RCP dominant L bursting 0202-0333 UTC from 16 to 20 MHz, negative drift emission envelopes. (non-Io-A)

LCP dominant L bursting 0228-0508 UTC from 16 to 19 MHz, negative drift emission envelopes. (non-Io-C)

Weak intermittent line noise present throughout the night.

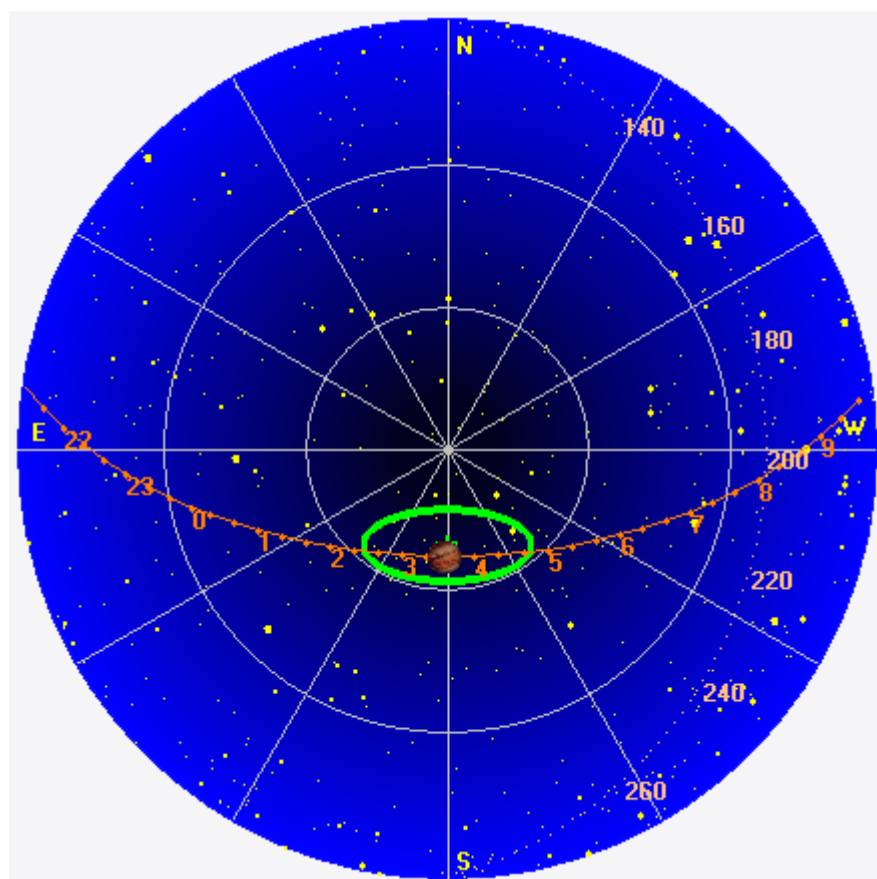
Jupiter was -24° to $+22^\circ$ off axis.

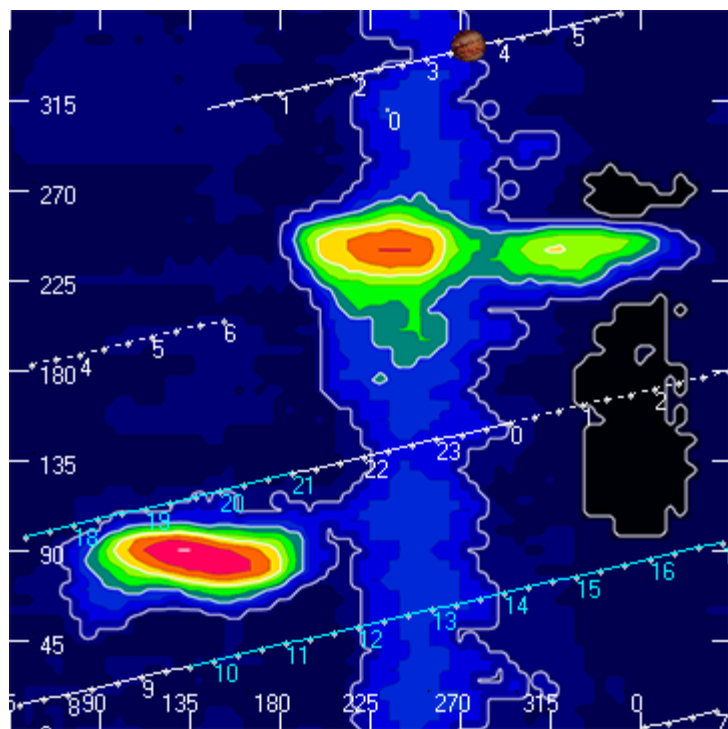
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 148° .

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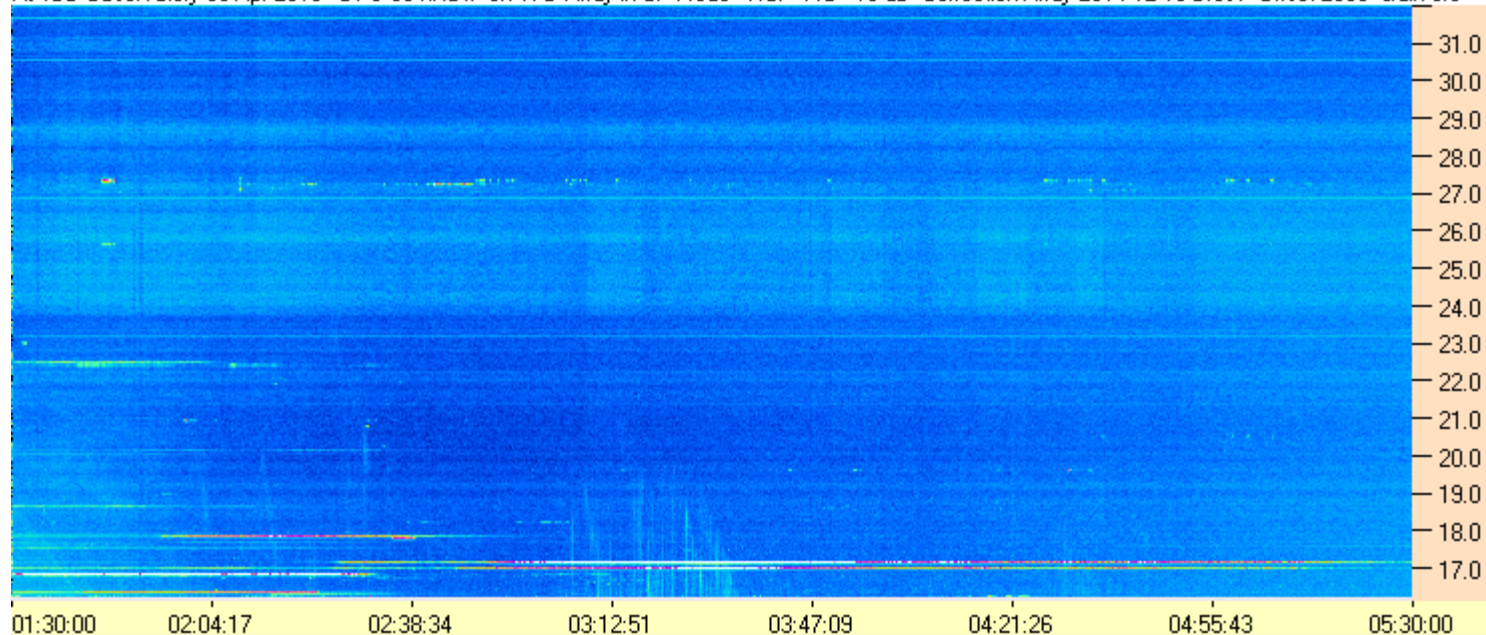

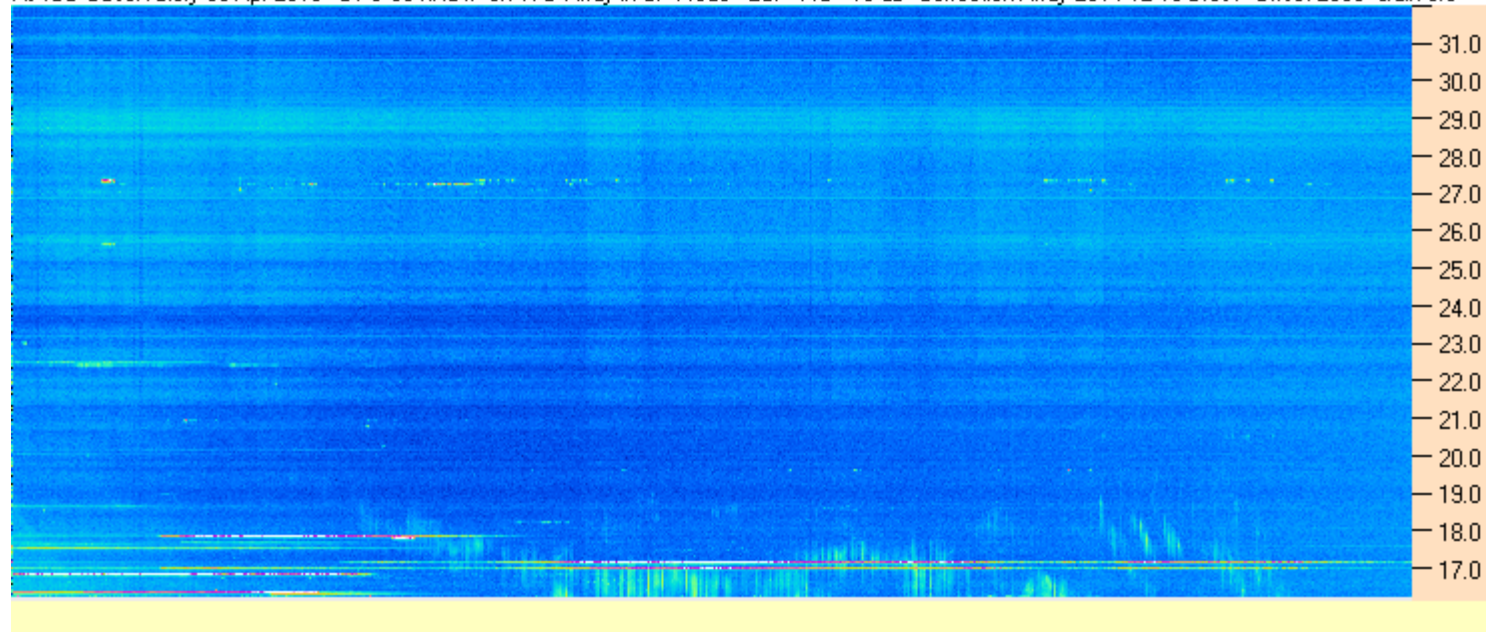




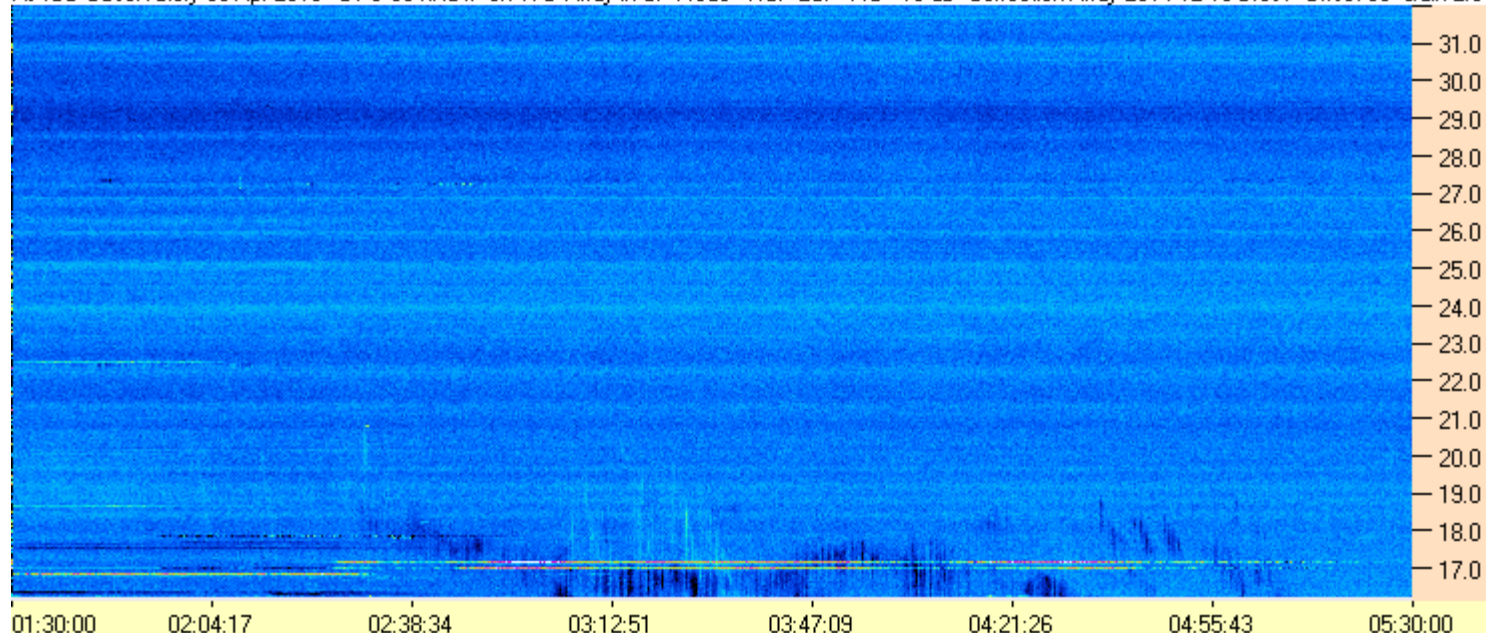
