LCP dominant L bursting 0724-0806 UTC from 16 to 19 MHz, positive drift emission envelope. (Io-D)

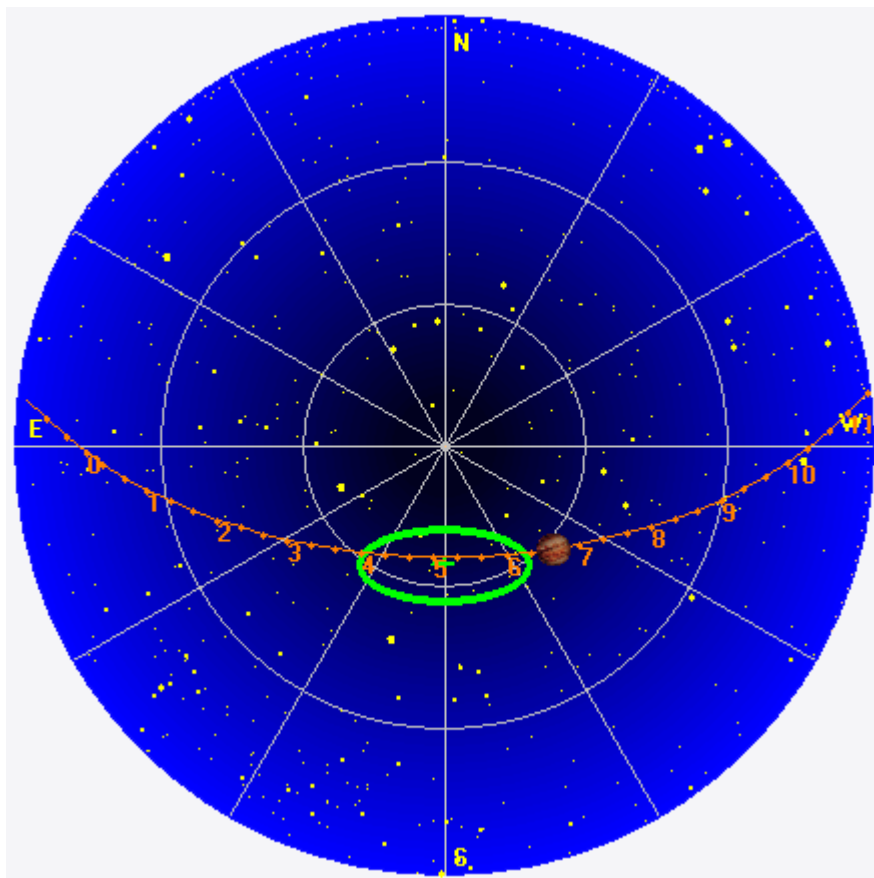
Jupiter was -2° to $+44^\circ$ off axis.

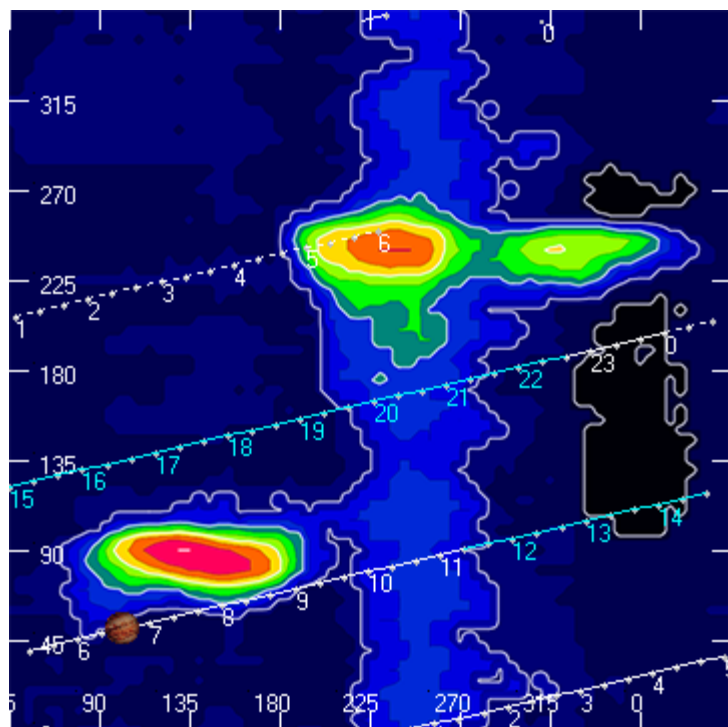
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 171° .

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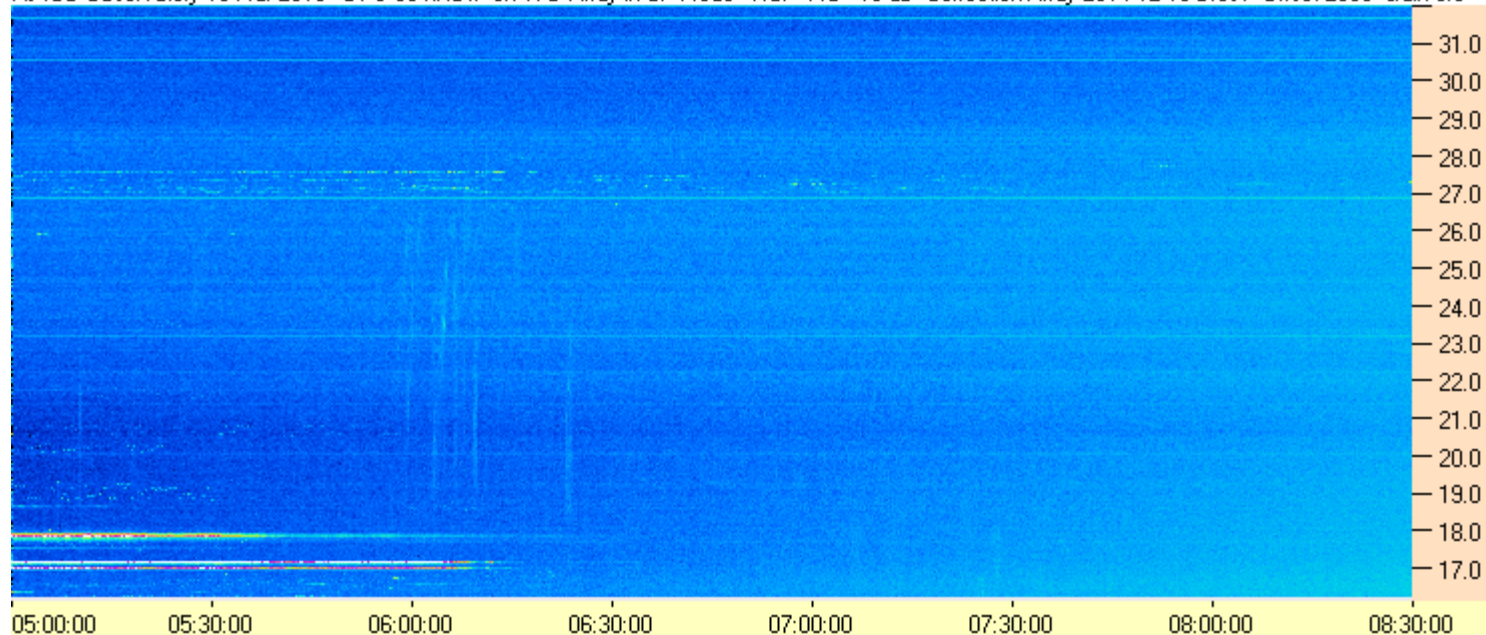

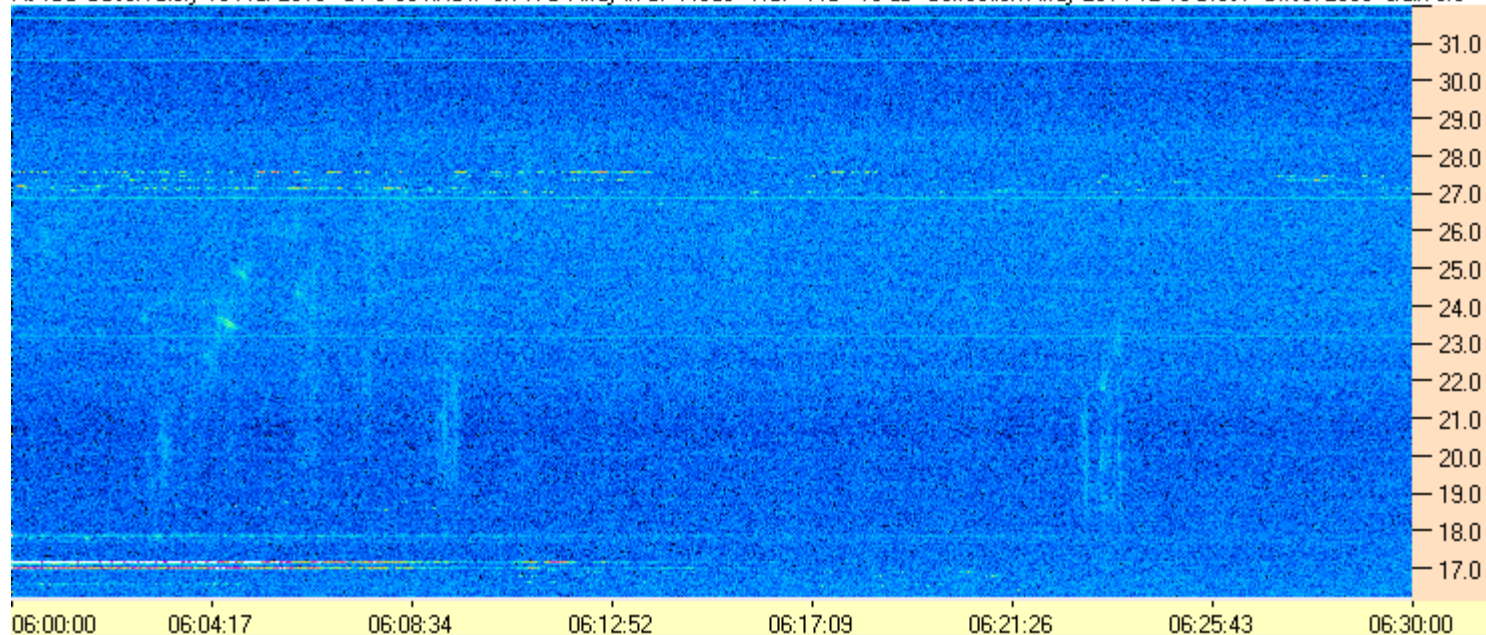
