LCP dominant L bursting 0449-0535 UTC from 16 to 20 MHz, negative drift emission envelopes. (non-Io-C)

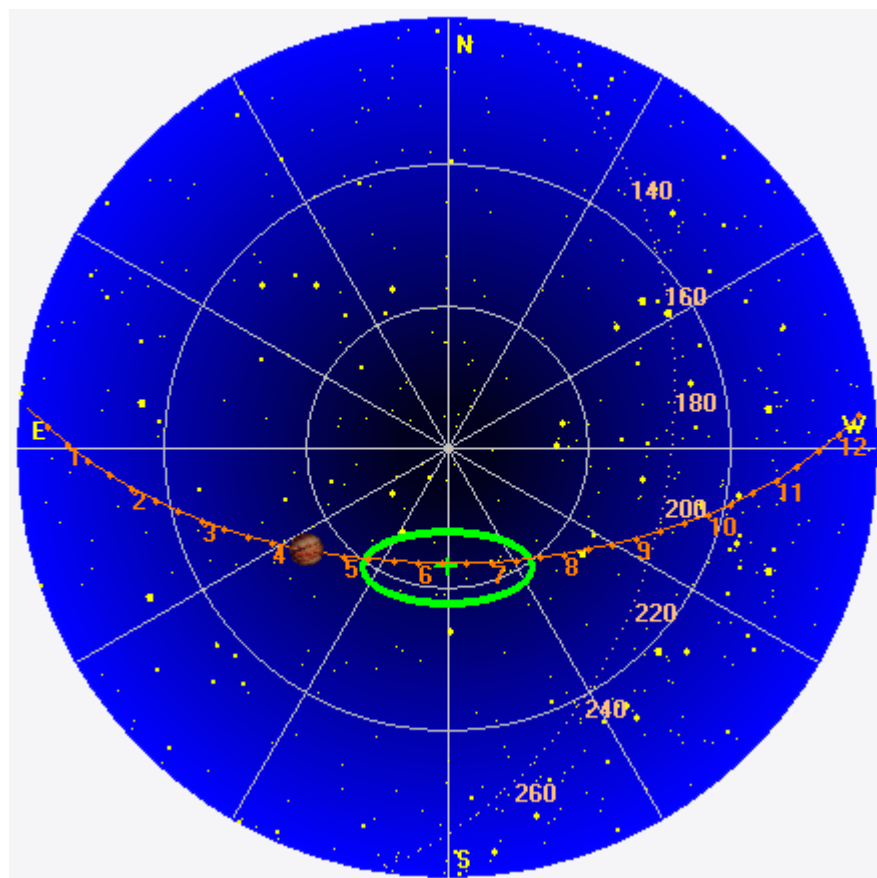
Jupiter was -44° to -12° off axis.

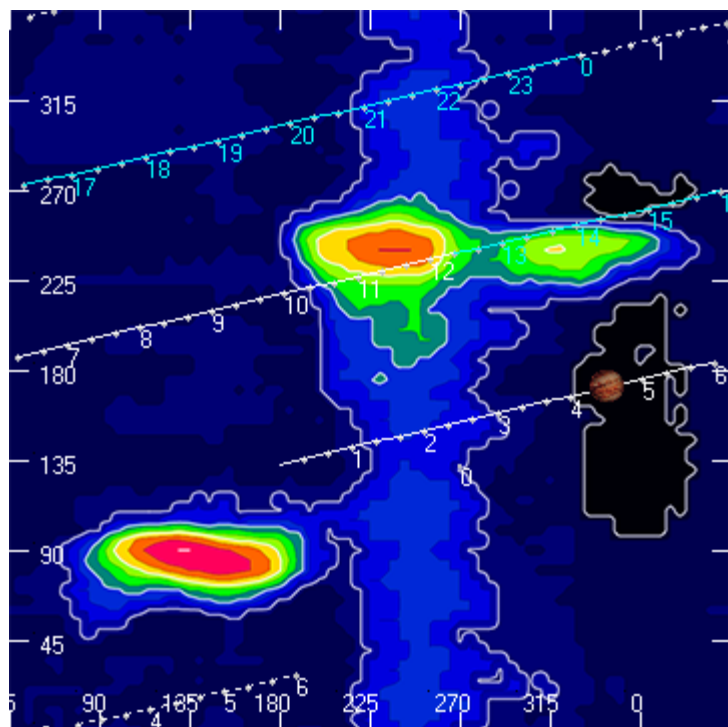
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 169° .

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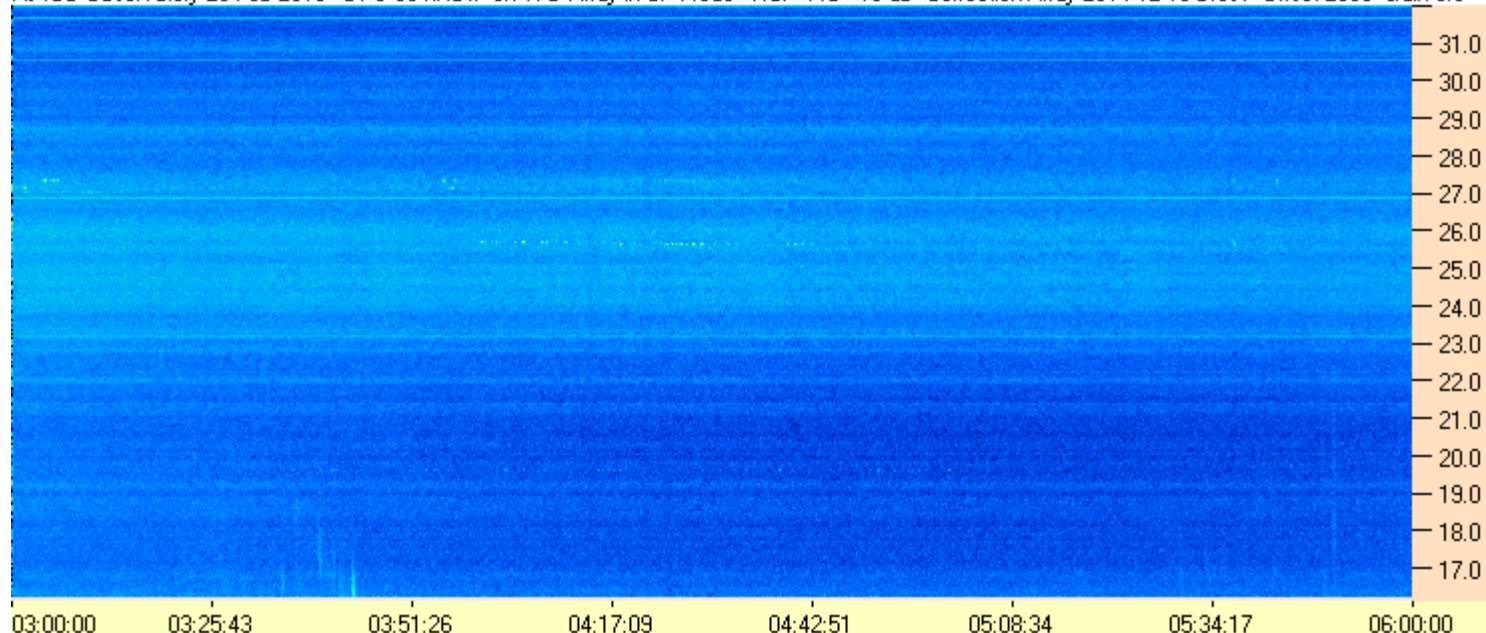

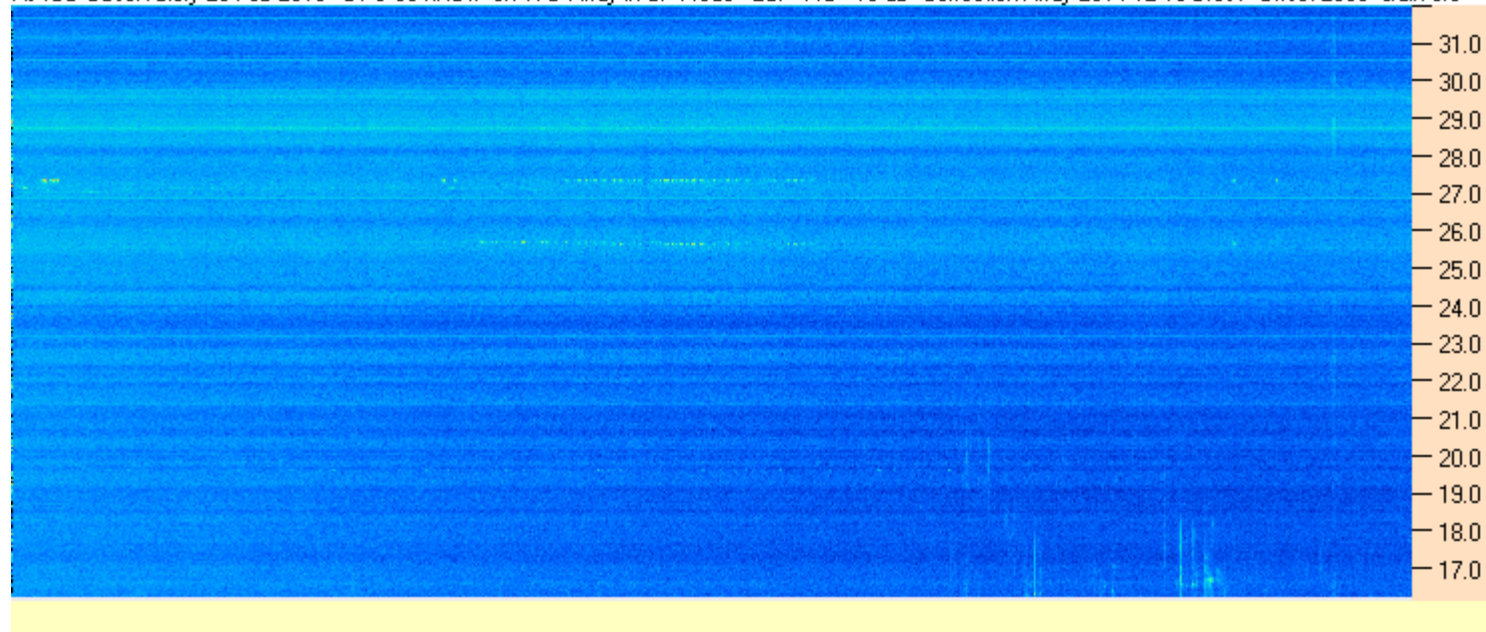




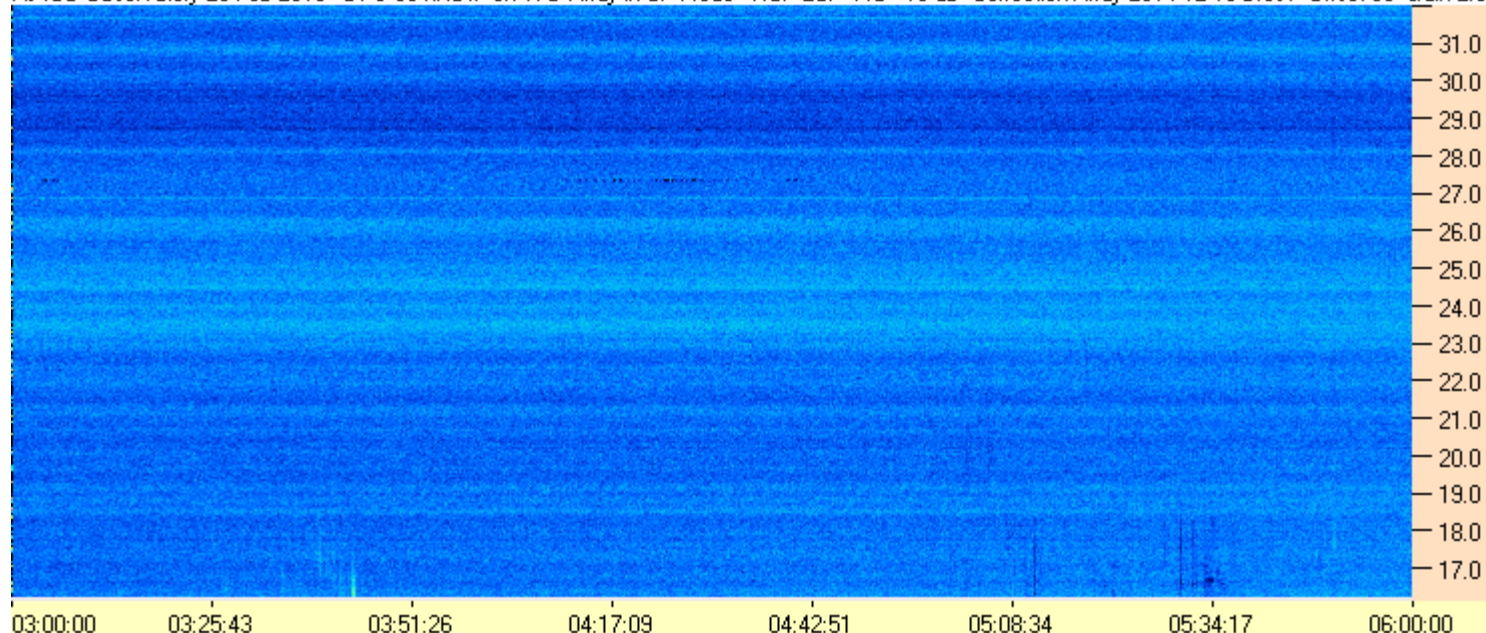
