RCP dominant L bursting 0457-0551 UTC from 16 to 28 MHz, negative drift emission envelopes. (non-Io-A)

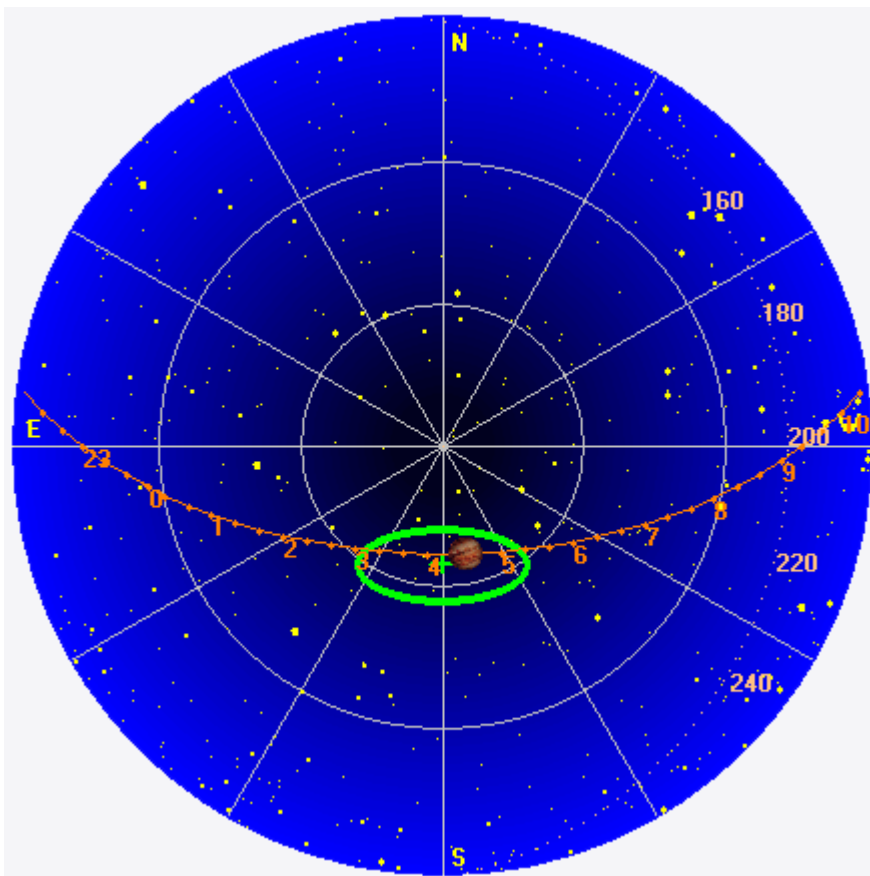
Jupiter was -15° to $+25^\circ$ off axis.

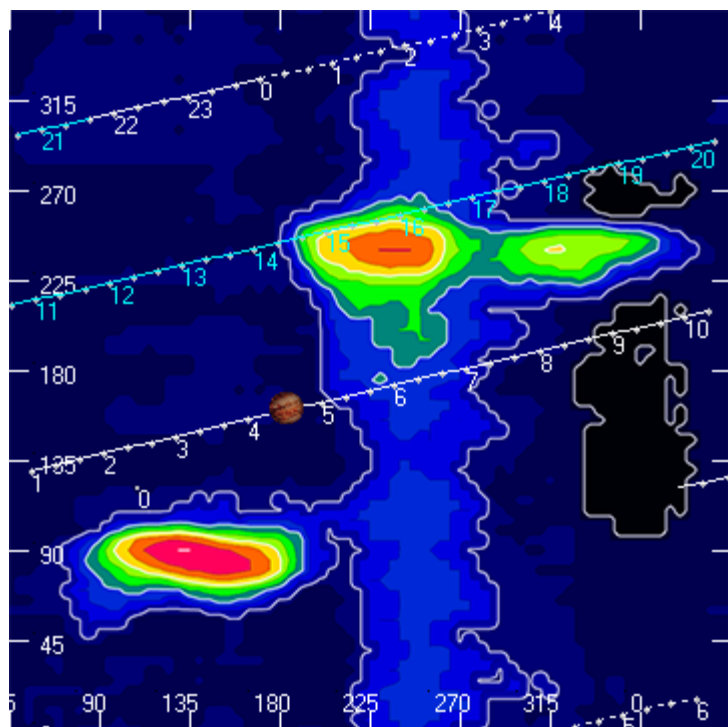
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 157° .

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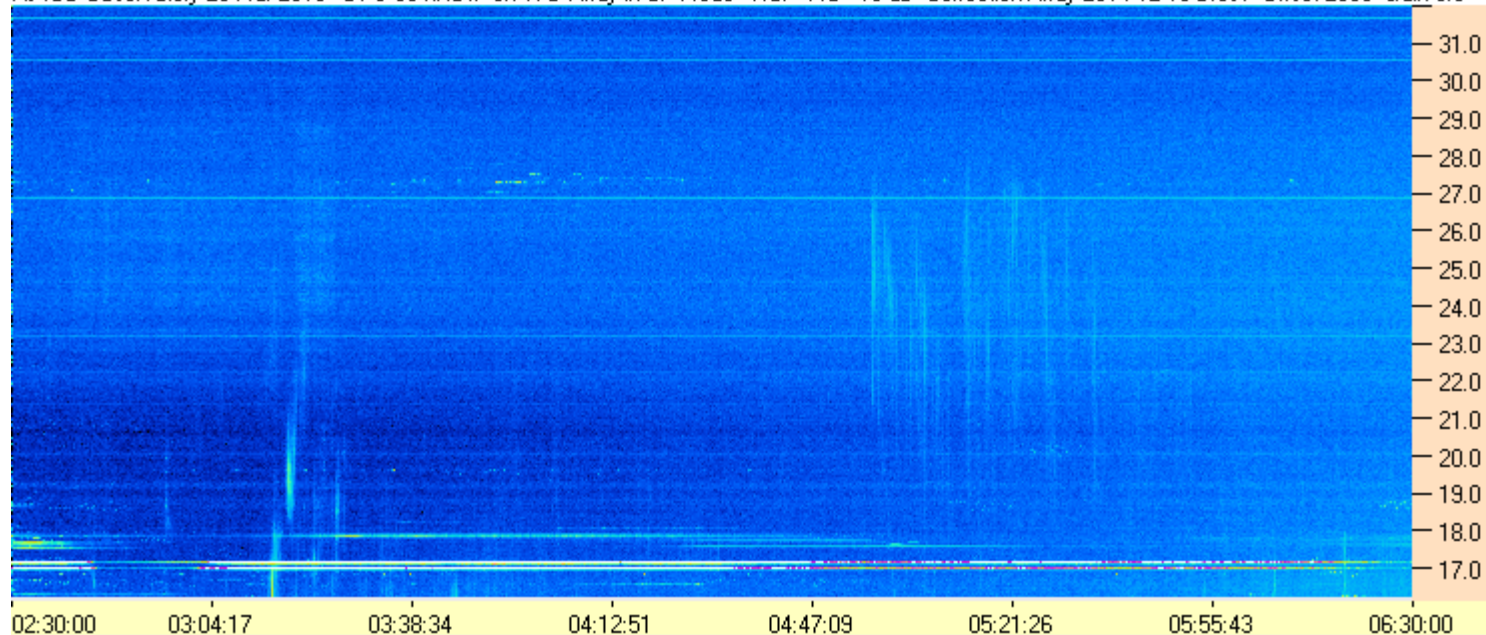

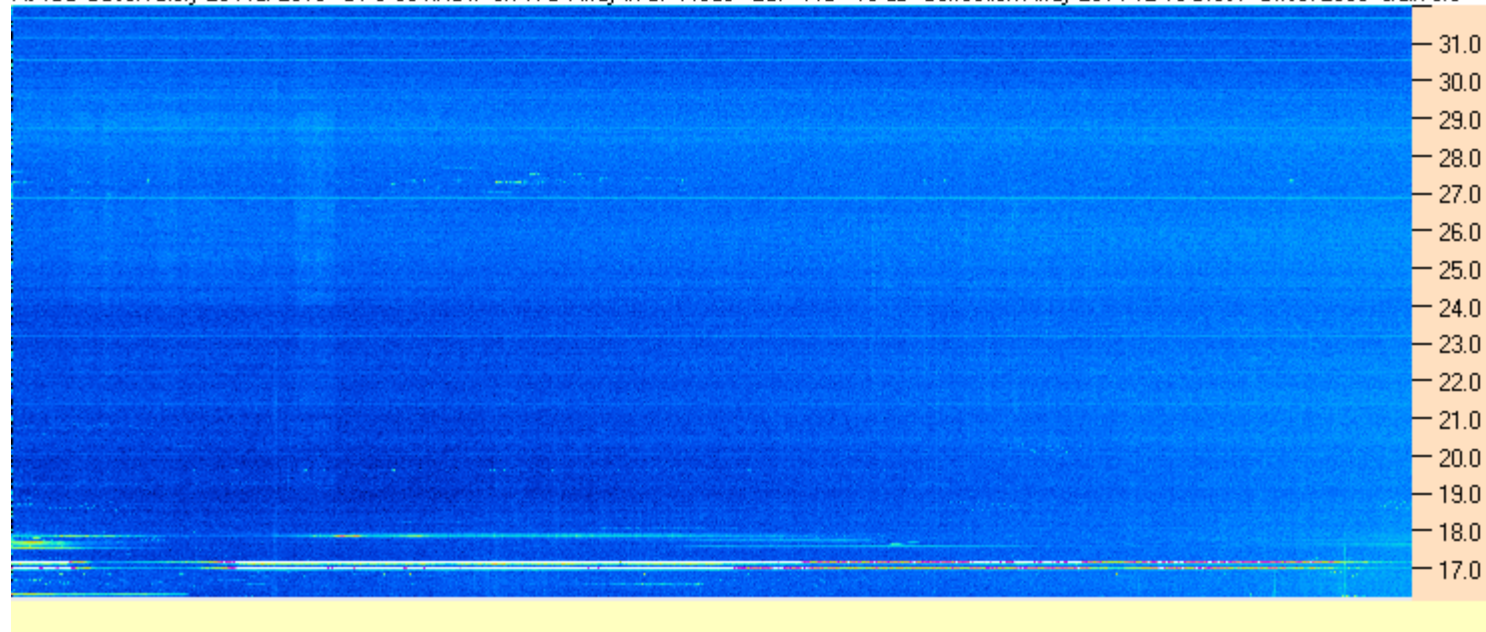

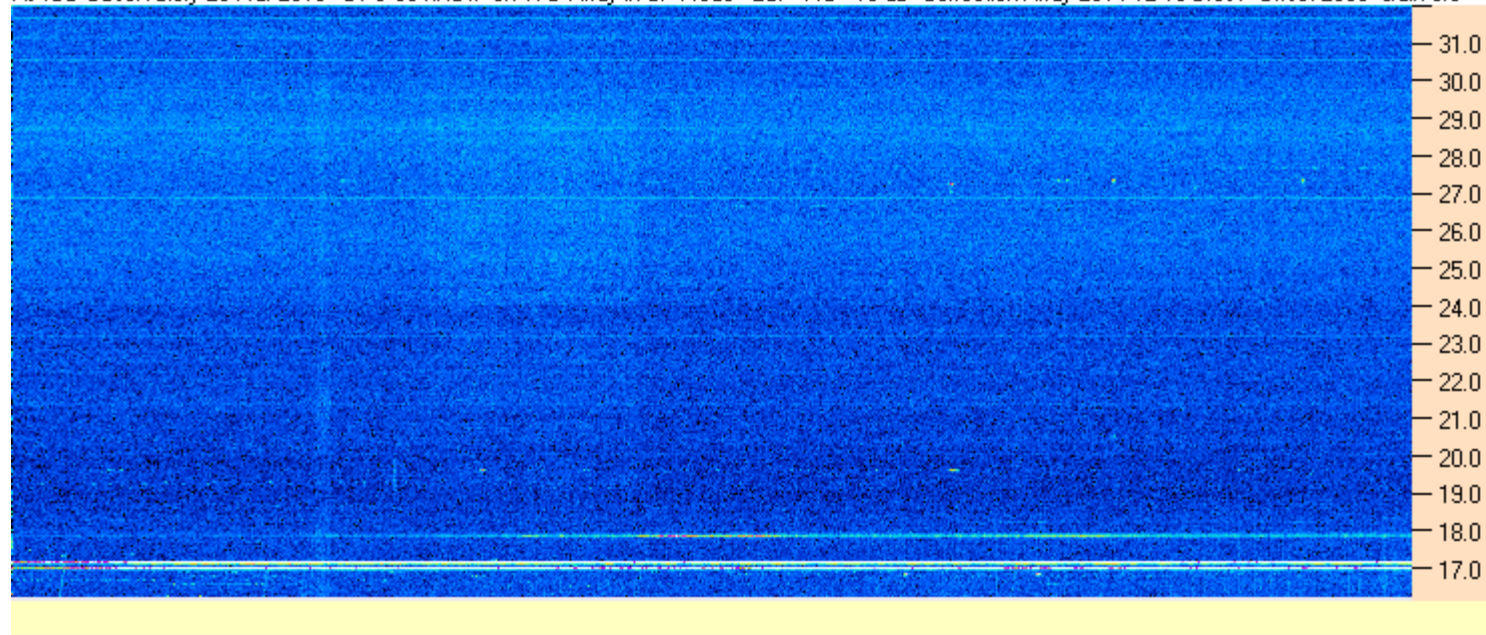

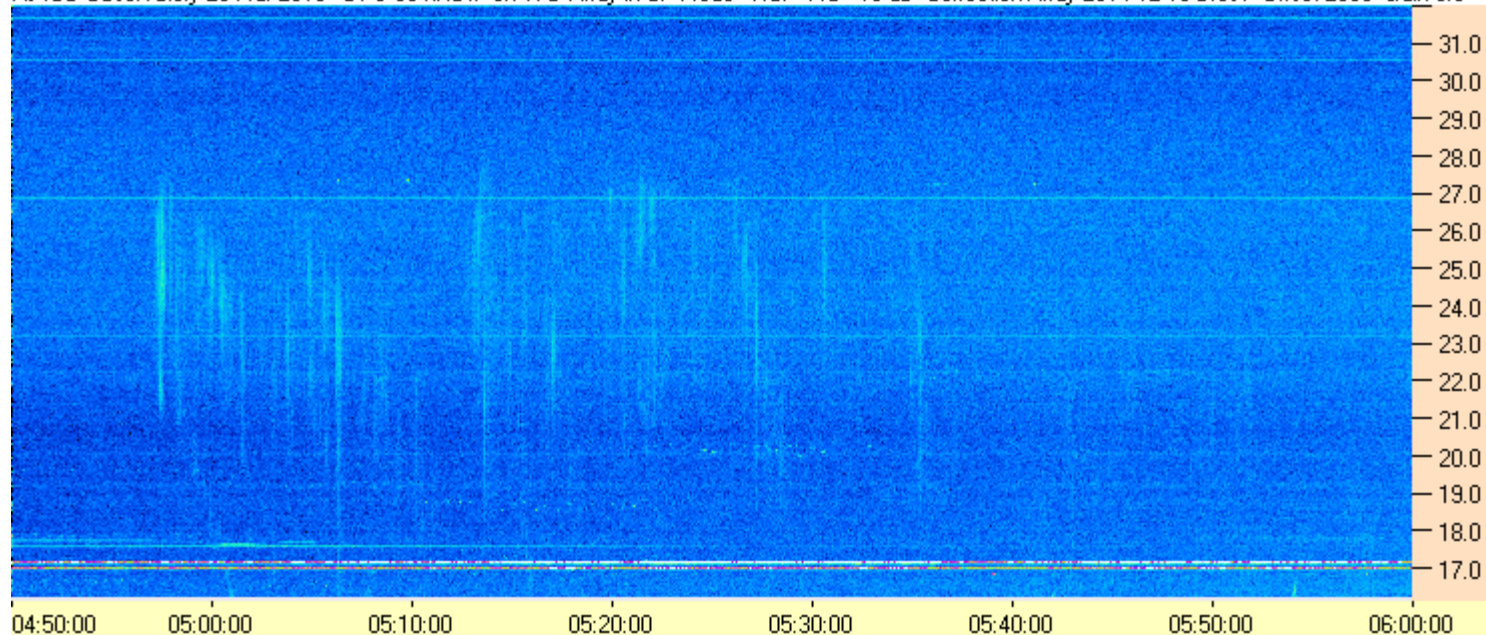
