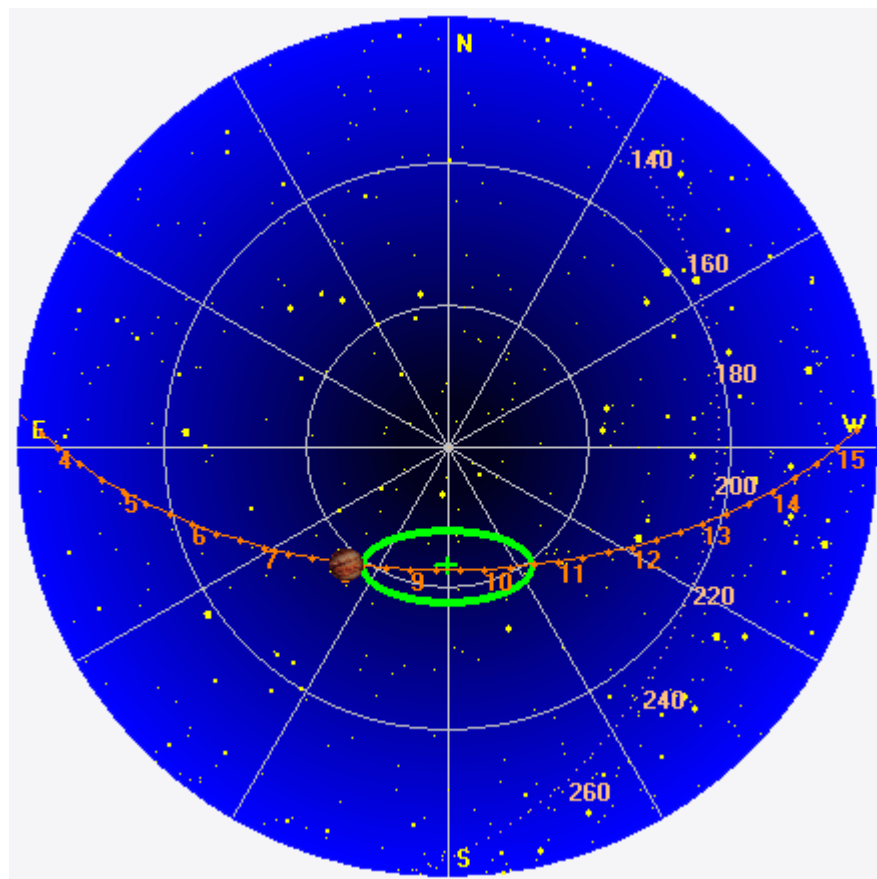
Jupiter was -39° to -2° off axis.

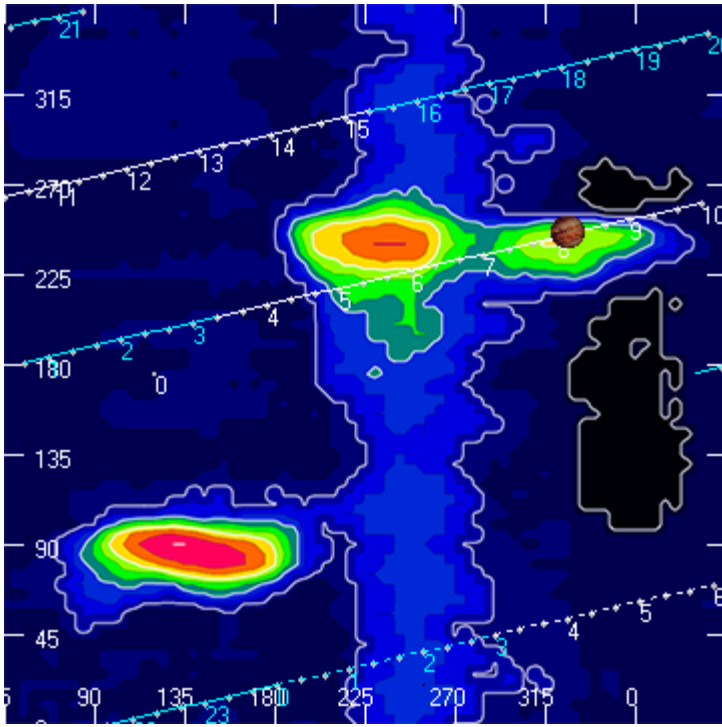
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 121° .

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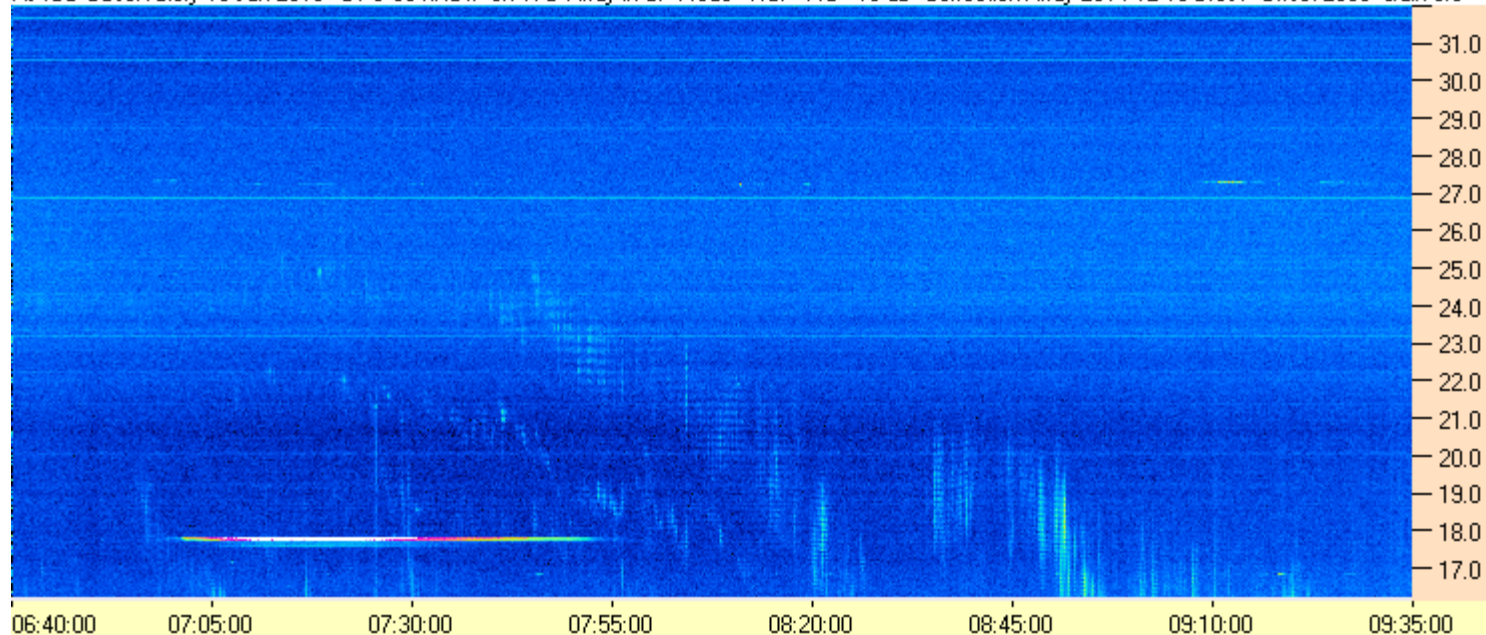
