LCP dominant N events 0130-0248 UTC from 16 to 19 MHz, negative drift emission envelopes. (Io-C)

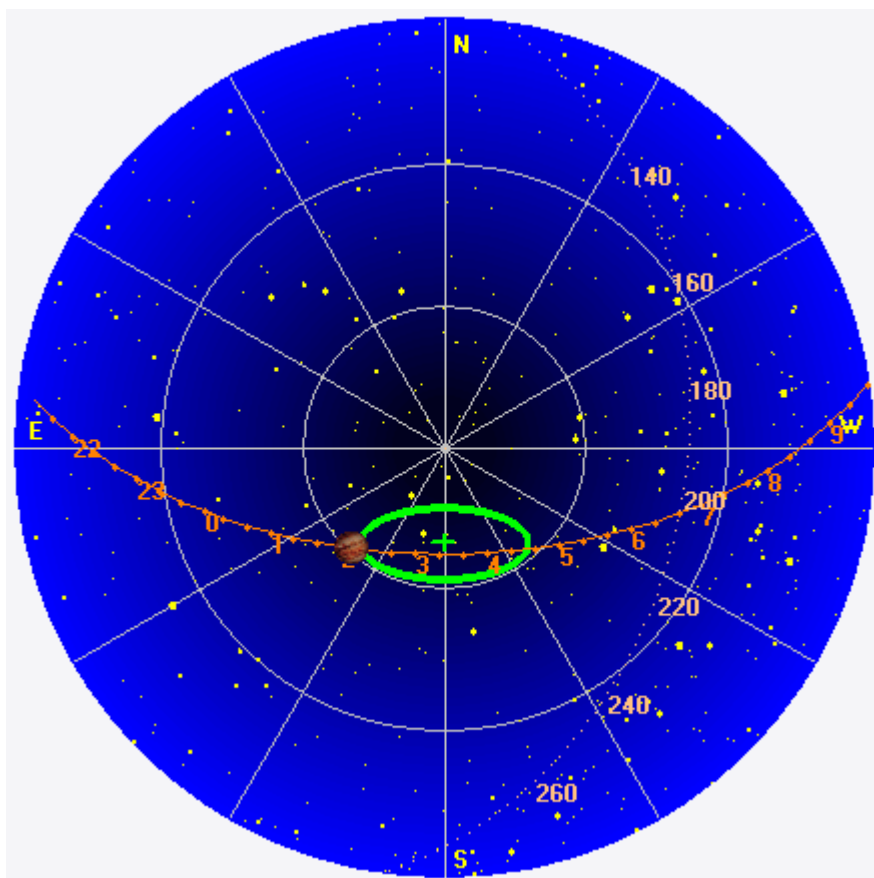
Jupiter was -29° to -9° off axis.

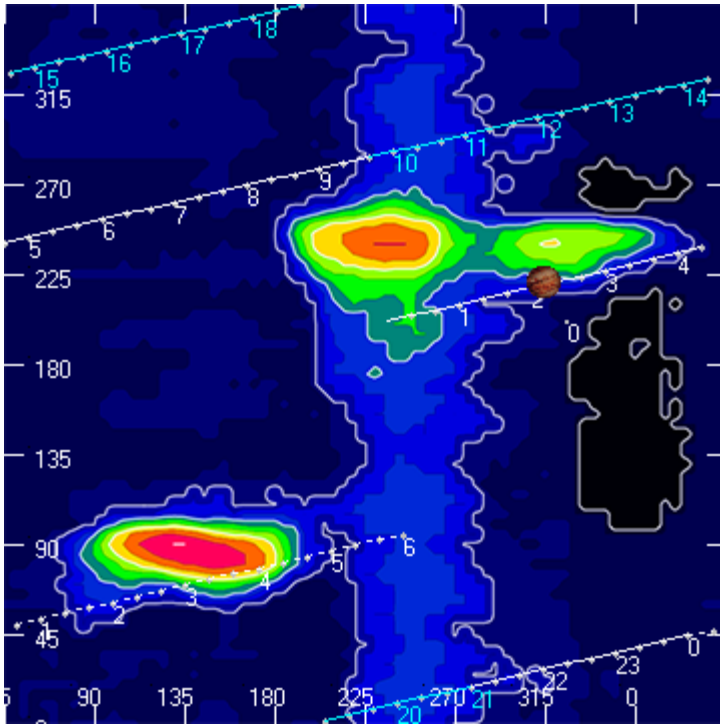
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 145° .

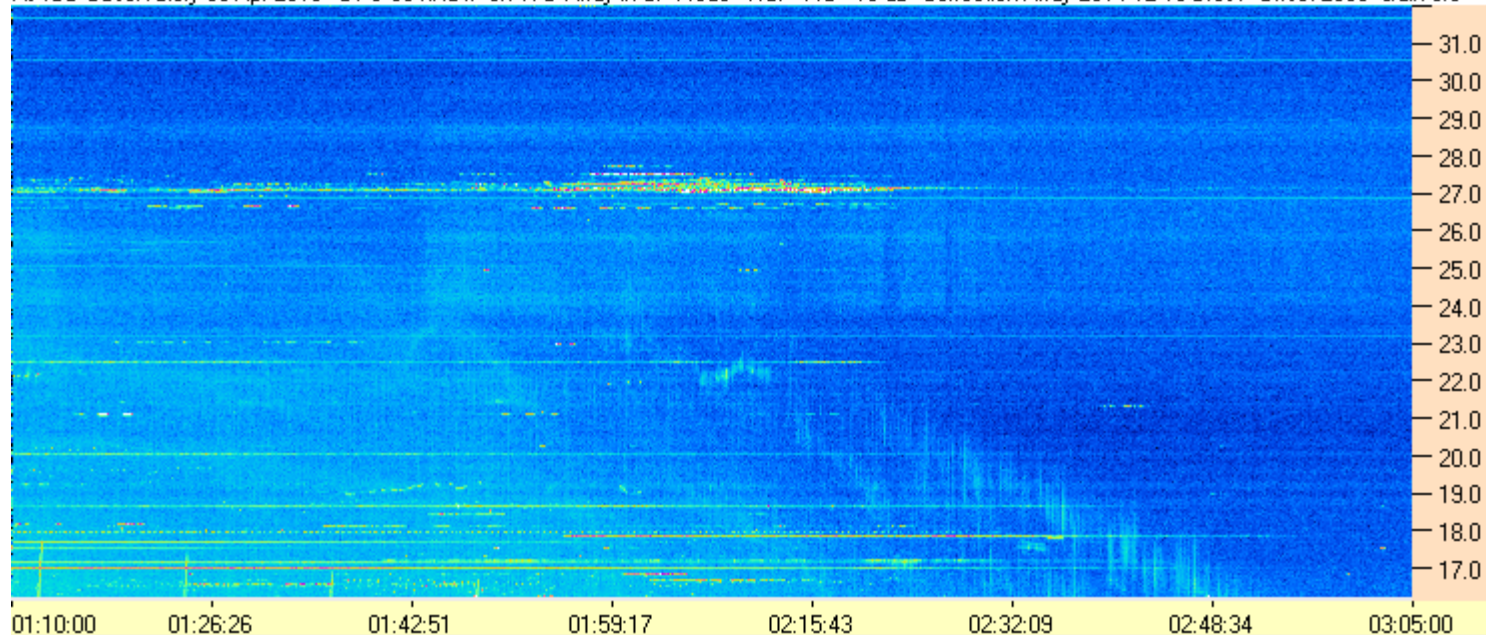

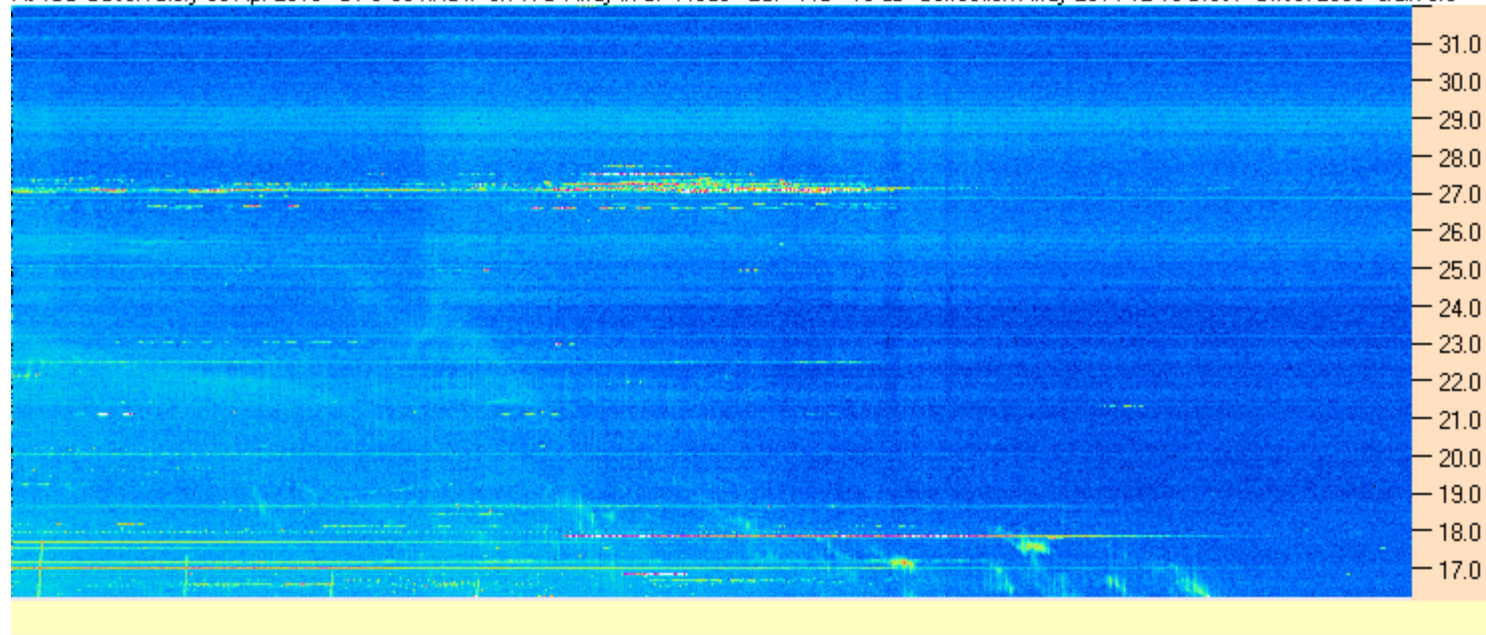




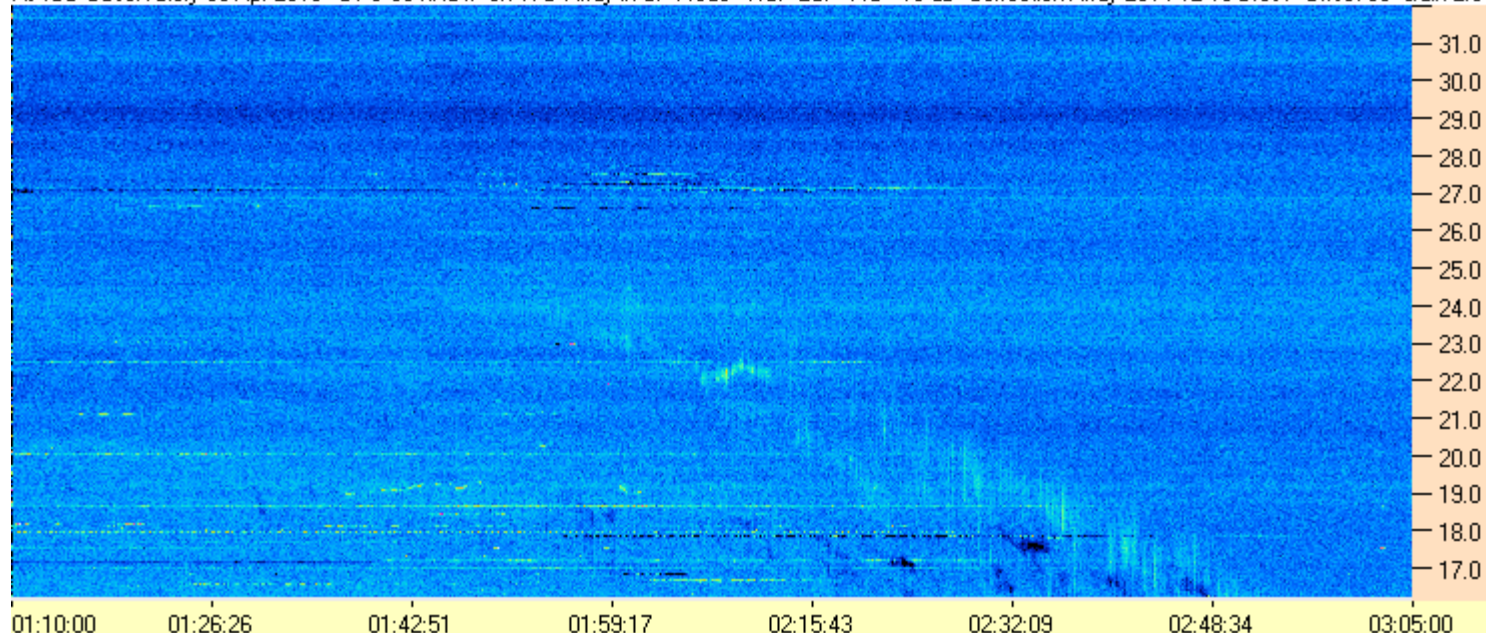
