Interesting ionospheric diffraction/refraction lanes 0732 to 0738 UTC.

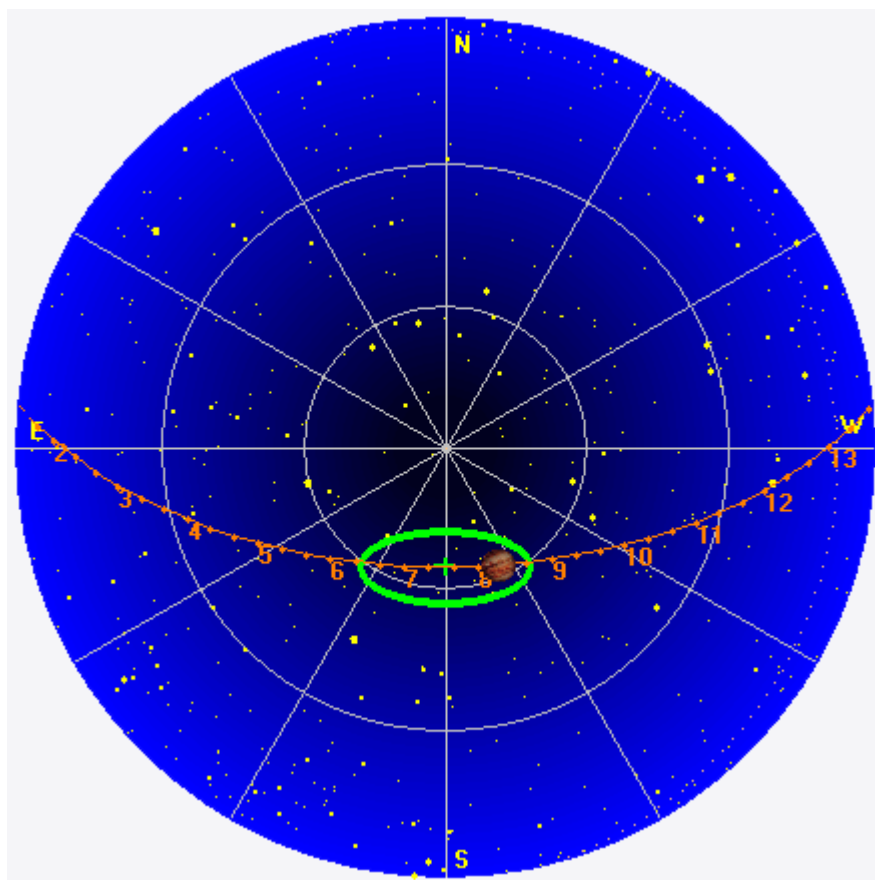
Jupiter was -2° to $+24^\circ$ off axis.

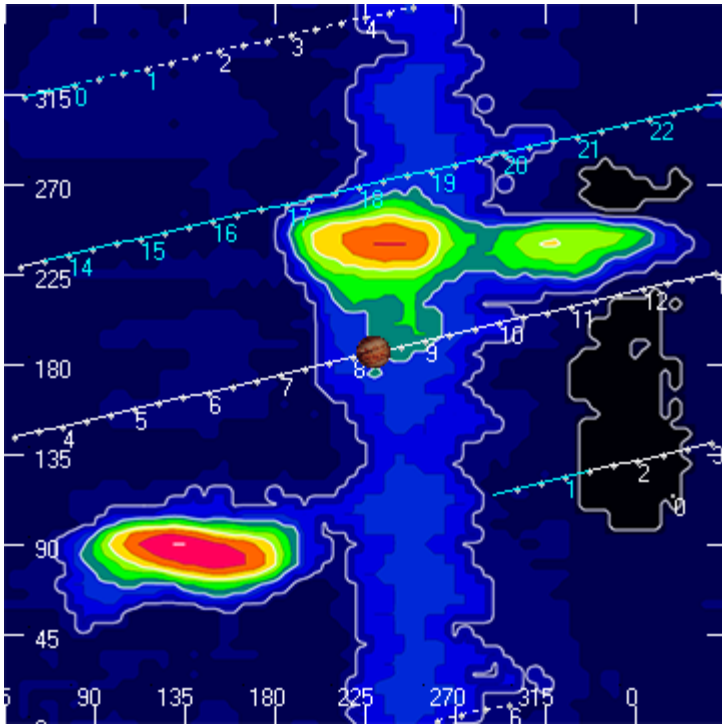
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 152° .

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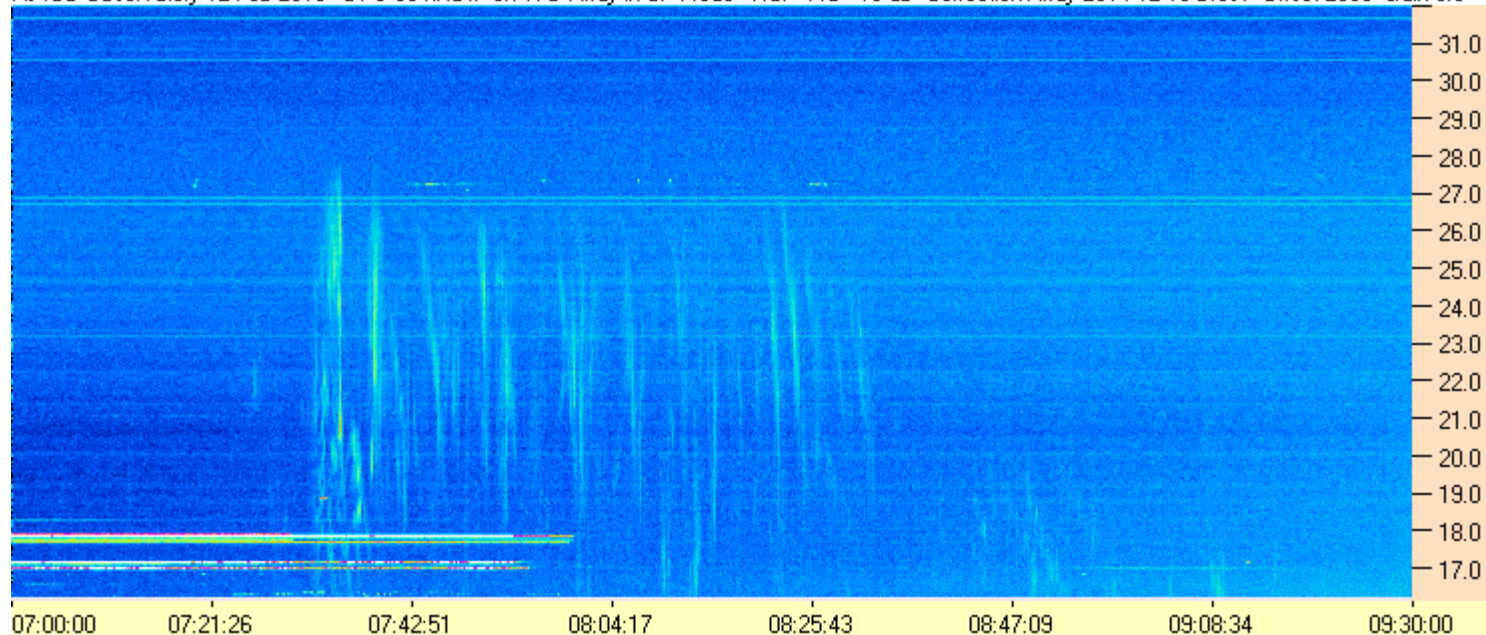

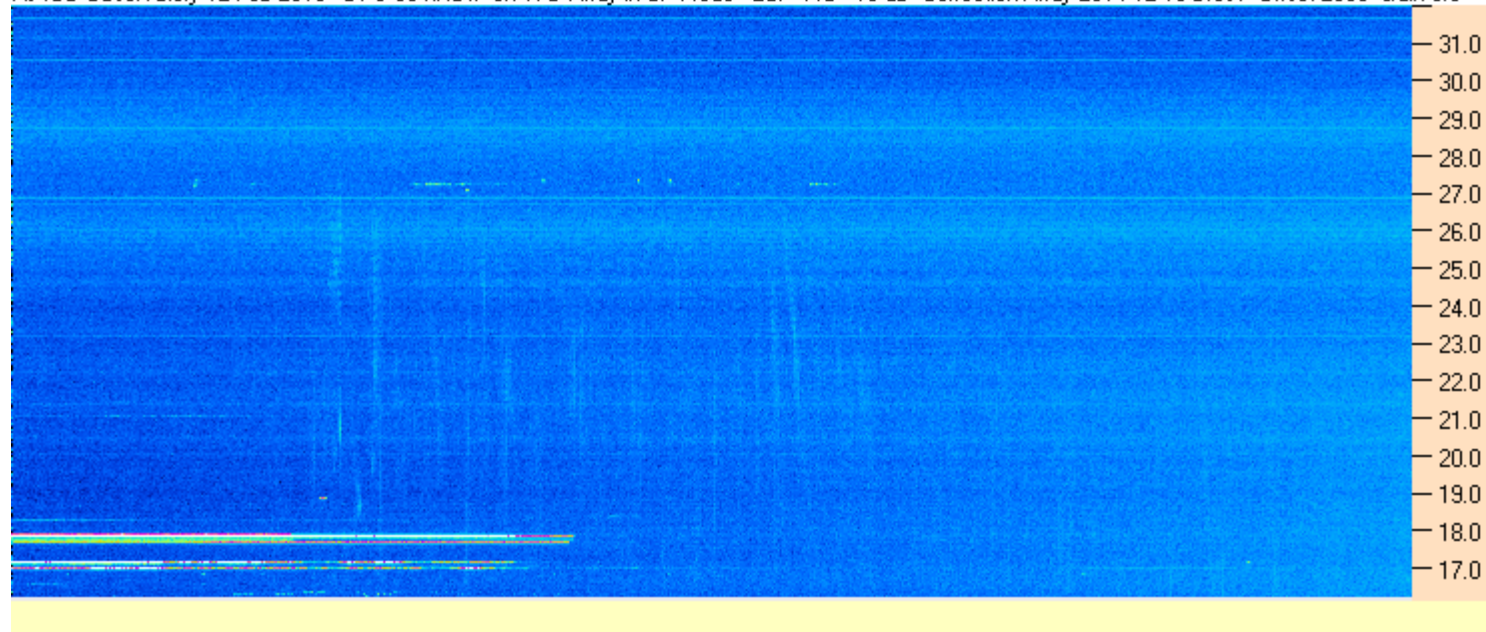

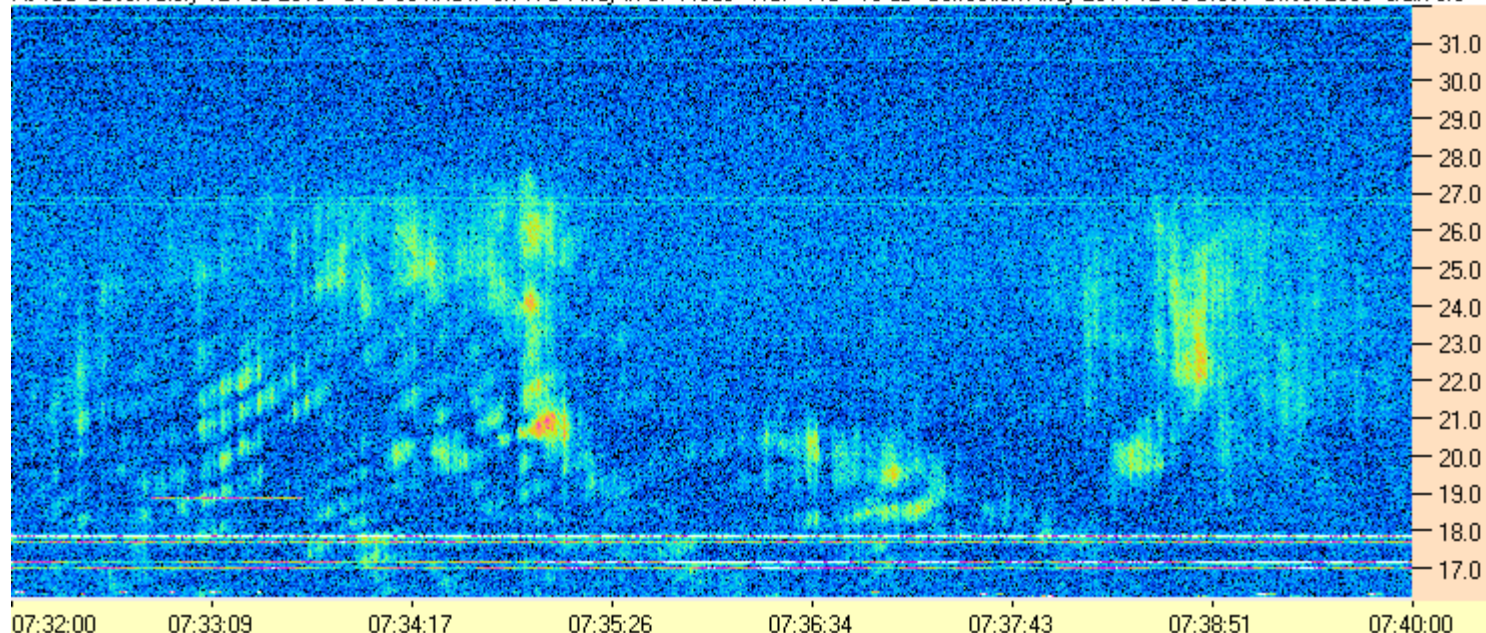
