LCP dominant N events 0200-309 UTC from 16 to 20 MHz, negative drift emission envelopes. (Io-C)

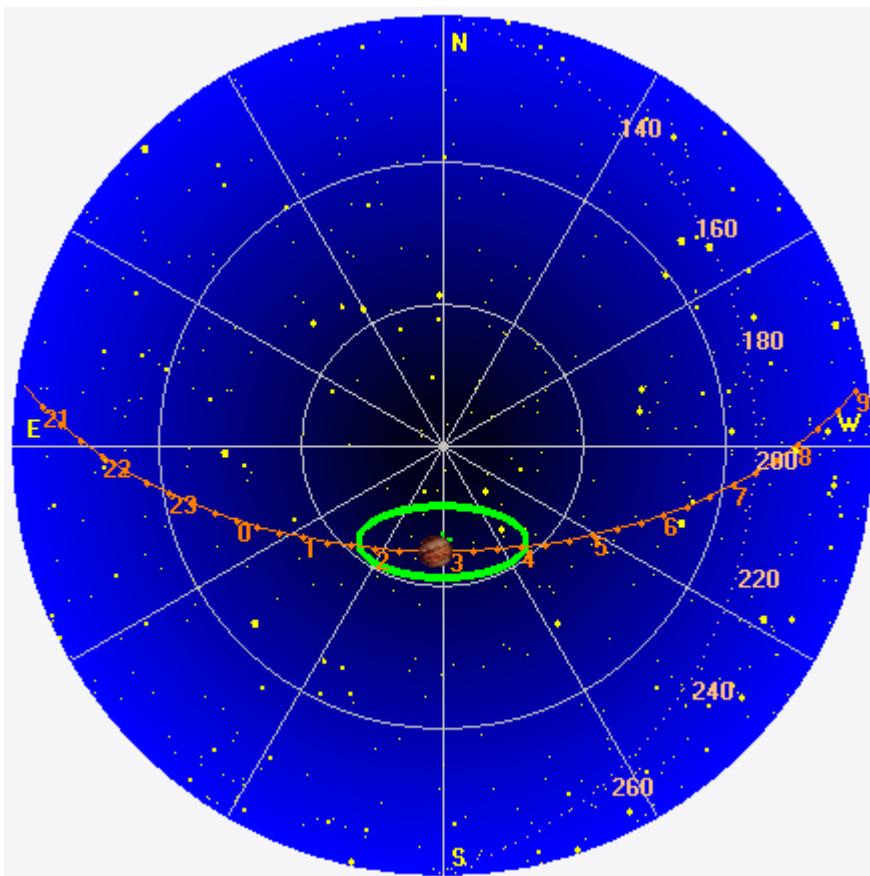
Jupiter was -14° to $+11^\circ$ off axis.

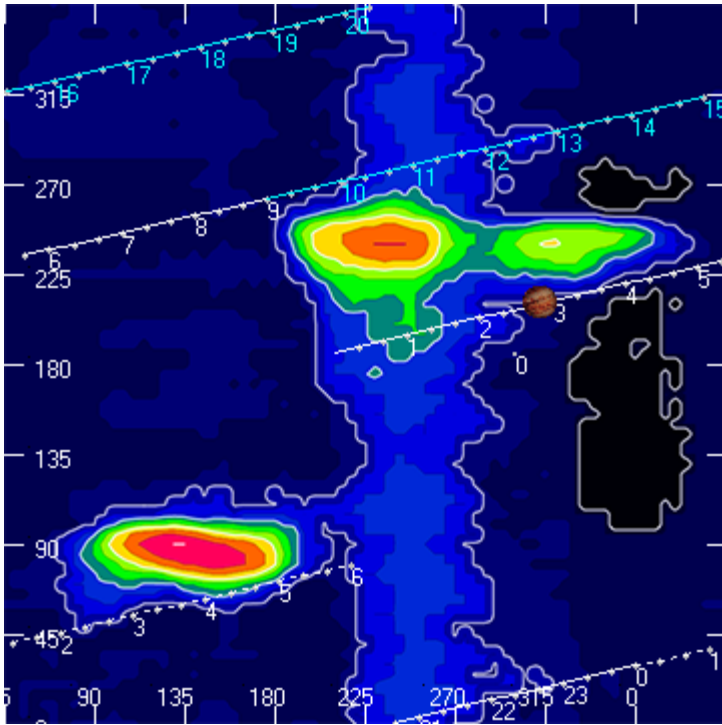
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 138° .

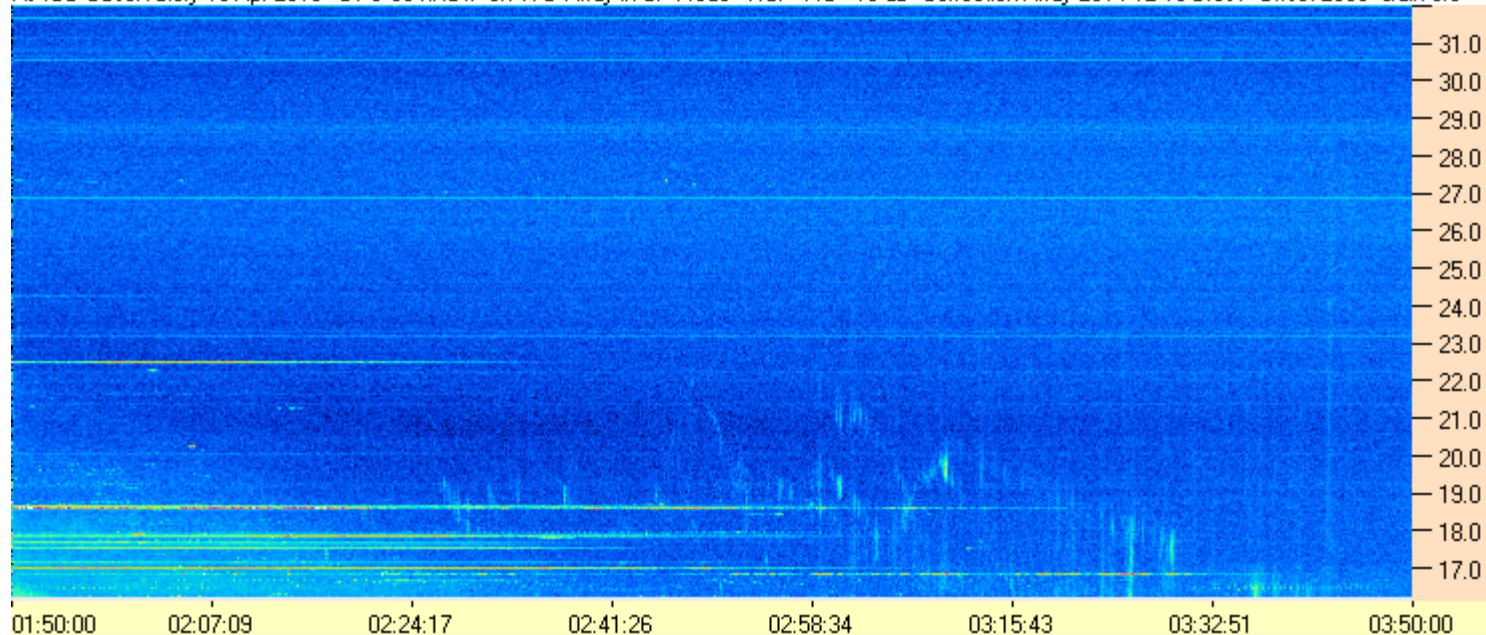

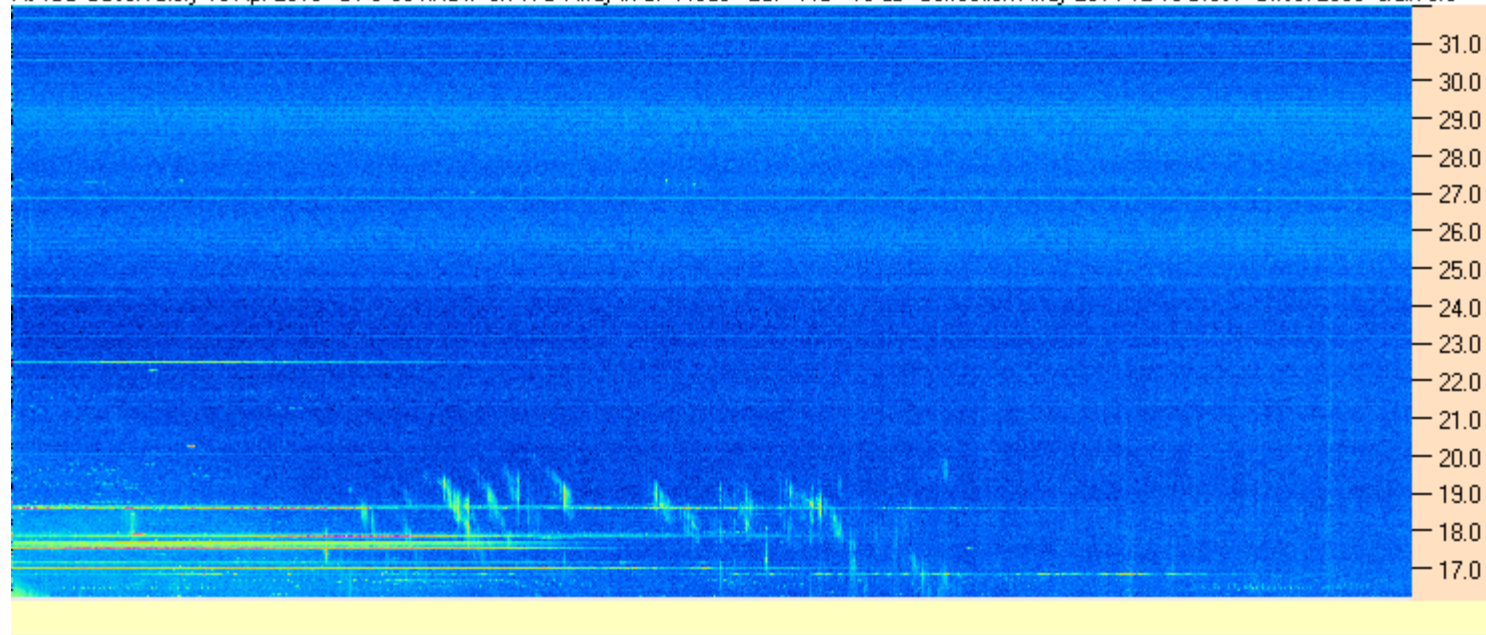




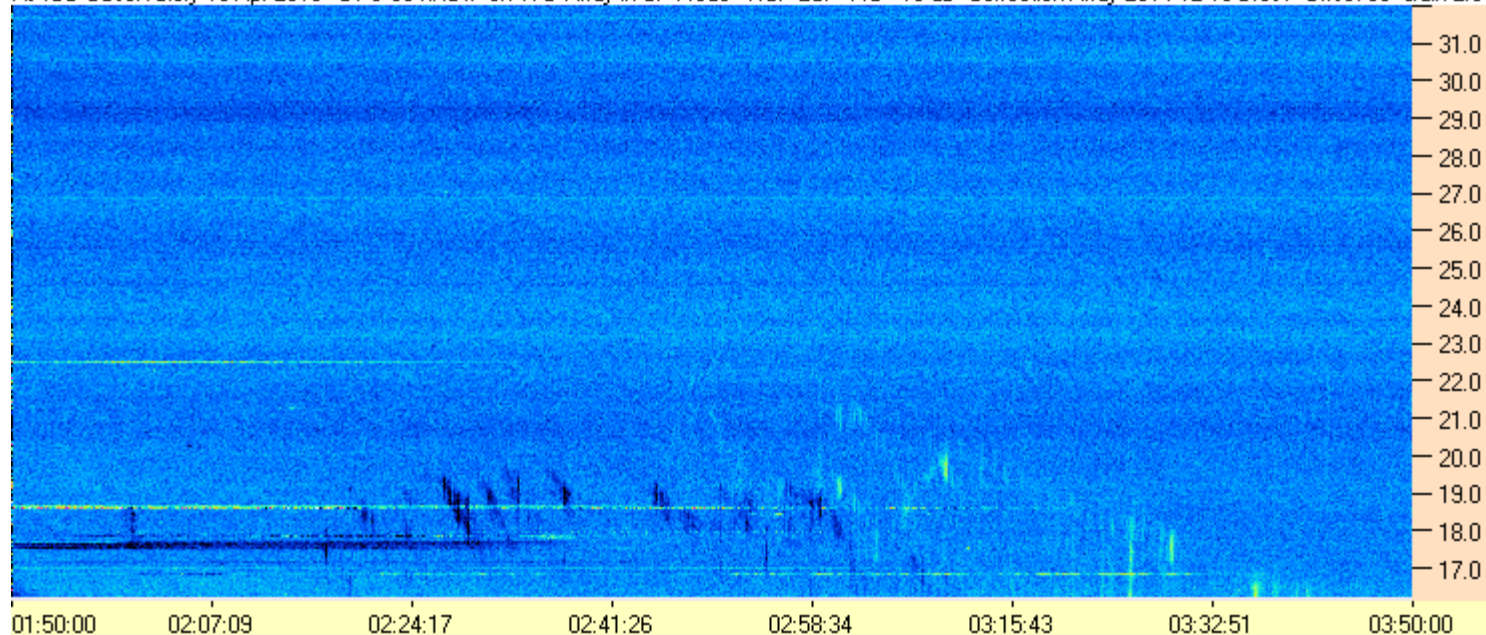
