RCP dominant L bursting 0436-0513 UTC from 16 to 25 MHz, positive drift emission envelopes.

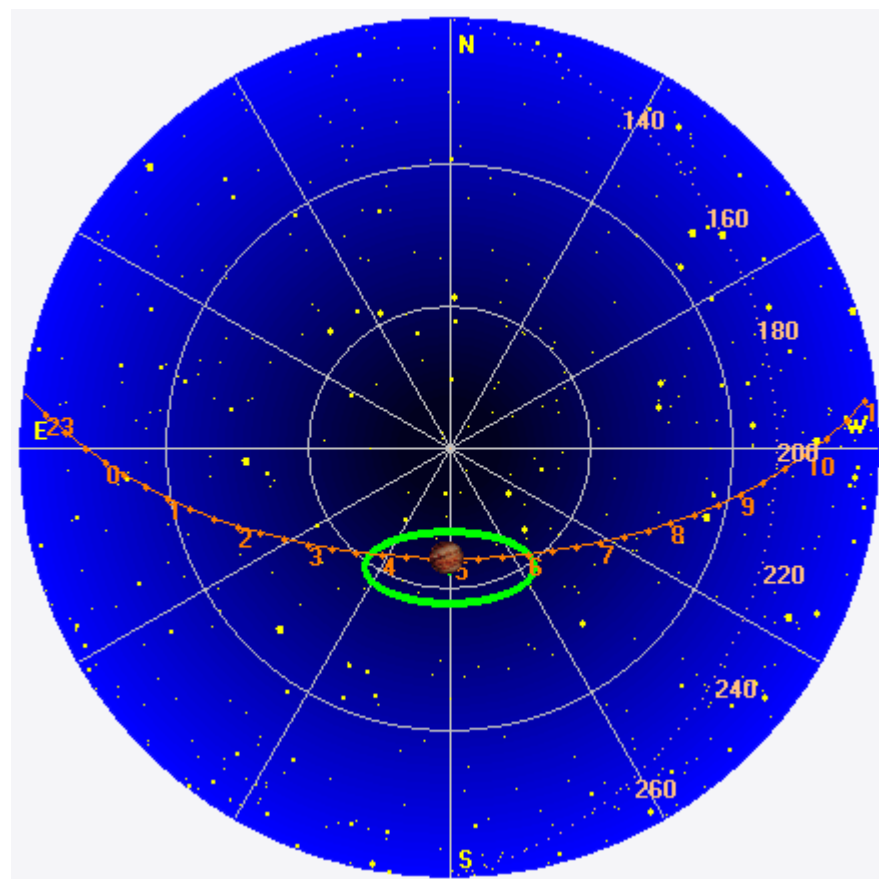
Jupiter was -5° to $+5^\circ$ off axis.

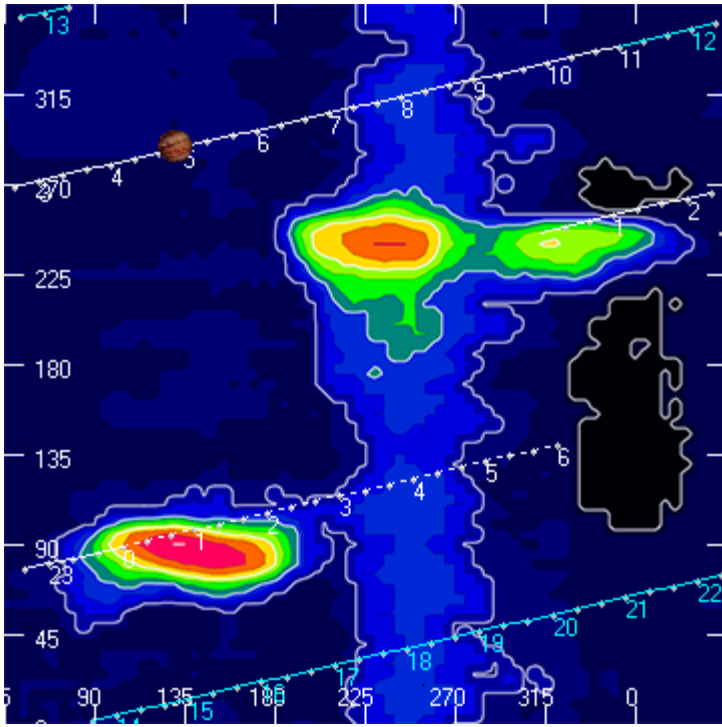
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 168° .

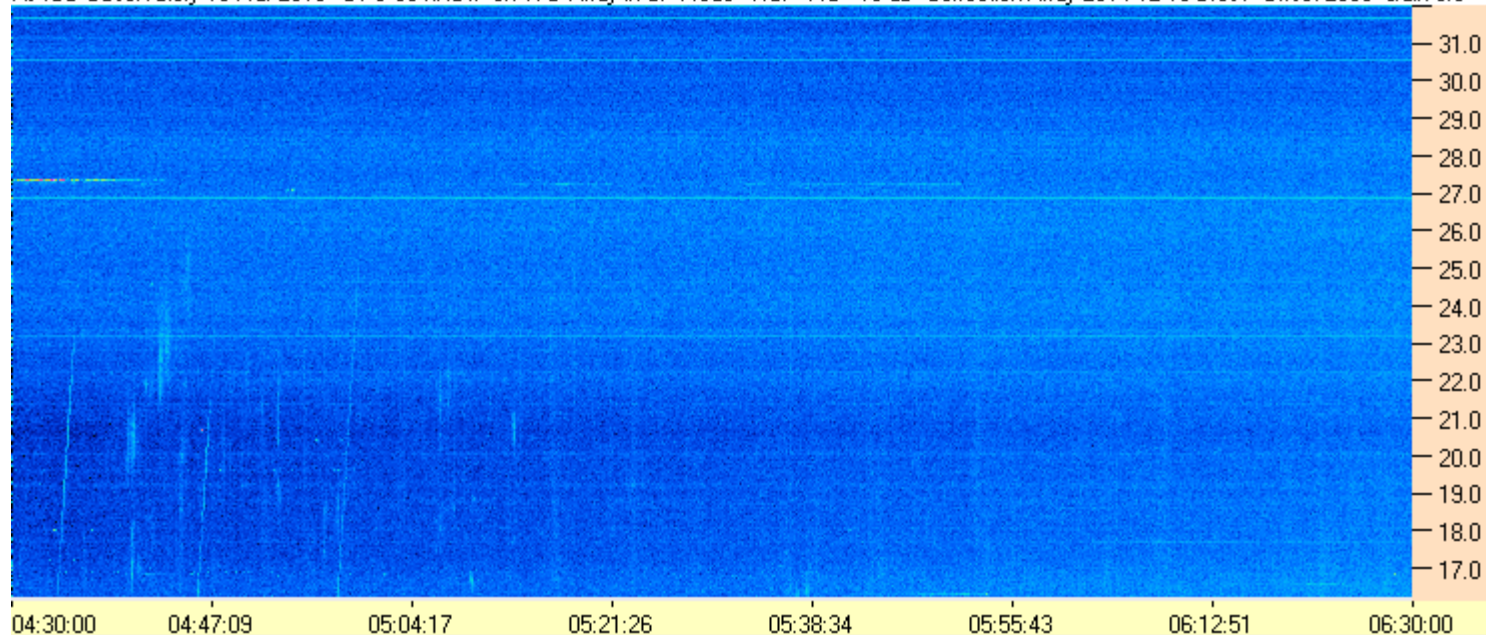

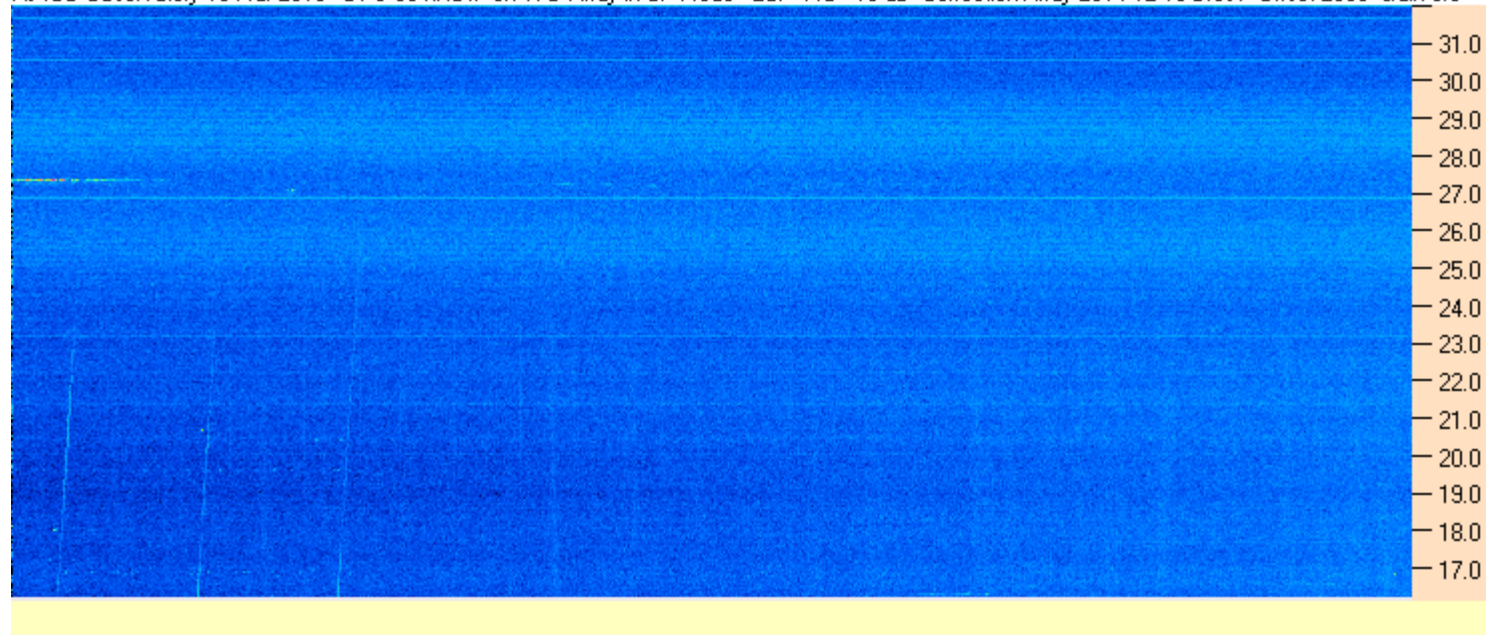




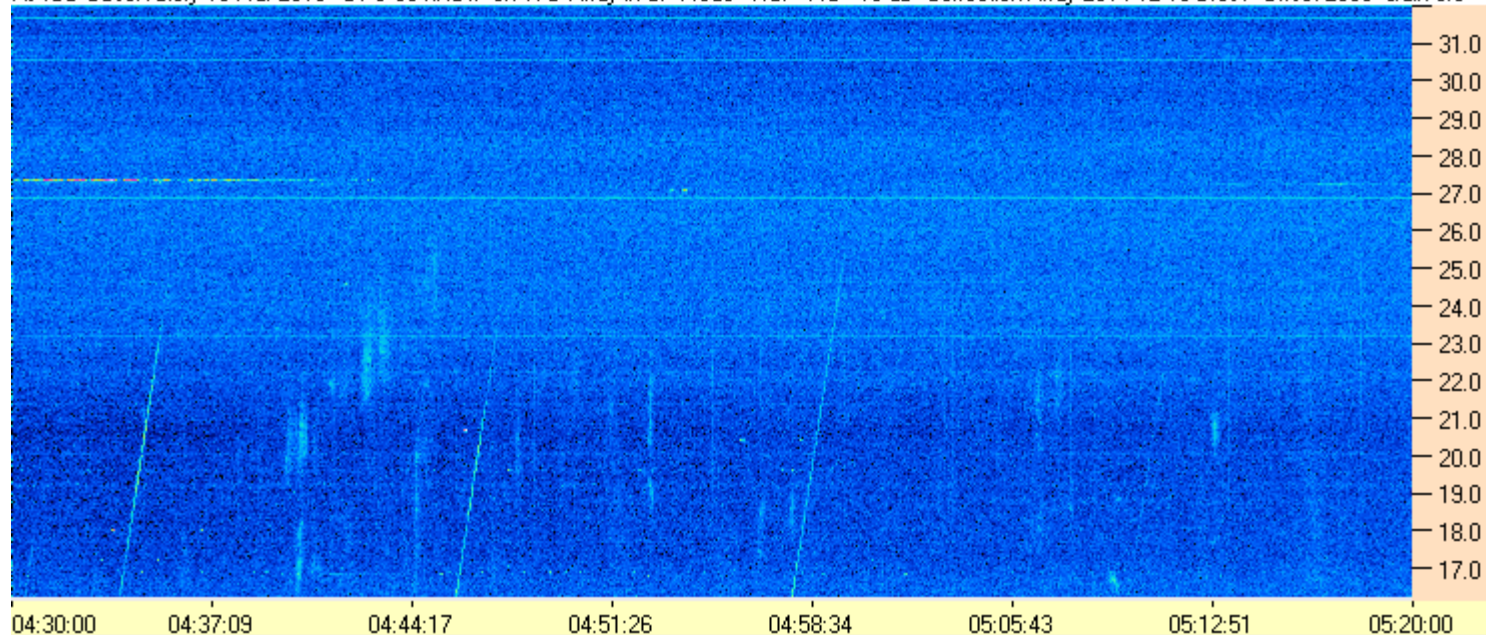
