RCP dominant L bursting 0653-0816 UTC from 16 to 20 MHz, negative drift emission envelopes. (non-Io-A)

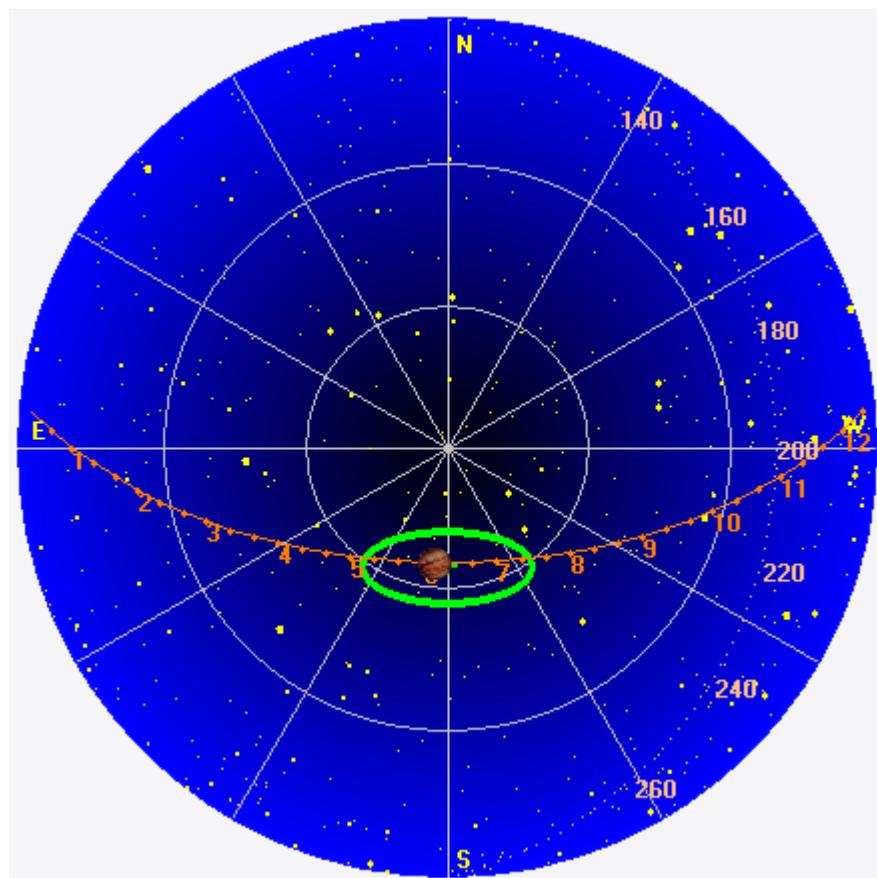
Jupiter was -34° to $+29^\circ$ off axis.

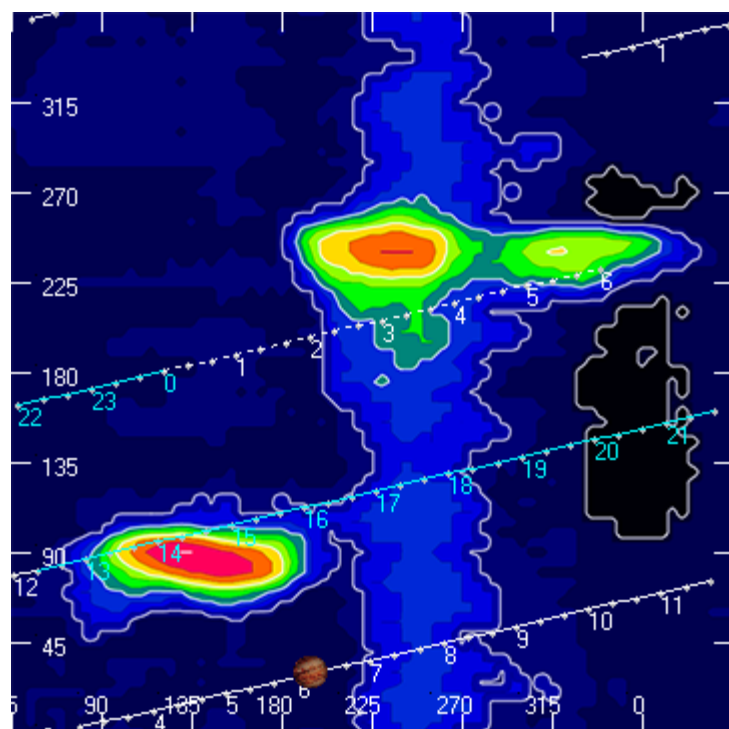
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 171° .

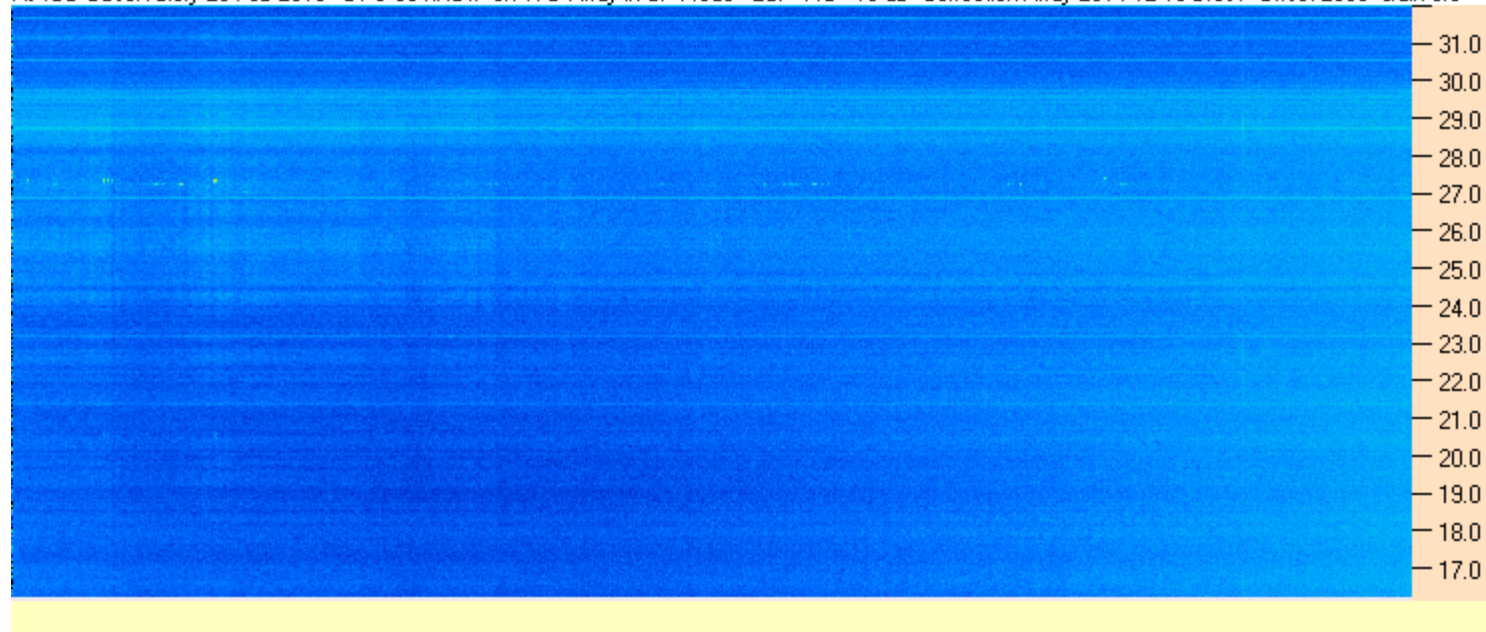

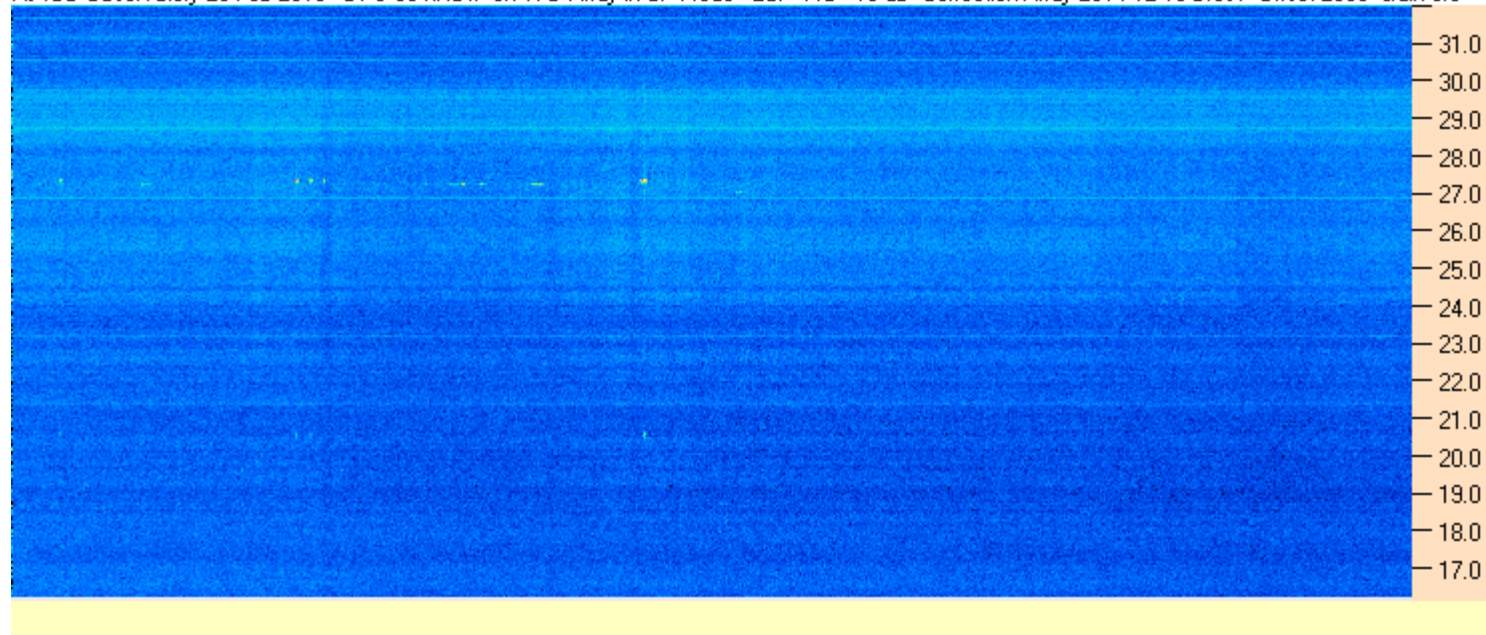

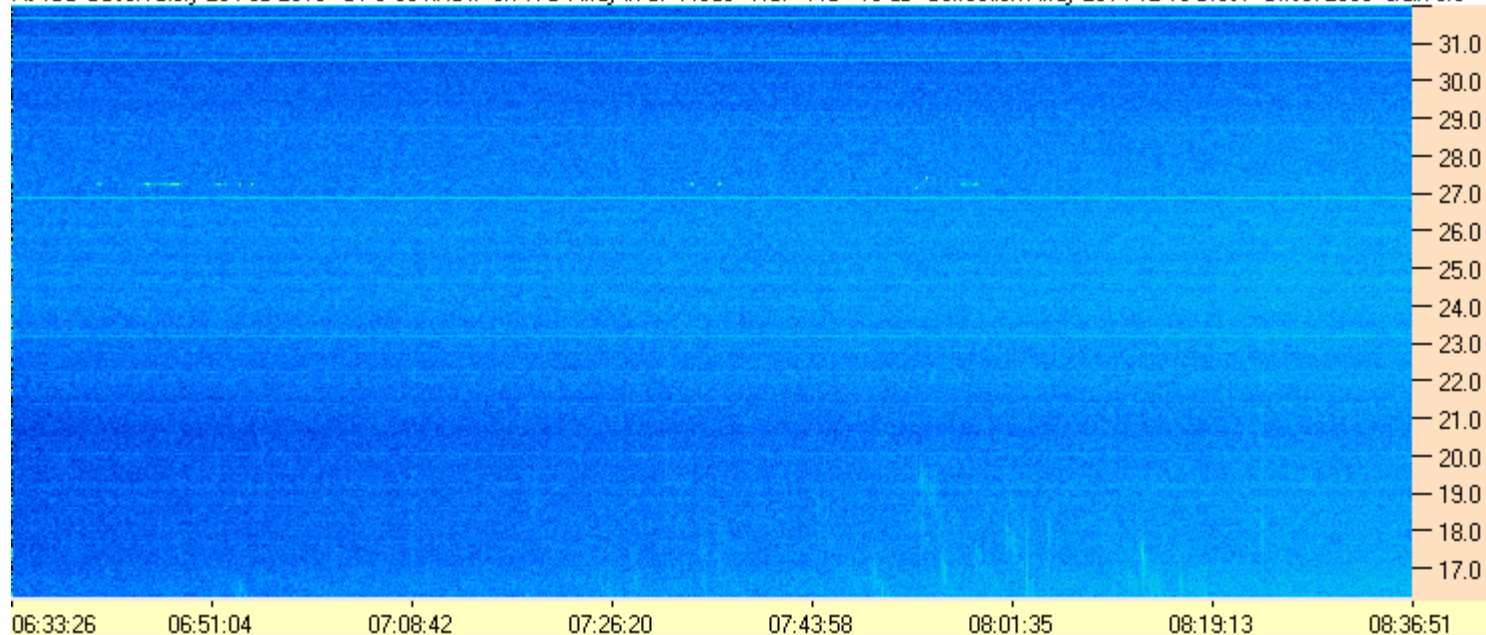
