RCP dominant N events 0717-0740 UTC from 16 to 20 MHz, negative drift emission envelopes.

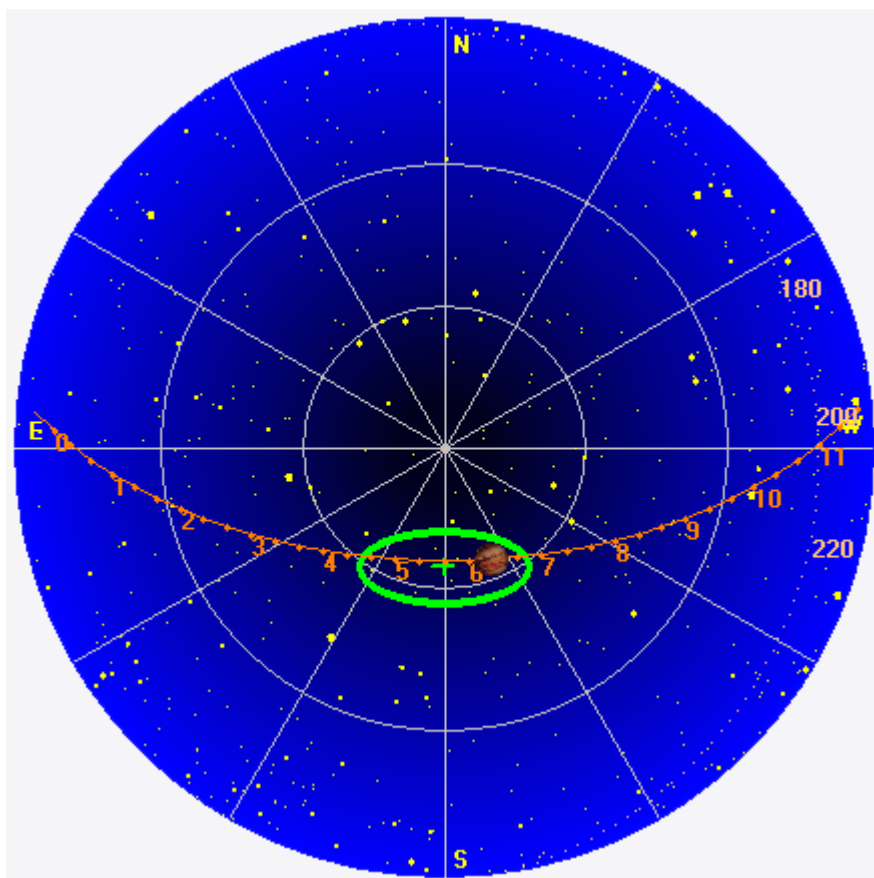
Jupiter was -11° to $+30^\circ$ off axis.

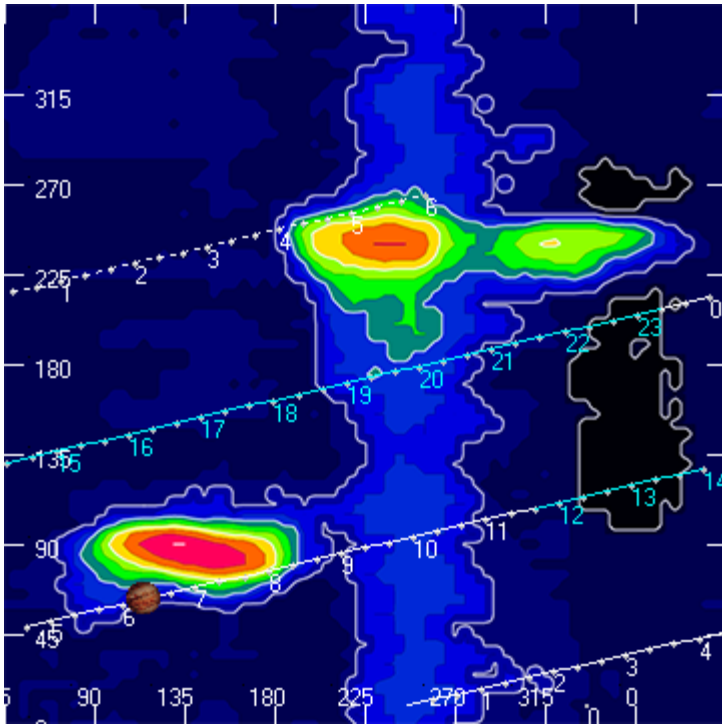
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 178° .

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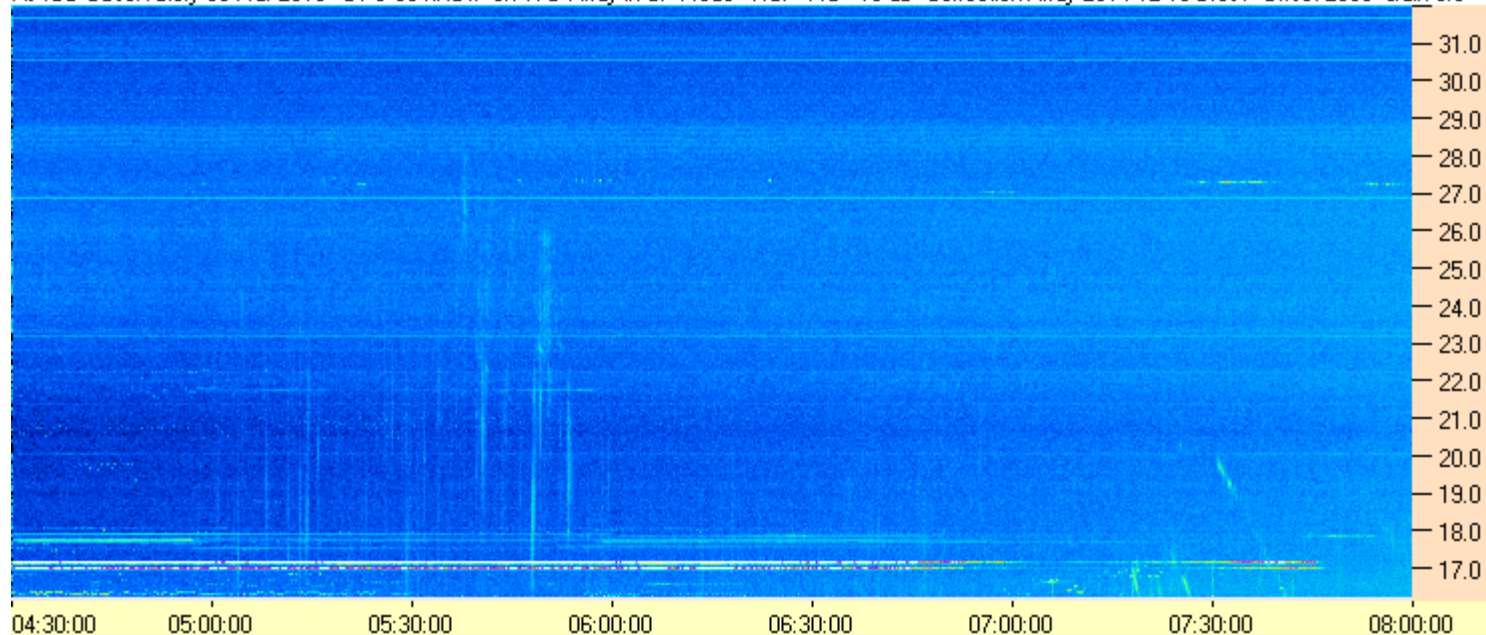
