RCP dominant L bursting 0823-0853 UTC from 16 to 25 MHz, negative drift emission envelope, no modulation lanes visible.

LCP dominant narrow-band S burst trains 0956-1022 UTC from 16 to 19 MHz, negative drift emission envelope.

LCP dominant L bursting 0959-1040 UTC from 16 to 21 MHz, negative drift emission envelope, no modulation lanes visible.

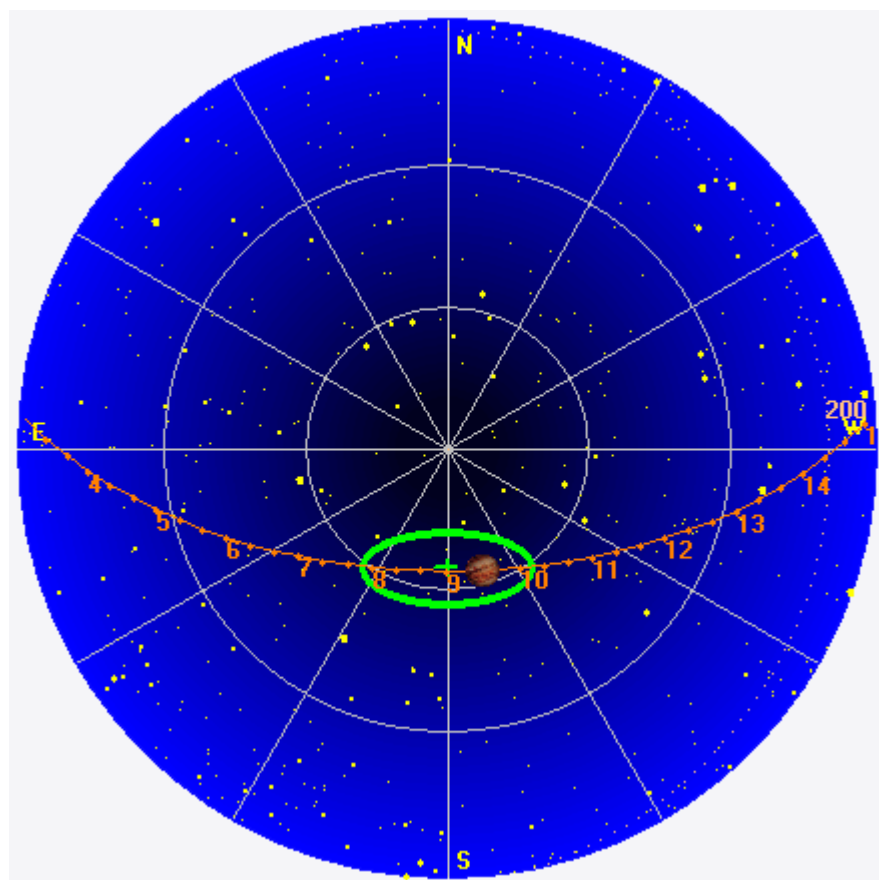
Jupiter was -10° to $+25^\circ$ off axis.

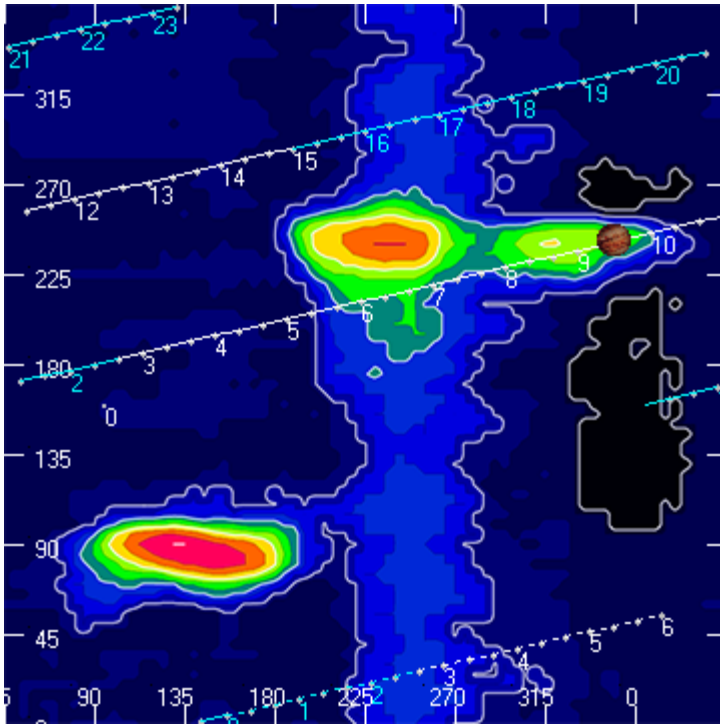
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 128° .

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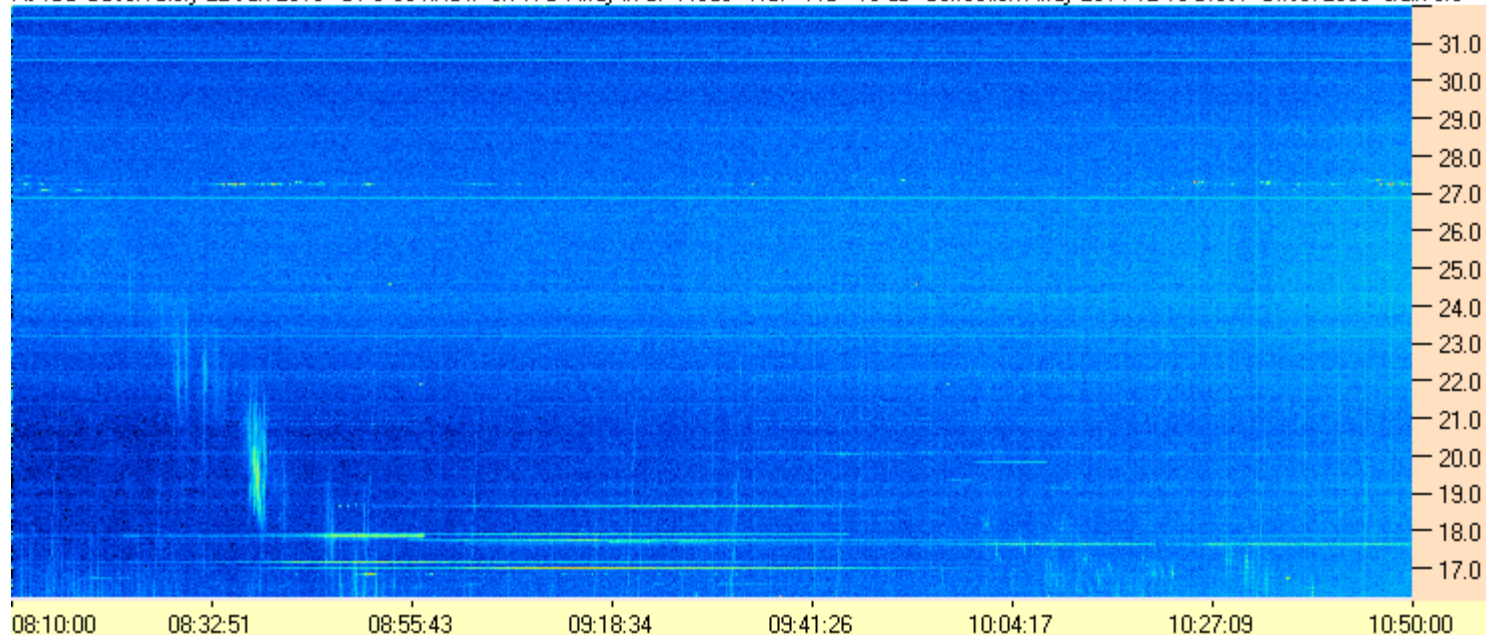
